# BAG

Starting at bottom with Black ch 16, 3 s c in 2nd ch from hook, 1 s c in each of the next 13 sts of ch, 3 s c in end ch, working on other side of ch, 1 s c in each st, do not join this or the following rounds. Place a marker at beginning of each round.

2nd Round. 2 s c in each of the next 3 s c, 1 s c in each s c on side, 2 s c in each of the 3 s c at end, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

3rd Round. 1 s c in each s c on sides and 2 s c in each of the 6 s c at each end.

4th Round. 1 s c in each s c.

5th Round. \* 2 s c in next s c, 1 s c in next s c, repeat from \* 5 times (6 increases), 1 s c in each s c on side, work opposite end same as beginning, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

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THIS BOOK FEATURES A NEW AND CHIC USE FOR THE WELL KNOWN "STAR" RUG YARN, ARTICLE 44.

6th and 7th Rounds. 1 s c in each s c.

8th Round. 1 s c in each s c.

**9th Round.** Is c in base of each s c working over entire st (double round worked for a firm edge).

Repeat the 8th and 9th rounds twice, break yarn. This finishes bottom of bag.

**UPPER SECTION:** With White ch 60 loosely, join to form a ring being careful not to twist ch, ch 1 and work 1 s c in each st of ch, do not join rounds. Place a marker at beginning of each round.

2nd to 11th Rounds. 1 s c in each s c, drop White.

When changing Color always complete last half of st with next Color.

12th Round. Attach Black, \* 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, now work 1 s c in base of each of the next 3 s c working over each entire st, repeat from \* all around, drop Black.

13th Round. Pick up White and work 1 s c in each s c, drop White.

14th Round. Pick up Black, \* 1 s c in base of each of the next 3 sts working over each entire st, 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, repeat from \* all around, drop Black.

15th Round. Same as 13th round.

16th Round. With Black 1 s c in each s c, break Black.

17th to 29th Rounds. With White work even in s c.

30th to 33rd Rounds. Repeat 12th to 15th rounds, break White.

**34th Round.** With Black 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, ch 2, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 6 s c, ch 2, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 8 s c, \* ch 2, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 6 s c, repeat from \* twice, ch 2, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 8 s c, ch 2, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 6 s c ending row with ch 2, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the last 3 s c.

35th Round. 1 s c in base of each s c all around and 2 s c in each ch 2 loop, break yarn. Cut oval shape cardboard 3¾ inches in width and 8 inches in length. Cut 2 pieces of felt same shape allowing ¼ inch all around for sewing. Insert cardboard between the 2 felt pieces and sew ¼ inch in from edge all around.

Cut felt lining to fit upper section having it about 1 inch shorter at top and sew to oval shape bottom. Sew an inside pocket if desired. Place entire lining in upper section and sew lower edge of upper section to oval shape bottom. Sew top of lining in position just under the 33rd round.

Place completed bag in 1st Black section made having the last 2 double rows extend up over bag to form a cuff. Sew in position.

With Black crochet 2 chs each about 1 yd. long. Lace 1 ch through beading at top of bag. Lace other ch through beading from opposite side. Sew free ends together.

# HAT

With White ch 4, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 10 s c in ring, do not join rounds. Place a marker at beginning of each round.

2nd Round. 2 s c in each s c (20 s c).

3rd Round. \* 2 s c in next s c, 1 s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around (30 s c).

4th Round. 1 s c in each s c.

5th Round. \* 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around (40 s c). Work 1 round even in s c.

7th Round. \* 1 s c in next s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around (60 s c).

8th to 14th Rounds. Work even, drop White.

15th to 19th Rounds. Repeat 12th to 16th rounds (pattern) of bag.

**BRIM:** 1st Row. With White, \* 1 s c in next s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from \* to within last 7 s c, ch 1, turn.

2nd Row. 1 s c in each s c, ch 1, turn.

3rd to 5th Rows. Same as 2nd row, break White. Sew side end of brim to 1st 4 free sts of last Black round sewing on wrong side. Sew other side end of brim to remainder of free sts of last Black round. This forms a point in the back of hat.

