

MOTIF (Make 4) . . . Starting at center with Shaded Pinks, ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Ch 1, www2ntiquepatternilbrary.org st in first sc. 2nd rnd: Ch 1, sc in same place as sl st, \* ch 3, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* around. Join. 3rd rnd: In each loop around make sc, half dc, 3 dc, half dc and sc. Join. 4th rnd: \* Ch 4, sc in back loop of sc between this and next petal. Repeat from \* around. Join. 5th rnd: In each loop around make sc, half dc, 5 dc, half dc and sc. Join. 6th rnd: \* Ch 5, sc in back loop of sc between this and next petal. Repeat from \* around. Join. 7th rnd: In each loop around make sc, half dc, 7 dc, half dc and sc. Join. 8th rnd: \* Ch 6, sc in back loop of sc between this and next petal. Repeat from \* around. Join. 9th rnd: In each loop around make sc, half dc, 9 dc, half dc and sc. Join and break off. 10th rnd: Attach White to back loop of sc between any 2 petals, \* ch 7, sc in back loop of sc between this and next petal. Repeat from \* around. Join. 11th rnd: Ch 3, \* 11 dc in next sp, dc in next sc. Repeat from \* around. Join. 12th rnd: Sc in same

place as sl st, \* ch 5, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 2, dc in first sc (24 loops).

13th rnd: \* Ch 5, sc in next loop.

Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 2, dc in dc. 14th rnd: \* Ch 10, skip next loop, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* around. Join. 15th rnd: In each loop around make 6 sc, ch 5 and 6 sc. Join and break off. 16th rnd: Attach Green to any ch-5 loop, ch 4, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr make 2 tr in same loop, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), ch 4, sl st in same loop, ch 5, make a 2-d tr cluster in same loop, ch 5, sl st in same loop, ch 4, make a 2-tr cluster in same loop, ch 4, sl st in same loop. Break off (leaf made). Attach thread to next ch-5 loop and work as before. Make a leaf in each ch-5 loop around. 17th rnd: Attach White to tip of center cluster on any leaf, sc in same place, \* ch 7,

INSERTION . . . Starting at narrow edge with Shaded Pinks, ch 17. 1st row: Dc in 7th ch from hook, ch 1, skip 1 ch, dc in next ch, ch 5, skip 5 ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, skip 1 ch, dc in next ch, ch 3, sl st in any ch-5 loop on motif. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Dc in first dc on insertion, ch 1, dc in next dc, 5 dc in next sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next dc. Ch 6, turn. 3rd row: Dc

in first dc, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 5, skip 5 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 3, sl st in same ch-5 loop on motif. Ch 3, turn. 4th row: Repeat 2nd row. 5th row: Dc in first dc, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 5, skip 5 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 3, sl st in next ch-5 loop on motif. Ch 3, turn. Repeat 2nd to 5th rows incl until 40 rows are completed. At end of 40th row, ch 3, sl st in any ch-5 loop on next motif. Ch 3, turn. Work in pattern until 2 more loops are joined to insertion on First Motif-at the same time joining loops on Second Motif to opposite side of insertion until 10 loops in all are joined. Continue in this manner, joining Third Motif as before and attaching it to same side of insertion as First Motif was joined, and joining Fourth Motif the same as Second Motif was joined. Break off.

Rip out hem of pillow case, press out any creases. Sew motifs and insertion in place. Cut out material in back of motifs, leaving 1/4 inch for hem. Sew hem neatly in place. Cut back of pillow case, rounding edges to correspond with front and hem.

EDGING...1st row: Attach Pink to back edge and sc closely across, sl st in last loop on insertion. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: In first sc make dc, ch 3 and 2 dc; \* skip 3 sc, in next sc make 2 dc, ch 3 and 2 dc. Repeat from \* across. Sl st in last loop on insertion. Break off.

Starch motifs lightly and press.

