

Marie Antoinette Pattern

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Principal Stitches in Crochet and How to Make Them

Chain Stitch (ch): Catch thread with hook, making a toop. Draw thread with hook through the loop. This makes the first stitch. Repeat, drawing thread through as many loops as required. Each loop is termed a chain. (ch) Slip Stitch (sl st): Insert the hook into work, draw thread through work and the loop on the hook at the same time

thread through work and the loop on the hook at the same time.

Single Crochet (sc): Insert hook into work, draw thread through, making 2 loops on the hook; place thread again over the hook and draw through both loops.

Double Crochet (dc): Place thread over hook once, draw thread through work; place thread again over the hook and draw thread through 2 loops; place thread once more over the hook, and again draw through 2 loops.

Short Double Crochet (sdc): Place thread over hook once, draw thread through the work; place thread over the hook again and draw thread through all 3 loops at once.

Treble Crochet (tr cr tc): Place thread over hook 2 times; draw thread through the work; thread over hook again and draw thread through 2 loops; place thread over the hook, and draw through 2 loops; place thread over hook once more, and draw through 2 more loops.

Triple Treble Crochet (tt): Place thread over hook 3 times; draw thread through the work; place thread over

hook again; draw through 2 loops; thread over hook again, draw through 2 loops; thread over hook, draw through 2 loops; place thread over hook once more and again draw loops; place through 2 lo 2 loops.

Long Treble Crochet (ltr): Place thread over hook 5 times; cast off 2 loops, and again 2 loops; leaving 5 loops on the hook; hold 4 loops; chain 6 on 1st loop; slip stitch through 5th chain from hook; bring under second loop; cast off 2 loops; then 2 loops, and again 2 loops.

Forked Treble Crochet (ftr): Place thread over hook 5 times; draw thread through work; place thread over hook again, cast off 2 loops, and again 2 loops; place thread over hook 2 times, draw thread through work to left; thread over hook; cast off 2 loops, then 2 loops; etc., until all are cast off.

Picot Crochet (pi): Chain 4: insert hook in first chain

Picot Crochet (pi): Chain 4; insert hook in first chain made; thread over hook; draw through chain stitch and loop on hook at once.

Cluster (Cl): * Place thread over hook twice; draw thread through work; thread over hook again; cast off 2 loops; then 2 more loops; repeat from * twice; then cast off remaining loops at once.

First (1st); Second (2nd); Stitch (st); (*) To be repeated.

As used in Marie Antoinette Pattern: ½ loop means: ch 8; sl st in 4th ch from hook; ch 4. Loop means: ch 8; sl st in 4th ch from hook; ch 12; sl st in 4th ch from hook; ch 4.

Instructions for Centerpiece—Marie Antoinette Pattern (Cover Design)

Material required: 6 balls No. 15 Cotton. (For 12 scallops.) No. 10 or 11 Crochet Hook

1st Row: Ch 870; 1 de in 9th ch from hook; * ch 6; 1 de in top of dc just made. (This forms a small arch.) Skip 2 on foundation ch; 1 de in 3rd ch; ch 3; skip 2 on foundation ch; 1 dc in 3rd ch; repeat from *.

NOTE: 12 small arches are required for 1 scallop. For a 12 scallop centerpiece make 144 arches; join. every additional scallop add 12 arches. A 15 scallop centerpiece requires 180 arches, etc.)

2nd Row: Sl st to center of 1st arch; ch 8; 1 sl st in 4th ch from hook; (for picot) ch 12; 1 sl st into 4th ch from hook; ch 4; skip 1 arch; 1 sc in next arch. (This forms a long arch which hereafter will be called a loop.) Repeat loops around: join.

3rd Row: SI st to center of 1st loop; * * * 1 loop; fasten to center of 2nd loop with 1 sc (through ch); 1 loop; fasten to center of next loop with 1 sc; ½ loop; 1 ltr into next loop; for 1st petal of daisy; ch 11; skip 1st ch from hook; 1 sc in 2nd ch; 7 dc in following 7 chains; 1 sc in next ch; 1 sl st in next; turn; 1 sc in each st of petal; 1 sl st into point; ch 12 for 2nd petal; make 2nd petal same as 1st; leaving 1 ch between 1st and 2nd petals for daisy center; 1 ltr to left into same ch as 1st ltr was made; 1/2 loop; fasten with sc to center of 5th loop of 2nd row; 1 loop to center of 6th loop of 2nd row; 1/2 loop and 1 ltr to 7th loop of 2nd row.

