

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" INFANT'S WOOL, ARTICLE W5

2-1 oz. Balls White.

I-1 oz. Ball Blue or Pink.

1 Pair each Bone Knitting Needles No. 2 and No. 6. Bone Crochet Hook No. 2.

11/2 yds. Ribbon.

Back of Yoke. With White on No. 2 needles cast on 66 sts and k 1 row, p 1 row, k 1 row, p 1 row, k 1 row, p 1 row. Pick up Blue and k 4 rows. Repeat these 10 Continued on Page 16-1st Column

Small, Medium and Large Sizes

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" INFANT'S WOOL, ARTICLE W5

1 oz. Balls.

Small Size - 8 Balls of any Pastel Shade and 1 Ball White.

Medium Size- 9 Balls of any Pastel Shade and I Ball White.

Large Size -10 Balls of any Pastel Shade and 2 Balls White.

1 Pair Bone Knitting Needles No. 2.

1 Pair Bone Knitting Needles No. 6.

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## Dandy Dickey

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" INFANT'S WOOL, ARTICLE W5, or "DAWN" WORSTED FLOSS, ARTICLE W16

3-1 oz. Balls White, or any Color desired.

6 Buttons.

Bone Crochet Hook No. 3 or No. 4.

Directions are given for "DAWN" Infants Wool, if using "DAWN" Worsted Floss, ch 77 and work 2 less rows for Collar, 1 less s c for each side of front, 3 less s c at each side of center of back section.

Collar. Ch 85 about 13 inches long without stretching ch. Work 84 s c on ch. ch 1 to turn each row, work 14 more rows of s c even. Do not break yarn.

16th Row. Start Right Front, 1 s c in each of the 1st 18 s c, ch 1 to turn.

17th Row. 2 s c in 1st s c, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

18th Row. 1 s c in each s c. Repeat 17th and 18th rows 34 times.

Repeat 18th row until work measures about 151/9 inches from beginning, break yarn.

## Striped on White

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" WORSTED FLOSS, ARTICLE W16

2-1 oz. Balls White.

2-1 oz. Balls Green.

1-1 oz. Ball Red.

1 Pair Bone Knitting Needles No. 3.

Measurements: Width-12 inches.

Length-171/2 inches.

Shoulder seam-31/2 inches.

Gauge. 7 sts = 1 inch.

10 Rows = 1 inch.

Back. With White, cast on 84 sts and k 5 rows, then work in stockinette st (k 1 row, p 1 row) until work measures 161/2 inches from beginning, always knitting the first and the last 3 sts at the beginning and end of each row for border of entire dickey.

Next 2 Rows. Bind off 7 sts at beginning of each row.

Next 6 Rows. Bind off 6 sts at beginning of each row and bind off remaining 34 sts for back of neck, break

Front. With White, work same as back for the first 5 rows.

### Tatted Charm

No. 4805

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" MERCERIZED TATTING COTTON,
ARTICLE 25

5-60 yd. Balls White.

1 Shuttle and 1 Ball.

41/2 inch square of Linen.

Make a very narrow hem all around square.

Ist Row. Using shuttle only, R, 3 d, 3 p sep by 3 d, 3 d, cl r. ½ inch space. \*\* Work a clover leaf at corner as follows: 3 d, join to last p of last r, 3 d, 2 p sep by 3 d, 3 d, cl r. LR, 3 d, join to last p of last r, 3 d, 3 p sep by 1 d, 3 d, p, 3 d, cl r. R, 3 d, join to last p of previous r, 3 d, 2 p sep by 3 d, 3 d, cl r. \* ½ inch space: R, 3 d, join to last p of previous r, 3 d, 2 p sep by 3 d, 3 d, cl r. Repeat from \* 20 times. Repeat from \*\* all around having 21 rings on each side between corners. Sew this 1st row to square of linen.

