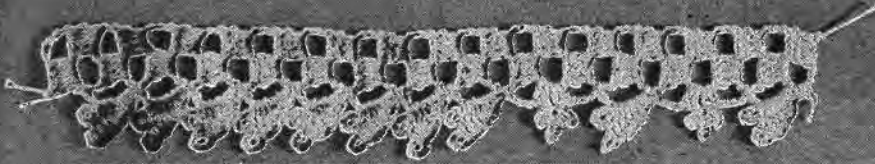

CORNERS

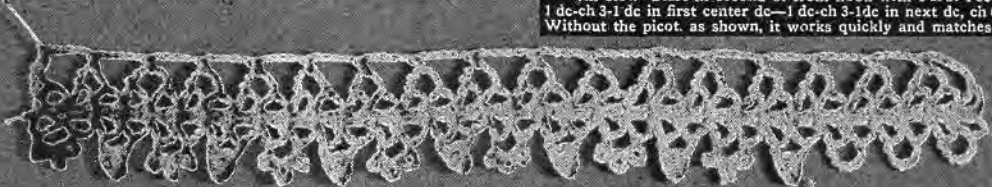
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All edges are shown actual size of the thread used—No. 40 here. Ch 12, 4 dc in last 4 sts, ch 5, turn, 4 dc in space below, ch 5, turn, 4 dc in mesh. 2nd Row—1 sl st in first mesh, ch 1—1 dt in second mesh—ch 5, go back in second st, for each one of the two picots, then 2 dt, 2 dc, 2 single crochets, 1 sl st—all, over the dt in second mesh. 1 sl st in same mesh. Ch 1, dt in next mesh. The last several scallops show a neat alternative for a picot figure. It is—ch 3, 2 dc, 3 p, 2 dc, ch 3 in mesh.

Ch 12-1-dc-ch 3-1 dc in second ch and same in first ch. Ch 5, turn. 2nd Row—Go back in second ch with sl st, for picot, ch 5 for 2nd p, going back in sl st of first, ch 4, for 3rd p—in sl st of second... 1 dc in first of the 2 center dc, ch 3, 1 dc in same st—1 dc-ch 3-1 dc in next dc. Ch 6 for upper loop, turn. 3rd Row—1 dc-ch 3-1 dc in first dc—1 dc-ch 3-1 dc in second dc, ch 5 turn.

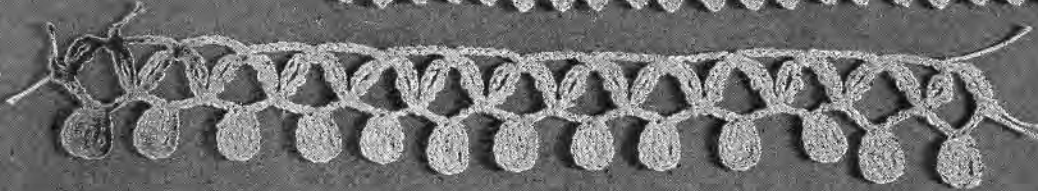
4th Row—Start in second st from hook with 1 sl st-1 sc-2 dc, ch 1, 1 dc-ch 3-1 dc in first center dc—1 dc-ch 3-1 dc in next dc, ch 6 for loop. Without the picot, as shown, it works quickly and matches filet.



Ch 19, 1 dt in 10th st back, ch 2, 1 dt in next st, sk 2, 1 dt-ch 2-2 dt, ch 4, turn. 2nd Row—3-dc over first 2 chs, ch 1, 4 dc over 2nd 2 chs, ch 8 for loop, turn. 3rd Row—1 dt-ch 2-1 dt in 3rd dc. 1 dt-ch 2-1 dt in second of the 3 dc. 1 dt in end of row. Ch 4, turn.

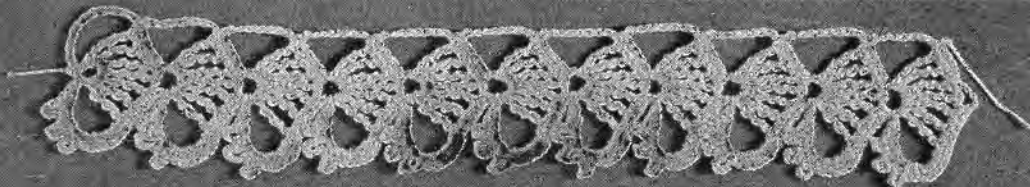
Lower Row—Make 1 regular sl st, then insert hook over loop, catch thread and draw thro both loops at once; ch 1. Work 5 of these sl st with 1 ch betw each. Ch 4 for picot, again 5 sl st with the ch over other half of loop. Ch 1 between loops.

Ch 10, 2 sl st in first 2 chs, ch 8, turn, 2 sl st in end of first loop, ch 8, turn, 2 sl st in end of loop last made, ch 8, turn. Work this for desired length. 2nd Row—Start over the 2 sl st, with 1 sl st, ch 6. Now start in second st from hook:—1 sl st-1 sc-3 dc-1 sl st over the 2 sts of first row, ch 6.

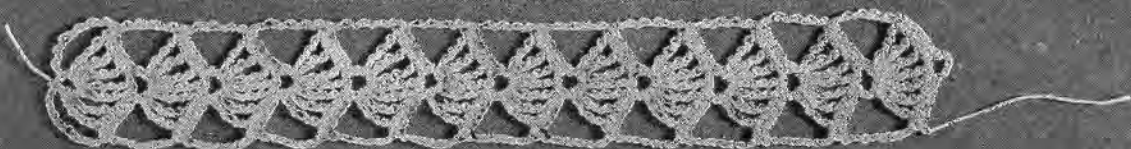


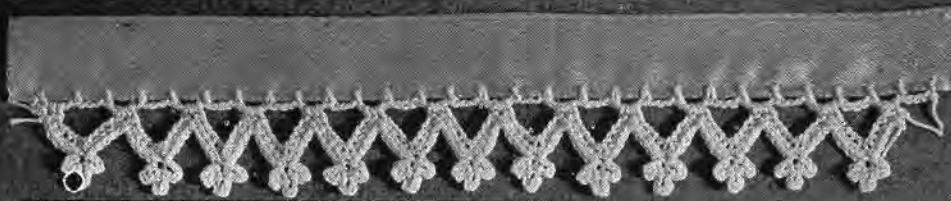
Lowest row worked first. Ch 11, 3 dt in fifth st back, ch 4, 1 sl st in same st, ch 11 for next figure—6 chs between. 2nd Row—from right to left, 2 sl st over 2 chs, ch 4, 1 dt in second sl st, ch 5, 1 dt in first ch of the 5 just made, forming a loop, 2 sl st over the 6 chs below. 3rd Row—1 sl st in center of loop, ch 6 between.

This edging covers space quickly. Ch 7, form ring, Ch 12, 1 tr tr (thread over 3 times) with 1 ch bet in ring, ch 9, 1 sl st in ring, turn. 2nd Row—3 sl st-ch 4-2 sl st-ch 4-2 sl st-ch 4-9 sl st, over the 9 chs. 6 sl st over the next 6 sts, ch 5, sk center tr tr, 7 sl st over next 7 sts, ch 8, turn then again the 7 tr tr, in the loop of 5 chs.



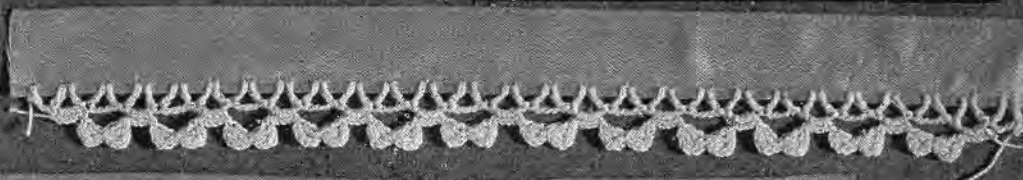
Ch 7, form ring, ch 12, 7 tr tr (thread over 3 times) with 1 ch bet each in ring. Now—in ring—thread over hook 6 times, work loops off 2 by 2, ch 1, TURN. 2nd Row—6 sl st over next 6 sts, ch 5 over center, 7 sl st over next 7 sts, ch 8, turn. Now the 7 tr tr and chs in loop of 5 chs. Then thread over 4 times, work off, 2 by 2, in last sl st below.





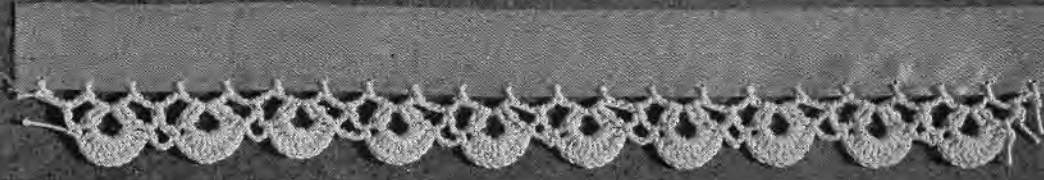
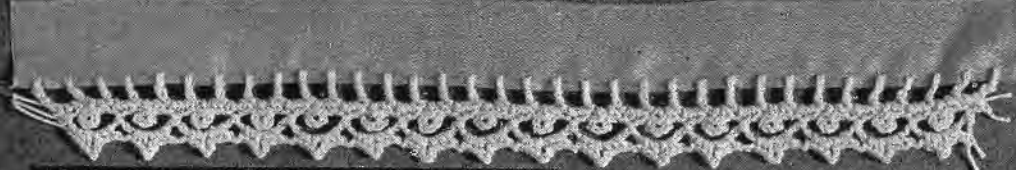
All edgings are shown actual size. No. 40 thread used. 1 sl st, ch 3, 1 sl st in material. 2nd Row—3 sl st over 3 chs, ch 10, skip second 3 chs. 3 sl st over third 3 chs.  
3rd Row—1 tight sl st over center st, 5 sl st over 5 stitches of the 10 chains, 3 picots of—ch 4, back to first—and 5 sl st over the next 5 sts, 1 sl st over center sl st.

1 sl st in material, ch 3, skip a small space, 1 dc. Ch 3, 1 dc next to dc last made, skip a small space. 1 dc, ch 3, 1 dc next to dc last made.  
2nd Row—5 sl st in first space, then ch 4, 3 dc in first of these chs. Ch 3, 3 dc in top of dc last made. Skip second space, 5 sl st in the third space.



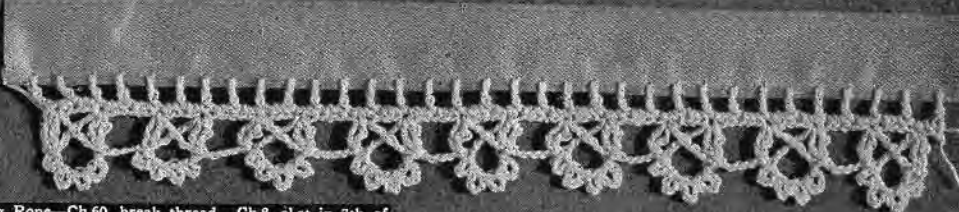
1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc in material. 2nd Row—3 sl st in first mesh. 1 sl st, 1 picot, 1 sl st in second mesh.  
3rd Row—1 sl st over center sl st, ch 7, skip picot, 1 sl st over next center sl st.  
4th Row—3 sl st, ch 3, 3 sl st over each loop of 7 chs. Ch 2 between.

1 sl st, ch 5, 1 sl st in material. 2nd Row—1 sl st over first loop of 5 chs, ch 3, 2 dc—ch 4—2 dc over second loop, ch 3, 1 sl st, ch 3 over third loop. 3rd Row—1 sl st over 3 chs, 10 dc over the 4 chs, 1 sl st over next 3 chs, ch 4 between, 1 sl st over next 3 chs.



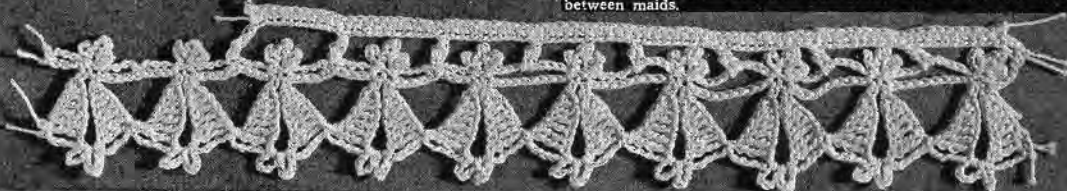
1 sl st, ch 5, 1 sl st in material. 2nd Row—1 sl st over first 5 chs. Ch 3, 3 dc in next loop of 5 chs. Ch 4—3 dc in first of these 4 ch sts—this forms first little petal. Ch 3, 3 dc in top of dc last made and again same for third little petal. Then 1 dc in top of the last one of the very first 3 dc. 3 dc in same loop. Ch 3, 1 sl st in next loop.

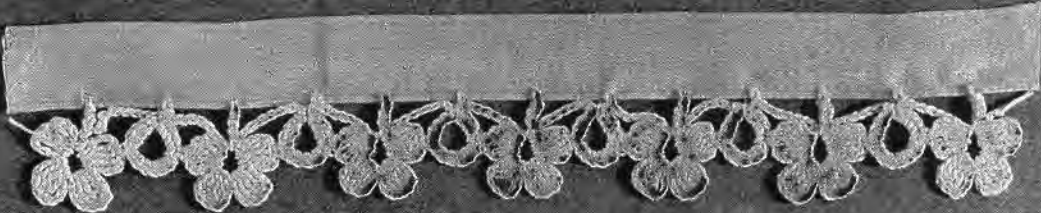
1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc in material. 2nd Row—3 sl st in each mesh. 3rd Row—1 sl st. Ch 4, 1 dt in first st, sk 4—1 tr tr (thread over 3 times). Then 4 picots, working second picot into sl st of first and so on. 1 tr back to st of first dt, crossing the tr tr made. A petal of 2 dt in same st with first tr tr, ch 4, sk 5, a petal of 2 dt, starting second figure.



Kiddies Jumping Rope—Ch 60, break thread. Ch 8, sl st in 7th of long ch. Turn. 1 sl st-1 sc-1 dc-1 cs-4 sl st over the 8 chs. Ch 11, to 8th st. of long ch, turn. Same way over these, leave 3 at lower end. Ch 8, Sk 11 of long ch, 1 sl st in next st, turn. 1 sl st-1 sc-3 dc-3 dt over these 8 chs. Ch 11, turn. Work same, leaving 3 at bottom. 2nd Row—Start over 1st st of long ch, with sl st. Ch 5, sk 5, 1 sl st. Now 3 p over the 2 sl sts, for boy's head. Ch 5, 1 sl st over center st of 11 chs. Same over girl.\* Then ch 5, sk 5, 1 sl st, 1 p, in next 2 sts. Repeat 4 times. Bottom—Sl st over dt, ch 5, 2 p for feet, ch 5, to boy, ch 3 for each foot 2 tight sl st betw.