4th Row: Turn; 1 loop to center of 2nd loop of 3rd row; 1/2 loop and 1 ltr to point of 2nd petal; ch 11; 1 sc in base or end of 2nd petal; 2 dc in ch between 1st 2 petals; 1 sc in base of 1st petal; ch 11; 1 ltr to point of 1st petal; 1/2 loop to center of loop of 3rd row to left; 1/2 loop and 1 ltr to center of next loop of 3rd row; turn.

5th Row: 1 loop; fasten with sc in beginning of the ch of 11; on the ch of 11 make the 3rd petal of daisy as follows: Skip 1st ch; 1 sc in next ch; 1 dc in next; 5 tc in following 5 chains; 1 dc in next; 1 sc in next; 1 sl st; 1 sc in 1st sc of center of daisy; 2 dc in each of the 2 dc of center; 1 sc in last sc of the center; make 4th petal on next 11 ch same as 3rd; 1/2 loop and 1 ltr into center of loop of the 4th row to left; turn. 1/2 loop; ch 11; fasten with sl st into 1st sc of center of daisy; turn; make 5th petal on ch 11 same as 1st petal; thus (1 sc; 7 dc; 1 sc; 1 sl st; turn; sc back on petal; sl st into end). Sl st into 1st dc in center of daisy; ch 11; 1 ltr to point of 5th petal; 6th petal on ch of 11 same as preceding; sl st into next dc in center; sc back to point of 6th petal.


Make 1 loop; ch 11; sl st into next dc of center; make this petal same as preceding one; sc to base of 7th petal; sl st into next dc of center; ch 11; 1 ltr to point of 7th petal; make 8th petal same as preceding; sl st into last sc of center; sc to point of 8th petal; ½ loop; fasten in center of last loop to left of daisy; break thread * Start 2nd scallop by fastening thread in center of 7th loop of 2nd row; repeat same for next 11 scallops.

12th scallop is finished. don't break thread, but continue making next row as follows: turn; crochet from right to left toward point of scallop; ½ loop; * ch 8; 1 ltr to point of 8th petal of daisy; ch 8; 1 ltr to point of 7th petal; ch 8; 1 ltr to left of picot of loop; ch 13 (this is the center of the top of scallop); 1 ltr to the right of 2nd picot of same loop; ch 8; 1 ltr to point of 6th petal; ch 8; 1 ltr to point of 5th petal; ch 8; 1 ltr in the top of 1/2 loop to left of daisy; ch 8; 1 ltr to top of next ½ loop; ½ loop and 1 ltr to the top of next ½ loop; 1 ltr across to the 1st ½ loop of 2nd scallop; ½ loop and 1 ltr to top of next ½ loop; There ch 8; 1 ltr; repeat from (*) as over 1st scallop. must be 9 spaces of 8 chains over each scallop for the crescent and 2 spaces with 1 picot each between the scal-

1st. 2nd and 3rd Rows of the Crescent: Fasten thread in beginning of 1st 8 chains; (* *) ch 3; skip 1 ch; 1 sc in next ch; ch 3; skip 1 ch; 1 sc in next ch; ch 3; skip 1 ch; 1 sc in next ch; ch 3; skip 1 ch; 1 sc in next. This makes the 1st 4 small loops of crescent. Make 5 such small loops over next space of 8 chains; 4 over next; 5 over next; 8 over next ch of 13; 5 over next space; 4 over next; 5 over next; 4 over next. Make last small loop by ch 1 and 1 dc instead of 3 chains; turn; ch 3; 1 sc in 2nd loop; * ch 3; 1 sc in next loop; repeat from *. The last small loop of this row is made with ch 1 and 1 dc in last loop of 1st row; turn; ch 3; 1 sc in next loop; repeat small loops across crescent. This makes the 3rd row of loops across crescent; sl st alongside to 1st row of loops; ch 20: 1 sc in 1st ch of 8 of 2nd scallop. Repeat from (* *):

