

## Curtain Pulls

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#### SUGGESTED MATERIALS FOR CURTAIN PULLS

"Star" Mercerized Crochet Cotton. Medium or Large Balls size 3, 5 or 10. "Trojan" Mercerized Crochet Cotton. "Gem" Mercerized Crochet Cotton size 10. "Puritan" Mercerized Crochet Cotton.

"De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton.

No. 200 MATERIALS REQUIRED. About 30 yds. of Thread.

1 1-inch Bone Ring.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 10 or 11.

Work 45 s c over ring.

2nd Row—Ch 3, 1 d c in each of next 8 s c, ch 3, 1 d c in each of the next 9 s c, repeat from \* all around, ch 3, join.

3rd Row—Ch 5, 1 d c in each of the 3 center d c, ch 5, sl st in last d c, ch 5, sl st in 1st d c of next group, repeat from beginning all around.

4th Row—Sl st to center of loop, \* ch 5, d c in center d c, ch 4, sl st in top of d c for picot, ch 5, sl st over next loop, ch 3, sl st over next loop, ch 3, sl st over next loop and repeat from \* all around, break thread.

**CORD.** Join thread in center of one side and make a ch twice the length desired, join in same space with other joining, knot at joining and then knot at regular intervals.

#### No. 201 MATERIALS REQUIRED. About 20 yds. of Thread.

1 %-inch Bone Ring. Steel Crochet Hook No. 10 or 11.

Work 40 s c over ring.

2nd Row-Ch 3, thread over, insert in same space and pull up the length of a d c, \* thread over, insert in same space, pull up the same length, repeat from \* thread over and pull through all loops but 2, thread over, pull through 2 loops on needle, \* ch 2, skip one st puff st in next st and repeat from \* all around, ch 2, join.

3rd Row—Sl st to center of loop, ch 4, sl st over next loop, repeat all around, do not break thread, crochet a ch twice the length desired for cord, sl st into same st with ch, break thread and fasten securely. Knot the cord at regular inter-

#### No. 202 MATERIALS REQUIRED. About 30 yds. of Thread.

1 %-inch Bone Ring.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 10 or 11.

Work 40 s c over ring, join.

**2nd Row**—Ch 4, skip 1 s c, d c in next s c. \* ch 1, skip 1 s c, d c in next s c, repeat from \* 6 times (8 meshes) ch 3, turn.

3rd Row—2 d c in same space with ch, \* ch 3, skip 1 d c, 3 d c in next d c, repeat from \* 3 times, ch 3, turn.

4th Row—1 d c in same space with ch, 2 d c in each remaining d c, ch 3, turn.

5th Row—1 d c in each d c with ch 1 between each d c, ch 1, turn.

6th Row—Work a picot at corner then over the first 9 meshes work 2 s c in each mesh with picot after every 5th s c, break thread and repeat over last 9 meshes.

Finish the center 9 meshes with a fringe. Take five 6-inch strands, double them and knot through mesh.

CORD. Fasten thread in center of plain part of ring, ch for desired length, sl st into 10th st from hook, \* ch 5, skip 4 sts of ch, sl st in next st, repeat from \* for entire length and fasten securely in same space with ch.

#### No. 203 MATERIALS REQUIRED. About 30 yds. of Thread.

1 Bone Ring.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 10 or 11.

1st Row—Work a row of s c over the ring.

2nd Row—Ch 3, skip 2 s c, s c in next s c. repeat from beginning ending last loop in first loop.

3rd Row—Work five 4 ch loops, ch 1, turn.

4th Row—Sl st to center of loop, ch 3, popcorn st in next loop, (popcorn st, work 4 d c in same loop, slip loop off hook, insert in 1st d c made and pull loop through) \* ch 2, popcorn st in next loop, repeat from \* 1 d c in next loop, ch

5th Row—s c in next 2 ch loop, \* ch 3, s c in next loop, repeat from \* ch 1, turn.

6th Row—Sl st to center of ch, ch 3, popcorn st in next loop, d c in next loop, ch 2, turn. s c in top of popcorn st, \* ch 2, turn, s c in s c, repeat from \* until cord is desired length.

#### No. 204 MATERIALS REQUIRED. About 35 yds. of Thread.

1 %-inch Bone Ring.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 10 or 11.

Work 45 s c over ring, join.

2nd Row—Ch 4, skip 2 s c, s c in next s c, repeat all around (15 loops).

3rd Row—Sl st to center of loop and work s c over same loop, \* ch 3, s c over next loop, repeat from \* twice, ch 3, 2 d c over next loop, ch 3, 2 d c over same loop, \* ch 3, s c in next Continued on page 5 No. 205 For the body use any of the following Threads—"Star" Pearl Cotton size 5, "De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton, "Puritan" or "Trojan" Crochet Cotton or "Clover" Crochet and Knitting Cotton in White, Ecru, or Cream. For the garments use "Sillateen" "Sansil" in any color desired.

About 15 yds. are required for the body and about 10 yds. for the garments.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 8 or 9.

Over a 2½-inch card board wind thread about 60 times, tie at one side and cut through the other side.

With the flat side toward you, wrap thread and tie about ½ inch down to form head. Tie with color in front leaving tiny ends to form a tie.

Take 10 strands at each side for arms, tie about  $\frac{5}{8}$  inch down from the neck and cut  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch from wrist. Tie about  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch from neck for waist, divide the strands and tie about  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch from waist to form legs. Trim the lower edge even.

**PANTS.** With color, ch 10, join, ch 3, work 16 d c into ring, join and work 3 more rows of d c joining each row, break thread leaving a length to fasten. Make another section, break thread leaving a length to fasten and for suspenders.

Slip sections over legs and fasten together and to body.

Starting at center front carry thread to shoulder and fasten, bring thread back to center and to other shoulder and back again to center, slip through to back of body and make straps to correspond.

Take a length of Ecru Thread, double it and slip through top of head and with double thread work a cord of chs for length desired.

HAT. Leaving a length of thread to fasten, ch 7, join to form a ring, 14 s c into ring. Work 5 more rows of s c, break thread. Slip cord through the center of hat and fasten hat in position. Indicate the face using Black Star Twist.

**SKIRT.** Ch 15, join, ch 3 and work 1 d c in each st.

**2nd Row**—Ch 3, 3 d c in each st and work 1 row even.

**BANDEAU.** Ch 8, d c in first st of ch, ch 5, turn, d c in 5th st of ch, \* ch 5, turn, d c in 3rd st of ch, repeat from \* twice, break thread leaving an end to fasten.

Slip arms through 2nd and 4th mesh and fasten in back.

HAT. Work 5 rows of s c and roll hat all around.

No. 206 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton or "Star" Six Cord Mercerized Crochet Cotton size 10.

About 30 yds. each of Yellow and Rust or any 2 colors desired. One 3/4-inch Button Mold. Steel Crochet Hook No. 8.

With Yellow ch 3, 6 s c in first st of ch.

2nd Row—2 s c in each s c. Next 3 rows—Work 1 s c in each s c, working 1 row in Rust, 1 row Yellow and 1 row Rust, break thread.