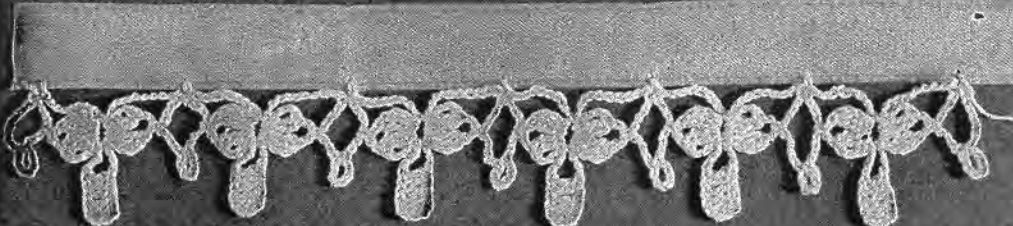
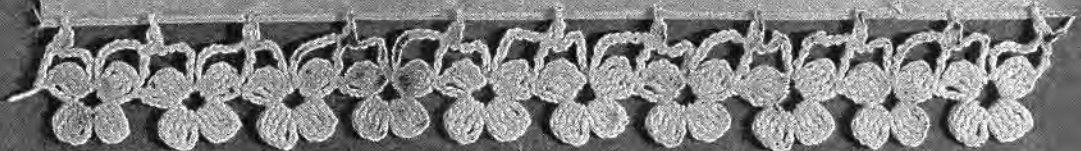
Won't this dainty edging, "Little Maids in a Row," please the baby? Make a long chain, another of, ch 7, 1 sl st in 6th of long ch, turn—1 sl st-1 sc-3 dc-2 dt over the 7 chs last made. Ch 10, 1 sl st in 7th st of long ch, turn—work same sts down, leaving 3 sts for loop. Skip 9 sts of long ch, ch 7, 1 sl st. 1st Upper Row—3 picots over the 2 sl st in long ch—right over figures. Ch 9 bet. (or as in 5 of the maids, ch 4, 1 sl st, ch 4). 2nd Row—2 dc in center of 9 chs, ch 9. 3rd Row—All sl sts. Lower Row—Ch 4 over dt, 2 p over loop of 3 chs, ch 4, sl st between maids.





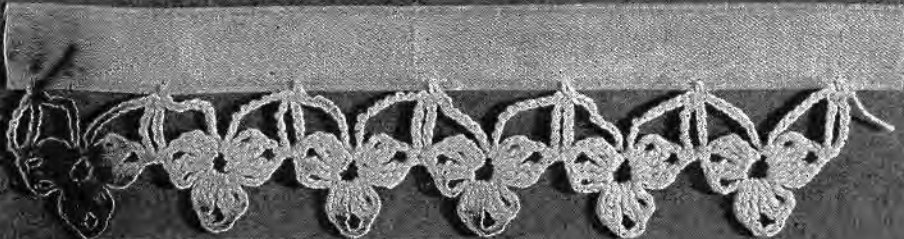
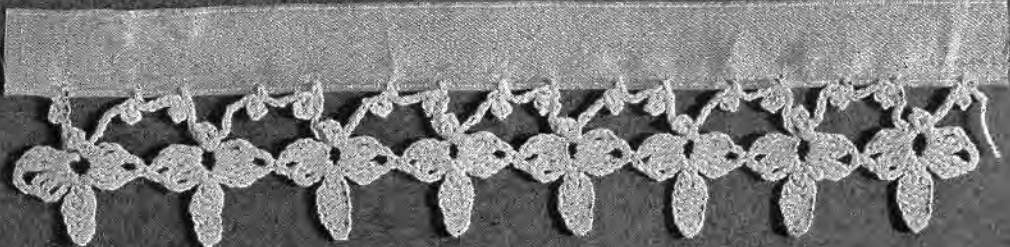
Ch 5 (second very loose), 3 dt in loose-(L)-st. Ch 3, tight sl st in L st\*, ch-3-3 dt-ch 3, tight sl st, all, in L st, repeat twice. Ch 3, sl st in material, turn. 3 tight sl st over the 3 chs just made, tight sl st in center of clover. Ch 19, 1 sl st in 11th st back, turn. On right side of this loop 4 sl sts, the 4th into center dt of last petal. 11 sl st in rest of loon—last one being very tight. 1 sl st in material leaving space 3-8 in. Ch 12—the 9th very loose—repeat clover, fastening 2nd dt of first petal in ring.

Ch 7, sl st in material. Ch 2, sl st in 3rd of 7 chs. Ch 12—the 9th very loose-(L)-3 dt in this L st, fasten with sl st in end of 7 chs, turn, ch 3, tight sl st. \*ch 3, 3 dt, ch 3, tight sl st, all, in L st, repeat twice. Ch 8, turn, 1 dt in 3rd dt of last petal, ch 2, sl st in material—leave 1-2 inch, ch 2, turn, fasten over dt last made. Ch 12 for next clover, after 3rd dt, fasten in same st where upper dt is worked.



Ch 14, back to 7th—ch 7, back to very first st and sl st in material. Ch 13—9th very loose-(L)-2 dt in 4th st from hook. Ch 1, turn, fasten over loop. Ch 1-2 dt-ch 3-tight sl st, all, in L st. Ch 11-5 dc over 5 sts of these 11, start in 4th, from hook. Ch 3, fasten with tight sl st in L st, work leaf like first. Ch 14, turn, fasten in center of leaf last made. Ch 11, back to 7th for picot, ch 7, fasten over the 10th st of the 14 chs 1 sl st in material, leaving 3-4 inch, between figures.

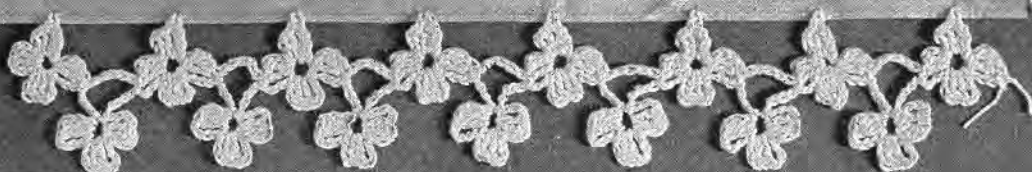
Ch 5, go back in first st, fasten with sl st in material. Ch 10-7th very loose-(L)-now 2 dt-ch 3-2 dt in this L st, ch 3, tight sl st into L st. Ch 9, 1 sl st-2-sc-3-dc-1 sc-1 sl st, all, in these 9 sts, starting in second. Sl st in L st. Ch 3 and work other side petal, 1 tight sl st in ring. Turn. Ch 5, tight sl st in ring. Turn. Ch 11, go back in 5th, sl st in material, leave 3-8 inch. Ch 9, go back in 5th, sl st in material, leave 1-4 inch. Ch 10—7th loose. Connect motifs with sl st, as shown.



Ch 12, form ring, 1 sl st in material. Ch 13—the 10th very loose-(L), 2 dt in this L st, ch 1, turn, fasten in loop of 12 chs, ch 1, turn. 2 dt-ch 3-1 tight sl st, all, in the L st. \*Ch 3-2 dt-ch 3-2 dt-ch 3, 1 tight sl st, still in L st. Repeat once. Ch 15, 1 sl st in center of last leaf. Ch 6, 1 sl st in 11th of the 15 chs. 1 sl st in material, leave 5-8-inch betw figures. Ch 13—10th very lose. Work second figure.

Same design is shown with sl st top. It is 1 sl st over upper loop, ch 11 between. 2nd Row—1 sl st in each st.





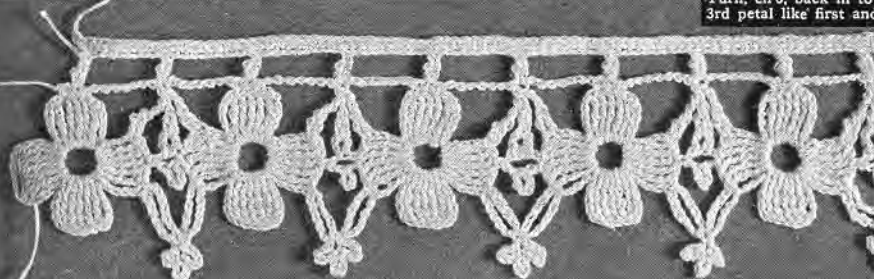
Ch 4, 2 dc in first st. Ch 4—first one loose—(L). 1 dc in this L st. 1 sl st in material, 1 dc-ch 3-1 tight sl st in L st. Ch 3-2 dc still in L st. Ch 9 for next clover. 2 dc in 4th st from hook. Leave 5-8 inch space between clovers.

2nd Row—Completing lower half of 4 leaf clovers—Ch 3, tight sl st in center of L st. Ch 3-2 dc-ch 3-1 sl st in same L st. Ch 3, 1 sl st over last petal of clover, just finished. Ch 8, 4th one, very loose and work the 3 leaf clover, each petal is 2 dc-ch 3-1 sl st, in loose st, ch 3, for next. After 3rd leaf, ch 4, fasten over first petal of second 4 leaf clover and complete it as you did the first.

Ch 10, form ring. \*ch 5, 5 tr tr (thread over 3 times), ch 5, sl st in ring, repeat, thro 3rd petal. Ch 17, go back with sl st into 5th—leaving loop to join to next motif—then 5 tr tr, ch 5, sl st in ring. Break thread. Connect next clover after the second petal has reached—ch 5 and 2 tr tr. Now ch 7 and go back in 2nd to form picot, ch 1, connect in 3rd tr tr adjoining in first clover, with a sl st. Ch 7—back to second—ch 1 and sl st into, your last tr tr, 3 more tr tr in ring. Ch 6, sl st into loop waiting from first clover, 3 picots (of ch 5) in this sl st. Turn, ch 6, back in to tr tr last made, ch 5, 1 sl st in ring. Complete 3rd petal like first and ch 17—sl st back into 5th for loop, as before.

Upper Edge—3 sl st over center of petal. Ch 7. With thread over 3 times go in corner st of petal to left, work off one loop, go in again, work off 2 by 2, until 2 are left on hook, then thread over twice, go in picot betw motifs, work off 1, go in again, work 2 by 2 until 3 are left on hook. Then thread over 3 times again, go in corner of next motif, 1 off, in again, and 2 by 2 until 4 are left. Now work off 3 of these and then the last 2, ch 7, 3 sl st over next upper petal.

2nd Row—1 petal of 2 dc in center sl st, ch 8, same over tr tr group, ch 8. 3rd Row—sl st in each st.

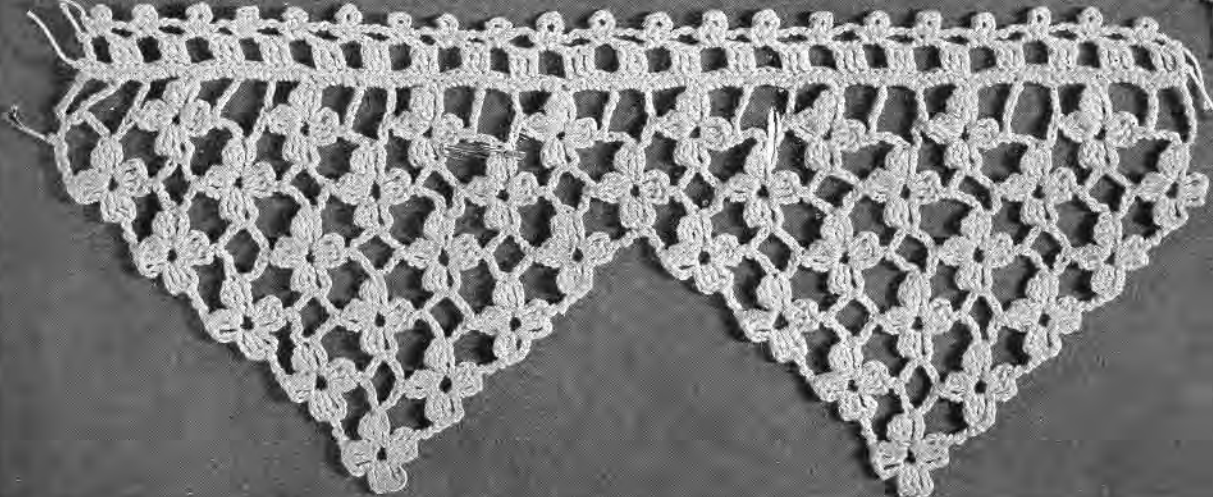
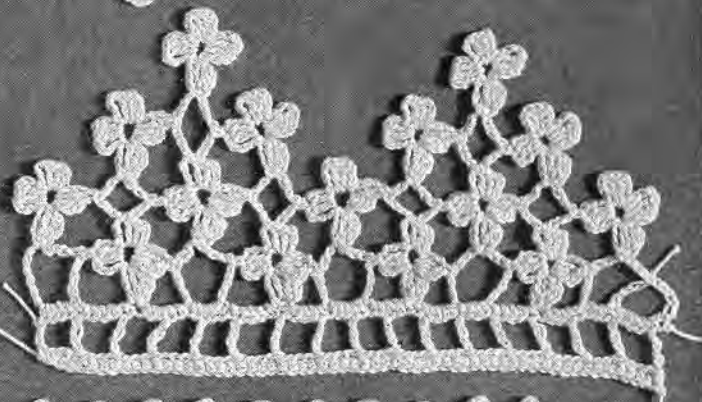


Ch 24—18th very loose—(L)—3 tr tr-3 times over—in this L st. Ch 2, 3 tr tr in L st, ch 5, 1 tight sl st in L st. Ch 9-4th loose-work same petal in this st. Then sl st over 3 remaining chs and complete 3rd petal in same st as first is worked. 6 sl sts up the original chain. Ch 24, start second clover, connect to first with sl st, as shown.

Upper Row—1 dc in each st. Lower edge—Start in original chain. Ch 6—sl st in space of first petal. Ch 5, sl st in corner of this same petal, ch 5, sl st in lower petal as shown, ch 5, sl st in 3rd tr tr, then ch 9, 1 dc in 8th st from hook, ch 1, 1 sl st skipping the 2 ch space in lower petal. Repeat over other side, chain 4 between motifs.