4th Row: Fasten thread in 1st small loop of 3rd row of crescent; 1 dc in same small loop; ch 1; 1 sc in 2nd small loop; ch 3; 1 sc in 3rd small loop; repeat loops across crescent. At the other end of crescent; instead of last loop, ch 1; 1 dc in the last small loop of 3rd row; ch 8; 1 dc in 8th ch of the ch of 20; ch 4; skip 3 ch; 1 dc in 4th ch; ch 8; 1 dc in 1st small loop of 3rd row of 2nd crescent; ch 1; 1 sc in 2nd small loop; ch 3; crochet small loops across 2nd crescent same as over 1st. Repeat.

5th Row: Sl st to top of 2nd small loop of 4th row; 1 dc in same loop; ch 1; 1 sc in next; ch 3; 1 sc in next small loop; repeat loops across. At the end of this row; instead of making a ch of 3 for last loop; ch 1; 1 dc in next to the last loop of 4th row; ch 8; 1 tt in top of dc of previous row; ch 20; 1 tt in top of next dc of previous row; ch 8; 1 dc in 2nd small loop of 4th row of 2nd crescent; ch 1; 1 sc in next small loop; ch 3; repeat loops across crescent. (Hereafter small loops are made over the crescent in each row. No further mention will be made of this.) Also remember that the 1st small loop of the crescent in each row is made with 1 dc in the 2nd loop of previous row. Ch 1 and 1 sc in next loop. The last small loop of crescent in each row is made with ch of and 1 dc in the next to last loop of previous row.



Crocheted Cluny Insertion Pattern No. 1

6th Row: Ch 8; 1 tt; ch 8; 4 dc in 9th, 10th; 11th and 12th chains of the ch of 20 in previous row; ch 8; 1 tt; ch 8; etc.

7th Row: Ch 8; 1 tt; ch 8; 1 sc in ch; 4 sc above 4 dc of previous row; 1 sc in ch; ch 8; 1 tt; ch 8; etc.

8th Row: Ch 8; 1 tt; ch 8; 1 sc in ch; 6 sc above 6 sc; 1 sc in ch; ch 8; 1 tt; ch 8; etc.

9th Row: Ch 8; 1 tt; ch 15; 2 dc in 2 ch; 8 dc above 8 sc; 2 dc in 2 ch; ch 15; 1 tt; ch 8. After this row, do not crochet around center but back and forth over each crescent and each spider separately. Do not break thread now but crochet loops across crescent; ch 8; 1 tt; turn,

Ch 15; * crochet small loops over crescent; at other end of crescent ch 8; 1 tt in top of corresponding tt; turn; ch 15; crochet back and forth over crescent in this manner until 3 small loops are left. Fill in 4 lacking spaces with a ch of 6 and 1 ltr without picot; close with ch of 6; break thread;

fasten in last tt made between spider and crescent; ch 15; repeat from *; fasten thread in 9th ch of ch of 15 in spider; ch 15; 8 sc above 12 dc of spider; ch 8; 1tt; turn; ch 15; 6 sc above 8 sc of previous row; ch 8; 1 tt; turn; ch 15; 4 dc above 6 sc; ch 8; 1 tt; turn; ch 15, close spider.

Fasten thread in top of the 1st 8 chains of crescent to left of spider; ch 7; 4 times over hook into same space; 3 times over hook into top of next ch of 8; 3 picots each with ch of 6; 3 times over hook in same space as previous tt; 4 times over hook into top of next ch of 8; ch 7; fasten with sc in same space; repeat. There should be 8 scallops like this over each crescent; ch 6; 1 sc into 9th ch of the ch of 15 of spider; 3 dc into center of 1st space to left through ch; ch 4 for picot; 3 dc in same ch with previous 3 dc; 1 sc; repeat this scallop to point of spider; 3 picots of 6 chains; repeat scallops on opposite side of spider.

