

Irish Crochet Yoke

Material Required: 2 balls No. 80 crochet cotton, 1 No. 13 or 14 crochet hook.

Roses: Ch 6; join to form a ring. 1st Row: Ch 6; 1 dc in 1st ch of ring; * ch 3; 1 dc in next ch; repeat from * 3 times; ch 3; join. 2nd Row: Over each ch of 3 make 6 dc; 1 sc above the dc; join. 3rd Row: Ch 5; 1 sc fasten in back of sc of previous row; repeat 5 times; join. 4th Row: Over each ch of 5 make 8 dc; 1 sc in sc; repeat. 5th Row: Ch 7; 1 sc; fasten in back of sc of previous row; repeat; join. 6th Row: Over each ch of 7 make 10 dc; 1 sc in sc; repeat; join; break thread. Leaves: Ch 10; turn; skip 1 ch; 1 sc in each of next 9 st; ch 3; 1 sc in each of next 7 st down other side of ch; * ch 3; turn; 1 sc in each of the 7 sc of last row and 1 sc over the ch of 3; ch 3;

1 sc over ch of 3; 1 sc in each of next 6 st; ch 3; turn; 1 sc in each of 7 sc of last row; 1 sc over ch of 3; ch 3; 1 sc over ch of 3; 1 sc in each of next 6 st; repeat from * until you have 6 ribs on each side of center.

Join 2nd leaf to 1st in last row with sl st. Make 5 leaves and join to rose according to design. Make 3 leaves; join to rose for each shoulder. Lay roses and leaves on cambric on which is outlined the shape and size of yoke, baste subjects to cambric and fill in as follows: Join thread to rose at back of yoke; * ch 2; 1 pi (composed of 5 ch; 1 sc in the 1st of the 5 ch); ch 3; 1 pi; ch 2; 1 sc; repeat from *. Edge: 4 sc; 1 pi; repeat




Princess Boudoir Cap

Material Required: 2 balls pink knitting silk, 1¾ yards pink satin ribbon 1½ inches wide, ½ yard bobinett, 1 2/3 yards lace edging, 1 No. 7 crochet hook.

Ch 16; join; 40 sc in ring; join; ch 15; 1 sc in 2nd sc of ring; ch 15; skip 1 sc; 1 sc in next sc of ring; repeat from * 17 times; ch 7; 1 ltr (4 times over hook) in last sc of ring; ch 15; 1 sc over 1st ch of 15; * ch 15; 1 sc over next ch of 15; repeat from * 17 times; ch 7; 1 ltr; repeat as in previous row for 16

rows, widening enough to keep from capping by making a few extra loops with a ch of 15. Scallop: Join thread in sc of last row; ch 7; 1 ltr in same sc; * 1 tr in center of ch of 15; 3 pi of 6 ch each; 1 tr in same place as last tr; 1 ltr in next sc; ch 7; 1 sc in same sc; ch 7; 1 ltr in same sc as last ltr; repeat from *.



Candle Shade

Material Required: 1 bolt white coronation braid, 1 ball pink crochet cotton No. 10, 1 ball white crochet cotton No. 15, small piece of delicate pink silk to cover wire frame, 1 No. 9 crochet hook.

1st Row: Cross three torpedoes of coronation braid; outside of this cross 4 torpedoes; join thread over narrow part; ch 4; 2 tr; * ch 7; 3 tr over next oval formed with braid; repeat from * 14 times; ch 7; join. There should be 16 ovals in all. 2nd Row: Ch 3: 1 dc above 2 tr; * ch 2; skip 2 ch; 3 dc; repeat from * 30 times; ch 2; join. 3rd Row: Ch 5; 3 dc over ch of 2; * ch 2; 3 dc over next ch of 2; repeat from * 29 times; ch 2; 2 dc; join. 4th and 5th Rows: Repeat 3rd row 2 times. 6th Row: Ch 3; 1 dc; * ch 1; 2 dc; repeat from * around. 7th, 8th and 9th Rows: Repeat 6th row 3 times. 10th Row: 1 sc over ch; (2 tr; 1 pi; 1 tr; 1 pi; 1 tr; 1 pi; 2 tr) over next ch; 1 sc over next ch; repeat; break thread. Lower Part of Shade: 1 sc over the narrow part of two outside ovals; ch 2; 1 sc over narrow part of inner oval; ch 6; 1 sc over narrow part of inner oval; ch 2; 1 sc over narrow part of two outside ovals, etc. Repeat around; join; break thread. Join thread over lower part of outside oval; ch 5; 5 tt; * ch 8; 6 tt over next oval; repeat from * 14 times; ch 8; join. Sl st to center of tt; 1 sc about tt; 12 dc over ch of 8; * 1 sc above next cluster of tr; 12 dc over next ch; repeat from * 13 times; join; 1 sc above sc; (2 dc; 1 pi; 1 tr; 1 pi; 1 tr; 1 pi; 2 dc) above 4 dc; 1 sc between 6th and 7th dc; (2 dc; 1 pi; 1 tr; 1 pi; 1 tr; 1 pi; 2 dc) above 9th dc; 1 sc above sc; etc; repeat around; break thread. Balls: Ch 4; join; 8 sc; 3 rows of 16 sc; then decrease and end with 1 sc; fill with cotton. Fringe: Wind thread over cardboard 21/2 inches wide 20 times, making 40 threads. Cut and tie.