FRINGE. Cut 6-inch lengths of Yellow and Rust. Take one strand of each, double and knot them through both loops of s c, repeat all around. Slip work over button mold and tack in position.

CORD. Take 2 strands of Rust, attach to center of tassel, work an s c over joining, \* ch 2, s c in first st, repeat from \* for length desired.

No. 207 MATERIALS REQUIRED. "De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton or "Star" Six Cord Mercerized Crochet Cotton size 10.

About 20 yds. each of Yellow and Rust or any two colors desired. 3 Bone Rings. Steel Crochet Hook No. 8 and 10.

Using large hook with Yellow work 10 s c over each ring without breaking thread and join to first st of first ring. Attach Rust and work 30 s c over remainder of ring, join to Yellow, sl st into Yellow of next ring, work 30 s c over ring and finish last ring in same manner.

Pick up the Yellow and with the fine needle work 4 s c picking up the back loop of st only, ch 3, 4 s c, repeat all around.

CORD. Take a length of Rust, double it and fasten between rings \* pull up thread the length of a dc, thread over, slip through loop on needle, s c over single thread of loop, and repeat from \* for desired length.



loop, repeat from \* 3 times and continue all around ending row in 1st s c made.

4th Row—3 s c over each of the next 3 loops, ch 5, 3 d c in center of shell, ch 3, 3 d c in same space, ch 5, skip 1 loop and repeat from beginning all around ending row in 1st s c made.

5th Row—Ch 5, 1 s c in each of the 3 center s c, ch 5, skip 2 s c, s c in next s c, ch 5, d c in 1st d c at corner, ch 4, sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, d c in next d c, picot, d c in next d c, picot, d c in each d c with picot between each d c, ch 5, s c in 1st s c, repeat from beginning all around, do not break thread.

CORD. Sl st to 1st s c, 1 s c in each s c, \* ch 4, turn, skip 1 s c, d c in next s c, ch 1, turn, 3 s c over ch, repeat from \* until cord is desired length.



No. 208 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "Star" Pearl Cotton size 5.

1 Ball White and 1 Ball Shaded Oranges or any 2 colors desired.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 8 or 9.

With color ch 4, 10 d c in first ch, join with a sl st.

2nd Row—Ch 3, 4 d c in same space, s c in next s c \* 5 d c in next s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* 3 times.

3rd Row—Ch 5, s c in back of s c between next 2 petals, repeat from beginning 4 times.

4th Row—1 s c, 7 d c over each loop, break thread.

5th Row—Join White in back of s c, \* ch 5, s c in back of s c between next 2 petals, repeat from \* all around.

6th Row—7 s c over each loop.

7th Row—2 s c in first s c, 1 s c in next s c,

repeat all around and work 4 rows of s c even, join row with sl st, break thread.

12th Row—Attach color, ch 3, 4 d c in same space, \* skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, skip 1 s c, 5 d c in next s c, repeat from \* all around. Break thread.

Repeat 5th and 6th rows.

15th Row—Work in s c increasing by working 3 s c in center s c of each scallop. Work 4 rows even and break thread.

20th Row-Attach color and repeat 12th row.

21st Row—1 s c in each s c and 5 d c in center d c of each shell.

22nd Row—1 s c in 1st d c of shell, 1 d c in next d c, 3 d c in next d c, 1 d c in next d c, 1 s c in last d c, skip the s c between shells and repeat from beginning all around.

23rd Row—Skip the s c of shell, s c in next st, d c in next st, 3 d c in next st, 1 d c in next

No. 209 MATERIALS REQUIRED.
American Thread
Company "De Luxe" Mercerized
Crochet and Knitting Cotton.
1 Ball White, Ecru or Cream.
1 Ball Red or any Color desired.
Steel Crochet Hook No. 8.

With Red, ch 8, join to form a ring, ch 3, 19 d c in ring, join each row.


2nd Row—With White, ch 3, 1 d c in each of the next 5 d c, ch 3, d c in same space, 1 d c in each of the next 5 d c, ch 3, d c in same space, repeat all around, ch 3, join.

3rd Row—Ch 3, 1 d c in each d c between corners and 2 d c, ch 3, 2 d c in each corner.

Repeat 3rd row for 10 rows alternating, 2 rows Red and 2 rows White.

Work a second section and join them together with a row of s c.

RING. Wrap thread around finger 14 times, and work 25 s c over ring, join to corner of pot holder.



No. 210 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton or "Star" Crochet Cord.

1 Ball each of White and any Contrasting Color.

1 Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

With color, ch 6, 5 tr c in first st, ch 3, turn, 1 bean st (thread over and insert in same st 5 times, pull through all sts and ch 1 to close) in each of the next 5 sts, 1 d c in end ch, ch 3, turn.

3rd Row—1 bean st in each bean st with 1 d c between bean sts, d c in end ch, ch 3, turn.

4th Row—1 bean st in each bean st with 2 d c between bean sts. Continue in same manner having one more st between bean sts until there are 7 d c between bean sts.

#### SCOTTIE POT HOLDER

No. 211 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company. "Puritan," "Trojan" or "De Luxe" Crochet Cotton.

1 Ball of White, Ecru or Cream.

1 Ball Yellow or any color desired.

1 Skein "Star" Art Thread, Black.


Steel Crochet Hook No. 7 or 8.


With Cream, Ch 57 (about 6 inches) turn and work 56 s c on ch. Continue working rows of s c until pot holder is square. Work a second section in Yellow.

Embroider Scottie on the Cream section following the cross st chart, working the dog in Black and ribbon bows in Yellow or any color used on the reverse side of pot holder.

RING. With Yellow, wind thread around finger 15 times and work s c over ring, attach to pot holder and crochet the two sections together with a row of s c.







No. 212 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton or "Star" Crochet Cord.

1 250-yd. Ball, Shade No. 26 Red.

1 250-yd. Ball, Shade No. 8 Maize.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 8.

With Maize, ch 24, s d c (short double crochet) in 3rd st from hook, 1 s d c in each remaining st, ch 2, turn.

2nd Row—1 s d c in each st taking up the back loop of st only. Repeat 2nd row 10 times, break thread.

Attach Red, d c in each s d c working 1 d c, ch 3, 1 d c in each corner.



#### FILET SCARF

No. 213 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "Star" Crochet Cotton size 30.

6 Medium Balls or 3 Large Balls in White, Ecru, Cream or Colors.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 11 or 12.


Ch 215 for 70 open meshes, work 1st d c in 8th st from hook and work back and forth according to diagram.


EDGE. Long side, fasten thread in 2nd d c from corner, 3 s c in each of the first 4 meshes, ch 6, turn, s c in 6th s c, ch 6, s c in 1st s c, ch 1, turn, 9 s c over first loop, 5 s c over next loop, ch 6, turn, s c in center st of first scallop, ch 1, turn, 9 s c over loop, 4 s c over remainder of unfinished scallop, repeat from beginning across side, at corner work 3 s c in next mesh, 6 s c in corner mesh, 3 s c in next mesh, ch 6, turn and work scallop.