Ch 1, turn. 3rd to 6th rows incl: Repeat 2nd row. 7th row: Sc in each sc to center sc of 3-sc group, sl st in center sc. Break off. Sew Leaves together, joining 6 sc on each side of center sc. Attach White to center point on any leaf, sc in same place, (ch 5, sc in next point) 3 times; \* ch 3, sc in next point on next leaf, (ch 5, sc in next point) 6 times. Repeat from \* around. Join and break off.

Clark's O.N.T. Best Six Cord Mercerized Crochet (Small Ball), Size 30, 12 balls of No. 126 Spanish Red or any other color, and 4 balls of No. 48 Hunter's Green.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.

A pair of white pillow cases.

FLOWER - CENTER BUD - Petal (Make 3) . . . 1st row: Starting at bottom with Red, ch 4, 5 dc in 4th ch from hook. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: 3 sc in first dc, sc in each dc across, 3 sc in top of starting chain. Ch 3, turn. 3rd row: Skip first sc, dc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. 4th and 5th rows: Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows once more. 6th row: Work off 3 sts as 1 sc, sc in each dc across to within last 3 sts, work off last 3 sts as 1 sc. Ch 1, turn. 7th row: (Work off 5 sc as 1 sc) twice (2 clusters made). Break off. Sew petals together to form Center Bud.

FIRST ROW OF PETALS-Petal (Make 5) . . . Work as for Petal of Center Bud until 3 rows are completed. 4th to 7th rows incl: Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows 2 more times. 8th row: Repeat 6th row of Center Bud. 9th row: Work off 5 sc as 1 sc, sc in each sc across to within last 5 sts, work off last 5 sc as 1 sc. Break off. Attach Red to first sc following cluster on any petal, sc in same place, \* sc in each sc across, sc in tip of next cluster, sc in end st along side of next 2 rows, skip cluster on next petal, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* across, joining all petals in this manner. Join with sl st to first sc. Break off (top of row).

SECOND ROW OF PETALS (Make 5) . . . Work as for First Petal until 3 rows are completed. 4th to 9th rows incl: Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows 3 more times. 10th row: Repeat 6th row of Center Bud. Ch 3, turn. 11th row: Skip first sc, dc in each sc across, Ch 1, turn. 12th row: Work off 5 sc as 1 sc. sc in each st across to within last 5 sts, work off 5 sc as 1 sc. Break off.

THIRD ROW OF PETALS (Make 5) . . . Work as for First Petal until 3 rows are completed. 4th to 13th rows incl: Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows 5 more times. 14th row: SI st in next dc, sc in next dc, half dc in next dc, dc in each dc across to within last 3 dc, half dc in next dc, sc in next dc, sl st in next dc. A pair of white pillow cases.