6th Round. Attach Black in point and work \* 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, 1 s c in base of next 3 s c working over entire sts, repeat from \* all around.

7th Round. 1 s c in each s c.

8th Round. 1 s c in base of each s c of previous round (double round made for a firm edge), break yarn.

Article 700

One 1½ inch Button. One 1/2 inch metal Button.

HAT

Work crown same as The Roller on Page 15.

TRIMMING: Using 1 strand of yarn and 1 strand of Rayon ch 7, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 1 s c in each st of ch, without joining and working on inside of roll, work 1 s c in each s c until roll measures about 30 inches. Sew roll to lower edge of hat crossing roll in front of hat.

Button Trimming. Using 1 strand of yarn and 1 strand of Rayon Crochet, ch 4, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 9 s c in ring, do not join.

2nd Round. 2 s c in each s c, then work 3 rounds even in s c, break yarn and thread. Using 1 strand of yarn only work another button trimming in same manner. Cover large button with this piece. Sew metal button in center of large button. Place covered button in center of 1st button trimming. Sew to top of hat.

# **FRONT SECTION**

Ch 4, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 9 s c in ring, do not join this or the following rounds. Place a marker at beginning of each round.

2nd Round. 2 s c in each s c.

3rd Round. \* 1 s c in next s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around (27 s c).

4th Round. 1 s c in each s c.

5th Round. 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 7 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, 2 s c in each of the next 3 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 6 s c, 2 s c in each of the next 3 s c, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

6th Round. S c in next s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of (continued on page 13)

28th Row. Same as 7th row, sl st in next st, break yarn.

29th Row. Skip next 5 sts, attach yarn in next st, 1 s c in each of the next 17 sts, sl st in next st, turn.

30th Row. Skip the sl st, sl st in next st, l s c in each of the next 15 sts, sl st in next st, turn.

31st Row. Skip the sl st, \* cluster st in next st, l s c in each of the next 3 sts, repeat from \* twice, cluster st in next st, (continued on page 13)



Steel Crochet Hook No. 00.

**SOLES:** With Black ch 32, 2 s d c in 2nd st from hook (s d c: yarn over hook, insert in st, pull loop through, yarn over and pull through all loops at one time), 2 s d c in next st of ch, 1 s d c in each of the next 27 sts, 2 s d c in next st, 3 s d c in end ch, working on other side of ch work 2 s d c in next st, 1 s d c in each of the next 27 sts, 2 s d c in next st, 1 s d c in same space with 1st 2 sts, join in 1st s d c.

2nd Row. Ch 2 (counts as 1 s d c), s d c in same space, 2 s d c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 29 sts, 2 s d c in each of the next 5 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 29 sts, 2 s d c in each of the next 2 sts, join.

3rd Row. Ch 2, s d c in same space, 2 s d c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 16 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 8 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 8 sts, \* 2 s d c

in next st, 1 s d c in next st, repeat from \* once, \* 1 s d c in next st, 2 s d c in next st, repeat from \* once, 1 s d c in each of the next 8 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 8 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 16 sts, 2 s d c in each of the next 2 sts, join.

4th Row. Ch 3 (counts as 1 d c), d c in same space, 1 d c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 3 sts, 2 d c in next st, 1 d c in each of the next 4 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 8 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 24 sts, 2 s c in each of the next 4 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 24 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 24 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 4 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 4 sts, 2 d c in next st, 1 d c in each remaining st (98 sts), join, break yarn.

5th Row. With right side of work toward you, attach Cerise in center st at heel, over each entire st, work 1 s c, join, break yarn. Work another sole in the same manner omitting last row. Place inner sole between the 2 sole sections and overcast together.

ANKLE STRAP: With Black ch 74, 1 s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch, break yarn (16 inches), do not turn.

2nd Row. Attach Cerise in 1st s c, 1 s c in each s c to end of row, working on opposite side of previous row 1 s c in base of each st, join, break yarn.

# HAT

With No. 6 hook starting at top of hat, ch 3, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 6 s c in ring, do not join this or the following rounds. Place a marker at beginning of each round.

2nd Round. 2 s c in each s c (12 s c).

3rd Round. \* 1 s c in next s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around.