2nd Row. R, 3 d, p, 3 d, join to p of 1st r of clover leaf at corner, 3 d, p, 3 d, cl r. ½ inch space, turn. R, 3 d, 5 p sep by 2 d, 3 d, cl r, turn. Leave a ½ inch space between all rings in this row. R, 3 d, join to p of 1st r made 3 d, join to 1st p of large r of clover Continued on Page 17

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" MERCERIZED TATTING COTTON, ARTICLE 25

3-60 yd. Balls White or any Color desired.

5 inch square of Handkerchief Linen.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 12 or No. 13.

Hem linen to measure about  $4\frac{1}{2}$  inches square. Join thread in center of one side and working over hem, work 70 s c on each side and 3 s c in each corner.


Ist Row. \* Draw up 1/4 inch loop on hook, thread over and pull through ch, s c in single loop of st. (Single knot st), skip 2 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* to center s c at corner, single knot st, s c in same st, continue sides and corners all around in same manner working all corners same as 1st corner.

2nd Row. \* Single knot st, s c in single loop of next single knot st, repeat from \* to corner, single knot st, s c in same st, continue sides and corners all around in same manner.

3rd and 4th Rows. Repeat 2nd row.

5th Row. Single knot st, \* s c in loop of next single knot st, ch 3, repeat from \* to corner, ch 3, s c in same loop, continue all around in same manner working all corners same as 1st corner, join.

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### Crocheted Hood and Mitts

No. 4807

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" WORSTED FLOSS, ARTICLE W16

5-1 oz. Balls White or any Color desired will make a set.

Hood: 3-1 oz. Balls.

Mitts: 2-1 oz. Balls.

Bone Crochet Hook No. 2 or No. 3.

1 yd. of 1 inch Ribbon.

Hood, Ch 83, insert needle in 3rd st from hook, pull loop through, yarn over, skip 1 st of ch, insert needle in next st, pull loop through, yarn over and pull through all 4 loops on needle, ch 1, \* insert needle in same space with last st, pull loop through, yarn over, skip 1 st of ch, insert needle in next st, pull loop through, yarn over and pull through all 4 loops on needle, ch 1, repeat from \* to end of row (ch 2 to turn each row).

2nd Row. Start pattern, insert needle in space with ch 2, draw loop through, yarn over, insert needle under 2 loops of st, draw loop through, yarn over and pull through all 4 loops on needle, ch 1, \* insert needle in same space with last st, draw loop through, yarn over, skip the ch 1, insert needle under 2 loops of st, draw loop through, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on needle, ch 1, repeat from \* across row. Continue working in pattern until work measures about 11½ inches, break yarn. Fold work lengthwise, thread a needle with length of yarn and starting at the first and last st of first row, sew short side together to form hood.

Attach yarn at end st of last row and work 1 row of s c all around front of hood, working 1 s c in each row.

2nd Row. Start double knot st (Double knot stitch) draw up ½ inch loop on needle, yarn over and pull through ch, s c in single loop of st, draw up another ½ inch loop, s c in loop, s c in next s c, repeat double knot sts all around front of hood, continue in double knot sts around lower edge of hood, working a knot st in each pattern.

3rd Row. Work a 3/4 inch knot st to turn. Working across lower edge of hood only, s c in center s c of last double knot st made, \* work another double knot st, s c in center s c of next double knot st, work another double knot st, s c in same st with last s c, thus increasing one double knot st, repeat from \* across row, turn and work 3 more rows even, then work 1 row of double knot sts all around hood, break yarn.

Mitts. Ch 35—about 63/4 inches, join being careful not to twist chain, ch 2, insert needle in same st with joining, pull loop through, yarn over, skip 1 st of ch, insert needle in next st, pull loop through, yarn over and pull through all 4 loops on needle, ch 1, \* insert needle in same space with last st, pull loop through, yarn over, skip 1 st of ch, insert needle in next st, pull loop through, yarn over and pull through all 4 loops on needle, ch 1, repeat from \* 15 times, join in the ch 2.

2nd Round. Ch 2, turn. Work in pattern same as hood, join each round and ch 2 to turn each round. Work 6 more rounds of pattern even (about 2 inches).

9th Round. Work 8 patterns, increase by working another full pattern in the same space with last st, then work 1 pattern even, increase 1 pattern in the same manner as last increase, continue even around remainder of mitt.