SKIRT . . . Starting at waist with Pastels, ch 15. 1st row: Dc in 7th ch from hook, (ch 2, skip 1 ch, dc in next ch) 4 times. Ch 5, turn. 2nd row: \* 3 dc in next sp, ch 3. Repeat from \* across, ending with 3 dc in last sp. Ch 5, turn. 3rd row: \* Sc in next sp, ch 5. Repeat from \* across, ending with sc in sp formed by turning chain. Ch 5, turn. 4th row: \* 3 dc in next loop, ch 5. Repeat from \* across, ending with 3 dc in last loop. Ch 7, turn. 5th row: \* Sc in next sp, ch 7. Repeat from \* across. Ch 5, turn. 6th row: \* 5 dc in next loop, ch 5. Repeat from \* across, ending with 5 dc in last loop. Ch 7, turn. 7th row: Repeat 5th row. 8th row: \* 7 dc in next loop, ch 4. Repeat from \* across, ending with 7 dc in last loop. Ch 3, turn. 9th row: Skip first dc, dc in next 3 dc, \* ch 4, sl st in 3rd ch from hook (picot made), ch 1, dc in same dc as last dc was made, dc in next 3 dc, ch 4, dc in next 4 dc. Repeat from \* across. Ch 3, turn. 10th to 13th rows incl: Skip first dc, dc in next 3 dc, \* ch 1, picot, ch 1, dc in next 4 dc, ch 4, dc in next 4 dc. Repeat from \* across. Ch 3, turn. 14th to 19th rows incl: Skip first dc, dc in next 3 dc, \* ch 2, picot, ch 2, dc in next 4 dc, ch 5, dc in next 4 dc. Repeat from \* across. Ch 3, turn. 20th, 21st and 22nd rows: Skip first dc, dc in next 3 dc, \* ch 3, picot, ch 3, dc in next 4 dc, ch 6, dc in next 4 dc. Repeat from \* across. Ch 3, turn. 23rd row: Skip first dc, dc in next 3 dc, \* ch 4, picot, ch 4, dc in next 4 dc, ch 7, dc in next 4 dc. Repeat from \* across. Ch 3, turn. 24th row: Skip first dc, dc in next 3 dc, \* ch 4, picot, ch 4, dc in next d dc, ch 8, dc in next 4 dc. Repeat from \* across. Ch 3, turn. 25th row: Dc in first dc, \* dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 4, picot, ch 4, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 8, 2 dc in next dc. Repeat from \* across. Ch 3, turn. 26th row: Dc in first dc, \* dc in next 4 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 8. Repeat from \* across. Ch 4, turn. 27th row: Skip first dc, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make tr in the next 2 dc, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), \* ch 7, make a 4-tr cluster by making tr in same dc as last tr was made and in next 3 dc, ch 7, make 3-tr cluster by making tr in same dc as last tr was made and in next 2 tr, sc in next loop, make 3-tr cluster over next 3 dc. Repeat from \* across. Ch 8, turn. 28th row: \* Sc in next loop, ch 8. Repeat from \* across, ending with sc in last loop, ch 4, tr in tip of last cluster. Ch 1, turn. 29th row: Sc in first loop, \* ch 8, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* across. Ch 8, turn. 30th row: \* Sc in next loop, ch 10. Repeat from \* across. Break off.

BODICE . . . Starting at top with Steel Blue, ch 18. 1st row: Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in each ch across. Ch 4, turn. 2nd row: Skip first dc, (dc in next dc, ch 1) 3 times; (tr in next dc, ch 1) 8 times; (dc in next dc, ch 1) 3 times; dc in top of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. 3rd row: 2 tr in each of the next 2 sps, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sps, 2 half dc in next sp, 2 sc in each of the next 5 sps, 2 half dc in next sp, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sps, 2 tr in each of the next 2 sps, tr in 3rd ch of turning chain. Break off. 4th row: Attach Blue to back loop of first half dc, ch 3, working in back loop only make dc in next 13 sts. Turn. 5th row: SI st in next dc, ch 3, dc in next dc and in each dc across to within last dc. Turn. 6th and 7th rows: Repeat 5th row. Break off at end of 7th row. Attach Blue to front loop of first st on 3rd row, sc in same place, \* ch 3, skip next st, sc in front loop of next st. Repeat from \* across. Break off.

BOW... Starting at center with Mid Rose, ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st row: Ch 3, 4 dc in ring. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Dc in first dc (1 dc increased at beginning of row), dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in top of turning chain. 3rd row: Dc in first dc, dc in next 5 dc, 2 dc in turning chain. Break off. Attach thread to other side of ring and work other side of Bow to correspond.

STREAMER . . . With Mid Rose, make a chain 7 inches long. 1st row:

Half dc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across. Break off. Fold Streamer and sew to one side of Bow. Sew Bow to Bodice.

ARM (Make 2) . . . Starting at top with Mid Pink, ch 4. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 2 ch. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures 1½ inches. Break off. Sew to Bodice.

HEAD . . . Starting at center with Mid Pink, ch 4. 1st rnd: 18 dc in 4th ch from hook. Join. 2nd rnd: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around. Join and break off.