4th Round. \* 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around (24 s c). This finishes top of hat, do not break yarn, ch 8, s d c in 2nd ch from hook (s d c: yarn over hook, insert in st, pull through, yarn

over and pull through all loops at one time), 1 s d c in each of the next 3 sts of ch, 1 s c in each of the next 3 sts of ch, ch 1, turn. This is upper edge to be attached to top of hat.

2nd Row. Working in back loop of sts only throughout, 1 s c in each s c and 1 s c in each s d c, ch 1, turn.

3rd Row. 1 s d c in each of the next 4 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, ch 1, turn.

Repeat the 2nd and 3rd rows alternately until there are 181 rows. Next row decrease 1 st at beginning of row then decrease 1 st at beginning of every other row 4 times, break yarn. Sew strip around 4th row of hat, place on head or form and wind strip around head overlapping strip over lower section of previous round (preferably pin to mold of head form), sew upper edges in place leaving the end or point of strip free. Attach button about 2 inches from end of point sewing through body of hat.

### BAG

With No. 4 hook if Wool Yarn is used and No. 00 hook if Cotton Yarn is used, starting at lower edge, ch 16, 3 s c in 2nd ch from hook, 1 s c in each of the next 13 sts of (continued on page 14)





# Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" Permanent "Crimp Set" Nylon Article N6

4 Balls French Blue or any Color desired. Plastic Crochet Hook No. 6 or H.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** This hat is worked with 3 strands of yarn throughout and all rounds are worked doubly as follows: work a round as directed, then work same round over it.

**CROWN:** Ch 11, 3 s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch working 3 s c in last st of ch, working on opposite side of ch, 1 s c in each st, do not join rounds.

2nd Round. Work in s c working in base of each st all around. All even rounds are worked in same manner and will not be referred to again.

3rd Round. 1 s c in each s c on sides and 2 s c in each of the 3 s c at, each end.

5th Round. 1 s c in each s c on sides and 2 s c in each of the 6 s c at each end.

7th Round. \* 1 s c in next s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from \* 5 times, 1 s c in each s c to next 2 s c group, \* 2 s c in next s c, 1 s c in next s c, repeat from \* 5 times, 1 s c in each remaining s c (52 s c).

Working even in s c work 10 more double rounds, break yarn.

**BRIM:** Ch 46, 3 s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch, 3 s c in last st of ch, working on other side of ch, 1 s c in each st.

2nd Round. Same as 2nd round of crown. All even rounds are worked in same manner.

3rd Round. S c in next s c, 3 s c in center s c of 3 s c group, 1 s c in each s c to next 3 s c group at opposite end, s c in next s c, 3 s c in center s c of group, 1 s c in each of the next 20 s c, \* 2 s c in next s c, 1 s c in next s c, repeat from \* twice, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

5th Round. 3 s c in center s c at each end, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

6th Round. Same as 2nd round. The increased part is at top of brim.

**FINISHING:** Starting at beginning of last round of hat, attach lower edge of brim to lower edge of hat working 1 s c in each of the next 25 s c, break yarn leaving an end and sew remainder of brim as desired twisting end as illustrated.

# Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "AUNT LYDIA'S" Heavy Rug Yarn, Article 235

2 Skeins Lt. Yellow or any Color desired. Feather.

Aluminum or Plastic Crochet Hook Size G.

CROWN: Ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 2 s c in each st of ch, do not join rounds. Place a marker at beginning of each round.

2nd Round. 2 s c in each s c.

3rd Round. \* 2 s c in next s c, 1 s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around (30 s c).

4th Round. Working in s c increase in every 3rd s c.

5th Round. 1 s c in each s c.

6th Round. Increase in every 4th s c, then work 3 rounds even.

10th Round. Increase in every 5th s c, then work 5 rounds even.

16th Round. Increase in every 10th s c, then work 2 rounds

19th Round-BRIM: Increase in every 6th s c, then work 1 round even.

21st Round. Increase in every 7th s c, then work 8 rounds even, break yarn. Turn brim up on the 19th round, then turn down about half way or shape as desired. Sew feather in position.

2 balls White or Color desired.

1 yd. 1/2-inch Ribbon.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 4.