Ch 15, 1 sl st in 13th from hook. Ch 7, 2 dc in 4th from hook. Ch 4—first one loosely—(L). 1 dc in this L st, turn. Make 1 dt into first st of starting chain, turn. 1 dc-ch 3-1 tight sl st in L st. \*Ch 3-2 dc-ch 3-1 sl st, all in same L st. Repeat once. Ch 3, fasten in end of first petal and a clover is completed. Ch 7, 1 dc in 6th st of first loop. Ch 7. Turn. 2nd Row—2 dc in 4th st from hook. Ch 4—first one loose—(L), 2 dc in L st, turn, sl st in center of 7 chs below. Ch 3—important—"bending right side up" make a tight sl st in L st. Ch 3-2 dc in L st, ch 3, turn, fasten over second dc of upper petal, of clover below. Ch 7, turn, 2 dc in 4th st from hook. Ch 4—first one loose—(L), 1 dc in this L st, turn, 1 dt in first dc of bottom petal of finished clover, turn. 3rd Row—1 dc-ch 3-1 tight sl st in L st. Two more petals. Ch 3, fasten in end of clover. Ch 7, sl st over petal of next clover, ch 3, sl st in center st, 1 more petal, ch 3, fasten in end of next petal. Ch 9, turn. 4th Row—1 sl st over upper petal, ch 7, and as before. Reducing is worked same way—dt being down to past clover instead of up. Upper edge, 5 sl st in each space. Then 3 dc-ch 3-sk 3. Then sl st—sl st over 3 chs, ch 3 between.

Smaller design is same without connecting dt at lower end. Edge is—1 dt, ch 4, sk 4, and last row, all sl sts.



Sl st, ch 3, 1 dc in material, Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc. 2nd Row—Sl st, Ch 6, sl st in 2nd space. Ch 3, 1 dc, ch 7-1 dc, ch 3, sl st in 4th sp. Ch 6, sl st in 5th, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 4-2 dc in 6th space, ch 3. 3rd Row—1 sl st over the 6chs, ch 4, sl st in loop.\* Ch 8, sl st-Ch 10, sl st-ch 12, sl st-ch 14, sl st-ch 16, sl st-and repeat, opposite, from \*. All this over the 7 ch loop. Ch 4, sl st in next 6chs. Ch 3, a petal of 2 dc over next 3 chs. 3 dc, ch 3-dt-over the 4 chs in center. A petal of 2 dc over 3 chs, ch 3, sl st in 6chs. 4th Row—Sl st over same, a sl st and picot (ch 5, back in first, ch 1), over each loop of chs in scallop. 1 sl st over same, ch 5 to the 3dt, a p over these. 3 p over the 3 chs, 1 p over 3 dt. Ch 5 and sl st over same.

A sl st ch 2, 2 dc in material, ch 7, space of 3-8 inch, 3 dc. 2nd Row—7 dc (2 at each side, 3 over 3) ch 3 betw. 3rd Row—5 dc over 7 dc, ch 4, 1 dt over 3 chs, ch 4. 4th Row—3 dc over 3 dc, ch 5, 3 sl st (each side of and over dt), ch 5. 5th Row—A sl st, over center dc. Ch 7, go back in 3rd st with sl st (for picot), 1 p in sl st, just made. 1 dt in center of 3 sl st. 3p-1 over the dt, next in sl st of first, third in sl st of second. 1 dt in same center sl st below. 2 more picots worked same way. Ch 2. 1 sl st over next center dc.

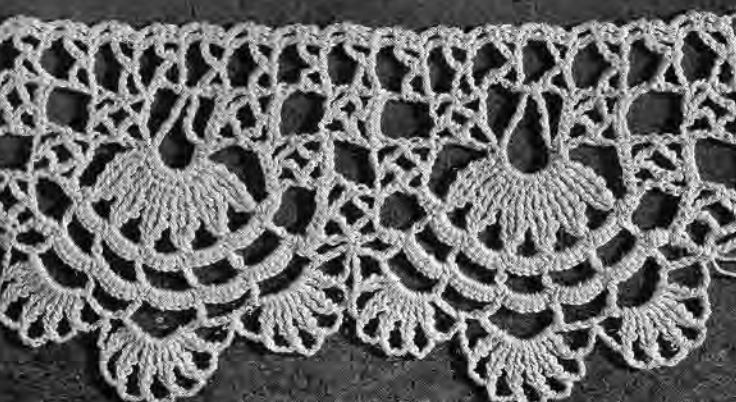
This dainty insertion will be ideal for hand bags and boudoir caps, it joins without sewing. A sl st in material, ch 8, sl st, 1 sc-3-4c-3 dt over these 8chs, start in second st from hook and work the last dt right into first sl st, over material. 1 sl st in material, leave space, length of the dt, ch 8. Repeat. 2nd Row—A sl st in first point, a knot st to next point, 1 sl st. 3rd Row—Make 1-2 kn st, then join over kn st below. Now 1 full kn st over second one below, ending with a 1-2 kn st. 4th Row—1 sl st in second material, ch 7 (only), 1 tight sl st in the 1-2 kn st last made, working from right to left, turn. Now work the same sts over these 7 chs, starting in first one. Make sl st in material as above.

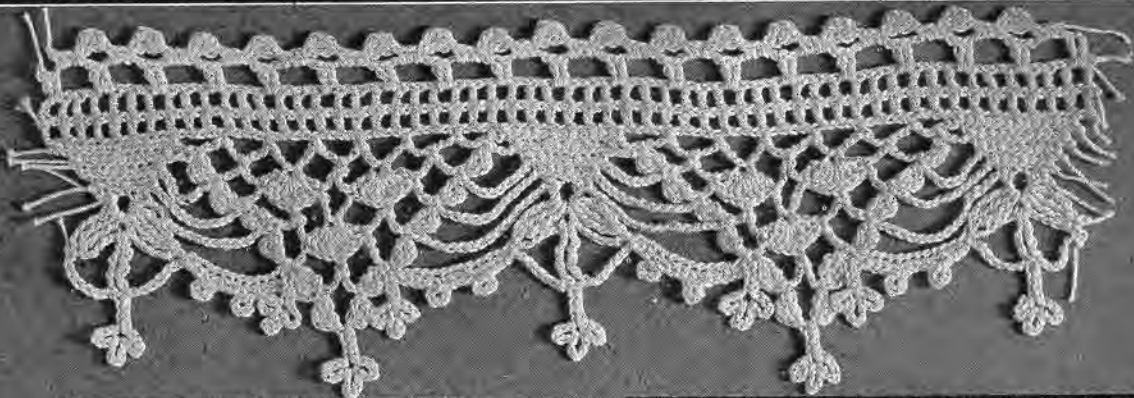
1 dc, ch 2 in material. 2nd Row—4 sl st, ch 9, skip 2nd mesh, 4 sl st in 3rd. 3rd Row—11 sl st over 9chs, 6 sl st over next loop, then ch 10, a tight sl st in 3th st from hook (forming ring), ch 7, turn. Work 6 dt with 3 chs betw each in ring. Fasten with a single crochet in the center st of finished loop, turn. Now 1 sl st-1 sc-2 dc-1 sc-1 sl st over each 3 chs. Sl st tightly over the turning 7 chs, 3 sl st over the stem, and 6 sl st in remaining loop. Now 6 sl st in 3rd loop, turn, 1 dt in last point of prior scallop, turn 6 sl st over remainder of 3rd loop.

The short thread at right upper corner shows the start. Ch 30, sl st in 9th from hook, ch 3, sk 2, 1 dc in next st. Ch 11, sk 5, 1 dc. \*Ch 3, sk 2, 1 sl st in next st, ch 3, sk 2, 1 dc. Repeat once and add 1 dc. Ch 3, turn. 2nd Row—1 dc over same, ch 5, 1 dc

over same. Now ch 2, 1 dt in same st of last dc, keep last loop on hook, another dt into next dc below, pull thread thru all. Ch 2, 1 tight sl st in 3rd of the 11 chs. This will be called a diamond st, 6 tight sl sts over next 6 of the 11 chs. Make another diamond st, 6 tight sl sts over next 6 of the 11 chs. Ch 1, 7 tight sl st over diamond, ch 6 sl st in 3rd st, ch 3, sk 2, 1 dc, now ch 11 and a dc over same. Ch 3, sk 2, sl st, ch 3, sk 2, 1 dc—this is a lacet—add 1 dc, ch 3, turn. 4th Row—1 dc over same. Ch 5, sl st in the 3rd of the 11 chs. 6 tight sl st over next 6 sts and finish diamond as before. 5th Row—Ch 1, 7 tight sl st over diamond, ch 6, sl st in 3rd st, ch 3, sk 2, 1 dc. Then the lacet as usual, add 1 dc, ch 3, turn. 6th Row—1 dc, lacet and diamond, turn. 7th Row—Ch 1, 6 sl st, ch 6 (for lacet), sk 2, sl st, ch 3, sk 2. 2 dc, ch 3, turn. 8th Row—1 dc, lacet, ch 6, turn. 9th Row—Sk 2, sl st, ch 3, sk 2, 2 dc, ch 3, turn. 10th Row—1 dc, finish lacet. Now ch 6, 1 dtt (thread 4 times over) betw the 2 lacets iset made. Ch 8, 1 dtt, fasten over diamond. 11th Row—12 sl st over 8 chs, ch 6, sk 2, sl st, ch 3, sk 2, 1 dc, lacet, 2 dc, ch 3, turn. 12th Row—1 dc, lacet, diamond, ch 8. Now 6 petals of 3dt over 12 sl st—each in 2 sl st, ch 4 betw. Ch 2, fasten over corner of diamond. 13th Row—Ch 1, 3 sl st over 2 chs, 6 sl st over each 4 chs, 3 over 2, at end. Diamond—lacet—2 dc, ch 3, turn. 14th Row—Usual thru diamond. Ch 8, 1 dc in 4th sl st over petal. Now 4 times ch 6-1 dc-sk 5. Ch 2, to corner of diamond. Ch 1, turn. 15th Row—3 sl st over the 2 chs, 8 over each 6, 3 over last 2 chs. Usual to top. 16th is first again.

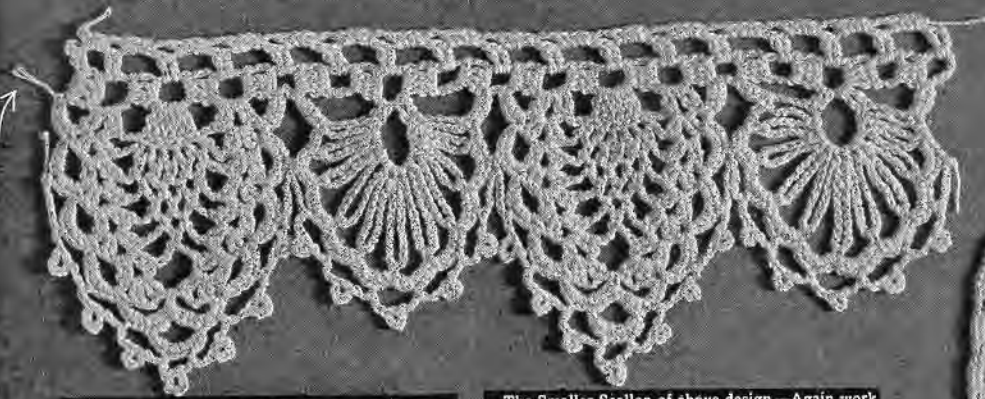
Finishing Row—1 sl st in center of lowest diamond, ch 2, 1 dc in sl st betw scallops (over the dc). Ch 7, dc, ch 5, dc, ch 8, dc. Repeat opposite. 2nd Row—1 sl st, ch 3, 1 petal of 2 dt, ch 4, 3 petals of 2 tr-tr (over 3 times), ch 4, between 2 dt in 7 chs, ch 4, sl st, ch 4, over 5 chs, add 1 petal of 2 tr tr in center loop.





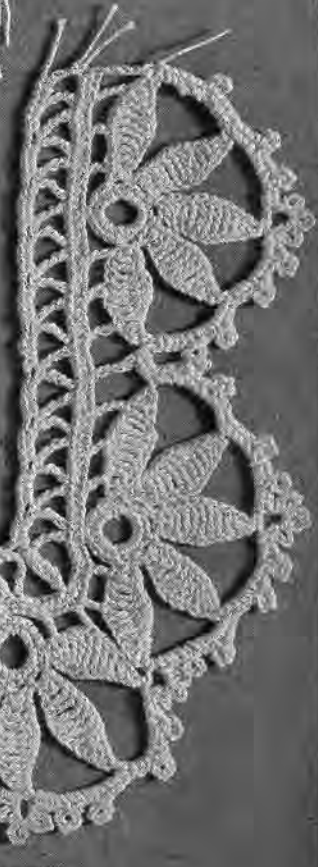
Make a long chain, 1 dc, ch 1, sk 1, or work this in material if desired. 2nd Row—1 dc, ch 1, sk 1, or work this in material if desired. 2nd Row—1 dc, ch 1, sk 1 over same. 3rd Row—13 sl st over 13 sts. Ch 6, sk 4 sts, 1 sl st—this 7 times—then 13 sl st. 4th Row—11 sl st over 13 sl st. Ch 3, sl st in first loop. Ch 3, 2 dc in sl st last made, this for first of the little scallops going down to point. Ch 3, sl st in second sl st betw next 2 loops. Ch 6, 1 sl st over center loop, 1 sh in next sl st loop. Ch 6, sl st over each of next 4 loops. Ch 7, 2 dc in 4th st from hook, 1 sl st in last loop. Ch 3, 11 sl st over 13 sl st. 5th Row—9 sl st over 11 sl st. Ch 9, 1 sl st just back of the little scallop. Ch 3, 2 dc in sl st betw next 2 loops. Ch 3, sl st in next loop. A shell st (sh) of 7 dc in sl st betw next 2 loops. Ch 6, 1 sl st over center loop, 1 sh in next sl st. Ch 7-2 dc in 4th st from hook, 1 sl st in front of scallop. Ch 9, 9 sl st over 11 sl st. 6th Row—7 sl st over 9 sl st. Ch 13, 1 sl st back of little scallop. Ch 3, sl st in center of sh. Ch 6, sl st in center loop, ch 6, sl st over next sh. Ch 7, 2 dc in 4th st from hook, 1 sl st in front of scallop. Ch 13, 7 sl st over 9. 7th Row—2 sl st, ch 4, sk 1 and 2 sl st—this over 7 sl st. Ch 17, sl st in back of scallop, ch 3, sl st in loop, 1 sh in next sl st. Ch 7, 2 dc in 4th st from hook, sl st in front of scallop,

ch 17, 2 sl st, ch 4, sk 1, 2 sl st over the 7 sl st. 8th Row—3 tr tr (thread over 3 times) in loop of 4 chs, ch 6, 1 sl st in same loop, ch 6 out again, 3 tr tr still in loop. Ch 13 sl st in back of scallop. Now ch 10, going back in 5th st, ch 5 for second and ch 5 for third picot, sl st tightly over remaining 4 chs, completing the small pendant at side of center scallop. Ch 4, 2 dc in first ch st. Ch 3, 1 sl st over sh. Ch 7, 2 dc in 4th st from hook. 1 sl st in front of scallop. Ch 10, make another pendant, 1 tight sl st, ch 13, 3 tr tr in next 4 chs. 9th Row—1 sl st in point of tr tr below, ch 7, 1 tr tr in sl st betw petals below. Ch 10, work same little pendant. 1 tr tr in same st with last, ch 7, 1 sl st in point of next 3 tr tr, 3 sl st in 3 of the 13 chs, 1 p, 4 sl st in next 4 sts, again 1 p, 4 sl st in next 4 sts, 1 tight sl st. Ch 5, bend down little pendant, fasten in back of scallop as usual. Ch 4, 2 dc in first st. Ch 10 for center pendant. Ch 4, 2 dc in first st, sl st in front of scallop, bend down little pendant, ch 5, 1 sl st in first of the 13 chs, 4 sl st in 4, lp and as other side. Upper Edge—2 dc in first space, ch 4, sk 2 spaces. 2nd Row—3 sl st over 4 chs. Ch 4, 2 dc in 3rd st from hook. 3 sl st over next 4 chs.