10th Round. Work even in pattern (19 patterns).

11th Round. Work 10 patterns even, increase by working 1 pattern in same space with last st, continue even all around.

12th Round. Work even in pattern (20 patterns).

13th Round. Work 11 patterns, increase 1 pattern, continue even all around.

14th and 15th Rounds. Work even in pattern.

### Knitted Stocking Cap and Mittens

No. 4808 - MITTENS

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" KNITTING WORSTED

4-11/4-oz. Skeins White or any Color desired.

1 Pair No. 10 Bone Knitting Needles.

Gauge: 11 sts = 3 inches (Stockinette st).

Work with double strand of yarn.

Right Mitten. Cast on 43 sts, p 25, k 2, p 6, k 2, p 8.

1st Row of Pattern. (Right side of work) k 8, p 2, sl the next 3 sts on a double pointed needle keeping sts in front of work, k the next 3 sts, k the 3 sts from double pointed needle, p 2, k 25.

2nd Row. P 25, k 2, p 6, k 2, p 8.

3rd Row. K 2, k 2 tog, k 4, p 2, k 6, p 2, k 5, k 2 tog, k 5, k 2 tog, k 5, k 2 tog, k 4.

4th Row. P 22, k 2, p 6, k 2, p 7.

5th Row. K 3, k 2 tog, k 2, p 2, k 6, p 2, k 1, k 2 tog, k 7, k 2 tog, k 7, k 2 tog, k 1.

6th Row. P 19, k 2, p 6, k 2, p 6.

7th Row. K 6, p 2, sl next 3 sts on double pointed needle, k next 3 sts, k sts on double pointed needle, p 2, k 19.

8th Row. P 19, k 2, p 6, k 2, p 6.

9th Row. K 1, k 2 tog, k 3, p 2, k 6, p 2, k 5, k 2 tog, k 5, k 2 tog, k 5.

10th Row. P 17, k 2, p 6, k 2, p 5.

11th Row. K 1, k 2 tog twice, p 2, k 6, p 2, k 1, k 2 tog, k 11, k 2 tog, k 1.

12th Row. P 15, k 2, p 6, k 2, p 3.

13th Row. K 1, k 2 tog, p 2, work cable twist, p 2, k 11, k 2 tog, k 2.

14th Row. P 14, k 2, p 6, k 2, p 2.

15th Row. K 2, p 2, k 6, p 2, k 14.

16th Row. P 14, k 2, p 6, k 2, p 2.

17th Row. K 2, p 2, k 6, p 2, k 14. Continued on Page 19

#### No. 4808 - CAP

#### Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" KNITTING WORSTED

4-11/4-oz. Skeins White or any Color desired.

1 Pair No. 8 Bone Knitting Needles.

Work with single strand of yarn.

Cast on 94 sts and work in ribbing of k 2, p 2 for 2 inches.

2nd Row. (Right side of work) k 38, p 2, k 6, p 2, k 6, p 2, k 38.

3rd Row. P 38, k 2, p 6, k 2, p 6, k 2, p 38.

4th Row. K 38, p 2, k 6, p 2, k 6, p 2, k 38.

5th Row. P 38, k 2, p 6, k 2, p 6, k 2, p 38.

6th Row. K 38, p 2, place next 3 sts on a double pointed needle, k next 3 sts, k 3 sts on spare needle (cable twist), p 2, repeat cable twist, p 2, k 38.

Repeat these 6 rows for pattern.

Work 1 more cable and 1st 5 rows of next cable.

Next Row. Decrease 3 sts evenly spaced in each stockinette section (6 sts in all), then decrease every 2nd cable twist row in same manner three more times. Decrease in same manner every 3rd cable twist row until 14 sts remain in each stockinette section. Work 3 cables and decrease in next cable. Work 3 more

Next Row. P 6, p 2 tog, p 3, k 2 tog, p 6, k 2 tog, p 6, k 2 tog, p 3, p 2 tog, p 6.