Hat is worked with double strand of thread throughout. Work tightly.

Ch 5, 1 d c in 5th st from hook, \* ch 1, d c in same space. repeat from \* 5 times, ch 1, join in 3rd st of ch.

2nd Row. Ch 3, d c in same space, \* ch 2, 2 d c in next d c, repeat from \* 6 times, ch 1, s c in 3rd st of ch (this brings thread in position for next row).

3rd Row. Ch 1, s c over s c, \* ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 1, tr c in 1st s c.
4th Row. Ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c over tr c, \* ch 2, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in next loop, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 1, s c in 3rd st of ch.

5th Row. \* Ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 2, d c in s c.

6th Row. \* Ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 1, tr c in d c.

7th Row. Same as 4th row.

8th Row. Same as 5th row.

9th Row. Work same as last row ending row with ch 2, d c in d c.

10th Row. Same as 6th row.

11th Row. Ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in same loop, \* ch 1, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in next loop, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 1, join in 3rd st of ch.

12th Row. Sl st to next ch 2 loop, s c in same space, \* ch 5, s c in next ch 2 loop, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 2, d c in 1st s c.

13th & 14th Rows. \* Ch 6, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around ending each row with ch 3, d c in d c.

15th Row. \* Ch 6, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 2, tr c in d c (6 inches in diameter).

16th Row. Same as 11th row.

17th Row. Sl st to next ch 2 loop, s c in same space, \* ch 6, s c in next ch 2 loop, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 3, d c in s c.

18th Row. Same as 15th row ending row with ch 3, d c in d c.

19th & 20th Rows. \* Ch 7, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around ending each row with ch 3, d c in d c.

21st Row. Same as last row ending row with ch 2, d tr c (3 times over hook) in d c.

22nd Row. Same as 11th row.

23rd Row. Same as 17th row.

(If deeper crown is desired, work 1 more row of loops.)

Next Row. Ch 3, 2 d c cover d c, \* 6 d c in next loop, repeat from \* all around ending row with 3 d c in 1st loop, join.

Next Row. \* Ch 5, skip 2 d c, s c in next d c, repeat from

\* all around ending row with ch 2, d c in joining.

Next 4 Rows. \* Ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from \* al

Next 4 Rows. \* Ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all (Continued on page 15)

Entire set is worked with 3 strands of yarn and all are double rows, except for 2 center pieces of ascot which is worked with 3 strands of yarn but single rows only.

**HAT:** Back Section—With White ch 13, 3 s c in 2nd ch from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch working 3 s c in last ch, working on opposite side of ch, work 1 s c in each st, do not join this or the following rows.

2nd Row. This row is worked in s c over entire st of previous row working 1 s c over each s c and working in the base of each st.

3rd Row. 3 s c in 1st s c, 1 s c in next s c, 3 s c in next s c (this is lower end of back section), 1 s c in each s c to the 3 s c group at opposite end (top of back section), 2 s c in each of the next 3 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 10 s c.

4th Row. Same as 2nd row.

5th Row. 1 s c in 1st s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next

11 s c, 2 s c in each of the next 6 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 10 sts.

6th Row. Same as 2nd row.

7th Row. Is c in each of the next 2 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 12 s c, \* 2 s c in next s c, 1 s c in next s c, repeat from \* once, 2 s c in each of the next 4 s c, \* 1 s c in next s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from \* once, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

8th Row. Same as 2nd row.

9th Row. 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 7 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

10th Row. Same as 2nd row, break yarn.

**FRONT SECTION:** With White ch 36, 3 s c in 2nd ch from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch working 3 s c in last ch, working on other side of ch, 1 s c in each st, do not join this or following rows.

2nd Row. Same as 2nd row of back section.



"DE LUXE" Crochet Cotton, Article 346 or "PURITAN"

Crochet Cotton, Article 40

1 Ball Ecru or White. Steel Crochet Hook No. 6 or No. 7.

BACK SECTION: Ch 76, s c in 2nd st from hook, \* ch 1, skip 1 st of ch, s c in next st, repeat from \* to end of row, ch 2, turn.

2nd Row. S c in 1st s c, ch 1, s c in same space (increase at top of little finger), \* ch 1, s c in next s c, repeat from \* to end of row, ch 2, turn.