Across short sides spread 2 scallops over 5 meshes to make scallop even at corner.

This scarf may also be made in "Gem" Mercerized Crochet Cotton.

The border of scarf featured will make attractive inserts for Curtains, Crib Cover or Baby Pillow.





## Bread Tray


No. 214 MATERIALS REQUIRED. 2 Medium Balls of American Thread Company "Star" Mercerized Crochet Cotton size 30 or 50, White, Ecru or Dark Cream. Steel Crochet Hook No. 12 or 13.

Ch 56, work 1st d c in 8th st from hook and work back and forth according to diagram.

To increase a number of open meshes at the end of a row, ch 2, d tr c (three times over hook)

into same st with last d c, ch 2, d tr c in center of last d tr c, repeat the number of times desired. To increase at beginning of next row, ch for the desired number of meshes and work 1st d c in 8th st from hook.

This doily may also be made in "Gem" Mercerized Crochet Cotton. For a finer doily use the finer sizes of "Star" or "Gem" Crochet Cotton or "Star" Tatting Cotton.

No. 215 MATERIALS REQUIRED. "Star" Pearl Cotton size 3 for the Mats and size 5 for the Edge.

5 Medium Balls, White, size 3.

5 Medium Balls, Light Yellow or any color desired, size 3.

3 Medium Balls, White, size 5. Steel Crochet Hook No. 6.

LARGE MAT. With White ch 81, turn, skip 1 ch and \* work 10 s c, attach Yellow and work 10 s c (carry all threads under sts) repeat from \* 3 times. Ch 1, turn and work 3 more rows working Yellow over Yellow and White over White.

Next Row—Work White over Yellow and Yellow over White and work 3 more rows. Repeat these 8 rows until there are 6 White Blocks and 5 Yellow Blocks.

START NEXT SIZE MAT with ch 71 and work 5 White and 5 Yellow Blocks.

START NEXT TO SMALLEST MAT with ch 61 and work 4 White Blocks and 4 Yellow Blocks.

SMALL MAT. Start with ch 51 and work 4 White and 3 Yellow Blocks.

EDGE. Large Mat. 1st Row—Work 41 one ch meshes on long side, 1 mesh in corner, 27 meshes on short side, mesh in corner and work other half to correspond.

2nd Row—9 tr c in corner \* skip 1 mesh, s c in next mesh, 7 tr c in next mesh, repeat from \* around mat working 9 tr c in corners.


3rd Row—S c in first tr c, ch 4, d c in next tr c, \* ch 1, d c in next tr c, repeat from \* 4 times, ch 1, s c in last tr c, s c in s c, s c in first tr c of next shell, \* ch 1, tr c in next tr c, repeat from \* 4 times, ch 1, s c in last tr c, s c in s c between shells, s c in 1st tr c of next shell, ch 1 and continue all around.

ON NEXT SIZE MAT. Work 37 meshes across long sides including corners and 23 meshes on each short side.

NEXT TO SMALLEST MAT. Work 33 meshes including corners across long sides and 19 meshes on short sides.

SMALLEST MAT. 25 meshes including corners on long sides and 15 meshes on short sides.

2nd and 3rd rows are worked same on all mats.



#### FILET MOTIFS

Filet Motifs which will make attractive Luncheon Sets, Scarfs, Pillows, Curtains, etc.

If a heavy Motif is desired use any of the following Threads:

"De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton—"Trojan" Crochet Cotton—"Puritan" Crochet Cotton—"Star" Pearl Cotton size 5—"Clover" Knitting and Crochet Cotton.


Any of the following Threads will make a dainty Motif:

"Star" Six Cord Mercerized Crochet Cotton. Sizes 20 to 100—"Star" Tatting Cotton— "Gem" Crochet Cotton sizes 20 to 50.

No. 216 Ch 104 for 33 open meshes, work 1st d c in 8th st from hook, \* ch 2, skip 2 sts, d c in next st, repeat from \* to end of row and continue working back and forth according to illustration.


No. 217 Ch 93 for 30 meshes, work 1st d c in 4th st from hook and work back and forth according to illustration.

No. 218 Ch 89 for 28 open meshes, work lst d c in 8th st from hook and work back and forth according to illustration.

No. 219 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "Star" or "Gem" Mercerized Crochet Cotton size 20 or 30.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 11 or 12.

Ch 7, join, ch 3, 14 d c into ring.

2nd Row—Ch 5, skip 1 d c, s c in next d c, repeat from beginning all around.

3rd Row—Sl st into loop \* ch 7, s c into next loop, repeat from \* all around.

4th Row—SI st into loop, ch 3, \* 4 d c over loop, slip st off hook, insert in 1st d c made and pull loop through (this is termed a popcorn st). Ch 3, work another popcorn st of 4 d c, ch 7, repeat from \* all around.

5th Row—SI st between 2 popcorn sts and work a popcorn st in same space, \* ch 7, s c over next loop, ch 7, popcorn st between next 2 popcorn sts and repeat from \* all around joining row in popcorn st.

6th Row—Sl st to center of loop, \* ch 9, s c over next loop, repeat from \* all around.

7th Row—Ch 1 and work 11 s c over each loop, join.

8th Row—Ch 5, \* skip 3 s c, d c in next s c, ch 2, skip 2 s c, d c in next s c, ch 2, d c between scallops, ch 2 and repeat from \* all around.

9th Row—Sl st into loop, \* ch 5, s c into next

loop, repeat from \* all around, ending last loop in 1st loop (42 loops).

10th Row—Ch 3 and work popcorn st in same loop, \*ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from \* 4 times \*\* ch 5 and work a popcorn st in next st, work five 5 ch loops and repeat from \*\* all around. Join row in popcorn st.

11th Row—Ch 3, popcorn st in next loop, \*four, 5 ch loops, ch 5, popcorn st in next loop, ch 5, popcorn st in next loop and repeat from \*.

12th Row—Sl st in loop, popcorn st in same loop, \* three 5 ch loops, ch 5, popcorn st in next loop, ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 5, popcorn st in next loop and repeat from \* all around.


Work 4 more rows having 1 less loop between popcorn sts in first group of meshes and one more loop between popcorn sts in next group of meshes and working 6 ch meshes in the 3rd row and 7 ch meshes in the 4th row.

17th Row—Work 7 s c over each mesh, join.

18th Row—Ch 9, s c between scallops, repeat all around.

19th Row—SI st into center of next loop, \*\* ch 2, tr c in next loop, \* ch 2, tr c in same loop repeat from \* 3 times, ch 2, s c into next loop and repeat from \*\* all around ending with s c over last sl st.

20th Row—Ch 1, d c in tr c, \* ch 1, d c in mesh, ch 1, d c in tr c, repeat from \* 3 times, ch 1, s c in s c and repeat from beginning all around.



No. 220 MATERIALS REQUIRED. About 500 yds. of any of the following Threads:

American Thread Company "Puritan," "Trojan," "De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet Cotton or "Star" Pearl Cotton size 5.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 9 or 10.