Break yarn and draw remaining sts together. Sew

Tassel. Cut 75–20-inch strands and tie in the center. Cut one end and tie again about 1 inch from top.

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### Chicken Potholder Mitt

No. 4809

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" COTTON YARN, ARTICLE 75

1-100 yd. Skein Yellow.

2 yds. Black for Eyes.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 00.

Body. Ch 4, 11 d c in 1st st of ch, join in top of ch.

2nd Row. Working in back loop of st only throughout, ch 1, 2 s c in same space, 2 s c in each remaining st (do not join or turn this or following rows).


3rd Row. Place a marker at beginning of row, work 1 s c in each s c increasing in every 2nd st.

4th Row. Increase in every 3rd st.

5th and 6th Rows. Work even in s c.

7th Row. Increase in every 4th st.

8th Row. Increase in every 5th st.



9th Row. Increase in every 6th st.

10th Row. Increase in every 7th st.

11th Row. Work even, break yarn.

Head. Work 1st 5 rows same as body, then work bill, ch 3, 2 tr c in same space with last s c, ch 3, sl st in same space, break yarn.

Sew head in position as illustrated.

Tail. Skip 14 sts from head, join thread in next st, ch 10, s c in 3rd st from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch, then work 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c of body, (working in opposite direction from head) ch 1, turn.

2nd Row. Skip 1 s c, working in back loop of st only throughout, 1 s c in each of the next 7 sts, ch 3, turn.

3rd Row. Skip 1st 2 sts of ch, s c in next st, 1 s c in each of the next 7 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c of body, ch 1, turn. Repeat last 2 rows 3 times, break yarn.

Work other half of mitt in same manner but starting tail having the wrong side of work toward you.

Sew the 2 sections together leaving about 22 sts free below the tail for opening. With Black, embroider eyes.

#### Fish Potholder Mitt

No. 4810

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" COTTON YARN, ARTICLE 75

1-100 yd. Skein Yellow.

1-100 yd. Skein Green.

2 yds. Red and 1 yd. Black.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 00.

Body. With Yellow, ch 4, 4 d c in 1st st of ch, ch 1, turn.

2nd Row. 1 s c and 1 d c in each of the 4 d c, ch 1,

3rd Row. Work 1 s c in each d c and I d c in each s c (pattern) across row working 1 more pattern in last d c, ch 1, turn.

4th and 5th Rows. Repeat 3rd row.

6th Row. Work even in pattern.

7th Row. Increase 1 pattern at end of row.

Repeat last 2 rows 4 times, then work 11 rows even, ch 1, turn.

27th Row. Insert in 1st st, pull through, insert in next st, pull through, insert in next st, pull through and complete s c, (2 sts decreased) and continue even in pattern across row, ch 1, turn.

Next 8 Rows. Repeat last row, break yarn.

Fin and Tail Sections. With Green, work 1st 5 rows same as 1st 5 rows of body, then work 1 more row same as 3rd row of body, break yarn. Work 2 more sections in same manner.

Fins. Sew long side of section to the even rows at top of body.

Tail. Sew 1 short side to the 1st seven rows of body as illustrated. Sew other section to opposite side of body in same manner. Work other half of mitt in same manner. Sew the 2 sections together, leaving tail end open. With Black, embroider eyes as illustrated. With Red, embroider mouth using an overcasting st.

### Pinafore Dish Cloth

No. 4811

Materials Required—AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
"PURITAN" MERCERIZED CROCHET AND
KNITTING COTTON, ARTICLE 40

I-300 yd. Ball White and I-50 yd. Ball "STAR" Pearl Cotton, Article 90, Size 5. Red or any Color desired.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 8.

With White, ch 66, join being careful not to twist ch, ch 5, skip 2 sts of ch, d c in next st, \* ch 2, skip 2 sts of ch, d c in next st, repeat from \* all around, ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch, (22 meshes) drop white.

2nd Row. Attach Red, ch 3, \* 2 d c in next mesh, d c in next d c, repeat from \* all around, join, break Red.

3rd Row. Pick up White, ch 5, d c in same space. \* ch 2, 1 d c, ch 2, 1 d c in next d c, repeat from \* all around, ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch.

