## CHILD'S ROBE

Materials Required:

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY

"DAWN" NYLON or

"DAWN" NYLON POMPADOUR

7 ounces each White and Lt. Blue or colors of your choice and

"STAR" MERCERIZED SEWING THREAD

1 spool matching color

Plastic crochet hook size F OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN STITCH GAUGE BELOW

6 buttons

3 yds.  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch Ribbon

$1\frac{1}{4}$  yds.  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch Ribbon

$\frac{1}{4}$  yd. Material for Lining

**GAUGE:** 3 shells = 1 inch, 6 rows = 1 inch

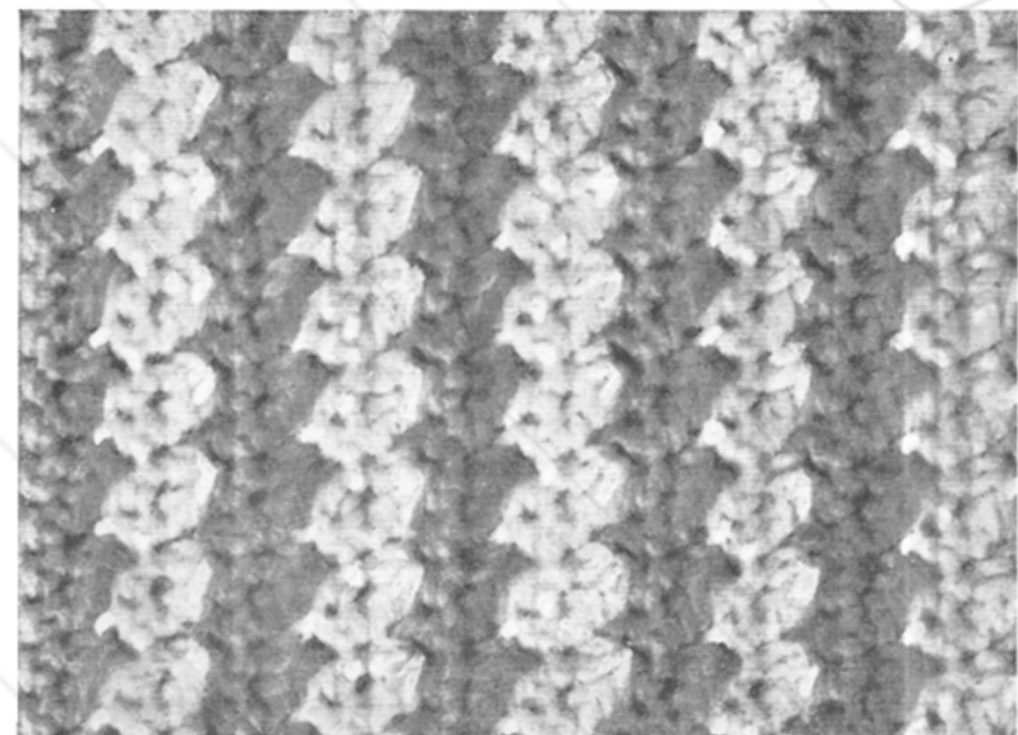
**BACK YOKE:** With Lt. Blue chain (ch) 60, single crochet (sc) in 2nd stitch (st) from hook, double crochet (dc) in same space, \* skip next st of ch, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st (shell), repeat from \* across ch to within last 2 sts, skip next st, sc in next st, ch 1, turn (right side of work). 2nd ROW: 1 sc in each st, drop Lt. Blue attach White (when changing color always complete last half of last st worked with next color), ch 1, to turn all rows. 3rd ROW: 1 sc, 1 dc in 1st sc, \* skip next sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, repeat from \* across row to within last 2 sts, skip next sc, sc in next sc. 4th ROW: Sc in each st, drop White, pick up Lt. Blue. (These 4 rows form the stripes and the colors will always be changed in same manner, this will not be referred to again). Repeat the last 2 rows 8 times alternating color of stripes. 21st ROW: With Lt. Blue slip stitch (sl st) across the 1st 4 sc, \* 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, skip next sc, repeat from \* 7 times, sc in next sc, ch 1, turn. 22nd ROW: 1 sc in each of the 1st 11 sts, ch 1, turn, cut Lt. Blue. 23rd ROW: With White sl st across the 1st 4 sc, \* 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, skip next sc, repeat from \* twice, sc in next sc. 24th ROW: 1 sc in each of the 1st 3 sts, sl st in next st, cut White. With wrong side of 20th row toward you attach Lt. Blue in 16th free st, 1 sc, 1 dc in same space, \* skip next sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, repeat from \* 6 times, skip next sc, sc in next sc, sl st in each of the last 4 sc. NEXT ROW: Sl st across the 4 sl sts and next 6 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 11 sts, cut Lt. Blue. NEXT ROW: Attach White, 1 sc,



1 dc in 1st sc, \* skip next sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, repeat from \* once, skip next sc, sl st in next sc, ch 1, turn. NEXT ROW: Skip the sl st, sl st in each of the next 3 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 3 sts, cut White.

**RIGHT FRONT YOKE:** With Lt. Blue ch 32, work 1st row same as Back Yoke. 2nd ROW: 1 sc in each of the next 25 sts, ch 2, skip next 2 sts (buttonhole), 1 sc in each of the next 4 sts, drop Lt. Blue. Repeat the 3rd and 4th rows of Back Yoke 4 times alternating color of stripes. 11th ROW: With White repeat the 3rd row. 12th ROW: Repeat the 2nd row, do not drop White at end of row. 13th ROW: Sl st in each of the 1st 2 sts, drop White, with Lt. Blue \* 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, skip next sc, repeat from \* across row ending with sc in last sc. 14th ROW: 1 sc in each of the 1st 26 sc, sl st in next st, do not drop Lt. Blue, ch 1, turn. 15th ROW: Skip the sl st, sl st in next st, drop Lt. Blue, with White \* 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, skip next sc, repeat from \* across row ending with sc in last sc. 16th

# the reversible knitted sacque with turn-back hood.



## KNITTED REVERSIBLE

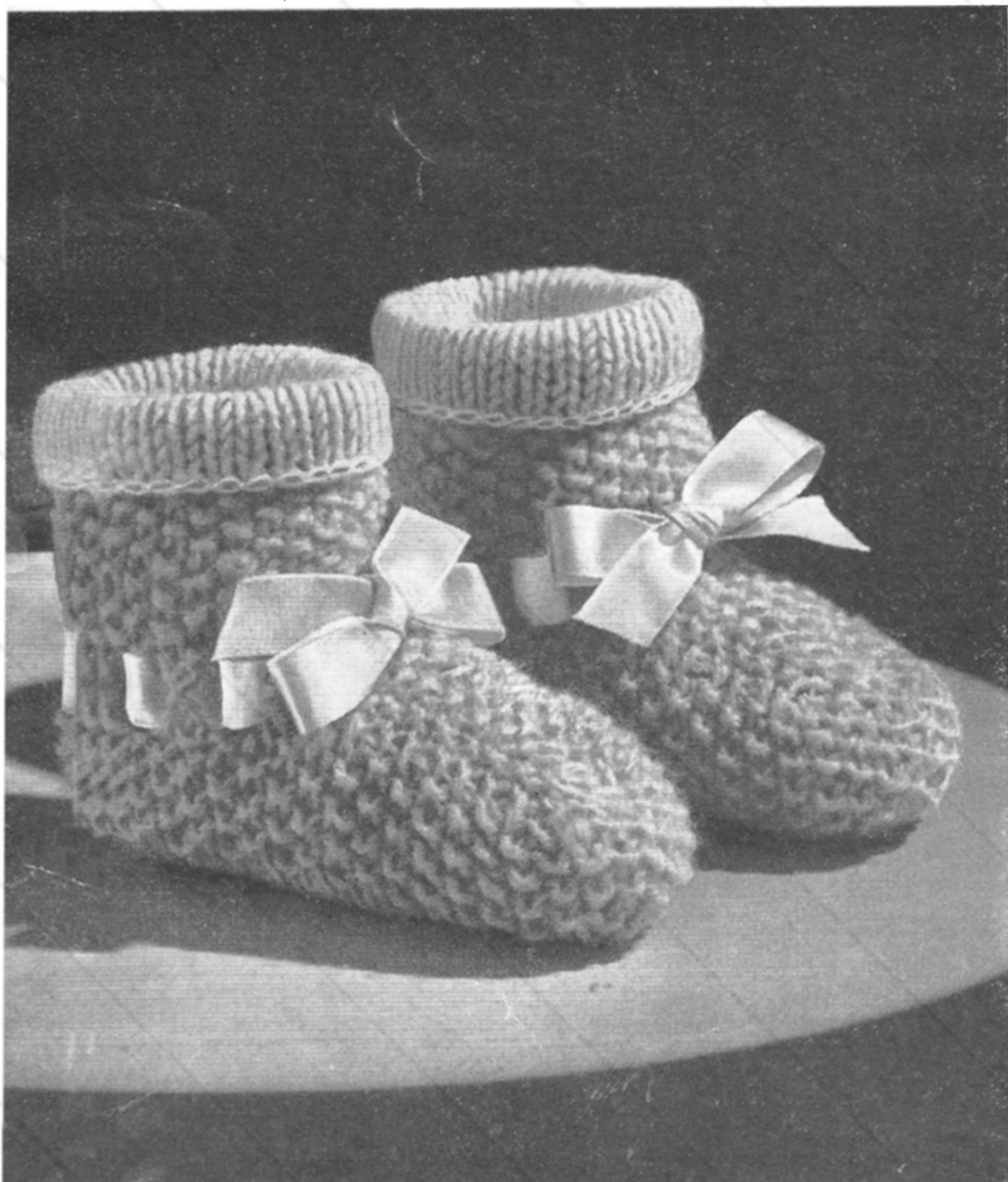
Materials Required:  
AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
"DAWN" WOOL AND NYLON FINGERING  
YARN or  
"DAWN" BABY YARN  
4 ounces Baby Green  
5 ounces White or colors of your choice  
2 yds. 1/2 inch Satin Ribbon  
1 1/2 yds. 2 inch Ribbon  
1 pair Knitting Needles No. 8 OR ANY SIZE  
NEEDLES WHICH WILL RESULT IN  
STITCH GAUGE BELOW