Instructions for Library Scarf—Marie Antoinette Pattern

1st Row: Ch 291; 1 dc in 9th ch from hook, * ch 6; 1 dc in top of dc just made; skip 2 ch; 1 dc in 3rd ch; ch 2; skip 2 ch on foundation ch; 1 dc in 3rd ch; repeat from *.

2nd Row: Make 2nd row according to directions for 2nd row of centerpiece.


3rd Row: Fasten thread in center of 2nd loop; make 1st scallop with daisy according to directions for centerpiece, beginning with (* * *) and ending with (* * * *). For 2nd scallop join thread in center of 9th loop of 2nd row. After the 3 scallops with daisies are made, make 1st row across the scallops as follows: * * * * * Fasten thread in center of 1st loop of 2nd row; 1/2 loop; 1 ltr to center of 2nd loop; 1/2 loop; 1 ltr in top of next 1/2 loop to left; ch 8; 1 ltr to next ½ loop to left; ch 8; 1 ltr to next ½ loop to left; ch 8; 1 ltr to point of 8th petal of daisy; ch 8; 1 ltr to point of 7th petal of daisy; ch 8; 1 ltr to left of picot of loop between 6th and 7th petals; ch 13; 1 ltr to right of 2nd picot of same loop; ch 8; 1 ltr to point of 6th petal of daisy; ch 8; 1 ltr to point of 5th petal of daisy; ch 8; 1 ltr into top of ½ loop to left; ch 8; 1 ltr into top of ½ loop to left; ch 8; 1 ltr to top of next 1/2 loop to left; 1/2 loop; 1 ltr to center of 8th loop of 2nd row; 1 ltr to center of 9th loop of 2nd row (where 2nd scallop begins) ½ loop; 1 ltr into top of ½ loop to left; ch 8; 1 ltr in top of next 1/2 loop to left; repeat same over remaining scallop; break thread.

1st Row of Crescent: Fasten thread in beginning of the 1st loop of 2nd row; ch 8; 1 dc into center of 1st loop of 2nd row; ch 8; 1 tr in top of next loop on side of scallop; ch 15; 1 sc in top of 1tr to right of ch of 8; ch 3; skip 1 ch; 1 sc; make 3 more such loops. This makes 4 small loops over the


ch of 8 and is the beginning of the crescent. Make 4 such loops in following 4 spaces of 8 ch; make 6 small loops over ch of 13. This is the center of scallop. Make 4 small loops over remaining 5 spaces of 8 ch; (the other half of the crescent). The crescent then extends over 11 spaces; ch 20; skip the two ½ loops with picot; 1 sc in the 1st ch of ch of 8 of 2nd scallop; repeat loops over 2nd and 3rd scallop same as over 1st; ch 15; 1 tc; ch 8; 1 dc; ch 8 on side of scallop as on opposite side.

2nd Row: Fasten thread in 9th ch of the ch of 15 at beginning of crescent; ch 15; 1 dc in 1st small loop of crescent; ch 1; 1 sc in 2nd small loop; * ch 3; 1 sc in next small loop; repeat from * across crescent. Instead of last small loop in this row; ch 1 and make 1 dc in last loop of crescent; ch 8; 1 dc in 8th ch of the ch of 20 between 1st and 2nd scallops; ch 4; skip 3 ch; 1 dc in 4th ch; ch 8; 1 dc in 1st small loop of 2nd crescent; ch 1; 1 sc in 2nd loop; * ch 3; 1 sc in next loop; repeat from * across crescent. Make last small loop with ch of 1 and 1 dc; ch 8; repeat across. Make last small loop with ch of 1 and 1 dc; ch 8; 1 tt into 9th ch of the ch of 15 at end of crescent; turn.

3rd Row: Ch 15; 1 dc in 2nd small loop of 2nd row; ch 1; 1 sc in 3rd small loop; * ch 3; 1 sc in next small loop; repeat from * across crescent; make last small loop of crescent with ch of 1 and 1 dc into the 2nd from last small loop of 2nd row; ch 8; 1 tt into top of dc between scallops; ch 20; 1 tt in top of next dc between scallops; ch 8; 1 dc in 2nd small loop of 2nd row; ch 1; 1 sc in 3rd small loop of 2nd row; ch 3; make loops across crescent and repeat same across other scallops; make the last small loop of the last crescent with ch

1 and 1 dc in 2nd from last small loop of 2nd row; ch 8; 1 tt in 9th ch of ch of 15 at end of crescent; turn.