Ch 6, d c in first st of ch, \* ch 2, d c in same space, repeat from \* 4 times, ch 2 and join in 4th st of ch 6.

2nd Row-3 s c in each loop, join.

3rd Row—Ch 4, 1 d c in each s c with ch 1 between each d c (21 meshes).

4th Row—2 s c in each space.

5th Row—Increase in every 3rd s c and work 1 row even.

7th Row—Increase in every 5th s c and work 2 rows even.

10th Row—Ch 4, skip 1 s c, tr c in next s c, ch 4, skip 1 s c, sl st in next s c, repeat from beginning all around ending row with tr c instead of ch.

11th Row—Ch 7, s c in next tr c, repeat from beginning all around.

12th Row—9 s c over each loop.

13th Row—Ch 6, tr c in center of scallop, ch 6, sl st between scallops, repeat from beginning all around ending row with d tr c instead of ch.

14th Row—Ch 7, 3 s c over next tr c, repeat from beginning all around.

15th Row—1 s c in each s c and 8 s c over each loop.

Next 5 Rows—1 s c in each s c.

Repeat 10th and 11th rows.

Next Row—Work 7 s c over each loop, join, and repeat 13th row.

Next Row—Ch 6, s c in next tr c, repeat across row.

Next Row—7 s c in each loop.

Next 5 Rows—1 s c in each s c.

No. 221 MATERIALS REQUIRED. 1 Ball American Thread Company "Star" Mercerized Crochet Cotton size 20 or 30, White, Ecru, Cream or Colors.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 10 or 11.

Ch 10, join to form a ring, ch 3, 19 d c in ring, join.

2nd Row—Ch 8, skip 1 d c, d c in next d c, \* ch 4, skip 1 d c, d c in next d c, repeat from \* all around, ch 4, join in 5th st of ch.

3rd Row—Ch 3, d c in same space, ch 3, 2 d c in same space, \* ch 1, 2 d c in next d c, ch 3, 2 d c in same d c, repeat from \* all around, ch 1, join.

4th Row—SI st into center of shell, ch 3, d c in same space, ch 3, 2 d c in same space, \* ch 3, 2 d c in same space, repeat from \* all around, ch 3, join.

5th Row—Sl st into shell, ch 3, shell in shell, \* ch 6, shell in next shell, repeat from \* all around, ch 6, join.

6th Row—SI st into shell, ch 6, d c in same space, \* ch 3, d c in same space, repeat from \* ch 1, \*\* s c over 6 ch loop, ch 1, d c in next shell, \* ch 3, d c in same shell, repeat from \* twice, ch 1 and repeat from \*\* all around.

8th Row—Sl st to center st of next group of s c, ch 3, d c in same space, \* ch 7, 2 d c over next ch, ch 7, 2 d c in center s c of next group of s c, repeat from \* all around.

9th Row—Ch 3 and work 9 d c over each loop.

10th Row—Ch 3, d c in same space, \* ch 5, skip 3 d c, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, ch 5, 2 d c between groups of d c, repeat from \* all around.

11th Row—Sl st to center of next ch, ch 10, d c in next ch, \* ch 7, d c in next ch, repeat from \* all around joining row in 3rd st of ch.


12th Row—Sl st to 3rd st of ch, ch 3, 2 d c over same ch, \* ch 7, 2 d c over next ch, ch 7, 3 d c over next ch, repeat from \* all around.

No. 222 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton or "Star" Crochet Cord.

14 300-yd. Balls, White or Ecru.

6 250-yd. Balls, Red or any Color desired.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

PATTERN. 1st Row—Ch 5, skip 2 sts, \* 1 d c in each of the next 3 sts, ch 2, skip 2 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 3 sts, ch 5, skip 5 sts,

1 d c in next st, ch 5, skip 5 sts and repeat from \* ending row with one open mesh.

2nd Row—1 open mesh, \* 3 d c, ch 2, 3 d c, ch 3, s c over 5 ch loop, ch 3, d c in d c, ch 3, s c over ch, ch 3, repeat from \* ending row with open mesh.

3rd Row—1 open mesh, \* 3 d c, ch 2, 3 d c, ch 5, d c in d c, ch 5, repeat from \* ending row with open mesh.

Repeat the last 2 rows for pattern.

LOWER SASH CURTAIN. Beginning work at top of one half. With Ecru ch 322, work 1st tr c in 7th st from hook and work 315 more d tr c on ch then work 1 more row of d tr c and 1 row of d c then work in pattern until curtain measures about 36 inches or length desired, work 1 row of d c and 1 row of open meshes. Work second half to correspond.

BEADING FOR ROD. Join thread in lower part of 1st row of tr c, ch 10, s c in top of 3rd row, ch 13, skip 10 sts at lower edge, s c in next st, ch 13, skip 10 sts at top, s c in next st, continue across curtain.

Upper sash curtain is made in 4 sections, 2 sections for each side.

With Red ch 135 for top edge, work a d tr c in 12th st from hook, \* ch 2, skip 2 sts, d tr c in next st, repeat from \* to end of ch (42 meshes).







No. 223 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton, 1 Ball each of Rust and Beige or any two colors desired.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7 or 8.

With Beige, ch 21 and work 20 s c on ch, ch 1, turn and work 1 more row.

3rd Row—10 s c in Beige, 10 s c in Rust, carry the one color under the second color.

4th Row—10 s c in Rust, 10 s c in Beige. Repeat the last 2 rows and work 2 rows in Rust.

9th Row-10 s c in Rust, 10 s c in Beige.

10th Row—10 s c in Beige, 10 s c in Rust. Repeat the last 2 rows and repeat from beginning until tie-back measures about 16 inches.

Finish edges with a row of shells, beginning at corner, 7 d c in corner, skip the length of shell, s c in next st, skip the length of a shell, 5 d c in next st and continue all around.

No. 224 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton.

1 Ball each of Rust and Beige or any two colors desired.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7 or 8.

With Rust, ch for about 18 inches and work 1 s c in each st until work measures 16 inches, cut off remaining ch.

2nd Row—S c in first s c, d c in next s c, repeat across row. To turn, ch l when row starts with s c and ch 2 when row starts with d c.

3rd Row—With Beige, s c in each d c and d c in each s c. Repeat 3rd row 11 times working 1 row in Rust, 1 row Beige, 4 rows Rust, 1 row Beige, 1 row Rust, 1 row Beige, 2 rows Rust, ch 3, turn, d c in same space, skip 2 sts, s c in next st, \* ch 3, d c in same space with s c, skip 2 sts, s c in next st, repeat from \* across long end, work 8 shells at short side and work other half to correspond.

"Star" Mercerized Crochet Cotton size 10 or "Star" Pearl Cotton size 5 may be used for these tie-backs.





## Tea Cloth

No. 225 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "Star" or "Gem" Mercerized Crochet Cotton, White, Ecru or Cream, size 30 or 50.

Each Motif measures about 31/4 inches.

Tea Cloth measuring 11 x 11 motifs, requires 7 400-yd. Balls.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 12 or 13.

Ch 7, join, ch 1, 10 s c into ring.

2nd Row—\* Ch 5, skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* 4 times.