**GAUGE:** 5 sts = 1 inch, 9 rows = 1 inch

This set is worked in two sections and is reversible.

### SACQUE

With Baby Green starting at Left Front cast on 63 stitches (sts). 1st ROW: Purl (P) 16 for yoke, then \* Knit (K) 1, P 1, repeat from \* across row ending with K 1. 2nd ROW: K the P st and P the K st for seed st pattern over next 47 sts, then K 16 sts for yoke. 3rd ROW: Same as 1st row. 4th ROW: Work 47 sts in seed st pattern, turn leaving the 16 sts of yoke on left hand needle. 5th ROW: Slip (sl) 1st st, work in seed st pattern to end of row. 6th ROW: Work 47 sts in seed st, then K 13 sts of yoke, turn leaving remaining 3 sts on left hand needle. 7th ROW: Sl 1, P 12, then work in seed st to end of row. Repeat last 6 rows for pattern until seed st section measures 6 inches ending at lower edge. Bind off 41 sts, cast on 38 sts for Left Sleeve, K 8 for cuff, then work in pattern across row. Continue in pattern as established working 8 cuff sts in stockinette st throughout sleeve omitting the 8 cuff sts every 3rd and 4th row until Sleeve measures 7 inches ending at cuff edge. Bind off 38 sts, cast on 41 sts for Back. Work in pattern until Back measures



10½ inches ending at lower edge. Bind off 41 sts, cast on 38 sts for Right Sleeve and complete Sacque to correspond.

**HOOD:** With right side of work facing, pick up 72 sts across neck edge.

**BEADING:** P 1, \* yarn over (yo), P 2 together (tog), repeat from \* across row ending with yo, P 1.

**NEXT ROW:** \* K 1, P 1, repeat from \* across row ending with K 1 (73 sts). Work in seed st pattern until Hood measures 4 inches from Beading, bind off 23 sts, work across next 26 sts, bind off remaining 23 sts, cut yarn. Work in seed st pattern over the 27 center sts for 4½ inches, bind off. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew center section of Hood to sides.

**LINING:** With White cast on 63 sts. Starting with a P row work 10 rows even in stockinette st (P 1 row, K 1 row) for border. Work in same manner as Sacque but work the entire lining in stockinette st, then work 10 rows even to correspond to beginning of lining for other border. Work Hood in same manner as Sacque but do not bind off the 27 center sts, place these sts on holder. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew center section of Hood to sides. With right side of Hood toward you pick up 20 sts on each side and slip the 27 center sts from holder on needle, then work 10 rows in stockinette st, bind off.

**FINISHING:** Place lining inside Sacque. With wrong side facing, turn the 1st and last 10 rows to outside of each front for border and stitch in place. Finish with large ribbon tie at neck. Lace narrow ribbon through both thicknesses of beading at neck.

### BOOTIES

With Baby Green cast on 30 sts and work 15 rows in seed st pattern. Beading. 16th ROW: P 1, \* yo, P 2 tog, repeat from \* across row ending with yo, P 1. 17th ROW: Starting with a P st work 31 sts in seed st. 18th ROW: Continuing in seed st work across 11 sts, place these sts on a holder, work across next 9 sts for instep, place remaining sts on another holder. Work across the 9 instep sts for 19 rows, cut yarn. Sl sts on needle from 1st holder, attach yarn and pick up 10 sts on side of instep, work across the instep sts, pick up 10 sts on other side of instep, sl sts from 2nd holder on needle (51 sts). Work 9 rows even in seed st pattern.

**SOLE:** 1st ROW: Sl 1, K 1, pass sl st over K st, (p.s.s.o.) K 20, K 2 tog, K 3, sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., K 20, K 2 tog. 2nd ROW: Decreasing 1 st at beginning and end of row P across row. 3rd ROW: Sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., K 17, K 2 tog, K 3, sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., K 17, K 2 tog. 4th ROW: Same as 2nd row. 5th ROW: Sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., K 14, K 2 tog, K 1, K 2 tog, sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., K 14, K 2 tog (34 sts) cut yarn leaving a 20 inch length for weaving. Thread yarn into blunt needle and weave sole tog as follows: with 17 sts on each needle, \* pass blunt needle through 1st st of front needle as if knitting and sl st off needle, pass into 2nd st as if purling and leave st



on needle, pass through 1st st of back needle and sl st off needle, pass through 2nd st as if knitting and leave st on needle, repeat from \* until all sts are worked off. Sew seam together.

**LINING:** With White cast on 30 sts. Starting with a P row work 6 rows in stockinette st for trim, then work lining same as bootie but working the entire lining in stockinette st.

**FINISHING:** Insert lining in booties and finish in same manner as Sacque. Lace ribbon through both thicknesses of beading.

### MITTENS

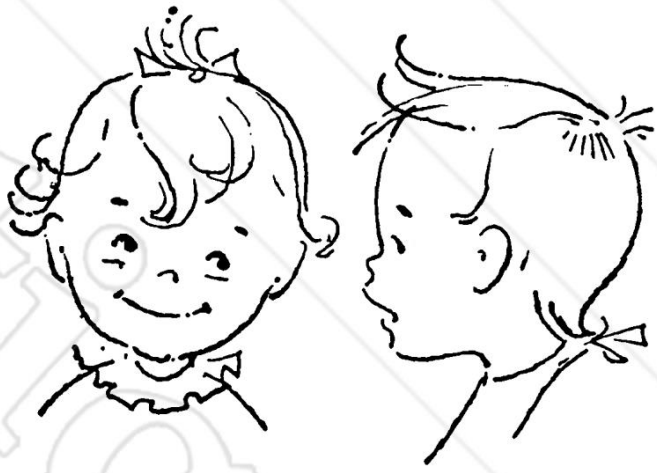
With Baby Green cast on 33 sts and work 7 rows in seed st pattern. 8th ROW: Beading. K 1, \* yo, P 2 tog, repeat from \* across row ending last repeat with P 1, K 1 (34 sts). Continuing in seed st pattern work even until Mitten measures 3 inches from beginning, then decrease for top of Mitten as follows: place a marker in center of row, then sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., work to within 2 sts from center, K 2 tog, sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., complete row decreasing 1 st at end of row. Work 3 rows even. Repeat last 4 rows twice, then repeat decreasing row once. Cut yarn leaving an end. Thread yarn into blunt needle and draw sts together. Sew side seam.