4th Row: Ch 15; 1 dc in 2nd small loop of 3rd row; ch 1; 1 sc in 3rd small loop of 3rd row; ch 3; 1 sc in next loop; make loops across crescent; ch 1; 1 dc in 2nd small loop on opposite side of crescent; ch 8; 1 tt in top of tt below; ch 8; 4 dc in following 9th; 10th; 11th and 12th chains of the ch of 20; ch 8; 1 tt in top of tt below; ch 8; repeat across. (This is the beginning of the spider.)

5th Row. Turn with a ch of 15; crochet loops across crescent. For spider ch 8; 1 tt; ch 8; 1 sc in ch; 4 sc above 4 dc of previous row; 1 sc in ch; ch 8; 1 tt; ch 8; repeat across scallops.

6th Row: Turn with a ch of 15; crochet loops across crescent; ch 8; 1 tt; ch 8; 1 sc in ch; 6 sc above 6 sc of previous row; 1 sc in ch; ch 8; 1 tt; ch 8; repeat across scallops.

7th Row: Turn with a ch of 15; crochet loops across crescent; ch 8; 1 tt; ch 15; 2 dc in ch; 8 dc above 8 sc of previous row; 2 dc in ch; ch 15; 1 tt; ch 8; repeat across scallops. (After this row do not crochet across the 3 scallops.)

8th Row: When the 7th row is finished; turn; ch 15; crochet across crescent in same manner as before; ch 8; 1 tt in tt of previous row; turn.

9th Row: Ch 15; crochet loops across crescent; ch 8; 1 tt; etc.; * * * * * * crochet across crescent until you have 4 small loops left; ch 6; 1 ltr without picot in center of 4 loops. Close last space with a ch of 6 and a sl st. Repeat same across the other two crescents.

§§Finish spider by joining thread in 9th ch from spider (of ch of 15); ch 15; 8 sc above 12 dc; ch 8; 1 tt in 9th ch of the ch of 15; turn; ch 15; 6 sc above 8 sc; ch 8; 1 tt in 9th ch; turn; ch 15; 4 dc above 6 sc; ch 8; 1 tt; ch 15; close with

Edge for Scallops: Make edge for scallops according to instructions for centerpiece.

Edge for Side of Scarf: Sc over edge of linen; repeat edge. the same as edge over crescent.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MEDALLION IN SCARF

1st Petal of Large Daisy: Ch 11; skip 1st ch; 1 sc in next ch; 7 dc in following 7 chains. 1 sc in next ch; 1 sl st; ch 3; skip 1 ch; sc in next 2 ch; sc in each st to the end of petal; ch 3; sc in ch of 2 and in each st to the other end of petal; continue making 3 rows of sc on one side of petal and 4 rows of sc on the other side. Break thread; make 7 petals like the preceding one.

Center of Daisy; 1st Row: Ch 6; skip 1 ch; 1 sc; 3 dc; 1 sc; turn.

2nd Row: Ch 2; 7 de; 1 sde; turn.


3rd Row: Ch 2; 7 de; 1 sde; turn.

4th Row: Ch 1; skip 1 dc; 1 sc; 1 dc in next 2 dc (taking up 2 together); 1 dc in next dc; 1 dc in next dc; 1 sc; 1 sl st; 1 row of sc around center; 1 sl st; sc closely to avoid drawing up of center. Sew petals to this center.

1st Row of Medallion: Join thread to point of 1 petal; ch 16; sl st into point of 2nd petal; ch 33; sl st into point of 3rd petal; ch 16; sl st into point of 4th petal; ch 33; etc. Continue; this encloses the daisy in a square.

