
Grandmother Clarks Patchwork Quilt Designs



Grandmother Clark's Patchwork Quilt Designs

In the pioneer days of our grandmothers, every home, even to the little log cabin, had its share of patchwork quilts. There was a fascination in working out various designs from scraps left from dresses and other garments. There was calm and contentment in sewing the tiny pieces together till they gradually took on the semblance of flowers, stars, rings, or other fanciful figures.

Now, women are again learning the charm of quilting and finding some of the keen pleasure that our grandmothers knew in this old and useful art.

This book contains some of the most popular patchwork quilt designs which may be set together piece by piece to form a design or block, or they may be appliqued on squares of any desired color of cloth.

All cutting patterns shown in this book are finished size, so it will be necessary to allow for seams to secure the desired result.

To make cutting pattern trace on thin paper and paste on cardboard and cut out, or pattern can be traced on cardboard direct with carbon paper.

When cutting the patches be sure to allow ¼ inch for all seams. After patches are cut out, the edges are turned over the cardboard and pressed. For stems and connecting lines cut material on the bias. To applique these patterns trace a pattern on the material to be used for the background and applique patches on outline. Nine attractive ways of setting blocks together are shown on Page 15.


No. 3—Fancy Star. 12-inch block for each star. Use diagram "A" for diamonds. Use half of diagram "A" for triangles.






No. 7—Star with Diamonds. 18-inch block. Use diagram "C" for diamonds. Use 25%-inch squares.




No. 4—Fancy Flowers. 18-inch block complete. Use diagram "B" for diamonds. Use 316-inch square in center.




No. 6—Texas Star. Use diagram "E" for diamonds. As shown on cover quilt is 75 x 86.




No. 8—Eight-Pointed Star. 12-inch block for each star. Use diagram "D" for diamonds.






No. 9—Pinwheel. 18-inch block for design as shown. Use diagram "F" for triangles.




No. 11—Reverse X. 18-inch block for design as shown. Use diagram "G" for large triangles. Use diagram "H" for small triangles.




No. 13—Windmill. 18-inch block as shown. Use diagram "F" for large triangles. Use diagram "G" for small triangles.




No. 10—Basket. 18-inch block. "A" for one-fourth of handle. "B" for triangles. Use diagram Use diagram




No. 12—Evening Star. 18-inch block. Use diagram "C" for points of star. Use 83/4-inch square for center.




No. 14—Swastika. 24-inch block or four 12-inch blocks. Use diagram "D" for large triangles. Use diagram "E" for small triangles.








No. 17—Ornate Star—18-inch block. Use diagram "D" for triangles. Use 51%-inch square in center. Use 41%-inch squares in corners.




No. 19—Eccentric Star. 12-inch block for each star. Use 418-inch square for center. Use diagram "F" (page 6) for white triangles.




No. 16—Double Hour Glass. 12-inch block for each. Use diagram "A" for squares. Use diagram "B" for triangles.




No. 18—Jack's Blocks. 18-inch block. Use $3\frac{1}{2}$ -inch squares.




No. 20—Mosaic. 18-inch block. Use 318-inch squares.






No. 24—Sun Flower. 18-inch block. Use 4-inch diameter circle for center. Use diagram "B" for petals.


Called Friendship Ring or Dresden Plate when ends of petals are rounded instead of pointed.





No. 25—Cushion Design. 18-inch block as shown. Use diagram "A" for center. Use half of diagram "B" for sides.