**LINING:** With White cast on 33 sts. Starting with a P row, work 6 rows in stockinette st for trim, then work lining same as Mitten but work lining in stockinette st.

**FINISHING:** Insert lining in Mitten and finish in same manner as Sacque. Lace ribbon through both thicknesses of beading.

# bulky sweater set





### BULKY SLIPON

Materials Required:

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY

“DAWN” WOOL and NYLON BULKY YARN or

“DAWN” BULKY YARN

10 ounces White or color of your choice

1 pr. Knitting Needles No. 7 and No. 10½ OR ANY  
SIZE NEEDLE WHICH WILL RESULT IN  
STITCH GAUGE BELOW

1 pr. double-pointed Needles No. 7

**GAUGE:** For No. 10½ needles

4 sts = 1 inch, 6 rows = 1 inch

Work Back and Front same as back of Cardigan  
on this page. Work Sleeves same as Sleeves of Cardigan.  
Block each section. Sew underarm and sleeve  
seams. Sew sleeves in position.

**NECK BAND:** Slip sts from stitch holders onto double  
pointed needles and work in ribbing of K 1, P 1 for  
1 inch. Bind off in ribbing.

### BULKY CARDIGAN

Materials Required:

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY

“DAWN” WOOL and NYLON BULKY YARN or

“DAWN” BULKY YARN.

10 ounces Crimson or color of your choice

1 pr. Knitting Needles No. 7 and No. 10½ OR ANY  
SIZE NEEDLE WHICH WILL RESULT IN  
STITCH GAUGE BELOW

7 - ½ inch Buttons

¾ yard Grosgrain Ribbon

Aluminum Crochet Hook size G

**GAUGE:** For No. 10½ needles

4 sts = 1 inch, 6 rows = 1 inch

**PATTERN:** 1st ROW: \* Knit (K) 1, slip (sl) 1 as if  
to K, repeat from \* across row. 2nd ROW: Purl  
(P) across row. Repeat last 2 rows twice. 7th ROW:  
Sl 1, K 1, repeat from beginning across row. 8th  
ROW: P across row. Repeat last 2 rows twice.  
Repeat last 12 rows for pattern.

**BACK:** With No. 7 needles cast on 54 sts and work  
in K 1, P 1 ribbing for 1½ inches. Change to No.  
10½ needles and work in pattern until Back  
measures 7½ inches ending with a P row.

**SHAPE RAGLAN ARMHOLE:** Sl 1, K 1, pass sl st  
over K st (p.s.s.o.), work in pattern across row to  
within last 2 sts, K 2 together (tog). NEXT ROW:

P across row. NEXT ROW: Work in pattern de-  
creasing 1 st at beginning and end of row. Repeat  
last 2 rows keeping pattern uniform until 20 sts  
remain. Place remaining 20 sts on stitch holder.  
**RIGHT FRONT:** With No. 7 needles cast on 30 sts  
and work in K 1, P 1 ribbing for 1½ inches. Change  
to No. 10½ needles and work in pattern until Front  
measures same as Back to underarm, then shape  
Raglan Armhole same as Back until 13 sts remain.  
Place 13 sts on stitch holder. Place markers for 7  
evenly spaced Buttons having 1st marker ¾ inch  
from lower edge and last marker 2 inches from  
neck edge.

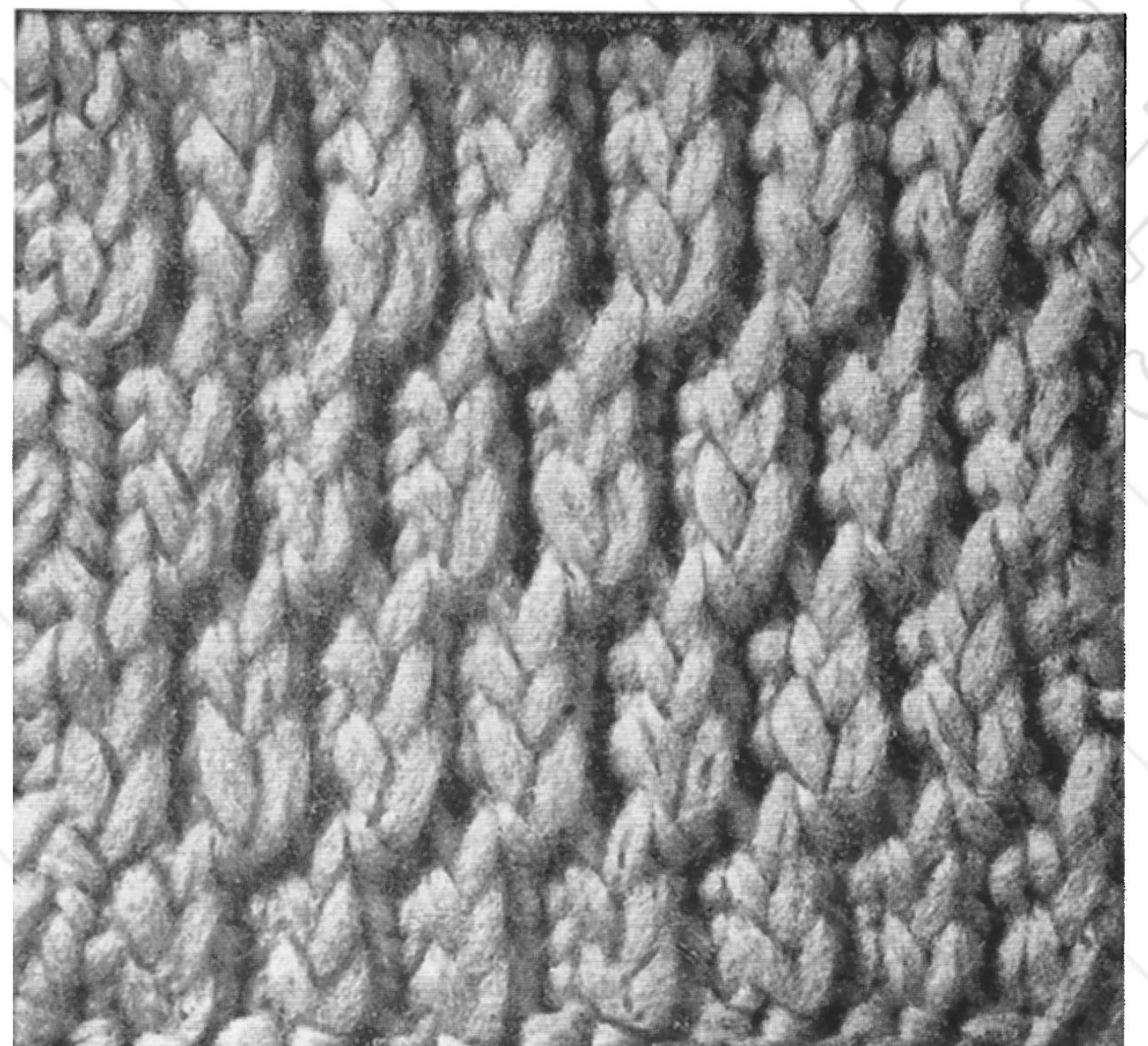
**LEFT FRONT:** Work same as Right Front reversing  
raglan shaping and working buttonholes to corre-  
spond to markers.

**BUTTONHOLES:** Starting at front edge work 2 sts,  
yarn over (yo), P 2 tog. In next row work a st in  
yo st. (For girl's cardigan, place markers for buttons  
on left front and work buttonholes on right front).