3rd Row. S c in 1st s c, \* ch 1, s c in next s c (pattern), repeat from \* to end of row, ch 2, turn.

4th Row. S c in 1st s c, \* ch 1, s c in next s c, repeat from \* to end of row, ch 2, turn.

5th Row. Work even in pattern to end of row, ch 2, turn. 6th Row. Skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, work in pattern to end of row, ch 2, turn.

7th Row. Work 27 patterns, ch 32 for 2nd finger, turn.

8th Row. S c in 2nd st from hook, \* ch 1, skip 1 st of ch, s c in next st, repeat from \* down ch, then work in pattern to end of row, ch 2, turn.

9th Row. Work even in pattern to end of row, ch 3, turn.

10th Row. S c in 1st s c, \* ch 1, s c in next s c, repeat from \* to end of row, ch 2, turn.

11th Row. Work 15 patterns, \* ch 3, skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* 4 times, then work in pattern to end of row working last s c in end ch, ch 2, turn.

12th Row. Skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, work in pattern to the ch 3 loop, \* ch 1, s c in center st of next loop, ch 1, s c in next s c, repeat from \* 4 times, continue in pattern to end of row, ch 2, turn.

13th Row. Work even in pattern, ch 2, turn.

14th Row. Skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, work even in pattern to end of row, ch 2, turn.

15th Row. Work 15 patterns, \* ch 3, skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* 4 times, \* ch 1, s c in next s c, repeat from \* twice, ch 34 for 3rd finger, turn.

16th Row. S c in 2nd st from hook, \* ch 1, skip 1 st of ch, s c in next st of ch, repeat from \* down ch, work in pattern to the ch 3 loop, \* ch 1, s c in center st of loop, ch 1, s c in next s c, repeat from \* 4 times, work in pattern to end of row, ch 2, turn.

Repeat the 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th rows.

21st Row. Work even in pattern, ch 2, turn.

22nd Row. Same as 14th row.

23rd Row. Work 28 patterns, ch 32 for forefinger, turn. Repeat the 8th, 9th and 10th rows.

27th Row. Work even in pattern working last s c in end ch, ch 2, turn.

28th Row. Same as 14th row.

29th Row. Work even in pattern, ch 2, turn.

30th Row. Same as 14th row.

31st Row. Work 22 patterns, ch 24 for thumb, turn.

32nd Row. Work in pattern down thumb ch same as on other fingers, work 2 patterns on hand part of glove, ch 1, sl st in next s c, ch 2, turn.

33rd Row. Skip the sl st, s c in next s c, work in pattern to top of thumb, ch 3, turn.

34th Row. Work even in pattern down thumb, ch 1, s c in same space with sl st, work 1 pattern on hand part of glove, ch 1, sl st in next s c, ch 2, turn.

35th Row. Same as 33rd row working last s c in end ch at top of thumb, ch 2, turn.

**36th Row.** Skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, then work same as 34th row.

37th Row. Skip the sl st, s c in next s c, work even in pattern to top of thumb, ch 2, turn.

**38th Row.** Skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, work in pattern down thumb and remainder of glove, ch 2, turn.

Work a row of pattern around entire glove working up and down each finger, around thumb section and across cuff, break thread.

PALM SECTION: Work 1st 6 rows same as back of glove.

7th Row. Work 27 patterns, ch 32 for 2nd finger, turn.

8th Row. Work in pattern down ch same as on back of glove and work in pattern to end of row, ch 2, turn.

9th Row. Work even in pattern, ch 3, turn.

10th Row. S c in 1st s c, \* ch 1, s c in next s c, repeat from \* to end of row, ch 2, turn.


11th Row. Work even in pattern working last s c in end ch, ch 2, turn.

12th Row. Skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, work even in pattern to end of row, ch 2, turn.

13th Row. Work even in pattern, ch 2, turn.

14th Row. Same as 12th row of palm section.

15th Row. Work 28 patterns, ch 34 for 3rd finger, turn. Work next 7 rows same as last finger.



23rd Row. Work 28 patterns, ch 32 for forefinger, turn. Work next 7 rows same as last finger.