NECK . . . Attach thread to any sc on Head. 1st row: Ch 3, dc in next 5 dc. Break off. Embroider face with scraps of Light Blue and Red embroidery floss. Sew Neck to top of Bodice.

HAT . . . Starting at center with Dark Yellow, ch 5. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Ch 3, 18 dc in ring. Join. 2nd rnd: Ch 1, 2 sc in each dc around. Join. Now work in rows as follows: 1st row: Ch 5, (dc in next sc, ch 2) 16 times; dc in next sc, ch 2) 16 times; dc in next sp, ch 5. Repeat from \* across, ending with sc in 3rd ch of turning chain. Ch 5, turn. 3rd row: \* Sc in next loop, ch 5. Repeat from \* across. Break off. Sew Hat to Head.

Rip out hem of pillow case, press out any creases. Pin Skirt to center of pillow case. Cut out material in back of Skirt, leaving ½8 inch for hem. Cut front of pillow case, curving to meet edge of Skirt. Turn hem under and sew neatly in place. With Pastels, sc closely around edge. Join and break off. Sew Skirt in place.

EDGING... Attach Pastels to first sc at edge of Skirt. 1st rnd: Sc in same place, \* ch 10, skip 7 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* around to other edge of Skirt. 2nd rnd: In each loop around edge of Skirt and pillow case make (3 sc. ch 3) 5 times and 3 sc. Join and break off.

SPRAY (Make 2) ... Starting at one end with Hunter's Green, ch 7, sl st in 7th ch from hook (leaf made), (ch 7, sl st in 7th ch from hook) twice (2 more leaves made); ch 17, sl st in 7th ch from hook, ch 7, turn, sl st in 7th ch from hook (leaf made on both sides of chain). Work in this manner, making leaves at various intervals as before, until piece measures 6½ inches. Break off.

LARGE FLOWER (Make 8) . . . With Light Steel Blue (ch 7, sl st in 7th ch from hook) 5 times. Break off. With Dark Yellow make a French knot in center. Make 8 more Large Flowers with Mid Rose.


SMALL FLOWER (Make 4) . . . With Mid Rose (ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from hook) 5 times. Break off. With

Dark Yellow make a French knot in center. Make 2 more Small Flowers with Light Steel Blue. With Hunter's Green, make a chain 1 inch long with 2 leaves at each end. Sew 2 Small Mid Rose Flowers to chain and sew to Hat. Sew remaining Small Flowers to Spray. Sew top of figure and Bow to pillow case. Sew Leaves and Flowers to pillow case. Starch figure lightly and press.









# Wild Rose Scroll P-305

Illustrated on Centerspread

#### MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats Tatting-Crochet, Size 70, 2 balls each of No. 48 Hunter's Green and No. 46 Rose.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 14.

A pair of green pillow cases.

LARGE MOTIF (Make 2) - First Leaf . . . Starting at center with Hunter's Green, ch 15. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of starting chain, make sc in each ch across, 2 sc in last ch. (Mark last sc for base of leaf.) Hereafter pick up only the back loop of each sc. Do not turn but make sc in each sc to within 3 sc from center sc at tip of leaf. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in each sc to marked sc, 3 sc in marked sc, sc in each sc on other side to within 3 sc from center sc at tip of leaf. Ch 1, turn. 3rd and 4th rows: Sc in each sc to within center sc of 3-sc group, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each sc on other side to within last 3 sts. Ch 1, turn. 5th row: Same as 3rd row, but making sc, ch 7 and sc in center sc of 3-sc group at base of leaf. 6th row: Sc in each sc to within ch-7 loop, in loop make (3 sc, ch 5) 3 times and 3 sc; sc in back loop of each remaining sc across to within last 3 sc. Break off.