4th Row. Ch 5, d c in next d c, \* ch 2, d c in next d c, repeat from \* all around, ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch. Repeat the last row 13 times, drop White.

18th Row. Attach Red and work same as last row, break Red.

Pick up White and work 2 more rows of 2 ch meshes, break thread.

Edge. Attach Red in d c, \* ch 3, d c in 3rd st from hook, s c in next d c, repeat from \* all around, break thread.

Attach Red at top and work 2 s c in each mesh and 1 s c in each d c, break Red.

Bib. With White, ch 17, d c in 8th st from hook, ch 2, skip 2 sts of ch, d c in next st, \* ch 2, skip 2 sts of ch, d c in next st, repeat from \*.

## Gay Dish Cloth

No. 4312

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
"DE LUXE" MERCERIZED CROCHET AND
KNITTING COTTON, ARTICLE 346


1-300 yd. Ball White and 1-200 yd. Ball Blue or any Color desired will make 2 Dish Cloths.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.

With White, ch 12, join to form a ring, ch 3 and work 23 d c in ring, join.

2nd Row. Ch 6, skip 1 d c, d c in next d c, \* ch 3, skip 1 d c, d c in next d c, repeat from \* 9 times, ch 3, join in 3rd st of ch, (12 meshes).

3rd Row. Ch 5, d c in mesh, \* ch 2, d c in next d c, ch 2, d c in next mesh, repeat from \* 10 times, ch 2, join to 3rd st of ch.



4th Row. Ch 5, d c in next mesh, \* ch 2, d c in next d c, ch 2, d c in next mesh, repeat from \* all around, join.


5th Row. Attach Color, ch 3, d c in mesh, ch 2, 2 d c in same mesh, \* ch 2, skip 2 meshes, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c (shell) in next mesh, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 2, join (16 shells). (When changing Color always complete last half of stitch with next Color.)

6th Row. Sl st to center of shell, ch 3 and work a shell in center of each shell with ch 3 between shells.

7th Row. Attach White in center of shell, ch 5 d c in same space, \* ch 2, d c in next mesh, ch 2, d c in center of next shell, ch 2, d c in same space, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 2, d c in next mesh, ch 2, join.

8th Row. SI st into loop, ch 5, d c in next loop, ch 2, d c in next d c, \* ch 2, d c in next loop, ch 2, d c in next loop, ch 2, d c in d c,

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### Design for snow

No. 4813

Sizes 38 to 40 and 42 to 44.

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" KNITTING WORSTED, ARTICLE WII

11/4 oz. Skeins.

Sizes 38 to 40 Sizes 42 to 44

White—13 Skeins. 14 Skeins.

Blue-3 Skeins. 4 Skeins.

Cardinal—1 Skein. 2 Skeins.

I Pair Bone Knitting Needles No. 5-14 inches long.

1 Pair Bone Knitting Needles No. 6–14 inches long.

1 set Double Pointed Knitting Needles No. 4 or 5.

Gauge: 5 sts = 1 inch.

Directions are given for size 38 to 40—large size is given in brackets. To knit in two colors leave an end about 4 inches long to be fastened when sweater is completed. Each square of design represents one st. Carry the yarn not being used loosely in back of work twisting yarns every few sts to prevent long loops.



Back. With White on No. 5 Needles cast on 100 sts (110) and work in ribbing of k 2, p 2 for 3½ inches increasing in the last row to 109 sts (119). Change to No. 6 needles and continue work in stockinette st (k 1 row, p 1 row). Work even in White (the allover

design is worked later), until back measures about 15 (15½) inches from the beginning ending with a purl row. Then work 2 rows in Cardinal, 2 rows White, 2 rows Blue, 2 rows White, 2 rows Cardinal. Next 2 rows in White, bind off 4 sts (6) at the beginning of each row. Next row start the pattern following chart on page 11. In the larger size the added sts of pattern are worked in Blue.