Marie Antoinette Pattern

(Page 6)

Material Required: 6 balls No. 15 cotton. (For 12 scallops.) No. 10 or 11 crochet hook.

1/2 Loop means: ch 8; sl st in 4th ch from hook; ch 4. Loop means: ch 8; sl st in 4th ch from hook; ch 12; sl st in 4th ch from hook; ch 4.

1st Row: Ch 870; 1 dc in 9th ch from hook; * ch 6; 1 dc in top of dc just made. (This forms a small arch.) Skip 2 on foundation ch; 1 dc in 3rd ch; ch 3; skip 2 on foundation ch; 1 dc in 3rd ch; repeat from *.

NOTE: 12 small arches are required for 1 scallop. For a 12 scallop centerpiece make 144 arches; join. (For every additional scallop add 12 arches. A 15 scallop centerpiece requires 180 arches, etc.)


2nd Row: Sl st to center of 1st arch; ch 8; 1 sl st in 4th ch from hook; (for picot) ch 12; 1 sl st into 4th ch from hook; ch 4; skip 1 arch; 1 sc in next arch. (This forms a long arch which hereafter will be called a loop.) Repeat loops around; join.

3rd Row: SI st to center of 1st loop; * * * 1 loop; fasten to center of 2nd loop with 1 sc (through ch); 1 loop; fasten to center of next loop with 1 sc; ½ loop; 1 ltr into next loop; for 1st petal of daisy; ch 11; skip 1st ch from hook; 1 sc in 2nd ch; 7 dc in following 7 chains; 1 sc in next ch; 1 sl st in next; turn; 1 sc in each st of petal; 1 sl st into point; ch 12 for 2nd petal; make 2nd petal same as 1st; leaving 1 ch between 1st and 2nd petals for daisy center; 1 ltr to left into same ch as 1st ltr was made; ½ loop; fasten with sc to center of 5th loop of 2nd row; 1 loop to center of 6th loop of 2nd row; ½ loop and 1 ltr to 7th loop of 2nd row.

4th Row: Turn; 1 loop to center of 2nd loop of 3rd row; ½ loop and 1 ltr to point of 2nd petal; ch 11; 1 sc in base or end of 2nd petal; 2 dc in ch between 1st 2 petals; 1 sc in base of 1st petal; ch 11; 1 ltr to point of 1st petal; ½ loop to center of loop of 3rd row to left; ½ loop and 1 ltr to center of next loop of 3rd row: turn.

5th Row: 1 loop; fasten with sc in beginning of the ch of 11; on the ch of 11 make the 3rd petal of daisy as follows: Skip 1st ch; 1 sc in next ch; 1 dc in next; 5 tc in following 5 chains; 1 dc in next; 1 sc in next; 1 sc in 1st sc of center of daisy; 2 dc in each of the 2 dc of center; 1 sc in last sc of the center; make 4th petal on next 11 ch same as 3rd; ½ loop and 1 ltr into center of loop of the 4th row to left; turn. ½ loop; ch 11; fasten with sl st into 1st sc of center of daisy; turn; make 5th petal on ch 11 same as 1st petal; thus (1 sc; 7 dc; 1 sc; 1 sl st; turn; sc back on petal; sl st into end). Sl st into 1st dc in center of daisy; ch 11; 1 ltr to point of 5th petal; 6th petal on ch of 11 same as preceding; sl st into next dc in center; sc back te




Baby Bonnet

Material Required: 2 balls No. 40 crochet cotton, 1 No. 11 or 12 crochet hook.