SECOND LEAF... Work as for First Leaf until 5th row is completed. 6th row: Sc in each sc to within ch-7 loop, 3 sc in ch-7 loop, ch 2, sl st in corresponding loop on First Leaf, ch 2, 3 sc in same loop on Second Leaf. Complete as for First Leaf (no more joinings). Make 4 more leaves, joining adjacent loops as Second Leaf was joined to First Leaf. Join the Last Leaf to First Leaf in same manner.

FILL-IN-MOTIF . . . With Green, ch 10. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: 3 sc in ring, ch 2, sl st in free loop at bottom of any leaf, ch 2, \* 3 sc in ring, ch 2, sl st in free loop of next leaf, ch 2. Repeat from \* around. Join and break off.

ROSETTE . . . With Rose, ch 12. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: 20 sc in ring, sl st in first sc. 2nd rnd: \* Ch 7, skip 3 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* around. Join (5 loops). 3rd rnd: In each loop around make sc, half dc, 5 dc, half dc and sc, sl st in first sc made. 4th rnd: \* Ch 8, sc in back of first sc on next petal. Repeat from \* around. Join. 5th rnd: In next loop make sc, half dc and 9 dc, sl st in 3rd point from center of any leaf, make half dc and sc in same loop on Rosette make sc and half dc in next loop, sl st in next free point on same leaf, make

9 dc in same loop on Rosette, sl st in first free point on next leaf, make half dc and sc in same loop on Rosette, sc and half dc in next loop, sl st in next free point on same leaf, make 9 dc, half dc and sc in same loop on Rosette. In each remaining loop around make sc, half dc, 9 dc, half dc, and sc. Join and break off. Make 5 more Rosettes, joining between leaves as before.

SMALL MOTIF (Make 5) ... Make 4 leaves as for Large Motif, joining 2 sets of 2 leaves as before.

ROSETTE... Work as before until 4 rnds are completed. 5th rnd: In next loop make sc, half dc and 2 dc; sl st in center loop at base of leaf, make 3 dc in same loop on Rosette, sl st in center loop at base of next leaf, in same loop on Rosette make 2 dc, half dc and sc. Complete next petal. (In next loop make sc, half dc and 5 dc, sl st in center loop on next leaf, make 4 dc, half dc and sc in same loop on Rosette) twice. Complete rnd as before (no more joinings).

Pin a small motif in place at center of pillow case, centering it over the hem. Pin a large motif to each side of small motif. Pin 2 small motifs on each side of large motifs. Sew motifs neatly in place. Starch motifs lightly and press.

### **MATERIALS:**

J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Best Six Cord Mercerized Crochet, Size 30:

SMALL BALL:

J. & P. Coats—3 balls of No. 9 Yellow and 2 balls of No. 8 Blue, or

CLARK'S O.N.T.—4 balls of No. 9 Yellow and 3 balls of No. 8 Blue.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.

A pair of blue pillow cases.

**GAUGE:** Each motif measures 4 inches in diameter.

MOTIF... Starting at center with Yellow, ch 6. Join with sl-st to form ring. Ist rnd: Ch 3, 19 dc in ring. Sl st in top of ch-3. 2nd rnd: Sc in same place as sl st, \* ch 15, sc in next 2 dc. Repeat from \* around, ending with sc in last dc. Join to first sc made (10 loops). 3rd rnd: \* In next loop make sc, half dc, 21 dc, half dc and sc, skip next sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* around. Join to first sc made. Break off.

FIRST FLOWER . . . Starting at center with Blue, ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Sc in ring, ch 4, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make 2 tr in ring, thread over and draw through all loops on hook

(cluster made), ch 1, sl st in center do of any loop on motif, ch 1, sl st in tip of cluster, ch 4, sc in ring, (ch 4, 2-tr cluster in ring, ch 3, sl st in tip of cluster—picot made—ch 4, sc in ring) 3 times, joining last ch-4 to first sc. Break off.