3rd Row—Ch 1, 1 s c, 5 d c, 1 s c over each loop.

4th Row—Ch 8, s c in center of petal, \* ch 5, d c between next 2 petals, ch 5, s c in center of next petal, repeat from \* all around joining row in 3rd st of ch 8.

5th Row—Repeat 3rd row.

6th Row—Ch 7, s c in center of petal, ch 7, s c between petals, repeat from beginning all around.

7th Row—Sl st into next loop, ch 3, 5 d c over loop, \* s c into next loop, ch 5, s c into next loop, ch 4, sl st in 3rd st for picot, ch 4, sl st in 3rd st for picot, ch 1, s c into next loop, ch 5, s c into next loop, 6 d c in next loop, repeat from \* all around and join in ch 3 of petal.

8th Row—Ch 9, s c into last d c of petal, \* ch 7, s c in next loop, ch 7, s c in center of double picot loop, ch 7, s c in next loop, ch 7, s c in lst d c of next petal, repeat from beginning all around.


9th Row—SI st into loop, ch 3, 4 d c over loop, ch 5, 5 d c over same loop, ch 5, sl st into center st of next loop, \* ch 5, sl st in center st of next loop, ch 4, sl st into same st to form picot, repeat from \* once, ch 5, sl st into center st of next loop, ch 5, 5 d c over next loop, ch 5, 5 d c over same loop and continue all around, joining row in ch 3 of petal.

10th Row—Ch 7, s c in loop between petals, ch 7, s c in last d c of next petal, ch 7, skip 1 loop, s c in next loop, ch 7, s c between next 2 picots, ch 7, s c in next loop, ch 7, skip 1 loop, s c in 1st d c of petal and repeat from beginning all around.

11th Row—Sl st into loop, ch 3, 5 d c over loop, ch 5, 6 d c over next loop, \*\* ch 5, sl st in center st of next loop, \* ch 5, sl st in center st of next loop, ch 4, sl st in same st, repeat from \* once, ch 5, sl st in center st of next loop, ch 5, 6 d c over next loop, ch 5, 6 d c over next loop and repeat from \*\* all around, join in ch 3 of 1st petal.

12th Row—Double picot loop, 4 d c over ch, ch 9, sl st in 9th st from hook for picot, 4 d c over same loop, d p loop, s c in last d c of next petal, ch 7, skip 1 loop, s c in next loop, ch 7, s c in center of ch between next double picot loop, ch 7, s c in next loop, ch 7, s c in lst d c of petal and repeat from beginning all around.

SECOND MOTIF. Complete 11 rows and join in the last row as follows: Work double picot loop, 4 d c in corner, ch 4, sl st into corner loop of 1st Motif, ch 4, sl st in first st of ch, 4 d c in same space, double picot loop, s c in last d c of next petal, ch 3, s c into next loop of 1st Motif, ch 3, skip 1 loop, s c in next loop, ch 3, s c in next loop of 1st Motif, ch 3, s c between picots, ch 3, s c in next loop of 1st Motif, ch 3, skip 1 loop, s c in next loop of 1st Motif, ch 3, skip 1 loop, s c in next loop, ch 3, s c into next loop of 1st Motif, ch 3, s c in 1st d c of petal, d p loop, 4 d c in corner loop, ch 4, sl st in corner loop of 1st Motif, ch 4 and sl st in first st of ch and complete Motif. Join all Motifs in same manner.





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## Luncheon Set

No. 226 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "Star" or "Gem" Mercerized Crochet Cotton size 20 or 30, or any of the finer sizes in White, Ecru, Dark Cream or Colors.

9 Medium or 5 Large Balls size 30.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 11 or 12.

LARGE DOILY. Ch 23, join to form a ring, ch 5, 32 tr c into ring with ch 1 between each tr c.

2nd Row—Ch 8, 1 tr c in each ch 1 with ch 3 between each tr c.

3rd Row—Sl st to center of ch and work same as 2nd row having ch 5 between each tr c.

4th Row—Same as 3rd row having ch 7 between each tr c.

5th Row—Same as 4th row, having ch 9 be tween each tr c.

6th Row—Sl st to 2nd st of ch, ch 4, skip 1 st, d c in next st, \* ch 1, skip one st, d c in next st repeat from \* once, \*\* ch 1, skip the last st of ch and the first st of next ch, d c in next st, \* ch 1, skip one st, d c in next st, repeat from \* twice then repeat from \*\* all around, ch 1, join in 3rd st of ch 4.

7th Row—Ch 4, d c in next mesh, \* ch 1, d c in next mesh, repeat from \* 10 times, \*\* ch 3, d c in next mesh, \* ch 1, d c in next mesh, repeat from \* 11 times and repeat from \*\* all around.

8th Row—Ch 4, d c in next mesh, ch 1, d c in next mesh, repeat from \* 11 times, \*\* ch 3, d c in same space, \* ch 1, d c in next mesh, repeat from \* 12 times and repeat from \*\* all around.

Work 13 more rows of meshes working d c with ch 3 between in each 3 ch mesh thus increasing a mesh in each section each row. Work 4 rows even.

EDGE. 1st Row—\* Work 9 s c over next 4 meshes, ch 7, skip 4 meshes, 3 d c, ch 2, 3 d c

in next mesh, ch 7, skip 4 meshes, and repeat from \* all around.

2nd Row—1 s c in each of the center 7 s c, ch 8, 3 d c, ch 2, 3 d c in center of shell, ch 8 and repeat from beginning all around.

3rd Row—1 s c in each of the center 5 s c. ch 9, shell in center of shell, ch 9 and repeat from beginning all around.

4th Row—1 s c in each of the center 3 s c, ch 10, 12 d c in center of shell, ch 10 and repeat from beginning all around.

5th Row—1 s c in center s c, ch 11, 1 d c in 2nd d c of shell, \* ch 2, skip 1 d c, d c in next d c, repeat from \* 4 times (5 open meshes). Ch 11 and repeat from beginning all around, ending row with s c.

6th Row—SI st to 6th ch, work a 5 d c cluster st in remaining 5 ch, \* ch 4 and work a 5 d c cluster st with ch 4 between in each mesh and 1 cluster st over next ch 11, ch 6, work a cluster st over next ch 11, and repeat from \* all around ending row with a cluster st over ch 11, ch 6, join in 1st cluster st made.

7th Row—2 s c, ch 4, 2 s c in each 4 ch loop and 4 s c, ch 4, 4 s c over each 6 ch loop.

SMALL DOILY. 1st Row—Ch 20, join to form a ring, ch 5 and work 26 tr c into ring with ch 1 between each tr c.

2nd, 3rd and 4th Rows—Same as 2nd, 3rd and 4th rows of large doily.

5th Row—Ch 5, skip 1 st of ch, d c in next st, \* ch 1, skip 1 st, d c in next st, repeat from \*, ch 1, d c in tr c, continue all around having 4 meshes between each tr c.

6th Row—Same as 7th row of large doily.

7th Row—Same as 8th row of large doily.