Decrease 1 st at the beginning of next 8 rows (10); then continue even. After the design is completed, work 2 rows White, 2 rows Cardinal, 2 rows White, 2 rows Blue, 2 rows White, 2 rows Cardinal, continue in White until armhole measures 9 inches (9½) from the 1st decreasing point.

Next 2 rows. Bind off 15 sts at the beginning of each row.

Next 2 rows. Bind off 14 sts (15) at the beginning of each row, and slip remaining sts on a stitch holder for back of neck.

Front. Work same as back until armhole measures about  $7\frac{1}{2}$  inches from the 1st decreasing point.

Next Row. Work across 32 sts (33), place next 29 sts (31) on a stitch holder. On the first 32 sts (33), decrease 1 st at neck edge every other row 3 times. Work even until armhole measures same as back armhole. Bind off shoulder same as back shoulder. Complete other side to correspond.

Sleeves. With White on No. 5 needles cast on 48 sts (52) and work in ribbing of k 2, p 2 for 5 inches increasing 8 sts in the last row. Change to No. 6 needles and continue in stockinette st. Increase 1 st each side every inch 11 times (12), then increase 1 more stitch, 79 sts (85). Work even until sleeve measures 18 inches (19) from the beginning, then work 2 rows Cardinal, 2 rows White, 2 rows Blue, 2 rows White, 2 rows Cardinal.

Next 2 Rows. With White, bind off 4 sts at the beginning of each row. Start pattern decreasing 1 st at the beginning of each row, then work stripe pattern. Complete sleeve in White, continuing to decrease 1 st at beginning of each row until 37 sts remain. Bind off 3 sts at the beginning of each row until 19 sts remain, bind off.

With Blue, embroider all over rain drop pattern on all sections of sweater, starting 1st pattern in the center of the 6th row from 1st stripe as follows: Work 2 sts over a knitted st following the slant of the knitted st forming a V, then work 2 more sts in same manner in row below. Work patterns 11 sts apart. Work a 2nd row of patterns in 12th row from stripes, placing raindrop in center st between 1st row of rain drops. Continue in same manner as illustrated.

Block each piece to correct measurements Sew shoulder seams. On 3 double pointed needles pick up the sts from st holders and 12 sts on each side of neck and work in ribbing of k 2, p 2 for 1 inch, bind off loosely. Sew seams and sew in sleeves matching pattern.

### After-Ski Slippers

No. 4814

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" KNITTING WORSTED, ARTICLE WIL

 $2-1\frac{1}{4}$  oz. Skeins White.

 $1-1\frac{1}{4}$  oz. Skein Blue.

14 yds. Cardinal.

4 Double Pointed Bone Knitting Needles No. 6. Bone Crochet Hook No. 4 or 5.

1 Pair Leather Soles.

With White and on 3 needles cast on 48 sts (16-16-16) and work in ribbing of k 2, p 2 for 2 inches.

Next Round. K 1, p 1, k 1, p 1, k 1, p 1, k remainder of round.

Next Round. P 1, k 1, p 1, k 1, p 1, k 1, k remainder

Repeat these 2 rounds until work measures 6 inches from beginning. The seed st stripe is center of slipper.

Next Round. Work the 6 center sts in seed st, then k next 8 sts, bind off next 26 sts for heel, k next 8 sts. Work in seed st across next 6 sts, k 8. Place all sts on one needle.

Next Row. P the 1st and last 8 sts working 6 center sts in seed st.

Next Row. K the 1st and last 8 sts working 6 center sts in seed st.





The arms are made the same as legs using 1 spool for each hand and 2 spools for each arm. Tie all cords around the last knot so cords cannot go through spool. Sew open section of head around knot. Embroider mouth with Red. Nose and eye brows with Black. Use buttons for eyes as illustrated.

Skirt. With "Star" Cotton Yarn, ch 23, 1 s c in 6th st from hook, \* ch 5, s c in next st of ch, ch 5, s c in same st, ch 5, s c in next st, repeat from \* to end of row, ch 5, turn.

2nd Row. 1 s c in 1st 5 ch loop, \* ch 5, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from \* to end of row, ch 5, turn. Repeat 2nd row 4 times.