Work 22 patterns, ch 24 for thumb, turn and work same as other half of thumb on back section. Work a row of pattern around entire section same as on back section. Crochet the 2 sections together using the pattern st and leaving about 1 inch free on outside lower edge for cuff opening, break thread.

**CUFF:** With wrong side of glove toward you, attach thread at lower edge of opening, work a row of pattern same as on glove across cuff edge picking up the back loop of st only, ch 2, turn.

2nd Row. Working through both loops work even in pattern, ch 2, turn.

3rd Row. Increase 1 pattern at beginning and end of row, ch 2. turn.

Repeat the last 2 rows once, then work 2 more rows even in pattern, work a row of pattern around opening, break thread.

Work other glove in same manner reversing the thumb when joining the 2 sections together.

sl st in next st, break yarn. Skip next 21 sts of 28th row, attach yarn in next st, 1 s c in each of the next 17 sts, sl st in next st, turn. Then repeat the 30th and 31st rows once, break yarn.

Next Row. Attach yarn at end of 28th row, working around entire hat, work in s c increasing a sufficient number of times until there are 84 s c, do not join or turn this or following rows. Work 1 row even in s c.

Next Row. Same as 7th row. Work 1 row even in s c, join, break yarn.

**TOE STRAP:** Work in same manner as ankle strap but ch 18 at beginning.

**LOOP FOR STRAP:** With Black ch 17, sl st in 2nd st from hook, 1 sl st in each remaining st of ch, break yarn leaving an end for sewing to slipper. Work another loop in same manner.

TO ASSEMBLE SLIPPER: Leaving 16 sts free at toe, sew toe strap to sole as illustrated. Sew one end of ankle strap to sole next to toe strap at right. Sew opposite end of strap to side of 1st end at sole edge. Place loops over ankle strap, sew ends together and sew to sole of slipper leaving 28 sts free at heel.

**POMPON:** Over a 4½ inch cardboard wind Black 130 times, tie in center with "Aunt Lydia" Carpet and Button Thread leaving an end. Work a Cerise Pompon in same manner. Sew pompons in position as illustrated. Sew hook to wrong side of ankle strap below Cerise pompon, sew eye to wrong side of same strap on opposite side.

the next 9 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each remaining s c. **7th Round.** 1 s c in each s c to center s c of 3 s c group, 3 s c in center s c of group, 1 s c in each of the next 11 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 12 s c, 2 s c in each of the next 6 s c, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

8th Round. 1 s c in each s c to center of 3 s c group, 3 s c in center s c of group, 1 s c in each of the next 13 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

9th Round. 1 s c in each s c to center s c of next 3 s c group, 3 s c in center s c of group, 1 s c in each of the next 15 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 9 s c, 2 s c in each of the next 5 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 11 s c, 2 s c in each of the next 5 s c, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

10th Round. 1 s c in each s c all around working 3 s c in center s c of both of the 3 s c groups.

Repeat 10th round 5 times, break yarn. Work another section in same manner.

**GUSSET:** Ch 51, 3 s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch working 3 s c in last st of ch, working on opposite side of ch, 1 s c in each st.

Work 4 more rounds in s c working 1 s c in each s c and 3 s c in center s c at each end, break yarn.

Line the front and back with felt.

Line gusset with buckram and felt and sew in position. **BAG OPENING:** Work a row of s c around opening, having 32 s c on each side (64 s c).

Next Round. 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, \* ch 3, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 4 s c, repeat from \* 4 times, ch 3, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 6 s c, \* ch 3, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 4 s c, repeat from \* 4 times, ch 3, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, join.

Next Round. 1 s c in base of each s c working over the entire st and 3 s c in each loop, join, break yarn.

HANDLE: With 1 strand of yarn and 1 strand of Rayon Crochet, ch 5, join to form a ring and work same as roll on hat until piece measures about 30 inches.

Work another roll measuring 36 inches in same manner. Stretch each piece thoroughly before attaching to bag to avoid stretching afterwards.

Insert the 2 rings over the longest roll, having the 2 rings at top of each side; sew roll in position around entire gusset. Insert handle through same 2 rings and sew ends together.