Work 7 more rows of meshes same as 7th row then work 2 rows even and finish with edge same as large doily.

This set will be equally attractive made with "Gem" Mercerized Crochet Cotton size 20 or any of the finer sizes if desired.



No. 227 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "Star" or "Gem" Mercerized Crochet Cotton, White, Ecru, Dark Cream or Colors, size 30 or 50.

3 400-yd. Balls will make a scarf measuring 5 x 12 Motifs.

Each Motif measures about 3 inches from point to point.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 11 or 12.

### Scarf

Ch 8, join, ch 5, tr c into ring, \* ch 2, tr c into r, repeat from \* 9 times, ch 2, sl st into 3rd st of ch to join. (12 meshes).

2nd Row—Ch 1, 3 s c in each mesh, join.

3rd Row—Ch 1, s c in each s c taking up back loop of st only, join.

4th Row—Ch 4, d c in next s c, taking up back loop of st only, \* ch 1, d c in next s c taking up back loop of st only, repeat from \* all around, join in 3rd st of ch.

5th Row—Ch 1, 2 s c in each mesh. 72 s c, join.

6th Row—Ch 4, 1 tr c in each of the next 4 s c, \* ch 7, skip 1 s c, 1 tr c in each of the next 5 s c, repeat from \* 10 times, ch 7, join.

7th Row—Ch 1, 1 s c in each tr c and 4 s c, ch 4, 4 s c in each loop, join.


8th Row—Sl st to center s c, ch 1, s c in same space, \* ch 7, d c in next picot, ch 3, d c in same picot, ch 7, s c in center s c, repeat from \* all around.

2nd Row—Ch 4, 1 d c in same space, ch 3, 2 d c in same space, 2 d c, ch 3, 2 d c in next 3 ch space, repeat twice, join and break thread.



#### CHAIR SET

No. 228 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "Star" or "Gem" Mercerized Crochet Cotton size 20, White, Ecru, Dark Cream, or Dark Linen.

3 Large Balls or 7 Medium Balls.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 10 or 11.

MOTIF. Ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 8, 1 d c in ring, \* ch 5, 1 d c in ring, repeat from \* 5 times, ch 3, d c in 3rd st of ch 8.

2nd Row—\* Ch 9, tr c in next loop, ch 9, s c in next loop, repeat from \* twice, ch 9, tr c in next loop, ch 9, join to beginning of 1st ch 9.

3rd Row—Work 11 s c over 9 ch loop, \* ch 4, s c over tr c for picot, 11 s c over next loop, 6 s c over next loop, ch 10, turn, sl st in center of previous loop, turn, 4 s c over 10 ch loop, work a 4 ch picot, 4 s c over same loop, 4 ch picot, 4 s c over loop, 5 s c over last half of 9 ch loop, repeat from \* twice, 4 ch picot, 11 s c over next loop, sl st

to 6th s c of first 9 ch loop, ch 10, turn, sl st in center of previous loop, turn, 4 s c over 10 ch loop, 4 ch picot, 4 s c over same loop, 4 ch picot, 4 s c over same loop.

4th Row—SI st to picot over tr c, ch 10, \* d c in next picot, ch 5, tr c in corner picot, ch 5, tr c in same picot, ch 5, d c in next picot, ch 5, tr c in next picot, ch 5, repeat from \* 3 times ending with ch 4 and joining to 4th st of ch 10.

5th Row—Ch 4, \* skip one st, d c in ch, ch 1, skip one st, d c in ch, ch 1, repeat from \* in all 5 ch spaces working 2 d c with ch 5 between in each corner st and finish row by joining to 3rd st of ch 4. (There should be 15 meshes between corners.)

Work 54 more Motifs.

Sew Motifs together. For arm rests use 3 rows of 4 Motifs.

For the back have 4 rows of 7 Motifs and 1 row of 3 Motifs.

EDGE. 5 s c, 5 ch picot, repeat from beginning all around.



#### GIANT MESH CHAIR SET

No. 229 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "Trojan" or "Puritan" Crochet Cotton, White, Ecru, Cream or Beige.

1 500-yd. Ball will make the entire set.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7 or 8.

Giant Mesh is made in tr c, 5 tr c are required for each single solid mesh and 4 tr c for each additional solid mesh.

For an open mesh—Ch 3, skip 3 sts and tr c in next st.

The stitch in center of the flower designs are worked in cross trebles as follows; thread over hook twice, insert in same space with last st and work off two loops, thread over twice, skip 3 sts, insert hook in next st and work off all loops 2 at a time, ch 3, d c in center of cross treble, this completes one cross treble st.

To decrease a mesh—\* Work to within the last 2 meshes, thread over 3 times, insert in the tr c which completes the next mesh and work off all loops 2 at a time, this brings the thread

in right position for the decrease in next row, ch 7, turn and work a mesh and repeat from \*.







3rd Row—1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, \* ch 1, skip 1 d c, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, repeat from \* ch 9, repeat from beginning across row, ch 4, turn.

4th Row—1 open mesh \* 1 solid mesh, 1 o m, 1 s m, 1 o m, 1 s m, ch 5, s c over center of 2—9 ch loops, ch 5, repeat from \* across row, ch 4, turn.

5th Row—1 d c in each of the next 11 sts, ch 9, repeat from beginning across row, ch 4, turn.

6th Row—D c in 1st d c, ch 9 skip 9 d c, d c in next d c, \* 9 d c in mesh, d c in each of the next 11 d c and repeat from \* 3 times, 9 d c in mesh, d c in d c, ch 9, skip 9 d c, d c in next d c, ch 1, d c in 3rd st of ch, ch 4, turn.

7th Row—D c in d c, ch 9, d c in each of the d c across row, ch 9, d c in d c, 1 o m, ch 4, turn.

8th Row—Ch 5, s c over the 2—9 ch loops, ch 5, d c in each of the next 5 d c, \* ch 1, skip 1 d c, d c in each of the next 3 d c and repeat from \* 19 times, ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 d c in each of the next 5 d c, ch 5, s c over 2—9 ch loops, ch 5, d c in d c, 1 o m, ch 4, turn.

9th Row—D c in d c, ch 9, 1 d c in each of the 1st 5 d c, d c in mesh, d c in next d c, ch 1 \* skip 1 d c, d c in next 3 sts, ch 1 and repeat from \* 18 times, ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 d c in each of the next 7 sts, ch 9, d c in next d c, 1 o m, ch 4, turn.

10th Row—D c in d c, 9 d c in mesh, 1 d c in each of the next 5 d c, \* ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, repeat from \* 19 times, ch 1, 1 d c in each of the next 5 d c, 9 d c in mesh, d c in d c, 1 o m, ch 4, turn.

11th Row—1 d c in each of the 1st 3 d c, ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, ch 1,



Work rather loosely. With White, ch 10, join to form a ring, ch 5, d c into ring, \* ch 2, d c in ring, repeat from \* until there are 16 d c in ring, ch 2, join.

2nd Row—Ch 5, d c in first mesh, ch 2, 2 d c with ch 2 between in same mesh, \* ch 2, d c in next mesh. ch 2, 4 d c with ch 2 between in next mesh, repeat from \* all around.