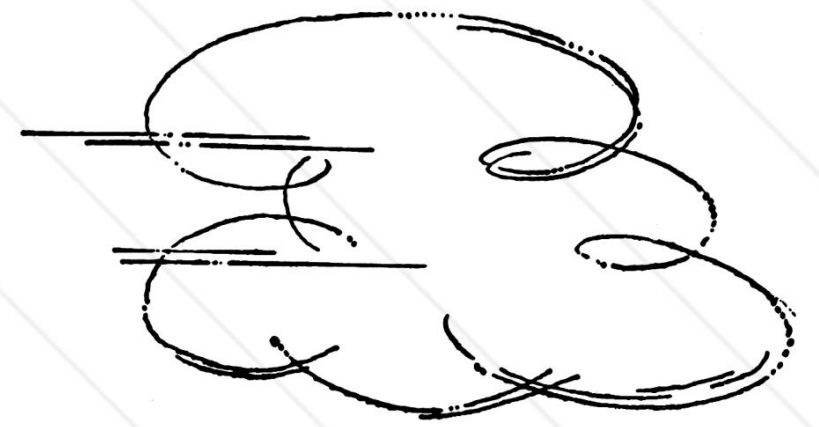
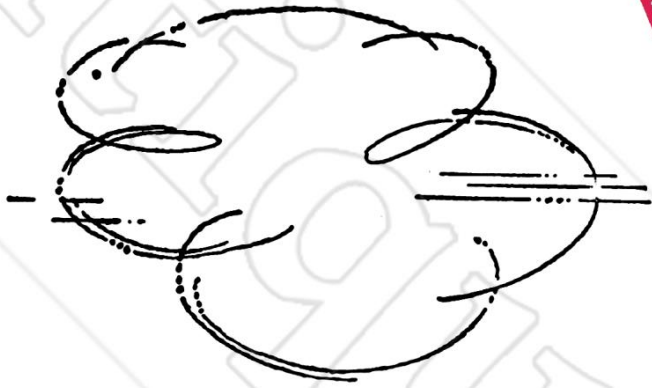
**SLEEVES:** With No. 7 needles cast on 26 sts and  
work in K 1, P 1 ribbing for 1½ inches increasing  
in every 4th st in last row (32 sts). Change to No.  
10½ needles and work in pattern increasing 1 st at  
beginning and end of row every ¾ inch 5 times  
(42 sts). Continue in pattern until sleeve measures  
8½ inches. Work raglan shaping same as Back until  
8 sts remain. Place 8 sts on holder.

**FINISHING:** Block each section. Sew underarm and  
sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in position.

**COLLAR:** Starting at Left Front edge and with No. 7  
needles, slip all sts from holders. Attach yarn and  
work 4 rows in K 1, P 1 ribbing decreasing 2 sts  
evenly spaced in last row, then work even in ribbing  
for 2 inches, bind off. Work a row of slip stitches  
(sl st) on each front edge. Face each front edge  
with grosgrain ribbon cutting buttonholes in ribbon  
to correspond. Sew buttons in position.

## SHELL STITCH BABY SET

Materials Required:

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY

“DAWN” ORLON HIGH BULK FINGERING  
YARN or

“DAWN” ORLON POMPADOUR

8 ounces Buttercup or color of your choice

Plastic Crochet Hook Size E OR ANY SIZE HOOK  
WHICH WILL RESULT IN STITCH GAUGE  
BELOW

1 yd. 1/2 inch Ribbon

6 yds. 1/4 inch Ribbon

**GAUGE:** 1 sc in back loop of 4 sc, 4 dc in ch 1 =  
1 inch

## SACQUE

Chain (ch) 76 to measure about 12 inches, 1 double  
crochet (dc) in 4th stitch (st) from hook, \* ch 1,  
skip 1 st of ch, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts of ch,  
repeat from \* across ch, ch 3, turn (ch 3 counts as  
1 dc). 2nd ROW: 1 dc in next dc, \* 1 dc in next  
ch 1, 1 dc in each of the next 2 dc, repeat from \*  
across row ending with 1 dc in each of the last 2 dc,  
ch 3, turn. 3rd ROW: 1 dc in next dc, \* ch 1, 1 dc  
in each of the next 2 dc, repeat from \* across row,  
ch 1, turn. 4th ROW: 1 single crochet (sc) in each  
dc and 1 sc in each ch 1 (110 sc), ch 3, turn. 5th  
ROW: 1 dc in same sc, \* 1 dc in next sc, 2 dc in  
next sc, repeat from \* across row, ch 3, turn (164  
dc). 6th ROW: Working in back loop of sts only  
1 dc in each of the next 3 sts, \* working in front  
loop of sts only 1 dc in each of the next 4 sts,  
working in back loop of sts 1 dc in each of the next  
4 sts, repeat from \* across row ending with a dc in  
turning ch, ch 3, turn. 7th ROW: Working in front  
loop of sts 1 dc in each of the next 3 sts, \* working  
in back loop of sts 1 dc in each of the next 4 sts,  
working in front loop of sts 1 dc in each of the  
next 4 sts, repeat from \* across row, ch 3, turn.  
8th ROW: Repeat 6th row, ch 1, turn. 9th ROW:  
\* Working in back loop of sts only 1 sc in each of  
the next 4 dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc, repeat from \* across  
row ending with 1 sc in each of the last 4 dc, ch 1,  
turn. 10th ROW: \* Working in back loop of sts  
only 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, 4 dc in ch 1, repeat  
from \* across row ending with 1 sc in each remaining  
sc, ch 1, turn. 11th ROW: \* Working in back loop  
of sts only 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, ch 1, repeat  
from \* across row ending with 1 sc in each remaining

sc (The last 2 rows form pattern). 12th ROW:  
Repeat 10th row. 13th ROW: Working in back  
loop of sts only 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, \* ch 1,  
1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, repeat from \* 4 times  
(Left Front), ch 3, skip next 6 shells, 1 sc in each  
of the next 4 sc (Sleeve opening), \* ch 1, 1 sc in  
each of the next 4 sc, repeat from \* 9 times (Back),  
ch 3, skip next 6 shells, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc  
(Sleeve opening), continue in pattern across row for  
Right Front, ch 1, turn. 14th ROW: Work in pat-  
tern to ch 3 at underarm, skip 1 st of ch, 4 dc in  
next st, skip 1 st of ch, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc,  
continue in pattern working other underarm in same  
manner. Work in pattern until Sacque measures 7  
inches from underarm ending with a shell row, cut  
yarn.