Ch 6, 3 s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch working 3 s c in last st, working on other side of ch, 1 s c in each st, join.

Next Row. 1 s c in each s c working 2 s c at center st at each end, join, break yarn.

Place over center of handles and sew in position.

Cut ribbon in half and lace through loops at top of bag, lacing 1 length from one side and the other from opposite side.

ch, 3 s c in end st, working on other side of ch, work 1 s c in each st, do not join. Place a marker at beginning of each round.

2nd Round. 1 s c in each s c on sides and 2 s c in each of the 3 sts at each end.

3rd Round. 1 s c in each s c on sides and 2 s c in each of the 6 sts at each end.

4th Round. 1 s c in each s c.

**5th Round.** \* 2 s c in 1st s c, 1 s c in next s c, repeat from \* 5 times, work 1 s c in each s c on sides and increase at other end same as beginning.

6th Round. 1 s c in each s c increasing 6 s c evenly spaced at each end.

7th and 8th Rounds. Is c in each s c.

9th Round. Same as 6th round.

10th to 18th Rounds. Work even in s c.

19th Round. \* Ch 2, skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around.

20th Round. \* Ch 2, s c in next ch 2 loop, repeat from \* all around.

21st to 23rd Rounds. Repeat 20th round.

24th Round. 2 s c in each ch 2 loop all around.

25th and 26th Rounds. 1 s c in each s c.

27th to 31st Rounds. Repeat 19th to 23rd rounds.

32nd Round. Same as 24th round.

33rd to 35th Rounds. 1 s c in each s c.

**36th Round.** 1 s c in each s c, decreasing 2 sts evenly spaced (84 s c).

37th Round. \* 1 s c in each of the next 6 s c, ch 4, skip 1 s c, repeat from \* all around.

There are 12 loops for lacing.

**38th Round.** \* 1 s c in base of each of the next 6 s c working over the entire st, 4 s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around, break yarn.

**TRIMMING BAND:** With No. 6 hook ch 10, s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch, ch 1, turn. **2nd Row.** Working through back loop of sts only, work 1 s d c in each s c, ch 1, turn.

3rd Row. Working through back loop of sts only, work 1 s c in each s d c, ch 1, turn.

Repeat last 2 rows until there are 34 ridges (68 rows). Sew short ends together and sew to bag on the 32nd round.

Work another trimming band in same manner and sew on the 24th round.

Cut cardboard 4 inches wide and 7½ inches long shaping ends to form an oval. Cut 2 pieces of felt ¼ inch larger than cardboard. Insert cardboard and sew all around ¼ inch in from edge. Place in bottom of bag.

**HANDLE:** With No. 6 hook using a double strand of yarn crochet 2 chs about a yard long. Lace 1 ch through loops at top of bag. Lace other ch starting at opposite side. Sew free ends together.

6th Row. Same as 2nd row.

7th Row. 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, 5 s c in next s c (front corner), 1 s c in each of the next 51 s c, 5 s c in next s c (corner), 1 s c in each remaining s c.

8th Row. Same as 2nd row.

9th Row. 1 s c in each s c and 5 s c in center s c at each of the 2 front corners.

10th Row. Same as 2nd row.

Repeat the last 2 rows once, break yarn.

Fold front section in half having the corners for outside edge and mark center st. Place the rounded part of back section to center back of front section and crochet the 12 center sts together with s c working through both sections.

**POMPONS:** Wind Red yarn over a 4 inch cardboard 125 times, tie through center, cut both ends and trim into shape. Comb edges and steam them, trim evenly.

With Red, using 3 strands of yarn, crochet a ch about 12 inches long, lace through lower ends of back and front of hat, thus connecting back and front sections. Sew a Red Pompon to each end of ch and tie in bow. Make another ch and lace through opposite side of back and front sections. Finish with Red Pompons same as before.

# **ASCOT**

With White ch 4, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 9 s c in ring.

2nd Row. \* 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, repeat from \* twice (3 points).

Next 8 Rows. Is c in each s c and 3 s c in center st of each of the 3 points in each row, break yarn. Work another piece in same manner but do not break yarn, ch 60, join to point of 1st piece.