3rd Row—Sl st to center of shell, ch 5, d c in center mesh, ch 2, 2 d c with ch 2 between in same mesh, \* ch 2, skip 1 mesh, d c in next mesh, ch 2, d c in next mesh, ch 2, skip 1 mesh, 4 d c with ch 2 between in center of shell, repeat from \* all around.

4th Row—Same as 3rd row increasing 1 d c between shells. Repeat 4th row working 2 more rows in White, 1 row in Iridescent, 3 rows White, 1 row Iridescent, 3 rows White, 3 rows Iridescent.

Last Row—With Iridescent 2 s c, picot, 2 s c in center of shell, 2 s c in next mesh, 1 s c, picot, 1 s c in next mesh \* 2 s c in each of the next 4 meshes, picot, repeat from \* twice, 2 s c in each of the next 3 meshes, 1 s c, picot, 1 s c in next mesh, 2 s c in next mesh, and repeat from beginning all around.

RING. Wrap thread around finger 15 times and work 24 s c over ring, attach to center of cloth. Any of the following threads may be used for the main part of the Face Cloth—"Puritan" or "Trojan" Crochet Cotton or "Clover" Crochet and Knitting Cotton.



No. 231 MATERIALS REQUIRED. 1 Ball each American Thread Company "De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton or "Star" Crochet Cord, White or Ecru and "Star" Pearl Cotton size 5, Iridescent shade or any color desired. Steel Crochet Hook No. 8.

#### CARNATION DISH CLOTH

No. 232 MATERIALS REQUIRED. American Thread Company "Clover" Knitting and Crochet Cotton, White or Ecru. 1 800-yd. Ball.

"De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton, Red or any color desired.





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Next Row—11 s c, \* ch 7, skip 4 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 11 s c, repeat from \* all around, ending last loop in 2nd s c of 1st group of s c. Work 8 more s c, ch 6, sl st into center of loop, ch 6, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 9 s c, continue all around and work 4 more rows decreasing 1 s c each side of solid section and increasing 1 mesh each side of open section of scallop.

st, s c in next st, skip the s c of scallop and repeat from beginning all around.

The reverse side is made in d c as follows:

With Color, ch 4, 10 d c in first st of ch, join each row.

2nd Row—Ch 3, 2 d c in each d c.

3rd Row-2 d c in every other d c, break thread.

4th Row—Attach White and increase in every 3rd st.

5th and 6th Rows—Increase in every 4th st.

7th Row—Increase in every 5th st, break thread.

8th Row—With Color repeat last row, break thread.

9th and 10th Row—With White increase in every 6th st and work 1 row even. Without breaking thread ch 20, skip 1 st, sl st in next st. ch 1 and work 35 s c over ch. Sew the two sections together with White.

The pot holder will be equally attractive made of "De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton.

10th Row—Ch 3, 1 d c in same st, ch 1, 2 d c in same space, \* skip 2 sts, s c in next st, skip 2 sts, 2 d c in next st, ch 1, 2 d c in same st, repeat from \* to end of row, break thread.

11th Row—With White work a shell between shells and s c in center of shell.

12th Row—Work a shell of 3 d c, ch 1, 3 d c between shells and s c in center of shell, break thread.

13th Row—With color work 1 d c in each d c and s c and 2 d c in center of each shell ending with 2 d c in center of shell (60 d c).

14th Row—With color 4 d c, with White, 4 d c carrying the color under White sts, with color 4 d c carrying the White under color sts, continue across row ending with 4 d c in color and repeat row. In changing color always pick up other color when working off last 2 loops of d c.

15th Row—Increase 1 d c each group of d c in color and work 1 row even. Continue work

increasing 1 st in groups of color every other row until there are 9 sts in groups of color and work 1 row even, break thread. Work other side reversing colors. With color crochet the 2 pieces together with a row of s c across the two sides.

Across upper edge work \* 4 d c in same space, skip 2 sts, s c in next st, skip 2 sts and repeat from \* across row. Make a ring by winding thread around finger 8 times and working over threads in s c.

"Puritan" or "Trojan" Crochet Cotton may be used for the White in the Pot Holders or "Star" Pearl Cotton White or Colors.

Next Row—Same as previous row, taking up the back loop of st only and working 2 d c, ch 3, 2 d c in each corner.

Next Row—1 s d c in each d c and 2 s d c, ch 3, 2 s d c in each corner, break thread. Work another section the same and 2 sections having Red centers with Maize around the edge, sew squares together as illustrated.

Work other side to correspond.

RING. Wind thread around finger 15 times and work 25 s c over ring, join to corner of pot holder and crochet the 2 sections together with a row of s c.

17th Row—S c in center s c, ch 3 and d c in each tr c with ch 3 between, ch 3 and repeat from beginning all around.

18th Row—Sl st to 1st d c, \* ch 4, d c in 4th st from hook, sl st in next d c, repeat from \* all around.

TIE-BACKS. Ch 23, d c in 8th st from hook, \* ch 1, skip 1 st, d c in next st, ch 2, skip 2 sts, d c in next st, repeat from \* twice. Ch 5, turn.

2nd Row—D c in d c, d c in mesh, d c in d c, ch 2, d c in next d c, d c in mesh, d c in d c, ch 2, d c in next d c, d c in mesh, d c in d c, ch 2 d c in center of ch. Repeat the last row until tieback measures about 16 inches and finish with edge same as curtain.

Finish all edges of the set with a row of s c working 4 s c in each mesh and 8 s c in corners. This set will be equally attractive made of any of the following threads; "De Luxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton, "Star" Pearl Cotton size 5, "Clover" Knitting and Crochet Cotton, or "Star" Crochet Cord.

skip 1 st, 1 d c in each of the next 95 sts, ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, 1 o m, ch 4, turn.

12th Row—Same as 11th row.

13th Row—1 d c in each of the 1st 15 sts, ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c and continue in pattern same as the 10th row, ch 4, turn.

14th Row—D c in d c, ch 9, skip 9 sts, d c in each of the next 7 sts, ch 1, skip 1 st, d c in each of the next 3 sts and follow pattern of 9th row ch 4, turn.

15th Row—D c in d c, ch 9, 1 d c in each of the 1st 5 d c, ch 1, skip 1 st, d c in each of the next 3 sts and follow pattern of 8th row.

16th Row—D c in d c ch 5, s c over 2—9 ch loops, ch 5, 1 d c in each st across solid part of row, ch 5, s c over 2—9 ch loops, ch 5, d c in d c, 1 o m, ch 4, turn.

17th Row—D c in d c, ch 9, 1 d c in each d c across solid part of row, ch 9, d c in d c, 1 o m, ch 4, turn.

18th Row—D c in d c, 9 d c over ch, d c in next d c, \* ch 9, skip 9 d c, 1 d c in each of the next 11 d c, repeat from \* 3 times, ch 9, d c in last d c, 9 d c in ch, d c in d c, 1 o m, ch 4, turn.

19th Row—Same as 3rd row.