SECOND FLOWER . . . With Blue, ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Sc in ring, ch 4, 2-tr cluster in ring, ch 1, sl st in center dc on next loop of motif, ch 1, sl st in tip of cluster, ch 4, sc in ring, ch 4, 2-tr cluster in ring, ch 1, sl st in picot on last petal made on First Flower, ch 1, sl st in tip of cluster, ch 4, sc in ring. Complete Flower as before (no more joinings). Make 8 more Flowers, joining cach Flower as Second Flower was joined to First Flower and motif.

EDGING...1st rnd: Attach Yellow to picot on any free petal, sc in same place, \* ch 10, sc in next joining between Flowers, ch 10, sc in next picot. Repeat from \* around. Join 2nd rnd: 13 sc in each loop around. Join and break off.

Make 5 more motifs. Sew motifs together, joining 2 points of each motif and leaving 3 points free between joinings. Rip out hem of pillow case and press out creases. Pin motifs in place on pillow case, attaching end motifs to corners and center motifs 1½ inches from edge to form curve. Sew motifs in place. Cut out material in back of motifs, leaving ½ inch for hem. Turn hem under and sew neatly in place. Scallop back to correspond with front, leaving ¼ inch for hem. Turn hem under and sew neatly in place. Attach Yellow to back and sc closely across. Break off. Starch motifs lightly and press.

# For-get-me-not . . . P-310

Illustrated on Centerspread

### MATERIALS:

- J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Best Six Cord Mercerized Crochet (Small Ball), Size 30, 1 ball of No. 37 Dark Lavender.
- J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Pearl Cotton, Size 5, 1 ball of No. 11 Orange.
- J. & P. Coats Big Ball Best Six Cord Mercerized Crochet, Size 30, 1 ball of No. 48 Hunter's Green.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.

A pair of pink pillow cases,

MOTIF—First Flower . . . Starting at center with Dark Lavender, ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Sc in ring, \* ch 4, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr make 2 tr in ring, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), ch 4, sc in tip of cluster (picot made), ch 4, Continued on page 11

sc in ring. Repeat from \* 3 more times. Join last ch-4 to first sc. Break off.

SECOND FLOWER . . . Starting at center, ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Sc in ring, ch 4, cluster in ring, ch 2, sl st in any picot on First Flower, ch 2, sc in tip of cluster on Second Flower, ch 4, sc in ring, ch 4, cluster in ring, ch 2, sl st in next picot on First Flower, ch 2, sc in tip of cluster on Second Flower, ch 4, sc in ring. Complete rnd as before (no more joinings).

Make 2 more flowers in this manner, joining adjacent sides as Second Flower was joined to First Flower. Where 4 corners meet, join 3rd and 4th corners to joining of previous 2 corners.

BORDER . . . 1st rnd: Attach Green to any corner picot, in same picot make sc, ch 5 and sc; \* ch 10, sc in next picning, ch 10, in next picot make sc, ch 5 and sc. Repeat from \* around. Join. 2nd rnd: \* In next loop make 3 sc, ch 5 and 3 sc; (in next sp make 5 sc, ch 5 and 5 sc) twice. Repeat from \* around. Join. 3rd rnd: SI st in next 3 sc, sl st in loop, ch 3, in same loop make 2 dc, ch 5 and 3 dc; \* (in next loop make 3 dc, ch 3 and 3 dc) twice; in next loop make 3 dc, ch 5 and 3 dc. Repeat from \* around. Join and break off.

Make 11 more motifs.

JOINING . . . Arrange motifs in groups of four. Make a flower as before, joining a picot to corner loop on each of 4 motifs. Make 2 flowers as before. Join between groups of motifs as illustrated. Sew motifs to pillow case. Embroider center of flowers with Orange Pearl Cotton. Starch motifs lightly and press.

# Daylilies . . . . . P-315

Illustrated on Centerspread

### MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats Tatting-Crochet, Size 70, 8 balls of No. 37 Dark Lavender, 2 balls of No. 48 Hunter's Green and 1 ball of No. 9 Yellow.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 14.

A pair of yellow pillow cases.