Start at bottom of first solid mesh, see arrow—this is necessary to have thread where it is wanted later. Ch 6, 3 dc, start in 4th st from hook, ch 5, turn. 1 dc over last dc. Ch 3, turn, 3 dc. This makes 1 sm, 1 om, 1 sm—continue until there are 7 meshes. Ch 3, turn. 2 dc—ch 2-2 dc (called a figure in this design) over first om. Ch 3, 6 dt in second open mesh. Ch 3, 1 figure in 3rd om. Ch 3, back in solid mesh, turn. 2nd Row—5 sl st over these 3 chs, 1 figure over same, ch 3, 1 sl st, ch 3 over each of the six dt, ch 3. 1 figure over same, ch 6, turn. 3rd Row—1 figure over same, ch 3, 1 sl st, ch 3 over each loop, ch 3. 1 figure over same. Ch 5, back in the last one of 5 sl sts on side. Turn. 4th Row—2 sl st over this new side loop, 1 figure over same, ch 3, 1 sl st, ch 3 over each loop, ch 3. 1 figure over same, ch 6. Turn. 5th and 6th Rows—Same decreasing 1 little loop in center, in each row. 7th Row—8 sl st over side loop, 1 figure over same, ch 3. 1 sl st in little loop in center, ch 3. 1 figure over same, ch 6, turn. 8th Row—1 figure over same, ch 1, 1 figure over same, ch 7, turn. 9th Row—1 sl st over the 1 ch sl, ch 6 over next figure, fasten, turn. 10th Row—9 sl st over this loop, 4 sl st over next loop, ch 6, turn, fasten over first loop, turn. 8 sl st in this new loop, 4 sl st in remaining loop. Now go in first ch st of each loop on the other side with a tight sl st. Then work 7 sl st in each loop, and 5 sl st in last smaller loop. Ch 5, 1 dc over the solid mesh of foundation.

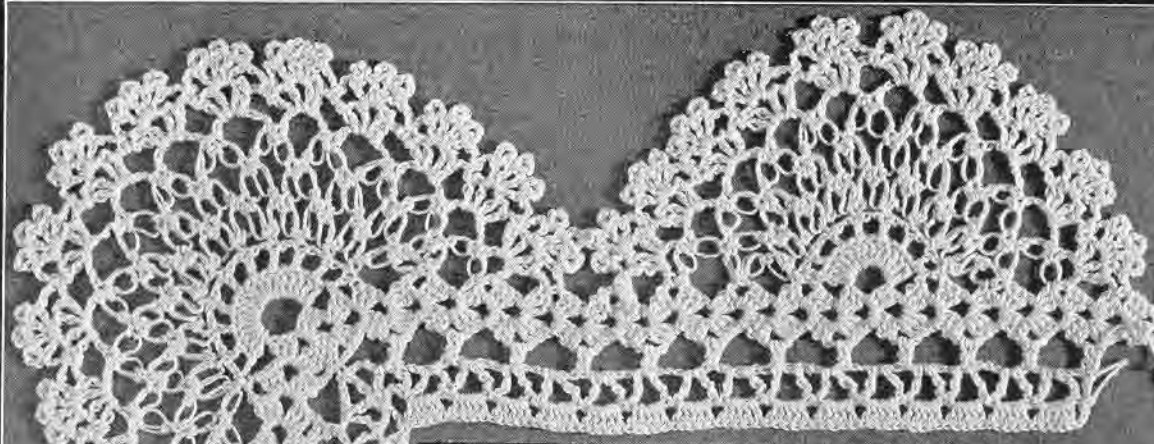
The Smaller Scallop of above design.—Again work 7 meshes of foundation, not counting the last om just made. Then ch 7, sk first om, 2 dc, ch 9, 2 dc in center om, ch 7, fasten over first sm. Turn. 2nd Row—5 sl st over first 3 of the 7 chs. Turn. Ch 5, 1 sl st in loop of 9 chs. Now ch 12, sl st—ch 14, sl st—ch 16, sl st—ch 18, sl st—ch 20, sl st, repeat in opposite direction, all in same loop. Ch 5 in 4th st of the 7 chs. Ch 2, turn. 3rd Row—1 sl st in first loop of chs, then ch 4 and sl st in each of the other loops, taking them up carefully. Ch 2, in last one of the 5 sl sts, turn. 4th Row—2 sl st over these 2 chs. 7 sl st in each loop of 4 chs. Connect second loop with scallop of first motif. 2 sl st over last 2 chs, 5 sl st over remaining chs, going up to the foundation, ch 5, 1 dc over solid mesh. Upper Edge—2 dc over each om, ch 4, between. 2nd Row—4 sl st over each 4 chs. Ch 2, between. Lower Edge—Ch 7, go back in second st, ch 2 over each little side loop. Go in twice in center loop at lowest point. Ch 5 between scallops.



These daisies are worked separately. Ch 10, form ring. 18 sl st in ring. 2nd Row—Ch 12, start in 2nd st from hook with 1 sl st—1 sc—2 dc—4 dt—2 dc—1 sc—all, over the 11 chs, 1 sl st in same of ring. Sk 1, 1 sl st, ch 12. Repeat for each petal. Break thread. Lower Edge—FIRST Row—1 sl st in each petal, ch 8 betw ch 4 between daisies, connecting them. At corner ch 1 instead of 4. See second row below. Upper edge—It is best to work this before finishing the lower part. 1 dc in point of petal, ch 3, sk 3, 1 dt, ch 3, sk 3, 1 dc, ch 3, sk 3, 1 dc, ch 4, 1 sl st in center of st of the ring. Ch 4, repeat in opposite direction, working the 2nd dt over the 4 connecting chs, instead of point. For the corner just work the 2 dc with 3 chs betw them. No ch between the 2 connecting dc over corner petals. 2nd Row—1 sl st in each sl. Skip 3 sts at corner. 3rd Row—1 dt, ch 3, 1 dt in next st, 1

dt, sk 3, ch 3, 1 dt in next st. 4th Row—4 sl st in each space, ch 1 between. Lower Edge—SECOND Row—5 sl st, 1 p, 4 sl st, 1 p, 4 sl st in first loop of 8 chs. 4 sl st, 1 p, 4 sl st, 1 p, 4 sl st in next loop, 3 picots in center, work second in sl st of first and again. Repeat as above on 2 loops. 2 sl st at each side of dt between scallops, 3 picots as before over the 1 ch st at corner.



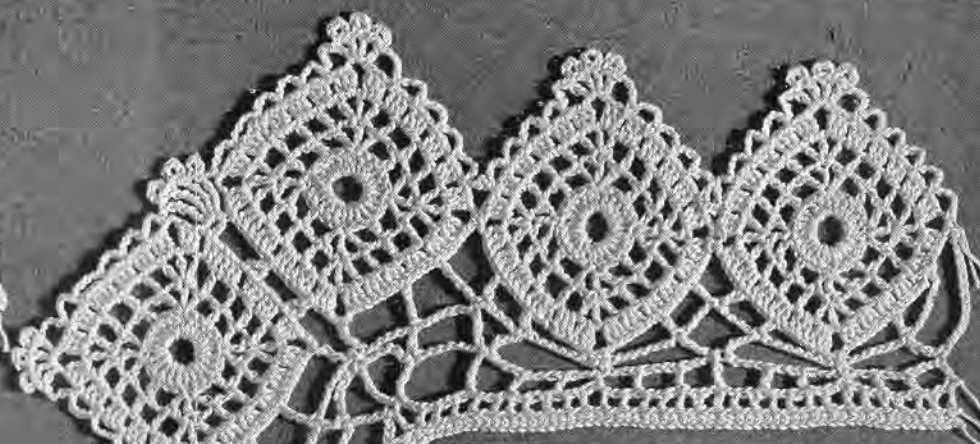


**A dainty Knot Stitch Corner.** Ch 7, 2 dc start in 4th st from hook, ch 3, 3 dc in next 2 sts, ch 3, turn. 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc over the 3 chs in center. This is the white center row, and 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc is called a figure, it is the foundation for each side. Repeat until there are 9 figures or 4 loops at the outer edge, then ch 7, instead of 3 (these for base of the knot st medallions). 2nd Row—Work 2 more figures, ch 2, 13 dc over the 7 ch loop. Ch 2, fasten in first small loop, turn. 3rd Row—Ch 2, 7 dc with 2 chs betw each, over the 13 dc below, the last dc is worked over the 2 ch st, 1 figure, over same, turn. 4th Row—1 figure over same, coming down again. 1 full kn st over each of the 7 dc, 1 kn st over the last 2 chs, 1 kn st in second little loop of foundation, ch 1, turn. 5th Row—Make a tight sl st, this makes a good turn for the kn st—1 kn st over each one below, skipping the first and the last one. There are 3, now fasten last one with a loose sl st over first dc of figure, work another figure over same, turn. 6th Row—A figure over same, start with a full kn st, a kn st over each below, fasten the last one in the third loop of foundation. (9 kn sts now.) Turn. 7th Row—Ch 6, fasten with 2 sl st in center of first kn st, ch 6, fasten with 2 sl st in center of 2nd kn st and continue all over scallop. This makes 10 loops of 6 chs, fasten last 6 chs with a loose sl st over first dc of figure. A figure over same, turn. 8th Row—1 figure over same, ch 2, 4 dc with 2 chs betw each, over each loop of 6 chs, ch 3 betw. Ch 2, fasten on last loop of foundation, turn. 9th Row—Ch 2, 4 dc with a picot betw each, in all spaces, between 2nd and 3rd dc below. Ch 3, 1 sl st, ch 3, over the 3 chs. Ch 2, fasten with loose sl st over first dc of figure, 1 figure over same.

**Corner**—Work 9 fig-4 loops at outer edge. Then ch 9, 1 fig over same, connect with sl st in inner loop of foundation, ch 3, turn. 2nd Row—Fig over same, ch 2, 18 dc over loop of 9 chs, ch 2, fasten in first outer loop of foundation. Ch 2, turn. 3rd Row—8 dc with 2 chs betw each over 18 dc, start in 3rd one and the last is worked over the 2 chs. A fig over same, turn. 4th Row—Fig over same. A full kn st over each dc below and full kn st in second loop of foundation. (11 kn sts). Ch 1, turn. 5th Row—A tight sl st, kn st over each below. (12) Fasten in dc over loop of 9 chs, ch 2, fasten in first outer loop of foundation. Ch 2, turn. Same loop of row below. A figure over same, turn. 6th Row—Fig over same, kn st over each below (13). Fasten in 3rd foundation loop, turn. 7th Row—Ch 6, 2 sl st over each of the first 5 kn sts. Ch 7, 2 sl st over the next 4 kn st. Then ch 6, 2 sl st over last 5. A loose sl st in first dc of foundation. A fig over same, turn. (14 loops). 8th and 9th Rows—same as 8th and 9th above.

**Connect second picot, with other scallop.**

**Inner Edge**—1 sl st, ch 3, 1 dc in first loop, ch 6, a petal of 2 dc in next loop, ch 6 (a sl st instead of dc in corner). 2nd Row—1 sl st, ch 4 in first st, 1 dt in 4th st, skipping 3. Ch 3, 1 dt in 5th st, sk 3, 1 dt, ch 3, 1 dt in next st. Work 1 dt right into corner st skipping 3 sts at each side. 3rd Row—5 dc in each upper space. Skip 2 spaces at corner. Work 1 dt in center stitch.



**Square Medallion Corner.** Ch 10, form ring, ch 3, 23 dc in ring. 2nd Row—ch 5, 1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc in same st. Ch 2, sk 2, 1 dc, ch 2, sk 2, \*1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc in next st. Ch 2, sk 2, 1 dc, ch 2, sk 2. Repeat twice from\*. This, for 4 little corners. 3rd Row—Ch 5, 1 dc, ch 2, over each space, going in 3 times at each corner. 4th Row—Ch 3, 3 dc in each space. Ch 3 over dc at corners. Join medallions with 1 sl st at corners. Join corner medallion with 3 picots, placing the 2 sides together. Upper Edging—Start over 5th dc of first medallion, 1 sl st, ch 7, sk 5, 1 dc, ch 7, 1 sl st in upper corner. Ch 7, sk 7, 1 dc, ch 5, sk 4, 1 dc, then 1 dc in second medallion, sk 5. Over Corner Medallion, work 1 dt in 6th st, ch 6, 1 dt, sk 4, Ch 6, 1 dt in corner, 1 dt in corner of next medallion.

2nd Row—1 dt over first dc, ch 10, 1 sl st over same, ch 10, 1 dt over dc, 1 dt over dc of second medallion, skipping the 2 lower dc. Over Corner Medallions, work-1 dt over same, ch 6, 1 dc over same, ch 6, 1 dc over next dt. Ch 7, 1 sl st over the 2 dt in center.