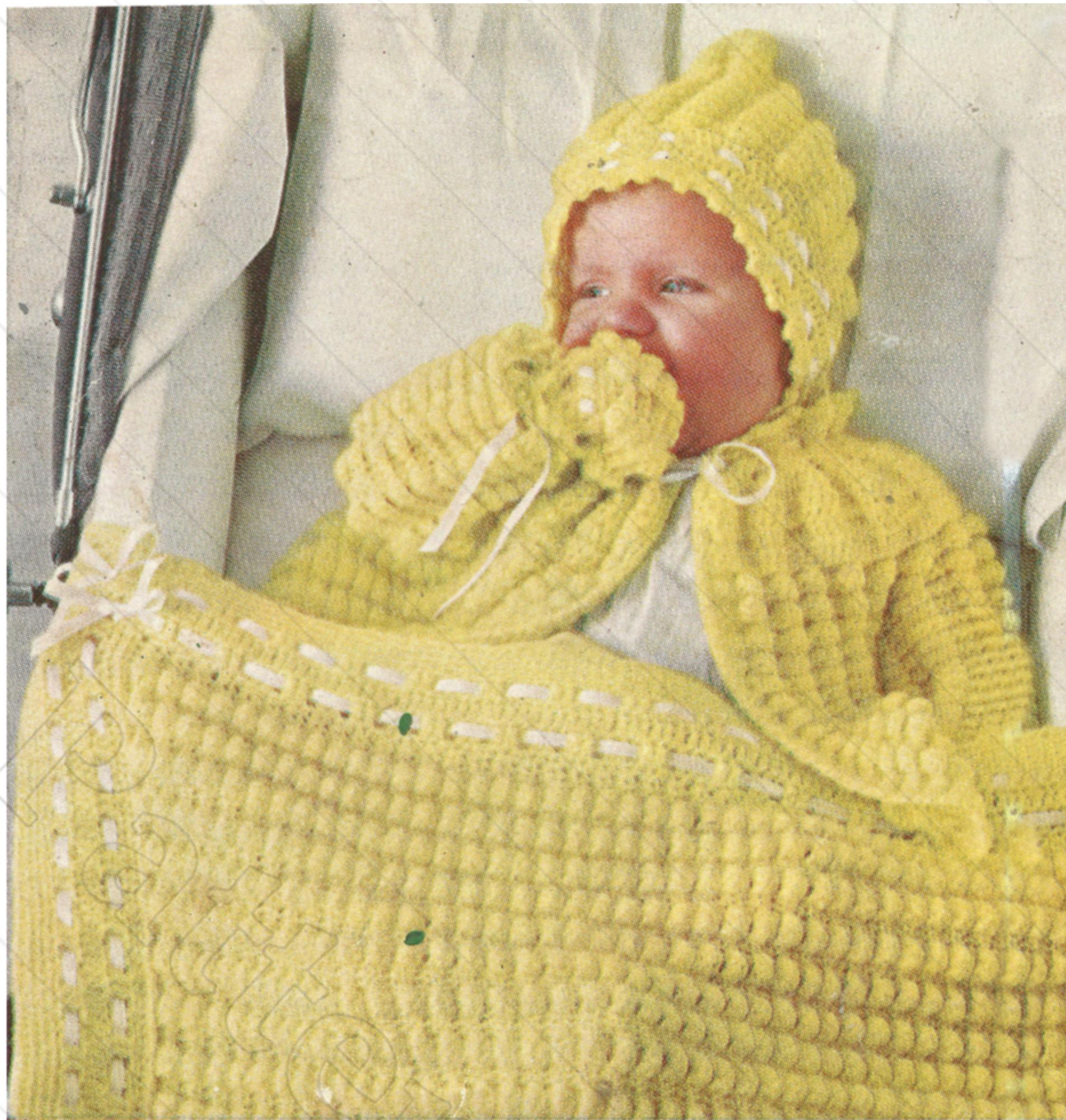
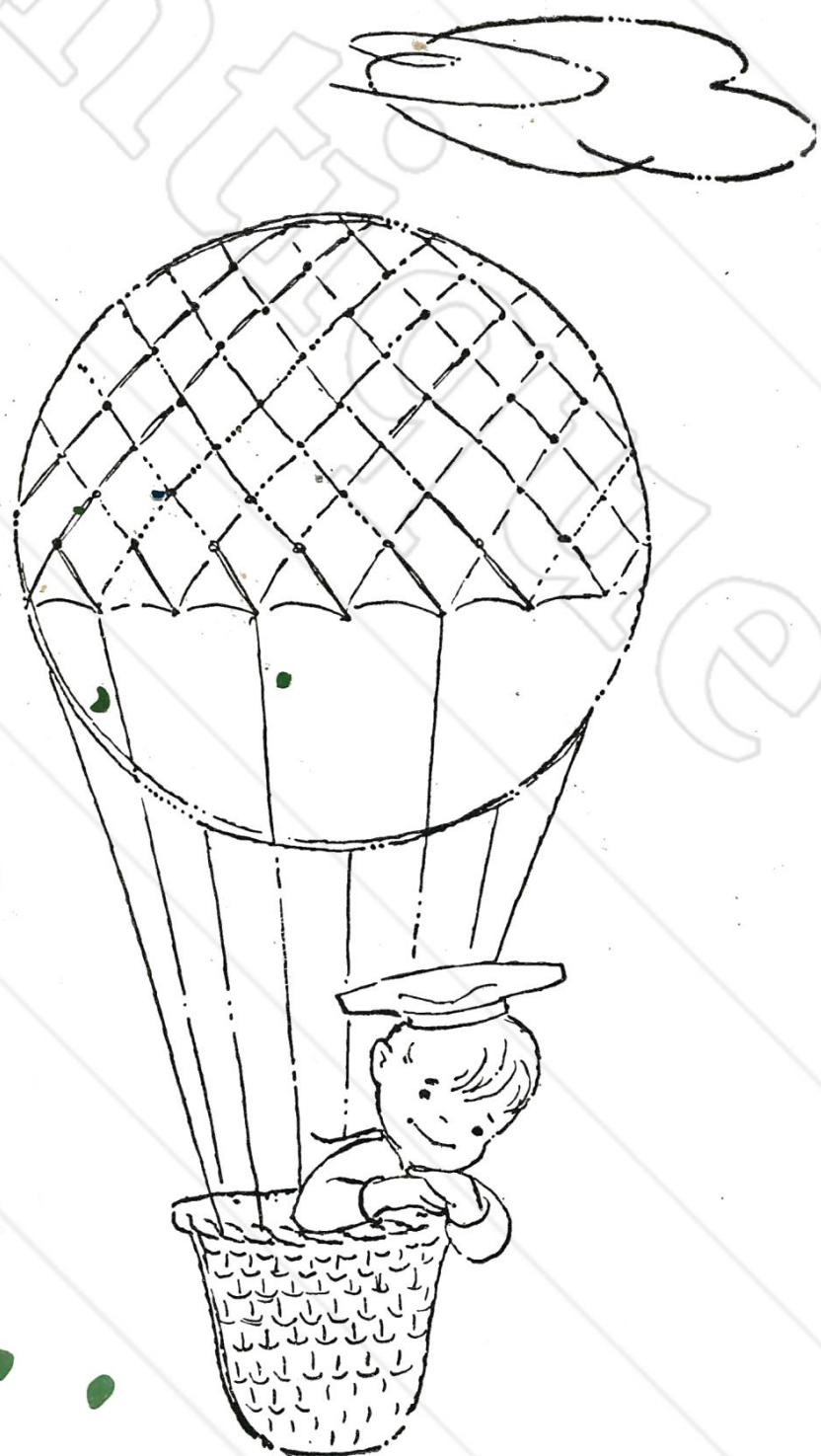
**SLEEVES:** With right side toward you attach yarn in  
center shell at underarm, ch 1, 1 sc in same space,  
1 sc in next st, 1 sc between rows, 1 sc in next st, 1 sc  
in next st, ch 1, continue in pattern around sleeve  
opening ending row to correspond, join, ch 1,  
turn. Work in pattern on 7 shells until sleeve  
measures 6 inches from underarm ending with an  
sc row, join, turn. NEXT ROW: Ch 3, 1 dc in next  
st, \* ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts,  
repeat from \* to end of row, ch 1, join, turn. NEXT  
ROW: Ch 1, working in back loop of sts only 1 sc  
in next st, \* ch 3, sc in same space for picot, 1 sc in  
each of the next 4 sts, repeat from \* to end of row,  
join, cut yarn. Work other sleeve to correspond.  
With right side toward you attach yarn at lower  
right front edge, work a row of sc around right front,  
neck and left front working 2 sc at corners of neck,  
1 sc in each st around neck and 1 sc in each ch 1  
space, cut yarn. With right side of work toward you  
attach yarn at neck edge and work picot edge same  
as sleeve edge ending both front corners in same  
manner. Trim with ribbon as illustrated.

## BOOTIES

Ch 35 to measure about 6 inches, 1 sc in 2nd st from  
hook, 1 sc in each of the next 3 sts, \* ch 1, skip 1 st  
of ch, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sts, repeat from \*  
across ch, ch 1, turn. Work in pattern same as  
Sacque for 1 1/2 inches ending with an sc row. NEXT  
ROW: Working in both loops of sts, ch 1, 1 sc in each  
sc, 1 sc in each ch 1, 1 sc in end st, ch 3, turn (35 sc).

NEXT ROW: Dc in next sc, \* ch 1, skip 1 sc, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sc, repeat from \* across row for beading, ch 1, turn. NEXT ROW: 1 sc in each dc, 1 sc in each ch 1 (35 sc), cut yarn. NEXT ROW: (In-step) Attach yarn in 12th sc and working in back loops of sts only 1 sc in each of the next 11 sc, ch 1, turn. Continue working in sc and back loops of sts until instep measures 2 inches, cut yarn. NEXT ROW: With right side facing, join yarn in 1st sc, ch 1, sc in same space, working in both loops of sts, work 1 sc in next 11 sc, 7 sc on side of instep, 12 sc across instep, 7 sc on other side of instep, 1 sc in each remaining sc, join. NEXT ROW: 1 sc in each sc decreasing 3 sts evenly spaced around toe (to decrease: \* insert hook in next st, pull loop through, repeat from \* once, yarn over and work off all loops at one time), do not join this or following rounds. Place a marker at beginning of each round. NEXT 2 ROUNDS: 1 sc in each sc (46 sc). NEXT ROUND: Working in back loops of sts only 1 sc in each sc. NEXT 3 ROUNDS: Working through both loops of sts 1 sc in each sc. NEXT ROUND: 1 sc in each sc decreasing 3 sts evenly spaced at both toe and heel. NEXT ROUND: Same as last round but decreasing 2 sts at toe and heel, join in sc to even round, cut yarn. Sew sole and back seams. Attach yarn at back seam and work a picot edge same as sleeve edge. Trim with ribbon. Work another bootie in same manner.