Ch 25; skip 1 ch; 24 sc; 3 sc in side of last sc; 22 sc on opposite side; turn; ch 2; 23 sc, taking up back st to form a rib; 3 sc in next sc; 22 sc up opposite of leaf; turn; ch 2; 23 sc; 3 sc in base; 22 sc up other side, continue crocheting in this manner until the leaf has 5 ribs on each side of center rib; break thread. Make 6 more of such leaves. In making last row of leaf join to preceding one with sl st. Squares: Ch 10; skip 1 ch; 8 sc in following 8 ch; 2 sc in last ch; turn; * ch 1; 10 sc, taking up back st to form a rib; turn; ch 1; skip 1 sc; 8 sc; 2 sc in last sc; turn; repeat from * 3 times; join in sl st between the 2 leaves; break thread; make 6 more squares. 1st Row: Join thread in point of leaf; ch 7; sl st in 4th ch for pi; ch 7; sl st in 4th ch for pi; ch 3; 1 sc in 2nd square (ch 3, 1 pi, ch 3, 1 pi, ch 3); 1 sc in next corner of square (ch 3, 1 pi, ch 3, 1 pi, ch 3); 1 sc in next corner of square

(ch 3, 1 pi, ch 3, 1 pi, ch 3); 1 sc in point of leaf, repeat around. 2nd Row: Make 1 more row with pi. 3rd Row: 4 tr; ch 3; 4 tr; repeat. 4th Row: Same as 2nd. Rose for Edge: Ch 6; join. 1st Row: Ch 6; 1 dc in ring; ch 3; 1 dc; repeat 3 times; ch 3; join. 2nd Row: Over each ch of 3 make 1 sc; 8 dc; 1 sc. 3rd Row: Ch 5; 1 sc between petals; repeat 5 times. 4th Row: Over each ch of 5 make (1 sc; 1 dc; 7 tr; 1 dc; 1 sc). 5th Row: Ch 7; 1 sc between petals; repeat 5 times. 6th Row: Over each ch make (1 sc; 1 dc; 1 tr; 7tt; 1 tr; 1 dc; 1 sc). Make 6 more roses; join with ch and pi according to design. Make rose for back of bonnet with 7 petals instead of 6. Edge: 1st Row: 4 tr with 1 ch between each; ch 3; 4 tr; repeat. 2nd Row: (1 dc; ch 1; 1 dc; ch 1; 1 tr; ch 1; 1 tr; ch 1; 1 tr; ch 1; 1 dc; ch 1; 1 dc; ch 2 and repeat. 3rd Row: Ch 4; 1 sc; repeat.



PRINCESS BED SPREAD PATTERN

Material Required: Indo-twist, carpet warp or No. 15 or 20 crochet cotton, 1 No. 10 crochet hook.

Ch 10; join. 1st Row: Ch 3; 23 dc in ring; join. 2nd Row:
ch 14; sl st into 10th st from hook; ch 4; skip 2 dc in ring; 1
sc in next dc; repeat from * 7 times; join; break thread. 3rd
Row: Fasten thread over ch of 9; ch 3; 12 dc in ring; * 13 dc in
next ring; repeat from * 6 times; join. 4th Row: Sl st to 6th dc; 1 sc
in 6th, 7th and 8th dc; * ch 12; 3 sc in top of next cluster; repeat
from * 6 times; ch 12; join. 5th Row: Sl st over the 1st 3 sc;
ch 4; 1 dc over ch of 12; ch 1; 1 dc; ch 1; 1 dc; ch 1; 1 dc; ch 3;
6 dc over last half of ch of 12 with 1 ch between each; * ch 1.
Over next ch of 12 make 5 dc with 1 ch between each; ch 3; 5 dc
with 1 ch between each; repeat from * 6 times; ch 1; join. 6th
Row: 1 sl st in 4th ch; ch 4; * 1 dc over ch of 1; ch 1; 1 dc over
next ch; ch 1; 1 dc over next ch; ch 1; 1 dc; ch 3;
1 dc; ch 1; 1 dc over next ch; ch 1; 1 dc over next ch;
skip 1 ch between the 2 dc; 1 dc over next ch; ch 1; repeat from
around; join. 7th Row: Sl st in ch of 1; ch 4; * 1 dc; ch 1; 1