FIRST MOTIF... Starting at center with Dark Lavender, ch 8. Join with sl st to form ring.

PETAL (Make 5) ... 1st row: Ch 3, 3 dc in ring. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Dc in first dc, 2 dc in each of next 2 dc, 2 dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. 3rd and 4th rows: Skip first dc, dc in each dc across, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. 5th row: Skip first dc, holding back on hook the last loop of each dc make dc in next 2 dc,



thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), dc in next 2 dc, cluster over next 2 dc and top of turning chain. Now working along side of petal (ch 3, sl st in base of next st) 4 times; ch 3, sc in ring (petal completed). Work as for First Petal until 5 petals are completed. Break off.

CENTER... Attach Yellow between any 2 petals, in same place make sc, ch 5 and sc; \* ch 5, make sc, ch 5 and sc between next 2 petals. Repeat from \* around. Join and break off.

Last rnd: Attach Hunter's Green to end dc on 4th row of any petal, \* (ch 7, sc in tip of next cluster) twice; ch 7, sc in end st of next row, ch 5, sc in corresponding st on next petal. Repeat from \* around. Join and break off.

**SECOND MOTIF...** Work as for First Motif until petals and Center are completed.

JOINING . . . Attach Green to any petal as on First Motif, ch 7, sc in tip of next cluster, ch 3, sl st in corresponding loop on First Motif, ch 3, sc in next cluster on Second Motif, ch 7, sc in end st of next row, ch 2, dc in corresponding sp on First Motif, ch 2, sc in end st of 4th row of next petal on Second Motif, ch 7, sc in next cluster, ch 3, sl st in corresponding loop on First Motif, ch 3, sc in next cluster on Second Motif. Complete rnd as for First Motif (no more joinings).

THIRD MOTIF... Work as before, joining adjacent sides as Second Motif was joined to First Motif, leaving one petal free at lower edge.

**FOURTH MOTIF...** Same as Third Motif, leaving one petal free at top edge.

Make 11 more motifs, joining as before, alternating free petals on top and lower edges.

Make another piece in this manner. Sew to pillow case, joining points of free petals on every other motif. Starch motifs lightly and press.

each dc across to within last 3 dc, half dc in next dc, sc in next dc, sl st in next dc. Break off.

LAST ROW OF PETALS (Make 5)
... Work as for First Petal until 3 rows are completed. 4th to 15th rows incl: Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows 6 more times. Repeat 14th and 15th rows of Third Row of Petals.

BASE OF FLOWER . . . Starting at center with Red, ch 4. 1st rnd: 17 dc in 4th ch from hook. Join to top of starting chain. 2nd rnd: Ch 3, dc in same place as sl st, 2 dc in each dc around. Join. 3rd rnd: Ch 3, dc in same place as sl st, \* dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc. Repeat from \* around. Join and break off. Sew Center Bud and rows of petals to Base to form flower. Catch petals together on each rnd. Make 2 more flowers in this manner.

LEAF (Make 6) ... Starting at center with Green, ch 45. 1st row: SI st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 3 ch. half dc in next 2 ch, dc in next ch, tr in each ch across to within last 7 ch, dc in next ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next 4 ch, 3 sc in last ch; now, working along opposite side of starting chain, make sc in next 4 ch, half dc in next ch, dc in next ch, tr in each ch across to within last 7 sts, dc in next ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next 2 ch, sl st in next ch (point of Leaf). Turn. 2nd row: SI st in next 3 sts, sc in each st across to within last 5 tr. Turn. 3rd row: SI st in first sc, sc in next 2 sc, half dc in next 2 sc, dc in each sc across to within last 5 sc, half dc in next 2 sc, sc in next 2 sc, sl st in next sc. Break off. Attach thread to opposite side and work to correspond. Attach thread to center of one side, sc closely around to point, ch 4, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 2 ch, sc in each remaining st around. Join and break off.

Starch lightly and press. Sew Flowers and Leaves in place on pillow case.