2nd Row: Over the ch of 16, make 16 sc; turn; ch 6; sl st into 14th sc; turn; over ch of 6 make 3 sc; 1 picot (of 4 ch); 3 sc; 1 picot; 3 sc; (this makes a small picot loop); 3 sc over the ch of 16; ch 16; turn; fasten in 2nd sc to left of small picot loop just made; turn; on the ch of 16 make 5 sc; 1 picot (of 6 ch); 3 sc; 1 picot; 3 sc; 1 picot; 3 sc; 1 picot; 5 sc; (this makes a large picot-loop); 12 sc on last part of ch of 16; over each ch of 33 make 64 sc; over each ch of 16 make 2 picot-loops. Continue around square; break thread. Make a large and small picot-loop in corner of each chain of 33 so that the picot-loops point toward the center of daisy.

3rd Row: Join thread in 3rd picot of 1st large picot-loop made. Ch 18; fasten with a sl st to right of large picot loop

Material required: 3 balls No. 50 Cotton. No. 12 Crochet Hook

to the point where the 1st petal of daisy is attached; 16 sc tightly over the last 8 ch of the ch of 18 just made; sl st into the 9th ch; ch 16; fasten in the 16th sc to the right; over this ch make 16 sc; sl st into the 9th ch; ch 16; fasten in the 32nd sc to the right. Over this ch make 16 sc; sl st into the 9th ch. This brings you into the corner of the square; ch 24; fasten in the same place as the last 16 ch was fastened. Over this ch make 16 sc; sl st into 9th ch; ch 16; repeat around square. (See design.) There should be 3 squares on each side of the square enclosing the picot loops.

4th Row: Sc tightly over the upper ch of each square with 16 sc.

5th Row: Fasten thread above the 3rd picot of the large picot loop; ch 24; fasten to right to the point directly above the post of sc in previous row; 16 sc over the ch and sl st into 9th ch; ch 16; fasten to the right above next post of sc; 16 sc over the ch; sl st into 9th ch; ch 16; fasten to right; 16 sc over the ch; sl st into 9th ch; ch 16; fasten in the corner of the square; 16 sc over the ch; sl st into 9th ch. Make 1st and 2nd petals of daisy as follows: ch 11; skip 1st ch; 1 sc; 7 dc; 1 sc; 1 sl st on this ch; turn; 1 sc in each st of the petal; sl st in the point of petal; ch 12; make 2nd petal like the one just made; ch 8; fasten in the same place where previous 16 ch. was fastened; 16 sc over the ch of 8; ch 16; fasten to right above next post of sc on the 2nd side of square; repeat around square; break thread.

6th Row: Fasten thread in point of petal; ch 19; 1 sc in the base of 1st petal; 2 dc in the ch between the two petals; 1 sc in the base of the 2nd petal; ch 19; fasten to the point of 2nd petal; 16 sc over each ch of 8 of previous row; continue around square.

7th Row: 16 sc over the 1st 8 of the ch of 19; make petal on the remaining 11 chs as follows: Skip 1st ch; 1 sc; 1 dc; 5 tc: 1 dc; 1 sc; 1 sl st; 1 sc in the 1st sc of center of daisy; 2 dc in the 1st dc of center; 2 dc. in the 2nd dc. of center; 2 sc in the last sc of center; make 4th petal same as the 3rd;

16 sc over last 8 of ch of 19; ch 12 (tightly) 1 tt above 2nd post of sc of previous row; ch 12; 1 sl st above next post; repeat until 1st petal of 2nd daisy is reached; 16 sc over 1st 8 of ch of 19; make 3rd and 4th petals like 3rd and 4th of 1st daisy; repeat around square.

8th Row: Fasten thread in point of 4th petal; ch 27; sl st into 1st sc of center of daisy; turn; make petal on last 11 ch like 1st petal of daisy; sl st into 1st sc of center; ch 11; 1 ltr without picot to point of 5th petal; make 6th petal same as 1st; ch 27; sl st into next st of center of daisy; make 7th petal same as 1st; ch 11; 1 ltr without picot to point of 7th petal; 8th petal like 1st; ch 16; fasten in point of 3rd petal; ch 12; sl st into top of tt to left of daisy; ch 12; 1 tt in sc between 2 chains of 12 of previous row; repeat around square.

9th Row: Fasten thread in center of ch of 16 between 4th and 5th petals of daisy; ch 12; sl st into sl st of previous row; ch 12; 1 tt in top of tt of previous row; ch 12; 1 sl st into sl st of previous row; ch 12; 1 tt in top of tt of previous row; repeat across side to next daisy; turn.