3rd Row—1 dc, ch 3, sk 3—3 times. Ch 3, 1 sl st over same. Ch 3, 1 dc, ch 3, sk 3—twice. Then 1 dt. Over Corner Medallion—Ch 7, 1 dt over dc, 1 tr tr in center, 1 dt over next dc, ch 7. 4th Row—1 dc, ch 1, sk 1—sk 2 at corner. 5th Row—sl st in each st. Lower Edge—sl st, ch 4 over each 3 dc. Over corner ch 4, 4 dc with picot betw each, ch 4. Ch 4 betw medallions. Work 4 tr tr instead of 4 dc in picot betw 2 corner medallions.

**Corner Work**—Corner begins in the first reducing row of the second design. Turn with 4 ch sts, at each side of the design after the 5 dc with ch betw, are worked. After finishing the last row, with its 3 dc, ch 11 as usual. Work 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc in 9th and 10th st from hook... Ch 1, 1 dc in last of the 3 dc of finished design. Ch 6, 1 dt into same st as the last dc, now 1 sl st in first turn of the finished design, ch 5, turn.

2nd Row—6 dc with a chain between each, that is, place 2 dc before the 3 dc, 2 betw same, and 2 in end loop, ch 11, turn. 3rd Row—2 dc with a ch betw, placed same way. Then ch 6, 1 tr tr (thread over 3 times) down in the connecting point below, 1 sl st in next turn of finished design, ch 5, turn. Now finish half this design with this same connection, except in the first reducing row use 1 dt back to last point instead of 1 tr tr, and then 2 sl st over the 2 dc ends. Then ch 3, 1 dc and the first regular row is again ready.

It is quite a problem to figure a pretty turning for an edging that may be very simple to work as a straight piece of lace. These few afford some dainty schemes in simple and elaborate pieces.

On another page of this issue you will find some one-quarter medallions, that are adaptable to edgings of a similar number of rows, that will be practical and neat, too, for any edge one may have started and desire to make the turn.

In a new book, now preparing, the Antique or Spider design is shown in a great number of variations and I will provide many corner schemes in this ever popular pattern.

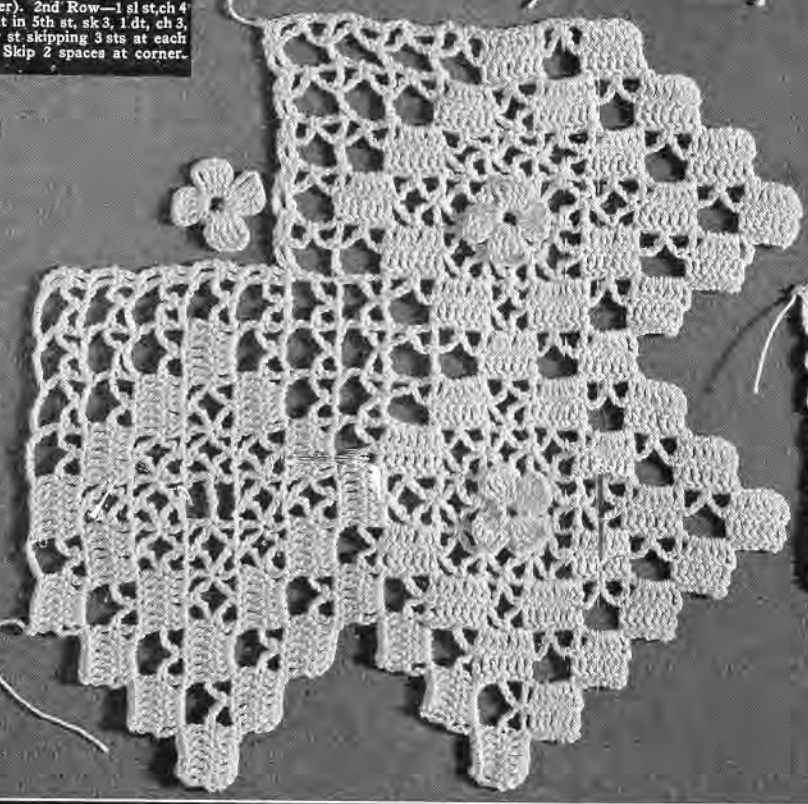
**A Torchon Corner** that is quickly made and not hard to accomplish. Ch 47, 1 dc in 9th st from hook. Ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc. \* Ch 5, sk 4, 1 sl st, repeat 4 times. Ch 5, 2 dc in last 2 sts, ch 3, turn. 2nd Row—1 dc over same, ch 3, 1 sl st over first loop, ch 5, 1 sl st over each of the next 4 loops. Ch 5, 1 dc-ch 1-1 dc, over last loop. Ch 1, 1 dc betw each of the 3 dc below. Ch 1, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc over the turning loop. Ch 11, turn. 3rd Row—1 dc in 9th st from hook, ch 1, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc-ch 1, betw each of the 6 dc below, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc over first loop. There is 1 dc, ch 1, nine times now. Ch 5, 1 sl st over each loop (skipping the small last loop of 3 chs always). Ch 5, 2 dc over same, ch 3, turn. 4th Row—1 dc, ch 3—small loop—Ch 5, 1 sl st over each of 3 loops. Ch 5, 2 dc with 1 ch betw over last loop, 3 dc, ch betw each over same. Ch 4, 1 sl st in center dc below, ch 4, 5 dc with ch, same as in 2nd row, skipping 1 space, ch 11, turn. 5th Row—5 dc, 1 ch betw, as in 3rd row. Ch 5, 1 sl st over 4 chs. Ch 5, 1 sl st over next 4 chs, ch 5, 5 dc, same way, ch 5, sl st, 2 loops, sl st, ch 5, 2 dc, ch 3, turn. 6th Row—1 dc over same, ch 3. 2 loops, ch 5, 5 dc-ch betw—ch 5, 1 sl st over 5 chs, ch 5, 5 dt over 2nd 5 chs. Ch 5, 1 sl st over chs, ch 5, 5 dc-ch betw, ch 11, turn. 7th Row—5 dc-ch betw—ch 5, 1 sl st, 5 times. 5 dc, ch 5, 1 loop, ch 5, 2 dc, ch 3, turn. 8th Row—1 dc over dc, ch 3, 1 loop, ch 5, 5 dc-ch betw—ch 5, sl st, ch 5, 5 dt, ch 5, sl st, ch 5, 5 dt over 4th 5 chs, ch 5, sl st, ch 5, 5 dc-ch betw—ch 11, turn. 9th Row—5 dc-ch betw. Ch 5, sl st, 7 times. 5 dc-ch betw, ch 5, sl st, ch 5, sk small loop, 2 dc, ch 3, turn. 10th Row—1 dc, ch 3, for small loop (at corner, use the 3 chs, sl st in 3rd ch), ch 5, 5 dc-ch betw—Ch 5, sl st, ch 5, 5 dt 3 times, in this row, and as usual. Ch 4 for turn, and last 2 of the 5 dc over a loop. Work opposite now, as this is half the design.

The Lacet stitch is used in this design and is—over a chain of 7, work 1 dc, ch 3, sk 2, 1 sl st, ch 3, sk 2, 1 dc. Next row, over this-1 dc, ch 5, 1 dc. The Diamond stitch is also used and is—over a ch of 7 sts, 1 dc, ch 3, sk 2, 1 sl st, ch 3, sk 2, 1 dc. Next row, over this-1 dc over same, ch 2, 1 dc in same st as dc just made, keeping last loop on hook, make another dt in the next coming dc below, pull thread thru all. Ch 2 and 1 dc into same st as the dt was just made.

**Slip Stitching Thread**—In bringing thread back or forward several stitches, use sl sts, as directed. Insert hook in stitch, pull thread thru this st, and thru the loop on hook, at the same time and as tight as possible.

**Instructions**—1st Row—Ch 45, 6 dc, start in 4th st from hook, 1 lacet, 7 dc in 7 sts, 4 lacets, 2 dc, ch 3, turn. 2nd Row—1 dc over same, completing lacets and 18 dc in all. At end ch 8, turn. This returning row is always the same, either completing lacets or diamonds, and dc over dc below. 3rd Row—Work 6 dc in 4th st from hook, 1 lacet over block of 7 dc, then 7 dc, a lacet being half a diamond, over block, 7 dc, 3 lacets, 2 dc, ch 3, turn. 4th Row—dc over dc and complete diamond, ch 8 (this always while increasing). 5th Row—6 dc, start in 4th st, a lacet, 7 dc, 3 lacets (diamonds), 7 dc, 2 lacet, 2 dc, ch 3, turn. 6th Row—As 4th row. 7th Row—6 dc as usual, lacet, 7 dc, 2 diamonds, then ch 5 over middle diamond—this is hidden under the little flower-2 diamonds; 7 dc, a lacet, 2 dc, ch 3, turn. 8th Row—As usual. At end of this row, turn and sl st as mentioned above over the first block. 9th Row—This is the first reducing row. Ch 3, 6 dc over the 5 sts; 1 lacet over first block, 7 dc, 3 diamonds, 7 dc, 2 lacet, 2 dc, ch 3, turn. 10th Row—As usual. 11th Row—Beginning of first irregularity for corner. Work up, ch 3, 6 dc, 1 lacet, 7 dc, 1 diamond, 7 dc, one lacet, don't work the 3. Now ch 8, turn. 12th Row—Return as usual. 13th Row—Work regular and turn at the same dc as in row below. 14th Row—as usual. Ch 8, now again. 15th Row—Regular to same point. 16th Row—Return as usual. 13th Row—Work regular and turn at the same dc as in row same point as in the 11th row. 23rd Row—Ch 3, 6 dc, 1 lacet, 7 dc, 1 diamond, 7 dc, NOW ch 3 and turn. 24th—return as usual. 25th Row—Ch 3, 6 dc, 1 lacet, 7 dc, 1 diamond, 7 dc, 26th—Return as usual. 27th Row—Ch 3, 6 dc only—and ch 3, turn. 28th Row—Ch 3, 6 dc over same. Now sl st over these 7 sts. Ch 8, turn and NOW work lengthwise, 6 dc, start in 4th from hook. Ch 3 sl st in center of block last made (betw the two rows), ch 3, sl st in 4th of 7 dc to the side, slip st tightly over 5th, 6th and 7th dc, ch 5, turn, 7 dc over your first turned row. Slip st back over these and work another block in same way and then another. This brings you to a regular straight row to work as before. Slip st over 3 sts when you meet the waiting chains of first design.

The Flower in center is—Ch 4, 3 dt in first ch stitch. Ch 4, 1 tight sl st in same st, repeat 3 times.



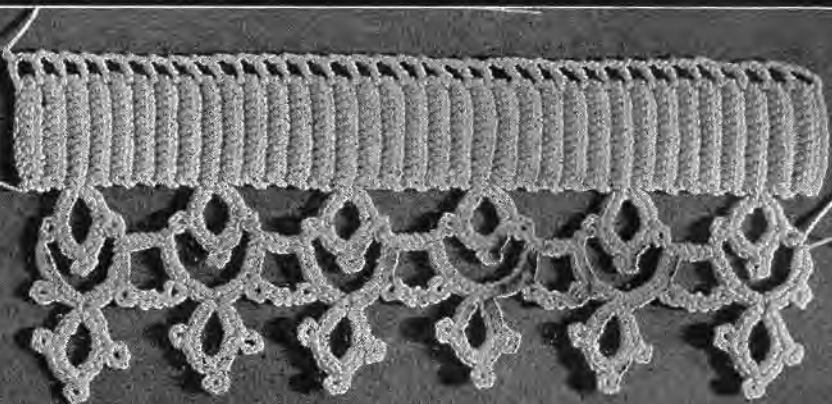
**DAINTY MOTIFS IN HOOK TATTING.**

Ch 13, 12 sl st, start in second st from hook.  
2nd Row—Ch 1, 12 sl st over same, taking up back thread only. 3rd and 4th rows—same.

5th Row—12 sl st over same. Then ch 12, take loop from hook, insert hook in last sl st, pull thread thru and work—5 sl st-1 p-5 sl st-1 p-5 sl st-1 p-5 sl st-over the loop. 6th Row—12 sl st over same, taking up backthread only. Start next loop in 17th row.

Lower motif—Worked lengthwise. Start over first picot, ch 14 to 3rd picot, ch 4 to next loop. 2nd Row—Over the 14 chs work-5 sl st-1 p-5 sl st, then ch 12, take loop from hook, insert hook in last sl st, pull thread through and work the same ring as above, 5 sl st over the 4 chs, 5 sl st over next loop, ch 2. Now carefully work 2 dt back into corresponding picot of past motif, ch 2 back to finish picot, 5 sl st and as before.

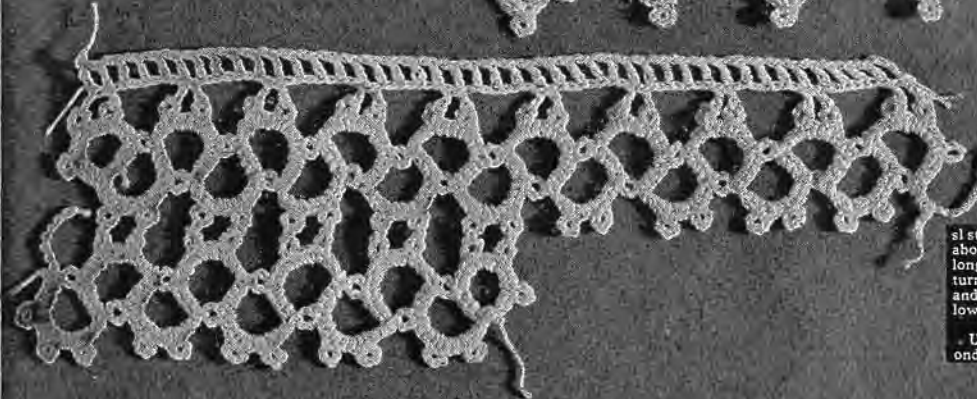
Upper Row—1 dc, ch 2—the 1 dc in each ridge.



**IRISH RICK RACK**

Use separate ball of thread for a long chain, thus you can lengthen all you desire. With another thread, make a loop on hook, insert hook in the first and 12th st of long ch, make a tight sl st. Then from left to right work 3 sl st-1 p-four times and 3 sl st, in this ring. Fasten. Turn, place long ch betw hook and thread, and work-1 tight, sl st, then 3 sl st-1 p-3 times, and 3 sl st over about 9 sts of long ch. Now 1 sl st over long ch in first picot of ring below. Again, turn, place long ch betw thread and hook and work same way to desired length. In lower rows, join picots.