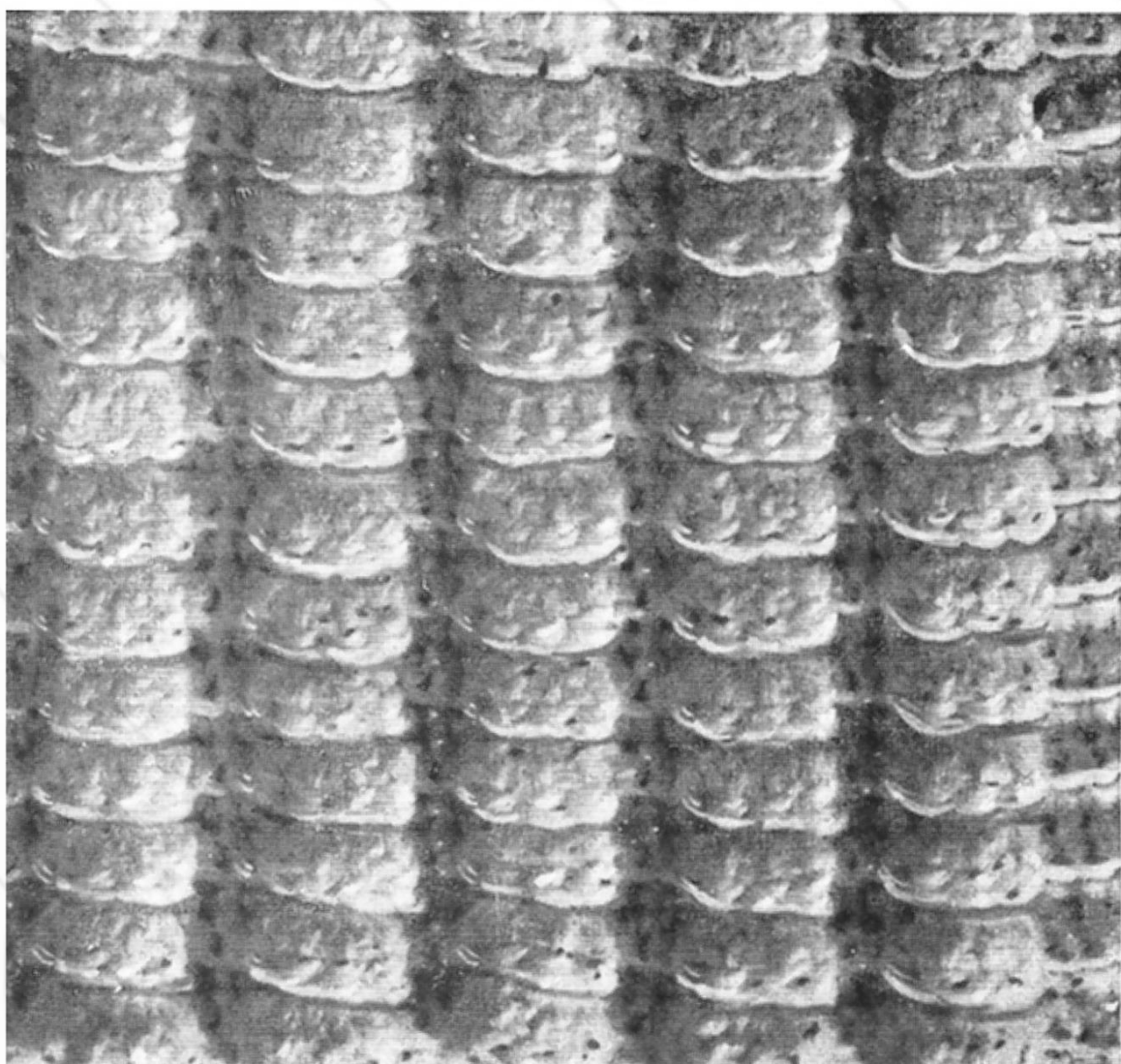

### CAP

Ch 67 to measure about 10½ inches, work 1st 2 rows same as Sacque. 3rd ROW: Dc in next dc, \* ch 1, skip 1 dc, 1 dc in each of the next 2 dc, repeat from \* across row, ch 1, turn. 4th ROW: 1 sc in each dc, 1 sc in each ch 1 space (64 sc), ch 1, turn. Work in pattern same as Sacque until cap measures 6 inches from beginning ending with an sc row, cut yarn. Sew back of cap. With right side toward you attach yarn at right lower edge and work 38 sc around lower edge of cap, ch 3, turn. NEXT ROW: 1 dc in next sc, \* ch 1, skip 1 sc, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sc, repeat from \* to end of row, ch 1, turn. NEXT ROW: Work a row of sc all around cap working 1 sc in each dc and in each ch 1, join in 1st sc, do not turn, ch 3, and work a picot edge all around cap same as sleeve edge ending to correspond. Trim with ribbon.

### MITTENS

Ch 31 to measure about 5 inches, join, \* ch 1, skip 1 st of ch, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sts of ch, repeat from \* all around, join, ch 1, turn. Work in pattern joining and turning each row (same as sleeve) until mitten measures 2 inches ending with an sc row. Continue working in pattern decreasing 1 st in each sc section until 2 sts remain in each sc section ending with an sc row. Discontinue pattern. Working in both loops of sts work 1 row of sc, join, ch 1, turn. NEXT ROW: 1 sc in each sc decreasing 4 sts evenly spaced, cut yarn leaving an end, draw through sts and fasten tightly. Attach yarn at seam and work 30 sc around edge of mitten, join in 1st sc, do not turn. NEXT ROW: Ch 3, 1 dc in each sc, join. NEXT ROW: Ch 3, 1 dc in next dc, \* ch 1, skip 1 dc, dc in next 2 dc, repeat from \* all around for beading, ch 1, join. Work picot edge same as sleeve edge, cut yarn. Trim with ribbon. Work another mitten in same manner.



## CARRIAGE COVER

Materials Required:

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY

“DAWN” ORLON HIGH BULK FINGERING YARN or

“DAWN” ORLON POMPADOUR

11 ounces Buttercup or color of your choice

Plastic Crochet Hook Size F

9 yds. narrow Satin Ribbon

Working loosely chain (ch) 125, 1 sc in 2nd stitch

**GAUGE:** 3 dc = 1 inch, 2 dc rows = 1½ inches

**CROWN:** With White chain (ch) 10, single crochet (sc) in 2nd stitch (st) from hook, 1 sc in each of the next 2 sts of ch, 1 short double crochet (sdc) in each of the next 3 sts. (sdc: yarn over hook, insert in st, pull loop through, yarn over and work off all 3 loops at one time), 1 double crochet (dc) in next st, 2 dc in next st, 5 dc in last st, working on opposite side of starting ch, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in next st, 1 sdc in each of the next 3 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 3 sts, ch 2, turn. 2nd ROW: Working in front loop of sts only 1 sdc in each of the next 5 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of the next 7 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts, 1 sdc in each of the next 6 sts, ch 3, turn. 3rd ROW: Working in back loop of sts only 1 dc in each of the next 9 sts, \* 2 dc in next st, dc in next st, repeat from \* once, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts, \* dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, repeat from \* once, 1 dc in each of the next 10 sts, cut yarn.

**SIDE SECTION:** With White ch 37, sdc in 3rd st from hook, 1 sdc in each of the next 7 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 18 sts, 1 sdc in each of the next 9 sts, ch 2 to turn all rows. 2nd ROW: Working in front loop of sts only 1 sdc in each of the next 7 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 20 sts, 1 sdc in each of the

next 8 sts. 3rd ROW: Working in back loop of sts only, 1 sdc in each of the next 6 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 22 sts, 1 sdc in each of the next 7 sts. 4th ROW: Working in front loop of sts only 1 sdc in each of the next 5 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 24 sts, 1 sdc in each of the next 6 sts. 5th ROW: Working in back loop of sts only 1 sdc in each of the next 4 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 26 sts, 1 sdc in each of the next 5 sts, cut yarn.

**BRIM:** With White ch 38, sdc in 3rd st from hook, \* sdc in next st, 2 sdc in next st, repeat from \* once, sdc in next st, \* 2 dc in next st, dc in next st, repeat from \* 11 times, \* sdc in next st, 2 sdc in next st, repeat from \* twice, ch 2, turn. 2nd ROW: Working in back loop of sts only sdc in same space, 1 sdc in each of the next 4 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 44 sts, 1 sdc in each of the next 4 sts, 2 sdc in last st, cut yarn.