20th Row—D c in each of the 1st 3 d c, \* ch 1, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, repeat from \* ch 5, s c over 2—9 ch loops, ch 5, and repeat from beginning across row.

21st Row—D c in first 11 sts, ch 9, d c in next 11 sts and continue across row. Ch 4, turn.

22nd Row—D c in d c, \* ch 1, skip 1 st, d c in next st and repeat from \* across row.

EDGE. Fasten thread in corner of short side, ch 4, d c in same mesh, \* ch 1, d c in same mesh and repeat from \* 4 times, ch 1, s c in next mesh, \* ch 1, skip 1 mesh, 4 d c with 1 ch between in next mesh, ch 1, skip 1 mesh, s c in next mesh and repeat from \* 4 times, ch 1, 7 d c with ch 1 between at corner, \* ch 1, skip 1 mesh, s c in next mesh, ch 1, skip 1 mesh, 4 d c with 1 ch between in next mesh and repeat from \* across long side.

CHAIR BACK. Work first 21 rows same as 21 rows of Arm Rests.

22nd Row—D c in 1st d c, ch 9, d c in last d c, 9 d c over ch, and repeat from beginning to end of row, ch 4, turn.

23rd Row—D c in d c, \*\* ch 9, 1 d c in each of the 1st 3 d c, \* ch 1, skip 1 d c, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, repeat from \* and repeat from \*\* to end of row, ch 4, turn.

24th Row—D c in d c, \*\* ch 5, s c over 2—9 ch loops, ch 5, d c in each of the first 3 d c, \* ch 1, d c in each of the next 3 d c, repeat from \* and repeat from \*\* across row, ch 4, turn.

25th Row—D c in d c, \* ch 9, 1 d c in each of the next 11 sts, repeat from \* across row.

26th Row—D c in d c, \* 9 d c over ch, d c in 1st d c, ch 9, d c in last d c and repeat from \* to end of row, ch 4, turn.

Repeat from the 3rd to 26th rows inclusive, then repeat from the 3rd to 21st rows, work 1 row of open meshes and finish with edge same as Arm Rests.



2nd Row—Ch 7, tr c in first space, ch 2, tr c in same space, ch 2, tr c in same space, ch 2, 3 tr c with ch 2 between in next space, continue all around and work 1 more row in Red.

With Ecru work 3 rows same as 2nd row.

EDGE. With Red, 1 s c in tr c, 1 s c in space. 1 s c in tr c and continue all around.

#### Simple Crochet Stitches



No. 1—Chain Stitch (CH.) Form a loop on thread insert hook on loop and pull thread through tightening threads. Thread over hook and pull through last chain made. Continue chains for length desired.

No. 2—Slip Stitch (SL ST) Make a chain the desired length. Skip one chain, \* insert hook in next chain, thread over hook and pull through stitch and loop on hook. Repeat from \*. This stitch is used in joining and whenever an invisible stitch is required.

No. 3—Single Crochet (S C) Chain for desired length, skip 1 ch, \* insert hook in next ch, thread over hook and pull through ch. There are now 2 loops on hook, thread over hook and pull through both loops, repeat from \*. For succeeding rows of s c, ch 1, turn insert hook in top of next st taking up both threads and continue same as first row.

No. 4—Short Double Crochet (S D C) Ch for desired length thread over hook, insert hook in 3rd st from hook, draw thread through (3 loops on hook), thread over and draw through all three loops on hook. For succeeding rows, ch 2, turn.


No. 5—Double Crochet (D C) Ch for desired length, thread over hook, insert hook in 4th st from hook, draw thread through (3 loops on hook) thread over hook and pull through 2 loops thread over hook and pull through 2 loops. Succeeding rows, ch 3, turn and work next d c in 2nd d c of previous row. The ch 3 counts as 1 d c.

No. 6—Treble Crochet (TR C) Ch for desired length, thread over hook twice insert hook in 5th ch from hook draw thread through (4 loops on hook) thread over hook pull through 2 loops thread over, pull through 2 loops, thread over, pull through 2 loops. For succeeding rows ch 4, turn and work next tr c in 2nd tr c of previous row. The ch 4 counts as 1 tr c.

No. 7—Double Treble Crochet (D TR C) Ch for desired length thread over hook 3 times insert in 6th ch from hook (5 loops on hook) and work off 2 loops at a time same as tr c. For succeeding rows ch 5 turn and work next d tr c in 2nd d tr c of previous row. The ch 5 counts as 1 d tr c.

No. 8—Rib Stitch Work this same as single crochet but insert hook in back loop of stitch only. This is sometimes called the slipper stitch.

No. 9—Picot (P) There are two methods of working the picot. (A) Work a single crochet in the foundation, ch 3 or 4 sts depending on the length of picot desired, sl st in top of s c made. (B) Work an s c, ch 3 or 4 for picot and s c in same space. Work as many single crochets between picots as desired.



No. 10—Open or Filet Mesh (O M) When worked on a chain work the first d c in 8th ch from hook \* ch 2, skip 2 sts, 1 d c in next st, repeat from \*. Succeeding rows ch 5 to turn, d c in d c, ch 2, d c in next d c, repeat from \*.

No. 11—Block or Solid Mesh (S M) Four double crochets form 1 solid mesh and 3 d c are required for each additional solid mesh. Open mesh and solid mesh are used in Filet Crochet.

No. 12—Slanting Shell St. Ch for desired length, work 2 d c in 4th st from hook, skip 3 sts, sl st in next st, \* ch 3, 2 d c in same st with sl st, skip 3 sts, sl st in next st. Repeat from \*. 2nd Row. Ch 3, turn 2 d c in sl st, sl st in 3 ch loop of shell in previous row, \* ch 3, 2 d c in same space, sl st in next shell, repeat from \*.

No. 13—Bean or Pop Corn Stitch. Work 3 d c in same space, drop loop from hook insert hook in first d c made and draw loop through, ch 1 to tighten st.

No. 14—Cross Treble Crochet. Ch for desired length, thread over twice, insert in 5th st from hook, \* work off

two loops, thread over, skip 2 sts, insert in next st and work off all loops on needle 2 at a time, ch 2, d c in center to complete cross. Thread over twice, insert in next st and repeat from \*.

No. 15—Cluster Stitch. Work 3 or 4 tr c in same st always retaining the last loop of each tr c on needle, thread over and pull through all loops on needle.


No. 16—Lacet St. Ch for desired length, work 1 s c in 10th st from hook, Ch 3 skip 2 sts, 1 d c in next st, \* ch 3, skip 2 sts, 1 s c in next st, ch 3, skip 2 sts 1 d c in next st, repeat from \* to end of row, 2nd row, d c in d c, ch 5 d c in next d c.

No. 17—Knot Stitch (Sometimes Called Lovers Knot St.) Ch for desired length, \* draw a ¼ inch loop on hook, thread over and pull through ch, s c in single loop of st, draw another ¼ inch loop, s c into loop, skip 4 sts, s c in next st, repeat from \*. To turn make 3/8" knots, \* s c in loop at right of s c and s c in loop at left of s c of previous row, 2 knot sts and repeat from \*.