Upper Edge—1 dc in first and 1 dc in second p, ch 7 bet. 2nd Row—1 dc, ch 1, skip 1

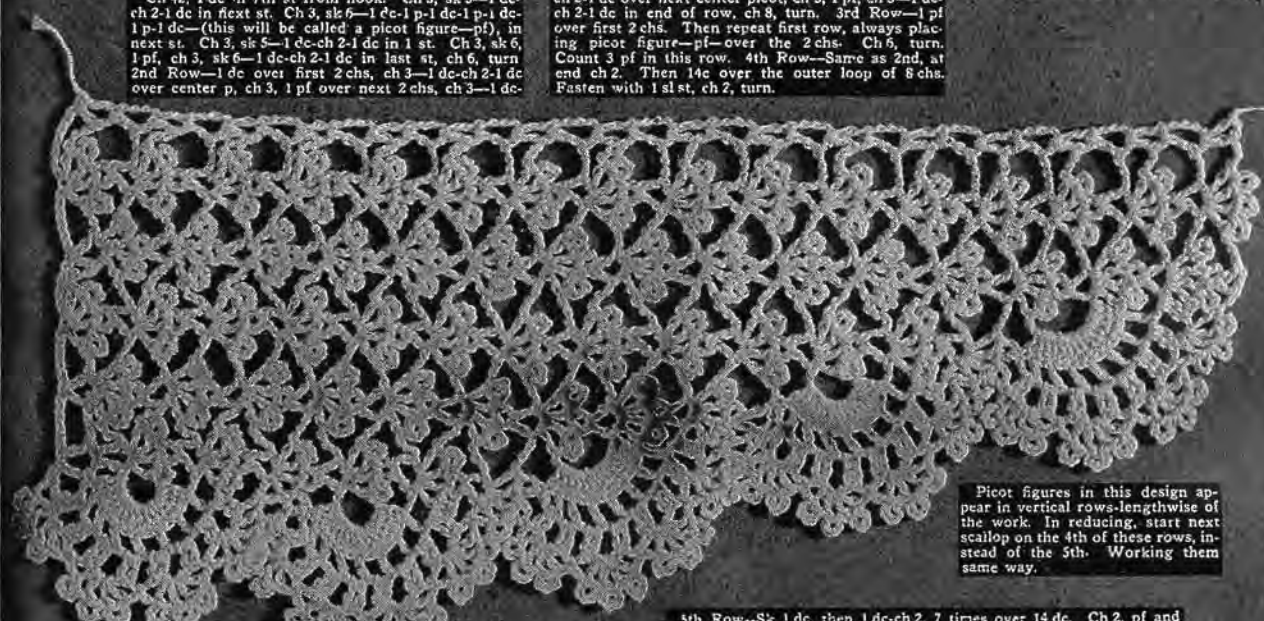
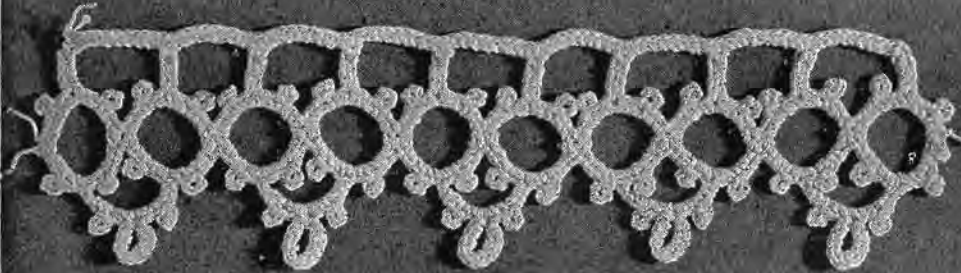


Make a long ch. With another thread, 3 sl sts over first 3 sts, ch 9, skip 9, 3 sl st, forming rings. 2nd Row—lower-1 tight sl st in center sl st, 4 sl st, 1 p, 5 sl st, 1 p, 4 sl st, over a half ring. A tight sl st in center of the 3 below, 4 sl st, 1 p, 3 sl st, now, ch 10, turn, fasten over center st of first ring, turn-3 sl st-1 p-3 sl st in this loop, ch 9, take loop from hook, insert in sl st last made, draw loop of thread thru and work 11 sl st in this new loop. Now in remaining loop, 3 sl st-1 p-3 sl st, and 3 sl st-1 p-4 sl st in ring, tight sl st over the 3 below.

Upper Part—4 sl st-1 p-3 sl st over half of ring. Ch 6, start in second st from hook, working 1 sl st in each st for the little stem, then over ring—3 sl st-1 p-4 sl st and 1 tight sl st over the center of 3 sl st below. 2nd Row—Sl st in stem, ch 9 between. 3rd Row—10 sl st over 9 chs, 1 over sl st of stem.

Ch 42, 1 dc in 7th st from hook. Ch 3, sk 5—1 dc-ch 2-1 dc in next st. Ch 3, sk 6—1 dc-1 p-1 dc-1 p-1 dc-1 p-1 dc—(this will be called a picot figure—pf), in next st. Ch 3, sk 5—1 dc-ch 2-1 dc in 1 st. Ch 3, sk 6, 1 pf, ch 3, sk 6—1 dc-ch 2-1 dc in last st, ch 6, turn 2nd Row—1 dc over first 2 chs, ch 3—1 dc-ch 2-1 dc over center p, ch 3, 1 pf over next 2 chs, ch 3—1 dc-

ch 2-1 dc over next center picot, ch 3, 1 pf, ch 3—1 dc-ch 2-1 dc in end of row, ch 8, turn. 3rd Row—1 pf over first 2 chs. Then repeat first row, always placing picot figure—pf—over the 2 chs. Ch 6, turn. Count 3 pf in this row. 4th Row—Same as 2nd, at end ch 2. Then 14c over the outer loop of 6 chs. Fasten with 1 sl st, ch 2, turn.



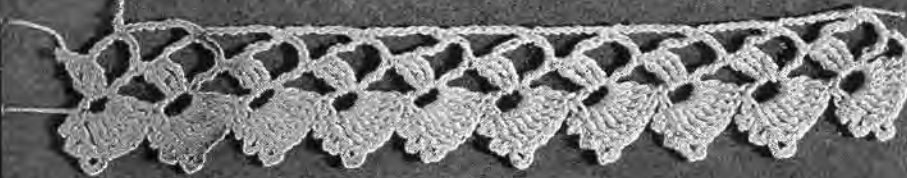
Picot figures in this design appear in vertical rows-lengthwise of the work. In reducing, start next scallop on the 4th of these rows, instead of the 5th. Working them same way.

5th Row—Sk 1 dc, then 1 dc-ch 2, 7 times over 14 dc. Ch 2, pf and finish as usual, ch 6, turn. 6th Row—Same until scallop is reached. Ch 2, then 2 dc-ch 2 over each space—(8 times), fasten, ch 1, turn. 7th Row—Work a pf over first space, ch 1-1 sl st-ch 1 over second space until there are 4 pf over scallop. Ch 1-1 sl st-ch 1 over last space, then usual picot figure.



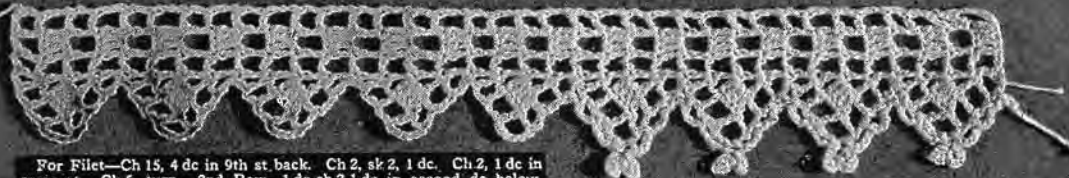
Braid is actual size here. Thread No. 50. 1 sl st, ch 1 over each of 3 picots of braid. Ch 11, 2 dt in next p, sk 2, 2 dt, sk 3, 2 tr tr—thread over 3 times—sk 3 p, and duplicate the 2 dt figures, bending braid carefully. Ch 3, turn, fasten in 8th st of the 11 chs. Ch 7 and 3 sl st in 3 picots. 2nd upper row—A sl st in each st. Lower row—1 sl st over 5 p of braid, betw scallops—skipping 1 betw. Now 1 sl st in next p. Count 5 p to center space. \*working a picot of 5 chs, sk a p of braid, sl st in next. Repeat once. Then a p in next p of braid, reaching center, where 3 p are worked. Repeat for other side.

Braid is actual size here. Thread is No. 70. 1 sl st in first p of braid. Ch 1, 1 sl st in next p, ch 3, sk 1-1 sl st-ch 1, 1 sl st in next 2 p of braid. 2nd Row—sl st—1 knot st over each 3 chs. 3rd Row—kn st over same. 4th Row—sl st over center of kn st, then 4 picots (of 5 chs each)—that is—work second picot into sl st of first, etc. Fasten over next kn st, 1 kn st over same, then the 4 p again. The last 3 loops show a change, which is—ch 6, 2 sl st, over each kn st, 5 sl st, ch 4, 5 sl st over each 6 chs. Novelty Braid is generally to be had, and this is size C.



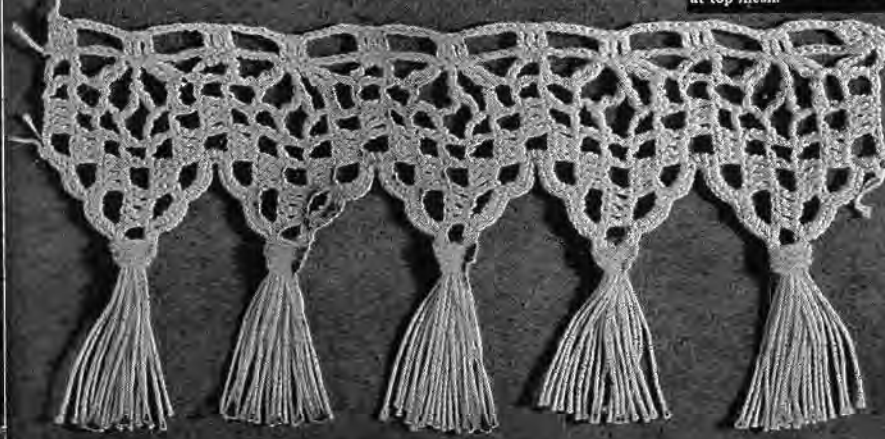
Ch 7, form ring, 1 sl st in ring, 3 picots, first in sl st just made, second in sl st of first, third in sl st of second. 7 dt in ring. Ch 7, turn, 1 sl st over dt just made, turn, 3 picots, first one in sl st just made. 2nd Row—From right to left. Ch 4—for beginning only—1 dt-ch-7-3 dt in remaining ring of 7 chs. 1 dt-ch-7-3 dt in next ring. 3rd Row—1 sl st over each 7 chs, ch 7, between.

Ch 15, 1 sl st in 10th st from hook. Ch 5, 1 sl st in first ch st, ch 7, turn. 2nd Row—1 sl st over the 5 chs. Ch 5, 1 sl st in the 5th ch st, ch 6, turn. 3rd Row—1 sl st over 5 chs, ch 5, 1 sl st in next loop. Ch 7, 1 sl st in the first ch st of the first row, turn. 4th Row—1 sl st-1 sc-1 dc-1 p-1 dc-1 p-1 dc-1 p-7 dc over the last loop of 7 chs. Ch 2, 4 dc in first loop, ch 2, 4 dc in second loop, ch 6, turn. 5th Row—1 sl st over first 2 chs, ch 5, 1 sl st over second 2 sts, ch 7, turn.



For Filet—Ch 15, 4 dc in 9th st back. Ch 2, sk 2, 1 dc. Ch 2, 1 dc in same st. Ch 5, turn. 2nd Row—1 dc-ch 2-1 dc in second dc below, then 3 om, there are 5 spaces in this row. Ch 5, turn. 3rd Row—1 om, 1 sm, 1 om, ch 2, 1 dc in same dc, 2 dc over 2 chs, 1 dc over next dc—this for slanting sm. Ch 2, sk 2, 1 dc, ch 5, turn. 4th Row—3 om, ch 2, 1 dc in same st, 3 om—7 spaces. 5th Row—1 om, 1 sm, 1 om, ch 2, 1 dc in same st, ch 5, turn. The finishing row is in blue silk finish cotton—it is—ch 3, 1 sl st in each mesh, 2 picots over center mesh. No chs between.

Ch 17, 2 om, 1 sm, 1 om, turn. 2nd Row—Ch 8, 1 sm, 2 om, turn. 3rd Row—1 sl st over first om, 2 om, 1 sm, 1 om—that is ch 2, 1 dt in same st of last dc. 4th Row—Ch 8, 1 sm, 2 om, ch 8, turn. Now at top of 4th mesh in center. Increase at upper, decrease at lower edge in same way. Upper first row—in blue silk finish cotton, 3 sl st over first om, ch 6, 1 petal st of 2 dt in next lower mesh. 1 dt—thread over 4 times—in lowest mesh, work off 2 loops, then thread over twice, in other lowest mesh and work all off 2 by 2, a petal of 2 dt in next om, ch 6, 3 sl st at top mesh.



2nd Upper Row—in white thread—3 dc in 3 sl st, in top mesh, ch 6, sk 6, 3 dc. Row on Lower Edge, 6 sl st in each mesh, 8 in center mesh. Fringe—Wind thread over cardboard 1 1/4 inches wide, 10 times, cut and tie in lower mesh. This is a dainty edging to match Filet work.

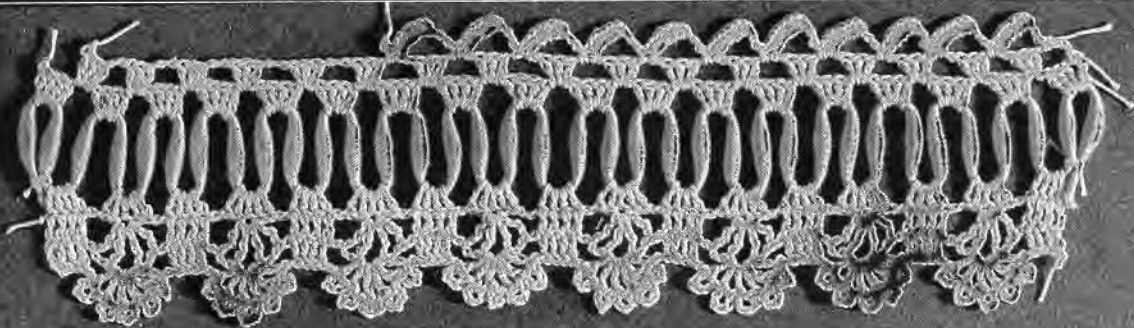
Actual size of braid and No. 40 thread. Lower edge, 1 sl st in dip of braid, ch 6 to next, 1 sl st, ch 8 for loop, sl st beside last one, ch 6 to next dip. 2nd Row—1 sl st in point. Ch 7—Go back in 3rd st for picot, 1 dc in loop, picot of 6 chs, 1 dc, picot of 4 chs, ch 2 to next point, 1 sl st, ch 2, 1 sl st in loop. Ch 3, 2 dc, 3 p, 2 dc, ch 3, 1 sl st all in the same loop. Ch 2, 1 sl st in next point. Upper row—sl st, ch 6, sl st

Folded Braid—1 sl st in first point—sl st in second point—to fold braid. Ch 7 to next point and repeat. 2nd Row—1 dc, ch 1, skip 1. 3rd Row—sl st in each st. These are the upper rows and in color make a neat contrast. Lower edge—sl st in point betw fold, ch 3. 1 dc—ch 5—1 dc over point, ch 3 to next point. 2nd Row—sl st over first dc. 1 sc—2 dc—2 st—1 sc over the 5 chs. 1 sl st over second dc. Chain 4 to next dc. These edges are all shown actual size.