**TRIM:** With wrong sides of Crown and Side Section together, attach Shell Pink in 1st st of starting ch of Side Section and 1st free st of Crown, working through both thicknesses but in back loop of sts only of Crown, \* ch 2, slip stitch (sl st) in next st, repeat from \* across row, cut yarn. With wrong side of Brim and right side of Side Section facing crochet the 2 sections together in same manner, do not cut yarn. Work a row of trim around edges of Brim working through both loops of sts, cut yarn. With White work a row of sl sts across Side Section and Crown. With right side of Bonnet toward you attach Shell Pink in 1st free loop under brim and work trim in each remaining free loop, cut yarn.

**TIE:** (Work 2). With Shell Pink ch 45, sl st in 2nd st from hook, sl st in each remaining st of ch, cut yarn leaving a length for sewing. Sew to each corner of Bonnet.

Plastic Crochet Hook Size J OR ANY SIZE HOOK  
WHICH WILL RESULT IN STITCH GAUGE  
BELOW

**GAUGE:** 3 sc = 1 inch, 3 rows = 1 inch

### BASIC CAP

**CENTER SECTION:** With Crimson chain (ch) 2, 2 single crochet (sc) in 1st stitch (st) of ch, ch 1, to turn all rows. 2nd ROW: 2 sc in each of the 2 sc. 3rd and 4th ROWS: Work even in sc. 5th ROW: Working in sc increase 1 st at the beginning and end of row. Repeat the last 3 rows 4 times. Work 11 rows even in sc, do not turn at end of last row.

**SIDE SECTION:** Working along side of center section work 1 sc in each row (27 sc), ch 1 to turn all rows. 2nd ROW: 1 sc in each of the 1st 3 sc, \* decrease (dec) in next 2 sts (to dec: insert hook in st, pull loop through, insert hook in next st, pull loop through, yarn over and work off all loops at one time), 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, repeat from \* across row. 3rd ROW: 1 sc in each of the next 6 sts, dec in next 2 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 5 sts, dec in next 2 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 6 sts (19 sts). NEXT ROW: Work even. 5th ROW: Sc in 1st sc, \* dec in next 2 sts, sc in next sc, repeat from \* across row. 6th ROW: Work even. 7th ROW: Dec 1 st at center. 8th ROW: Work even. 9th ROW: Dec in every 2 sts (6 sts). Repeat last 2 rows once. 13th ROW: \* Insert hook in next st, pull loop through, repeat from \* twice, yarn over and work off all loops at one time, cut yarn. Work another side section in same manner attaching yarn in side of 1st row of center section. Do not cut yarn at end of last row. With right side of work toward you crochet a row of sc around entire Cap working 11 sc in each edge of side sections, 13 sc across center



front and 1 sc at center back, join, cut yarn.

**TIE:** (Make 2) With Crimson ch 40 to measure about 12 inches, slip stitch (sl st) in 2nd st from hook, sl st in each remaining st of ch, cut yarn. Sew to each side of Cap.

**TRIM:** Cut White into 12 - 20 inch lengths. Tie one end, divide into 3 equal parts and braid having braid about 1 inch wide. When braid is long enough to fit across front of Cap, tie. Trim both ends. Sew to cap as illustrated.

**POMPON:** (Make 2) Wind White 25 times over a 3 inch cardboard. Remove from cardboard, tie in center and trim. Attach to each side of Cap as illustrated.

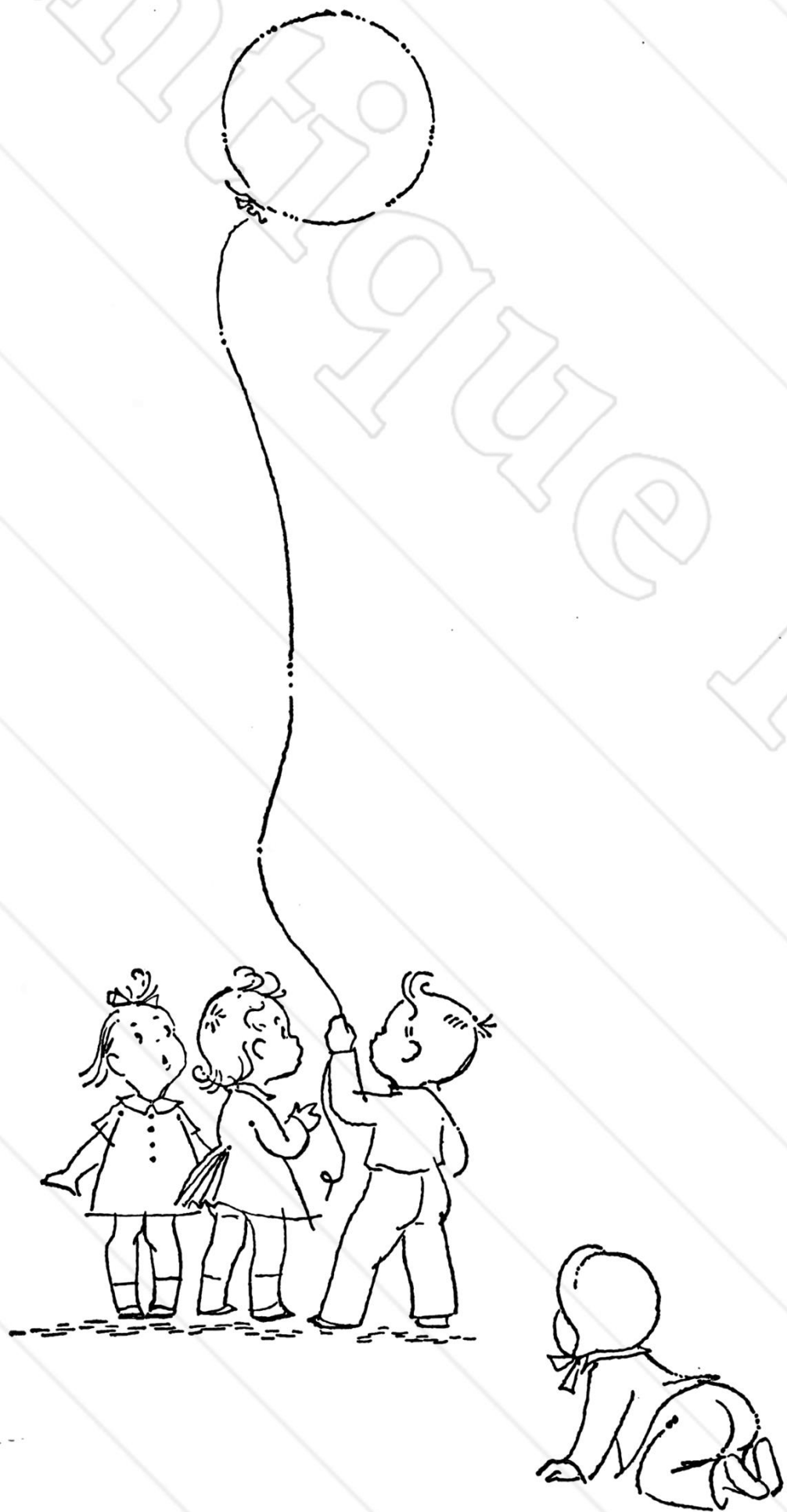
### BASIC MITTENS

With White ch 19 (6 inches long), join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 1 sc in each st of ch, join all rounds and ch 1 to turn all rounds. NEXT 6 ROUNDS: 1 sc in each sc. 8th ROUND: Working in sc decrease 2 sts evenly spaced in both front and back (15 sc). 9th ROUND: Work even in sc. Repeat the last 2 rounds once, cut yarn leaving a length for sewing. Draw sts together and sew firmly.

**BEADING:** With right side of work toward you and working on opposite side of starting ch attach White at joining, ch 1, sc in same space, \* ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st, repeat from \* all around, ch 1, join in 1st sc, ch 1, turn. NEXT ROUND: Work 1 sc in each sc and in each ch 1 space. NEXT ROUND: 1 sc in each sc, join, cut yarn.

**TIE:** With Crimson, working tightly, crochet a chain about 14 inches long, cut yarn. Lace through beading.

**POMPON:** (Make 2) Wind Crimson 20 times over a 2 inch cardboard. Tie in center, cut both ends and trim. Sew to each end of ties. Work other mitten in same manner.