7th Row. Ch 3, s c in 1st loop, ch 3, s c in same loop, \* ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, s c in same loop, repeat







On right side of work with Blue pick up and k 80 sts across the back, then k 3 more rows, break Blue.

Right Front. With Blue and using No. 2 needles on right side of work pick up and k 44 sts across row, k 3 more rows even, break Blue.

Attach White, change to No. 6 needles and work open work pattern same as back, then k 4 rows even, bind off loosely.

Work other front in same manner.

Sleeves. With Blue on No. 2 needles cast on 28 sts and k 4 rows.

Attach White, k 1 row, p 1 row, k 1 row, p 1 row.

With Blue, k 4 rows, fasten yarn and continue sleeve with White. With same needles k 1, \* yarn over twice, k 1 and leave on left needle, yarn over twice, k in back of same st and slip off needle, (this is an increase) yarn over twice, k 1, repeat from \* across row, do not increase in last st. Change to No. 6 needles and continue open work pattern same as jacket without any more increases until sleeve measures about 7 inches completing a pattern, bind off. Sew underarm seams. Sew sleeve seams and sew sleeves in position.

With White, work a row of s c up right side of yoke, around neck and down opposite side of front yoke, break yarn.

Attach yarn at neck and work a row of double knot sts around neck as follows:

\* Draw up ½ inch loop on hook, yarn over and pull through ch, s c in single loop of st, draw up ¼ inch loop on hook, yarn over and pull through ch, s c in single loop of st (double knot st) skip 1 st, s c in next st, work a double knot st, s c in next s c, repeat from \* around neck, break yarn. Work a row of double knot sts around cuffs of sleeves in same manner. Finish with ribbon bows as illustrated.

Next Row. Work across 30 sts, (32-34) bind off next 34 sts (36-38) for back of neck and continue pattern on last 30 sts (32-34) for shoulder. Work 1 stripe in Color, 1 in White and 1 in Color. With Color cast on 18 sts (22-26) at neck edge. Attach White and continue in pattern until there are as many stripes in front as in back, bind off and work other side to correspond.

On right front with No. 2 needles and White yarn, on right side of work, pick up 60 sts (63-66) and k 3 rows, break yarn. Attach Color, change to No. 6 needles and start open work pattern.

1st Row. K 1, \* yarn over twice, k 1, repeat from \* across row.

2nd Row. K 1, \* drop the 2 yarn overs from needle without knitting them, k 1, repeat from \* across row.

3rd and 4th Rows. K across row. Repeat these 4 rows for pattern. Work I more pattern. At the end of the 4th row of last pattern, cast on 7 sts for underarm and continue pattern until work measures about 11 inches (12-13) from underarm completing a pattern. K 4 more rows and bind off loosely. Work left front to correspond.

Back. With No. 2 needles and White yarn, on right side of work, pick up 120 sts (126-132) and k 3 rows, break yarn. Attach Color and work 6 rows of pattern.

Next 2 rows cast on 7 sts at the beginning of each row and continue pattern until back measures the same as the fronts finishing with k 4 rows.

Sleeves. With White and No. 2 needles, cast on 40 sts (44-50) and k 4 rows. With Color, k 1 row, p 1 row, k 1 row, p 1 row. With White, k 4 rows, fasten White and continue sleeve with Color. With No. 2 needles k 1, \* yarn over twice, k 1 and leave st on left needle, yarn over twice, k in back of same st and slip st off needle (this is an increase), yarn over twice, k 1, repeat from \* across row. Do not increase in last st. Change to No. 6 needles and continue open work pattern (without anymore increases) until there are 20 patterns (21-23) or sleeve is desired length to underarm. Work 2 rows of next pattern.

Next 2 rows bind off 7 sts at the beginning of each row. Continue pattern, decreasing 1 st at the beginning of every 3rd and 4th row of pattern until 28 sts remain. Bind off remaining sts 2 at a time.

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Sew underarm seams. Sew sleeve seams and sew sleeves in position. With Blue, work a row of s c up right side of yoke, around neck and down opposite side of front yoke, break yarn.