Lay two pieces of braid together with points meeting—make a sl st jo'ning them, ch 6 to next point. Unfold braid. 2nd Row—Lowest—Make a long and loose sl st over the dip, ch 3, picot—(of 5 chs)—in point of braid, ch 3, a long loose sl st over other dip, to right and left, ch 3. 3rd Row—In middle—from right to left—2 sl st, ch 4, 2 sl st over each 6 chs. Ch 4 to next opening. Upper Row—Sl st in point, ch 6 to next. 2nd Row—1 dc, ch 1, skip 1. The lower rows are worked in light blue.

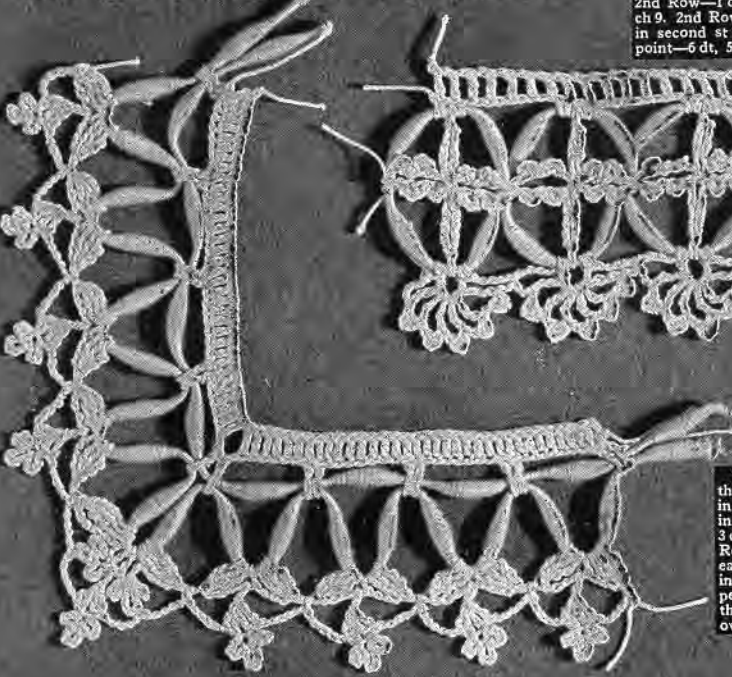
Inner Row is worked first. sl st in point of braid, ch 5, sl st in next point. Ch 13, sl st in third point, ch 6—back into 3rd st for picot, ch 3, sl st in 4th point. Ch 21, 3 tr, tr—thread over 3 times—in 6th st from hook. Ch 5, 1 tight sl st in same st. Ch 11. Repeat petal twice, then ch 9 for petal twice, again 11 twice, 4 tight sl st for stem. 2nd Row—Ch 14, turn, 1 sl st in center of petal. Ch 7 and sl st in petal twice. Ch 10—back to 6th for picot. 3rd Row—Ch 6, turn. 1 sl st, ch 7, 1 sl st over each of loops. Ch 21 and start second scallop, joining side petals to loop—bend right side up. Upper edge—1 sl st, ch 3, 2 dc in loop. Ch 6, 3 dc in next loop. Ch 6. 2nd Row—1 dc, ch 1, sk 1.

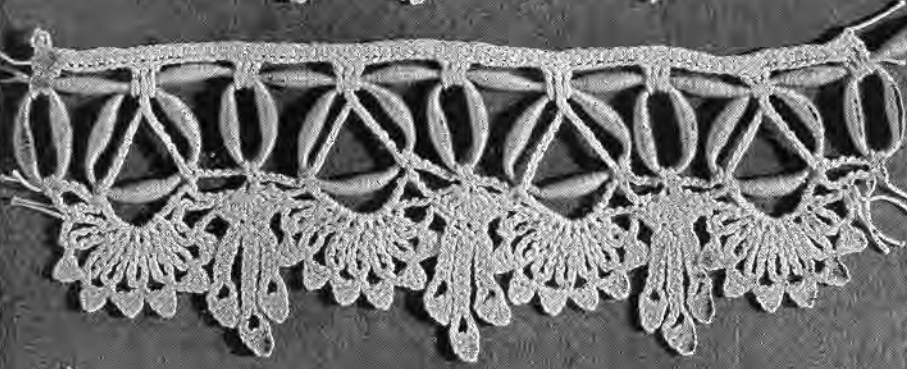

If the scallops shown are added, it will make a complete edge in itself. Scallop is—1 sl st, over 2 chs, ch 2, a dt over the next 2 chs. Ch 1, 7 sl st over the dt just made, 1 sl st in same space. Ch 2 for next scallop.  
Lower Edge—4 dc over first thin part, ch 1, 5 dc over next, ch 1. 2nd Row—4 dc over same, ch 1, then 4 dt with 2 chs betw each in center st of the 5 dc, ch 1. 3rd Row—4 dc over same, ch 1, then 6 dc with a picot betw each over second center space of the dt below. Ch 1.

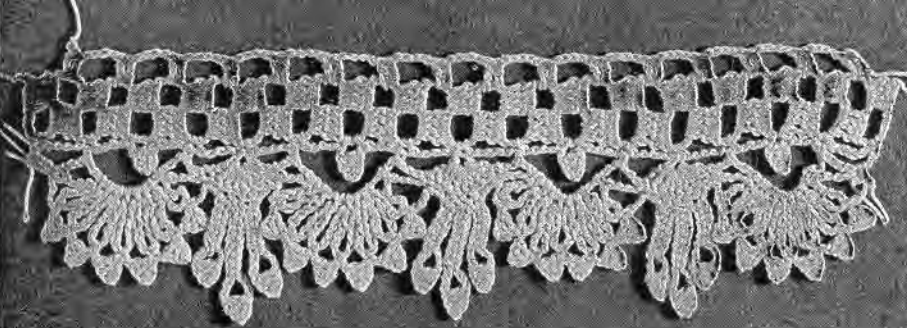
On Coronation Braid. With double length, fold braid and start at the middle. 1 sl st over thin part, ch 6-go back in second-for picot, ch 5-back in first-for p. 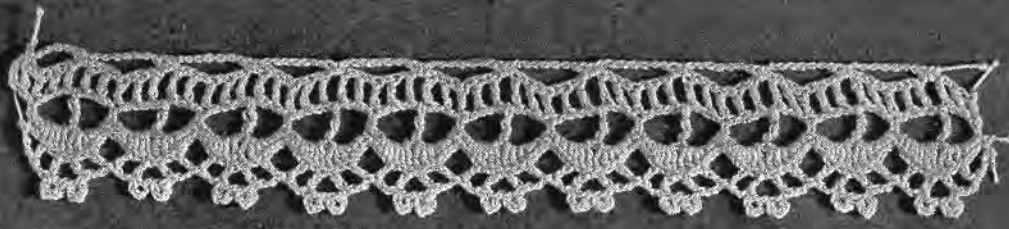
Two lengths of braid, gather as shown, 1 sl st, ch 3, 1 dc over first thin folds, ch 7, 2 dc over next folds, ch 7, continuing. 2nd Row—1 dc in each st. Sk 5 at corner and note braid folding. Lower edge—1 sl st in thin part, ch 4, 1 petal of 2 dt, ch 4, sl st over braid.\* Ch 4, petal of 3 dt, Ch 1, 1 petal of 3 dt in next braid loop, ch 4, sl st over braid. Repeat. Upper rows first. Fold braid as shown, 1 sl st, ch 3, 2 dc over thin folds. Ch 7, note braid, 3 dc over braid, ch 7. 2nd Row—sl st in each st. Lower Edge—2 sl st over braid, ch 5, sl st in corner of braid loop, then ch 8 up through this loop to upper row, sl st in 2 threads of dc, ch 8 down to corner, sl st, ch 5, 2 sl st in small braid loop, ch 5. 2nd Row—1 sl st betw the 2 sl st, ch 6, sl st over same, ch 11, sl st over same. Ch 6, sl st betw the 2 in small braid loop. 3rd Row—Sl st over center of 6 chs, ch 3, 1 sl st in loop of 11 chs. Ch 8, sl st—then ch 10, sl st, 5 times, ch 8, sl st—all in same loop. Ch 3, sl st over 6 chs, a shell of 7 dc in next sl st. 1 sl st, ch 3 to next 11 chs.  
Fourth Row—Sl st over same, ch 3 to first loop, sl st. Now ch 4, start in second from hook—1 sl st, 1 sc, 1 dc, this for point. Sl st in next loop, work 6 points, taking up all loops. Ch 3, sl st over same, net to shell st. Sl st up shell for 3 sts. Ch 12, work point as before, ch 3, sk 3, sl st in each left of the 12 chs. Fasten with sl st over sh st. Ch 14, make pendant same way. Again a pendant of 12 chs. Fasten 3 sl st over the shell, 1 sl st over last one, ch 3 to next scallop.



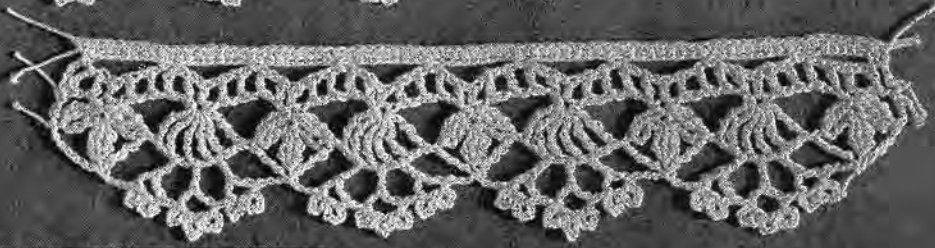
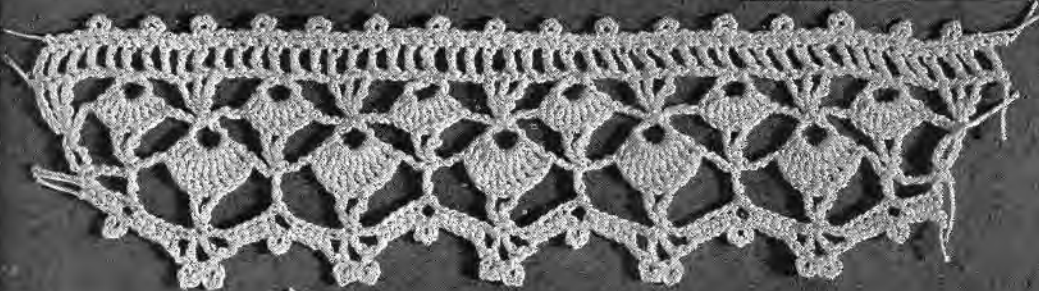

A loose sl st over next one below, ch 7, sl st over same. 3rd Row—1 sl st over 4th of 7 chs, ch 4, sl st in loop of 12 chs, then ch 9, sl st—ch 11, sl st—5 times—ch 9, sl st all in loop of 12 chs. Ch 4, sl st in the 4th of 7 chs, a shell of 7 dc in loose sl st, sl st in 4th of 7 chs. Ch 4, turn. 4th Row—As above.



Worked lengthwise. 1 dc, ch 1, sk 1 in a long chain. 2nd Row—1 sl st over dc, ch 4, sk 2 dc, 1 dt in next space. Ch 4, sk 2 dc, 1 sl st over next dc. 3rd Row—3 sl st-1 sc-2 dc-1 dt over first 4 chs. 1 dt-2 dc-1 sc-3 sl st over next 4 chs. 4th Row—1 dc in 5th st, ch 2, sk 1. 1 dc in next st, 1 p, then ch 5—go back into first ch for picot; 1 dc in next st, ch 2, skip 1 dc. Upper Row—2 sl st in space over the dt. Ch 7, sk 4 spaces, 2 sl st over space of next dt.