10th Row: Ch 10; 1 tt into last sl st of center of spider; ch 10; 1 sl st into top of tt of previous row; ch 10; 1 tt into center of next spider; repeat across side to daisy. Finish last 3 sides of square the same as 1st side.

11th Row: Crochet 32 sc over each corner of square and 16 sc over each ch of 10.



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Instructions for Yoke Pattern No. 8

Ch 6; join to form a ring.

1st Row: Ch 7; 1 to in ring; 6 more to in ring, with a ch of 3 between each.

2nd Row: Ch 4; 5 tc in first space; ch 2; 6 tc in next 7 spaces, with a ch of 2 between each set of 6; join.

3rd Row: Ch 4; 7 to above the 6 to; ch 5; 8 to above the next 6 to; 8 to above the next 6 groups with a ch of 5 between each; join.

4th Row: Make first cluster above the 8 tc as follows: ch 4; 1 tc, draw thread through 2 lps and 2 lps, leaving 1 lp on the needle; make 4 more such trebles, then having 6 lps on needle, draw through all at once, and ch 1 to draw cluster together; ch 7; 1 sc over ch of 5; ch 7; make 2nd cluster as follows: 1 tc, casting off 2 lps 3 times, leave 1 lp on needle, 5 more trebles, leaving 1 lp on needle each time. Then draw through all at once; ch 1; etc; repeat; join; break thread; make another daisy; join to preceding one with a sl st; make edge over daisies with a ch of 7 for scallop; a ch of 5 between daisies; over ch of 7, cr 6 sc; 3 picots; 6 sc over ch of 5, cr 8 sc; for small circles between daisies; ch 10; join; ch 7; sl st into ch of daisy; ch 7; 3 sc in ring; repeat 7 times; fill in lower edge of yoke with 2 tt; ch 1; 2 tt; ch 6; 1 dc; ch 6; 1 sc; ch 6; 1 sc; ch 6; 1 dc; ch 6; 2 tt; repeat; finish bottom of yoke with 1 dc; ch 1; 1 dc; repeat.

Richelieu Crochet Pattern No. 13

Ch 13; join; 1 sc in following 9 ch; ch 2; 1 sc in same place as last sc; ch 7; 1 sc in 1st sc to close ring; turn; 7 sc in 7 ch; 2 sc over ch of 2; turn; * ch 12; skip 2 sc; fasten in 3rd with sl st; turn; 7 sc; ch 2; 1 sc in same place; ch 7; 1 sl st to close ring; turn; 7 sc in 7 ch; 2 sc over ch 2; repeat from * for length required. This makes 1st border; join thread at beginning of border just made; ch 37; skip 1st ch; 1 sc in next ch; ch 12; fasten with 1 sc in same place; turn; 7 sc in 7 ch of ch of 12; ch 2; 1 sc in same place; ch 7; 1 sc to close ring; turn; 7 sc in ch of 7; 2 sc over ch of 2; crochet border same as 1st; ch 17; (for stem) skip 1st ch; 7 sc in following 7 ch; ch 14; skip 1 ch; 13 sc on ch; turn; 1 sc in each of the 13 sc on same side; turn; on same side make 1 sc in each of the 10 sc; turn; 1 sc in each of the 10 sc; skip 1 row of sc; 1 sc in next row at point of leaf; 13 sc down opposite side of leaf; 1 sl st in base of leaf; turn; sc around leaf; 1 sc in end of row; 1 sc in each of the 3 sc at the base of leaf to finish row: ch 2: fasten with a



This forms a circle; make other circles and join with sc. Outer Edge: 1st row: join thread above single dc; ch 9; 1 dc over ch of 8; ch 4; 7 dc above 7 dc; ch 4; 1 dc over ch of 8; ch 4; (3 times over hook over the next ch of 8, casting off 2 loops, then 2 more loops; leaving 3 loops on hook); 2 times over the hook, over the opposite ch of 8 of 2nd circle; cast off 2 loops, then 2 more, until all are cast off.