LACE FOR BED SPREAD

Make circles according to directions for 1st, 2nd and 3rd rows of motif; join, following design. 4th Row: SI st to the 6th dc; 1 sc in the 6th, 7th and 8th dc; ch 12; 1 sc in 6th, 7th and 8th dc of next scallop; ch 12; 3 sc; ch 12; 3 sc; * ch 9; 3 sc; repeat from *3 times; ch 9; join; break thread. Corner Motif: SI st to 6th dc; 1 sc in the 6th, 7th and 8th dc; ch 3; 3 sc over ch of 9 of previous motif; ch 3; 3 sc; eh * 12; 3 sc; repeat from * 4 times; ch 9; 3 sc; ch 9; join. Upper Edge of Lace: Join thread over ch of 9 to right. 1st Row: Ch 24; 3 sc over next ch of 9; ch 24; 1 sc over next ch of 9; turn; 7 sc over following 7 ch; ch 7; 1 sc over ch of 9 of next motif; turn; 7 sc in ch of 7; ch 7; 1 sc over ch of 9 of 3rd motif; turn; 7 sc in 7 ch; fasten with sl st into 17th ch of ch of 24; ch 16; 3 sc over ch of 9; repeat. 2nd Row: 1 row of meshes as follows: ch 1; skip 1 ch; 1 dc; repeat to corner; 1 dc; skip 3 ch; 1 dc in 4th ch; ch 1; skip 1 ch; 1 dc, etc. 3rd Row: 1 row of meshes. 4th Row: Join thread in mesh; ch 3;

skip 1 space; 1 dc in next space; ch 6; 1 dc in top of dc; ch 1; thread over hook 2 times into next space, cast off 2 loops; thread over hook; skip 1 space, cast off 2 loops and 2 loops until all are cast off; ch 3; 1 dc in fork; ch 1; thread over hook twice; into next space cast off 2 loops; thread over hook once; skip 1 space; into next

space cast off 2 loops and 2 loops until all are cast off; ch 3; 1 dc in fork; repeat to corner; 1 ftr; repeat cross trebles; 2 rows of open meshes; break thread. Lower Edge of Lace: 1st Row: Join thread over ch of 12 of motif; ch 3; 4 dc over ch with 1 ch between each; ch 3; 5 dc over same ch with 1 ch between each; over the next ch of 12, make 5 dc with 1 ch between each; ch 3: 5 dc with 1 ch between each; repeat around. 2nd Row: Same as 6th row of motif. 3rd Row: Same as 7th row of motif. 4th Row: Same as 8th row of motif, making a double loop at each point, and 1 double loop bet we en motifs. Square, Connecting Motifs: Ch 12; join to point of motif; 12 sc in ch; * ch 14; join to 5th sc just made; turn; 11 sc over ch of 14; ch 8; turn and fasten in 5th sc; turn; 6 sc over ch of 8; ch 7; fasten to point where the double loops of motifs are joined; 7 sc in 7 ch; 1 sl st; 6 sc over remaining ch of 8; 1 sl st; 6 sc over a part of the ch of 14; ch 7; join to next point of motif; 7 sc in 7 ch; 5 se in last 5 ch of the ch of 14; repeat from * 2 times; 4 sl st in last 4 sc of the 1st

ch of 12; ch 9; fasten in the 5th sc; turn; 11 sc over ch of 9; turn; ch 8; fasten in the 5th sc; turn; 6 sc; ch 7; fasten between the 2 double loops; 7 sc in 7 ch; 6 sc over ch of 8; 1 sl st; 6 sc over ch of 9; join.





* * * Start 2nd scallop by fastening thread in center of 7th loop of 2nd row; re-peat same for next 11 scallops.
When the 12th scallop is finished, don't break thread, but continue making next row as follows: next row as follows: turn; crochet from right to left toward point of scallop; ½ loop; * ch 8; 1 ltr to point of 8th petal of daisy; ch 8; 1 ltr to point of 7th petal; ch 8; 1 ltr to left of picot of loop; ch 13 (this loop; ch 13 (this is the center of the top of scallop); 1 ltr to the right of 2nd picot of same loop; ch 8; 1 ltr to point of 6th petpoint of 6th pet-al; ch 8; 1 ltr to point of 5th pet-al; ch 8; 1 ltr in the top of ½ loop to left of daisy; ch 8; 1 ltr to top of next ½ loop; ½ loop and 1 ltr to the top of next ½ loop: 1 ltr to the top of next ½ loop; 1 ltr across to the 1st ½ loop of 2nd scallop; ½ loop and 1 ltr to top of next ½ loop; ch 8: 1 ltr: repeat from (*) as over 1st scallop. There must be 9 There must be 9 spaces of 8 chains over each scallop for the crescent and 2 spaces with 1 picot each be-tween the scal-

lops. 1st, 2nd and 3rd Rows of the Crescent: Fasten thread in beginning of 1st 8 chains; (* *) ch 3; skip 1 ch; 1 sc in next ch; ch 3; skip 1 ch; 1 sc in next ch; ch 3; skip 1 ch; 1 sc in next ch; ch 3; skip 1 ch; 1 sc in next. This makes the 1st 4 small loops of crescent. Make 5 such small loops over next space of 8 chains: 4 over next; 5 over next: 8 over next ch of 13; 5 over next space; 4 over next: 5 over next: 4 over next. Make last small