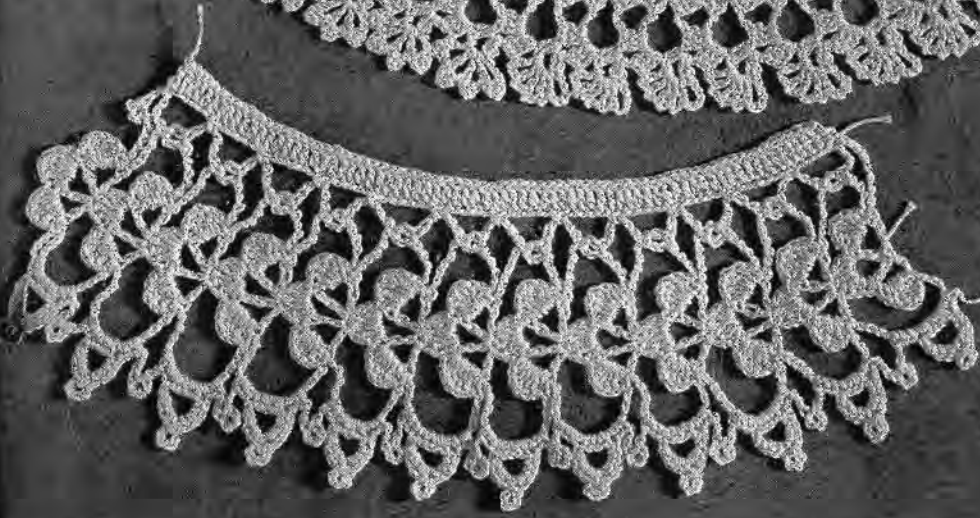
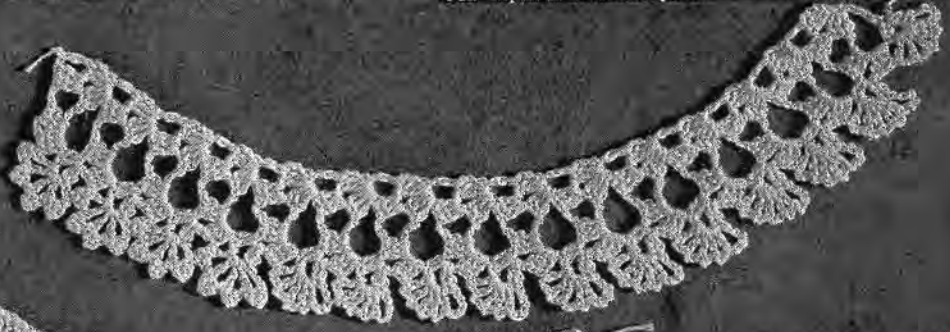

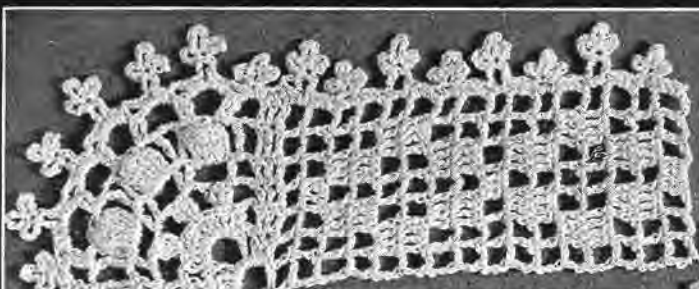

Then a figure (3 dc-ch 2-3 dc) over first half of 5 chs, ch 2, 3 dc over the 2 chs of figure below. Ch 1, 1 dc in end of row. Ch 5, turn. 3rd Row—2 dc-ch 2-3 dc over the 1 ch. Ch 5, 2 dc-ch 2-2 dc over the 2 chs of figure. Ch 5, turn. The last 4 scallops show a change—Ch 6, for turn, 1 sl st, 1 sc in second and third tr from hook. 1 dc, ch 3, 1 sl st, 1 sc in last 2 ch sts, 1 dc. Repeat un'il 4 of these points.



Rounding Edge—Ch 6, 3 dc with 3 chs betw each, in first ch st. Ch 17, go back into 13th st, to make a picot, turn. 2nd Row—Ch 4, fasten in dc last made. 1 sl st-1 sc-1 dc-2 dt-1 dc-1 sc-over each of the 3 chs. Ch 13, turn. 3rd Row—4 dc, with 3 chs betw each, in the 2 dt of center petal. Ch 6, fasten in picot, ch 10, going back in 6th, ch 4. Lower Row—3 sl st over center part of first loop, ch 6, turn, skip 4 sl sts, fasten in next st, turn, 4 sl sts, 1 p, 4 sl sts in this new loop, 3 sl sts in remaining loop. Ch 7, go back in third st, ch 2 and start second loop. Upper Rows—A sl st in each loop, ch 5 between. Then 1 dc in each st.



These corners are practical for any edges of their size and afford a much wanted means of turning. This one shows how filet edges work in connection with the scheme.

Ch 10 for ring. Ch 3, 2 dc, 1 dc-ch5-1 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, in ring, ch 3, turn. 2nd Row—2 dc over same. Ch 2, 1 dc over 1-5-1. Ch 2, 3 dc, ch 3, turn. 3rd Row—2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc over 3rd, 6th, 9th-3 chs betw. Ch 3, 3 dc, ch 3, turn. 4th Row—2 dc, ch 2, 1 dc in space, ch 4, 1 dc-ch 2, 1 dc in next space. Ch 4, repeat twice. 1 dc in last sp, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 4, turn. 5th Row—2 dc over dc. Ch 2, 1 dt in sp. Ch 2, a puff st-(7 dt, turn, tight sl st in first)-in next space. Ch 2, 1 dc-ch 2-1 dt in sp. Ch 2, repeat twice. 1 dt, ch 2, 3 dt over dc, ch 3, turn. 6th Row—2 dc over dt. Ch 3, 2 dc over 2 chs at pf st, ch 5, 2 dc in next space, ch 5, sk a space, repeat have 5 chs 5 times. Ch 3, 3 dc, ch 1, turn. 7th Row—3 sl st over dc, 1 sl st, 3 picots, 1 sl st in first space, 3 sl st-then ch 8, go back in second st, work 2 more picots, ch 2, 3 sl st over 5 chs.

Ch 7 for ring, Ch 5, 7 dc in ring, ch 2, 1 dc. Ch 5, turn. 2nd Row—7 dc with a ch betw-over 7 dc below. Ch 2, 1 dc in 3rd ch. Ch 5, turn. 3rd Row—3 dc over 1 ch-ch 1 betw-(6 times). Ch 2, 1 dc, ch 9, turn. 4th Row—1 dc, go back in 3rd st. 1 dc over 2 chs, 1 dc over 1 ch, ch 6, 1 dc in top of dc last made, 1 dc in same space. Repeat. Outer Edge—1 picot over every other row, 5 sl st betw.



Ch 5 for ring. Ch 7, 1 sl st, ch 4, 1 dc in ring, ch 7, turn. 2nd Row—Sl st in loop, ch 5, sl st in loop, ch 4, 1 dc in same loop, ch 7, turn. 3rd Row—1 sl st in first loop (Lp), ch 6, sl st in Lp, again in 3rd Lp, Ch 4, sl st in same Lp. Ch 7, turn. 4th Row—Sl st in Lp. Ch 6, sl st 3 times. Ch 4, 1 dc in last Lp. Ch 8, turn. 5th Row—Sk Lp, 4 Lp of 6 chs. Sk last Lp 1 dc, ch 7, turn. 6th Row—Sl st in first Lp. Ch 6, sl st in Lp. Shell of 9 dt in next sl st. Sl st in 3rd Lp, ch 6, sl st, ch 4, 1 dc, ch 7, turn. 7th Row—Sl st in Lp. Ch 6, sl st in Lp. Ch 6, sl st in center dt. Now ch 6, go back in 2nd st, ch 5-back in first, ch 7-back in 3rd, ch 5-back in first, ch 1, 1 sl st in same dt, making

picots. Repeat start of row. Ch 8, turn. 8th Row—Sk Lp. Sl st in 2nd Lp, 7 dc shell in next sl st, 1 sl st. Ch 8, sl st over center of picot figure, ch 8. Repeat start of row, ch 7, turn. 9th Row—Sl st in first Lp, ch 6, sl st over center dc of shell. Work same picot figure. Ch 9, sl st over same of center figure. Then another picot figure. Ch 9, repeat. Ch 7, turn. 10th Row—1 sl st in first Lp. Ch 7, go back in 3rd st, work 2 more picots, ch 2, 1 sl st in Lp. Ch 8, sl st over picot figure, 3 picots. Ch 10, go back in 6th st, work 2 more picots. Ch 5, 3 picots over center. Repeat. Side Rows are—1 picot over every other row, 5 sl st betw.

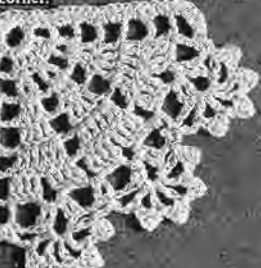

Ch 2, 1 dc over last dc, ch 2, 1 dc, ch 5, turn. 3rd Row—3 meshes, same center, 3 meshes. Increase in same way, with same sts in center, follow design thru 10th row. 11th Row—3 sl st in each mesh, 7 sl st in center space. 12th Row—Ch 5, sk 4, 1 sl st for first and last small loop. Ch 4, start in 2nd st from hook, 1 sl st-1 sc-1 dc forming point. 1 petal st in same loop. Continue until there are 3 of these little points. Then ch 3, 1 sl st, ch 3 in next loop. Ch 7 for ring, ch 7-then a figure—2 dt-ch 2-2 dt. Ch 2, 1 dt in ring. Ch 5, turn. 2nd Row—1 dt in first space, ch 2, 2 dt, ch 2, 1 dt, ch 2, 1 dt, ch 2, 2 dt in center sp. Ch 2, 1 dt, ch 1, 1 dt in last sp. Ch 5, turn. 3rd Row—1 dt in first sp, ch 3. Figure is above in 2nd, 3rd and 4th sp, ch 2 betw each fig. Ch 3, 1 dt, ch 1, 1 dt in last sp, ch 5, turn. 4th Row—1 dt in sp. Ch 3, 3 dt, ch 3, 3 dt in center of each figure below, ch 3 betw. Ch 3, 1 dt, ch 1, 1 dt in last sp. 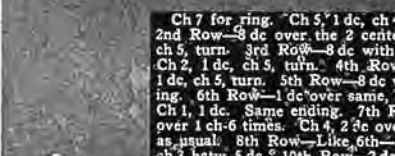

Ch 2, 1 dc, ch 1, turn. 8th Row—3 sl st in first space, ch 2, 1 dc over 3 chs in center. Ch 3, 1 sl st-1 sc in 2nd and 3rd st from hook for point. 1 dc, ch 3, for point, repeat until 4 points. Ch 2, 1 sl st betw next 2 dc, 3 sl st in last space. Edge is 3 sl st over each row.

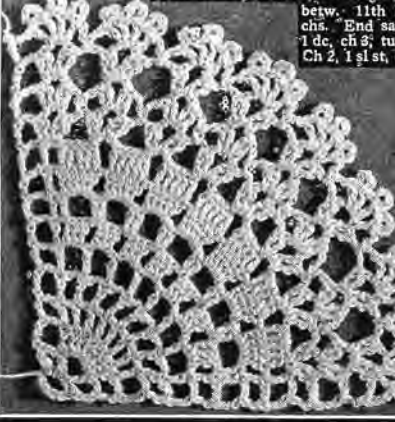
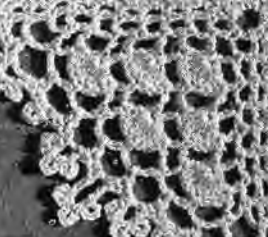


Ch 8 for ring. Ch 3, 1 dc, ch 3, 1 sl st, ch 3, 2 dc in ring. Ch 3, turn. 2nd Row—1 dc over same. Ch 3, 1 sl st in first loop, ch 5, sl st in next loop. Ch 3, 2 dc over same, Ch 3, turn. 3rd Row—1 dc over same, Ch 3, sl st in loop. Ch 5, 1 sl st in each of next 2 Lps. Ch 3, 2 dc over same, ch 3, turn. 4th Row—1 dc over same. Ch 3, sl st in Lp. Ch 5, sl st in Lp. A shell of 7 dc in next sl st in next Lp. Repeat, start of row. 5th Row—1 dc over same. Ch 3, 1 sl st in first Lp. Now 4 loops of 5 chs over same and shell. Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, turn. 6th Row—1 dc over same. Ch 3, sl st in Lp. Ch 5, sl st, shell, sl st, ch 5, sl st. Center. Repeat. 7th and 8th Rows—Same as 5th and 6th, increasing as before—3 shells in 8th row.

9th Row—1 dc over same. Now ch 5, sk loop of 3 chs. Now 1 Lp over same and over shell. Sk last small loop, 2 dc. (8 loops). 10th Row—1 dc over same, ch 3 for small Lp. Then 7 Lps of 5 chs, small Lp, 2 dc. 11th Row—1 sl st-1 p-1 sl st over small Lp. 2 sl st-3p-2 sl st in next Lp. 2 sl st-1 p-2 sl st in 3rd Lp. 2 sl st-3p-2 sl st in 4th Lp. 2 sl st, ch 8 go back in 4th st, 2 more picots, ch 3, 2 sl st in center loop. Repeat. Over sides—1 picot over every other row, 4 sl st between.



Ch 7 for ring. Ch 5, 1 dc, ch 4, 1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc in ring. Ch 5, turn. 2nd Row—3 dc over the 2 center dc and over the 4 chs. Ch 2, 1 dc, ch 5, turn. 3rd Row—3 dc with 1 ch betw each over the 8 dc below. Ch 2, 1 dc, ch 5, turn. 4th Row—3 dc with 2 chs betw each. Ch 2, 1 dc, ch 5, turn. 5th Row—3 dc with 3 chs betw over 8 dc. Same ending. 6th Row—1 dc over same, ch 1, 3 dc, ch 1 over each of 7 spaces. Ch 1, 1 dc. Same ending. 7th Row—2 dc over dc and ch. Ch 4, 2 dc over 1 ch-6 times. Ch 4, 2 dc over ch st and dc. Ch 2, 1 dc, ch 5, turn, as usual. 8th Row—Like 6th—5 dc over 7 spaces. 9th Row—Same as ch 3 betw 5 dc. 10th Row—2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc over the 1 and 3 chs, ch 2 betw. 11th Row—2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc in same. Ch 2, 1 sl st, ch 2 over 2 chs. End same. 12th Row—2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc in 2 chs, ch 4 betw, Ch 2, 1 dc, ch 3; turn. 13th Row—4 dc with 1 picot betw. each over 3 chs. Ch 2, 1 sl st, ch 2 over the 4 chs.



Ch 6 for ring. Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc in ring. Ch 3, turn. 2nd Row—3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc (a figure) over 3 chs. Ch 3, repeat figure. Ch 3, turn. 3rd Row—A figure over each 3 chs, ch 2, betw, ch 3, turn. 4th Row—Figure over each below, ch 3, betw, ch 3, turn. 5th Row—Fig. in center of first one, ch 5, 3 dc-ch 3-3 dc-ch 3-3 dc in center. Ch 5, fig over last one. Ch 3, turn. 6th Row—Fig. over each 3 chs, ch 5 bet first and 2nd and betw 3rd and 4th. Ch 3, turn. 7th Row—Fig. over same. Ch 3, sl st in center st of 5 chs, ch 3. Fig. over fig., ch 3, fig. Repeat. 8th Row—Fig. over same. Ch 5, sl st over same, ch 5, fig., ch 3, sl st in center st of 3 chs, ch 3, repeat. 9th Row—Fig. over same, ch 7, sl st over same, ch 7, fig, ch 5, sl st, ch 5, repeat, ch 3, turn. 10th Row—10 dt with 2 chs betw each, over center of each fig, ch 2 betw, ch 2 fasten, turn. 11th Row—Ch 4, 1 sl st over each 2 chs. Sk chs betw scallops, ch 2. Over sides—sl st in each loop, ch 6 betw, and second row is 3 sl st, 1p, 3 sl st, over each 6 chs.