Attach yarn at neck, \* draw up a 1/4 inch loop on needle, yarn over and pull through ch, s c in single loop of st, draw up a 1/4 inch loop on needle and pull through ch, s c in single loop of st (double knot st), skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, work a double knot st, s c in next s c, repeat from \* around neck, turn.

2nd Row. \* Draw up a 1/4 inch loop on needle, yarn over and pull through ch, s c in single loop of st, repeat from \* twice, s c in center of next double knot st, \* work a double knot st, s c in center of next double knot st, repeat from \* across row.

3rd Row. Same as last row, break yarn. Work 3 rows of double knot sts around each sleeve in same manner.

Finish with ribbon bows as illustrated.

Cuff. Attach yarn at top of mitt and work 5 or 6 rounds as desired of double knot sts, I double knot st in each st (see Hood for directions), break yarn.

16th Row. S c in 1st s c, \* ch 1, s c in next s c, repeat from \* 24 times, then ch 31 for next finger, turn and work on ch same as 1st row, ch 3, turn.

Repeat 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 10th rows, turn and work a row of pattern down side, around each finger and down opposite side, break thread.

Fold thumb to the left and with Red crochet the 2 sections of thumb together using same pattern st, break thread.

With Red, holding the 2 sections together and having the back of glove toward you, crochet the 2 sections together in pattern st, break thread.

Right Glove. Work same as left glove, but fold thumb in opposite direction when joining sections together.

ch 2, 2 tr c (shell) in ch of next ch 1 loop, ch 3, skip 1 loop, repeat from beginning across row ending row with s c in next loop, ch 4, turn.

5th Row. D c in s c, \* ch l, d c in lst tr c of next shell, ch 2, 2 d c with ch 2 between in center loop of same shell, ch 2, skip 1 tr c of same shell, d c in next tr c, repeat from \* across row ending row with ch l, d c in last s c, ch 5, turn.

6th Row. 2 tr c in next ch 1 loop, \* ch 3, skip 1 loop, s c in next loop, ch 3, skip 1 loop, shell in ch of next ch 1 loop, repeat from \* across row ending row with ch 3, skip 1 loop, s c in next loop, ch 3, skip 1 loop, 2 tr c, ch 2, 1 tr c in next ch 1 loop, 1 tr c in end ch, ch 4, turn.

7th Row. 2 d c with ch 2 between in center loop of same shell, ch 2, skip 1 tr c of same shell, d c in next tr c, ch 1, d c in 1st tr c of next shell, ch 2, repeat from beginning across row ending row with 2 d c with ch 2 between in 1st st of end ch, ch 1, turn.

8th Row. Same as 4th row but sl st in end loop.

Repeat the 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th rows until work measures 12 inches from beginning.

Next Row. 3 s c in next loop, 1 s c, 1 s d c in next loop (s d c: thread over needle, insert in space, pull through and work off all loops at one time), s d c in ch of next ch 1 loop, 1 s d c, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from beginning across row ending row with 3 s c in next loop, 1 s c, 1 s d c in last loop, ch 1, turn.

Next Row. 1 s c in each st, ch 1, turn.

Repeat the last row 27 times, ch 4, turn.

Next Row. D c in same space, \* ch 2, skip 2 s c, d c in next s c, ch 1, skip 1 s c, d c in next s c, ch 2, skip 2 s c, 2 d c with ch 2 between in next s c, repeat from \* across row ending row with ch 1, turn.

Repeat the 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th rows twice, break thread.

Work a row of s c down side of apron, across lower edge, up opposite side and across top, ch 1, turn and work back and forth across top of apron only for 10 more rows, break thread.

Tie. Ch 8, 1 s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch, ch 1, turn.

2nd Row. 1 s c in each s c, ch 1, turn.

Repeat 2nd row until tie measures 15 inches, break thread. Work another tie in same manner, sew to each side of waist band as illustrated.


Embroider solid band according to diagram on page 15 repeating pattern 4 times working designs 7 sts apart.

Embroider some aprons in yellow and some in orange as desired.

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
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