Princess Bed Spread Pattern




Library Scarf

Material Required: 6 balls soft mercerized No. 3 crochet cotton, 1 No. 2 crochet hook.

Make grapes and leaves according to instructions for pillow. 1st Row: Join thread in end grape; ch 14; 1 sl st in next grape; turn; 6 sc over ch; ch 10; fasten to same grape; turn; 6 sc over ch; repeat trellis according to design. 2nd Row: 1 row of sc

(6 sc over each ch); 12 sc over end ch; turn; sl st into 6th sc. 3rd Row; ch 5; 2 tr; * ch 2; 3 tr; repeat from *. 4th Row: 4 sc; 1 pi; 4 sc; 1 pi; repeat. Edge: 6 sc; 1 pi; 6 sc; etc.




Princess Pillow

Material Required: 2 balls soft mercerized No. 3 crochet cotton, 1 No. 2 crochet hook.

Grapes: Ch 4; join. 1st Row: 2 sc in each of the 3 ch. 2nd, 3rd and 4th Rows: 3 rows of 14 sc. Fill with cotton. 5th Row: 1 sc; skip 1 sc; 1 sc; skip 1; etc. Draw grape together at top; 12 grapes for each cluster. Sew grapes together according to design. Leaves: Ch 8; 1 sc in each ch; ch 3; 1 sc in each of the 6 st on opposite side; turn; ch 2; 1 sc in each of the 6 sc, taking up back thread; 2 sc over ch of 3; ch 3; 2 sc over same ch; 1 sc in each of the 6 sc on other side; turn; ch 2; 8 sc; 2 sc over ch; ch 3; 2 sc over ch; 6 sc on opposite side; turn; ch 2; 8 sc; 2 sc over ch; ch 3;

2 sc over ch; 8 sc; turn; ch 2; 10 sc; 2 sc over ch; ch 3; 2 sc over ch; 8 sc; turn; ch 2; 10 sc; 2 sc over ch; ch 3; 2 sc over ch; 10 sc; turn; ch 2; 14 sc; break thread. Make 2 more leaves; join the three sections of leaf with sc; join thread in base of center section of leaf; ch 35; skip 1 ch; 34 sl st; break thread; join thread in 8th sl st of stem; ch 10; 1 sl st in 8th sl st of next stem; turn; 6 sc over ch of 10; ch 10; 1 sl st in stem; turn; 6 sc over ch of 10; repeat; join. 1 row of sc (4 sc in each space).





Chain Stitch (ch): Catch thread with hook, making a loop, draw thread with hook through the loop. This makes the first stitch. Repeat, drawing thread through as many loops as required. Each loop is termed a chain. (ch) Slip Stitch (sl st): Insert the hook into work, draw thread through work and the loop on the hook at the same time.

Single Crochet (sc): Insert hook into work, draw thread through, making 2 loops on the hook; place thread again over the hook and draw through both loops.

Double Crochet (do): Place thread over hook once, draw thread through work; place thread again over the hook and draw thread through 2 loops; place thread once more over the hook and draw thread through 2 loops; place thread once more over the hook and draw thread

through work; place thread again over the hook and draw thread through 2 loops; place thread once more over the hook, and again draw through 2 loops.

Short Double Crochet (sdc): Place thread over hook once, draw thread through the work; place thread over the hook again and draw thread through all 3 loops at once.

Treble Crochet (tr or tc): Place thread over hook 2 times; draw thread through the work; thread over hook again and draw thread through 2 loops; place thread again over the hook, and draw through 2 loops; place thread over hook once more, and draw through 2 loops; place thread over hook once more, and draw through 2 more loops.

Triple Treble Crochet (tt): Place thread over hook 3 fimes;

draw thread through the work; place thread over wook again; draw through 2 loops; thread over hook again; draw through 2 loops; thread over hook, draw through 2 loops; place thread over hook once more and again draw through 2 loops.