Next Row. 1 s c in each st of ch and 1 s c in each s c around the triangle pieces working 3 s c in center st at each of the 2 points at lower edge, then work 1 s c in each st on opposite side of ch and work around opposite triangle same as 1st triangle.

Next Row. Same as 2nd row of hat.

Work 2 more double rows of s c all around working 3 s c in center s c at each of the 2 points at each end, break yarn. With Red and using 3 strands of yarn, crochet a ch about 12 inches long, lace into center of triangle and finish with Red Pompons. Work a ch and Pompons in same manner for opposite end.

Ch 3, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 6 s c in ring, do not join rounds. Place a marker at beginning of each round.

2nd Round. 2 s c in each s c (12 s c).

3rd Round. \* 1 s c in next s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around.

4th Round. \* 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around.

5th Round. \* 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around (30 s c).

6th to 11th Rounds. Same as last round having 1 more st between increasing points in each round (6 sts increased in each round).

12th Round. 1 s c in each s c.

13th Round. \* 1 s c in each of the next 10 s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around (72 s c). Work 8 rounds even, break yarn.

**BRIM:** Ch 22 loosely, s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each of the next 9 sts of ch, 3 s c in next st of ch, 1 s c in each of the next 10 sts of ch, ch 1, turn.

2nd Row. Working through back loop of sts throughout, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 10 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 9 s c, skip 1 s c, s c in last s c, ch 1, turn.

Repeat 2nd row until there are 30 ridges (60 rows).

**FINISHING:** Sew both short ends of brim together (1 end is starting ch and the other end is last row) placing the 3 s c directly in corner of starting ch. Sew lower edge of brim to lower edge of hat. Turn upper edge of brim toward you and sew to center of brim.



**SIDE OF BAG:** Skip 24 s c, attach yarn in next s c, s c in same space, I s c in each of the next 13 s c working through the back loop of sts only, ch l, turn.

2nd Row. Working through back loop of sts only for remainder of bag, work 1 s c in each of the 14 s c of 1st row, ch 1, turn.

3rd and 4th Rows. Increase 1 s c at beginning of each row, ch 1, turn.

5th to 10th Rows. Work even in s c, ch l to turn each row.
11th and 12th Rows. Same as 3rd and 4th rows.



13th to 16th Rows. Work even.

17th and 18th Rows. Same as 3rd and 4th rows (20 sts in last row).

19th to 24th Rows. Work even, break yarn.

2nd Side. Skip 24 s c, attach yarn in next s c and work same as 1st side. Sew each edge of side section to main body section.

Fold side section in half and sew across top.

TOP OF BAG: Work a row of sl sts around opening of bag (main body section) working 1 sl st in each row, join.

2nd Row. Ch 5, skip 1 sl st, tr c in next sl st, \* ch 1, skip 1 sl st, tr c in next sl st, repeat from \* all around, ch 1, join in 4th st of ch (beading).

3rd Row. Ch 1 and work 1 s c in each tr c and in each ch 1, join.

4th Row. Working through back loop of sts only, work 2 s c in each s c all around, join.

5th Row. Working through back loop of sts only, work 1 s c in each s c, join, break yarn.

cord: Ch 80, 1 sl st in 2nd st from hook, 1 sl st in each remaining st of ch, working on opposite side of ch, work 1 sl st in each st, break yarn.

Work another cord in same manner. Lace cord through beading lacing over 1 tr c and under the next tr c. Lace 2nd cord in same manner starting from opposite side. Sew ends of cord together.


Next Row. Ch 3, d c over d c, \* 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in next loop, repeat from \* all around ending row with 2 d c in 1st loop, ch 2, join, break thread. Starch and block. Attach ribbon trim as illustrated.

# **DIRECTIONS FOR STARCHING**

Dissolve ¼ cup starch in ½ cup of cold water. Boil about 1¼ cups of water, remove from flame, then slowly stir the starch mixture into boiling water stirring constantly. Place back on flame until it thickens. As soon as starch is cool enough to handle, dip hat, squeeze starch through it thoroughly. Wring out extra starch. The article should be wet with starch but there should be none in the spaces. Place over head mold and let dry.