### LOOP STITCH CAP

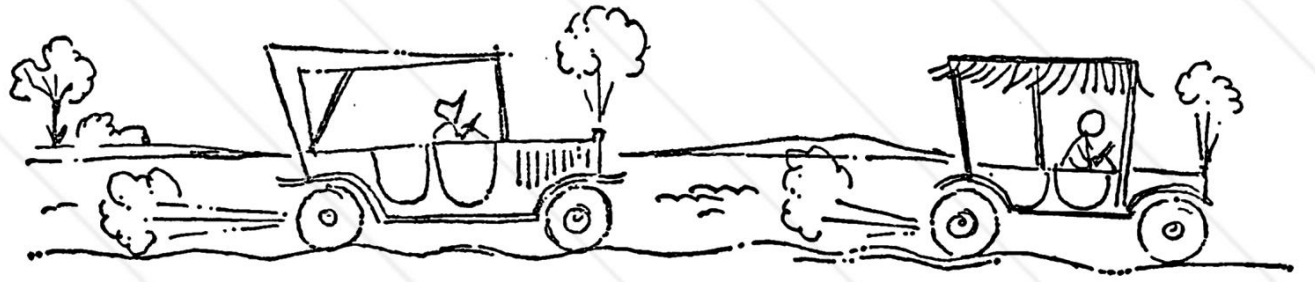
**CENTER SECTION:** With Shell Pink work in same manner as center section of Basic Cap on page 12 but working all even rows in double loop sts (double loop st: wind yarn twice around index finger, insert hook in st, pick up the 2 loops from finger and pull through st, complete sc), cut yarn.

**SIDE SECTIONS:** Work 1st row same as 1st row of side section of Basic Cap. 2nd ROW: 1 double loop st in each of the 1st 3 sc, \* skip next sc, 1 double loop st in each of the next 3 sc, repeat from \* across row. Work remainder of section in same manner working all even rows in double loop sts. Work other side section to correspond. With wrong side of work toward you work a row of double loop sts around entire cap working 1 double loop st in each st and in each row on sides of Cap. If desired a row of slip stitches (sl sts) may be worked around entire Cap. Work ties in same manner as Basic Cap.

### LOOP STITCH MITTENS

With Shell Pink ch 19 (6 inches long), join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 1 double loop st in each of the 1st 10 sts of ch and 1 sc in each of the next 9 sts, join, ch 1 to turn all rounds. 2nd ROUND: 1 sc in each st (19 sts), join. 3rd ROUND: 1 double loop st in each of the 1st 10 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 9 sts, join. Repeat the 2nd and 3rd rounds twice. 8th ROUND: Working in sc decrease 2 sts evenly spaced in both front and back sections (15 sc). 9th ROUND: 1 double loop st in each of the 1st 8 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 7 sts, join. 10th ROUND: Same as 8th round (11 sts). 11th ROUND: 1 double loop st in each of the 1st 6 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 5 sts, join, cut yarn leaving a length for sewing. Draw sts together and sew firmly. With Shell Pink work remainder of mitten and ties same as Basic Mittens omitting pompons.

### JACKET

**FRONTS:** Chain (ch) 40, 1 double crochet (dc) in 4th stitch (st) from hook, \* ch 1, skip 1 st of ch, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts of ch, repeat from \* across ch, ch 1, turn. 2nd ROW: (Right Side) slip st (sl st) between 1st 2 dc, \* ch 3, 2 short double crochet (sdc) in 1st st of ch (sdc: yarn over hook, insert in st, pull loop through, yarn over and pull through all 3 loops at one time), skip next ch 1 space, 2 sdc between the next 2 dc, repeat from \* across row, ch 3, turn. 3rd ROW: 1 dc between 1st 2 sdc, \* ch 1, 2 dc between next 2 sdc, repeat from \* across row working last 2 dc in ch 1 of turning ch, ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows for pattern until section measures  $7\frac{1}{2}$  inches, ch 3, turn. NEXT ROW: 1 dc in each dc and ch 1 space across row, ch 3, turn. NEXT ROW: Working in back loop of sts only 1 dc in next dc, working in front loop of sts only 1 dc in next dc, repeat from beginning across row, ch 3, turn. NEXT 5 ROWS: Repeat last row, cut yarn.

**BACK:** Ch 76 and work in same manner as front.

**SLEEVES:** Ch 43 and work in pattern until sleeve measures  $7\frac{1}{2}$  inches, cut yarn.

**FINISHING:** Sew 4 inches on each side for shoulder seams leaving 4 inches free for neck. Sew side and sleeve seams, sew sleeves in position.

**CUFFS:** With right side of work toward you, join yarn in seam, ch 1, \* 1 single crochet (sc) between next 2 dc, 1 sc in next ch 1 space, repeat from \* all around, join. 2nd ROUND: Ch 1, 1 sc in same space, 1 sc in each sc, join. Repeat the 2nd round 3 times. NEXT ROUND: \* Ch 3, 2 sdc in 1st st of ch, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc, repeat from \* all around, join, cut yarn.

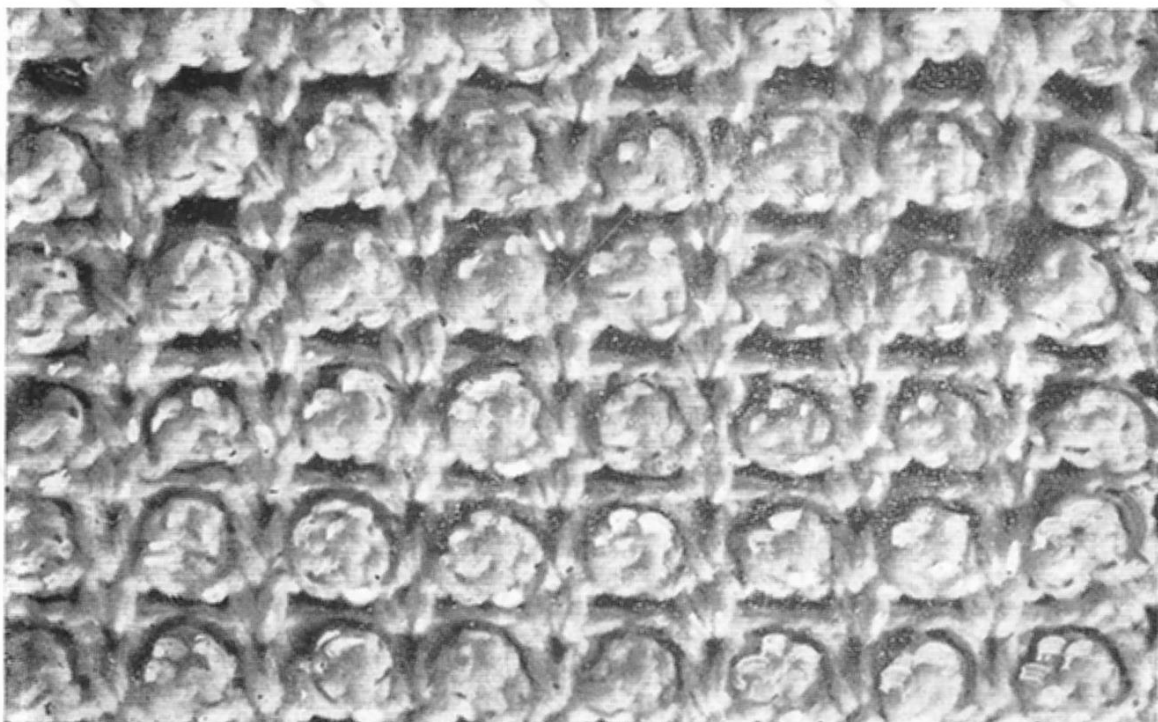
**COLLAR:** With right side of work toward you, join yarn in 1st row of yoke and work 2 sc in each dc on sides, 1 sc in each dc across top, ch 1, turn. 2nd ROW: 1 sc in each sc working 3 sc in each corner st, ch 1, turn. Repeat the 2nd row 3 times. NEXT ROW: Work same as last row of cuffs, cut yarn.

Attach yarn at neck edge of Left Front and working down front, \* ch 3, 2 sdc in 1st st of ch, sc in next dc row, repeat from \* all around working the sc between the 2 dc across lower edge, cut yarn. Lace narrow ribbon across lower edge and finish with bows as illustrated. Sew  $\frac{5}{8}$  inch ribbon at neck edge and tie in bow.

### BONNET

Ch 4, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 6 sc in ring, do not join this or following rounds. Place a marker at beginning of each round. 2nd ROUND: 2 sc in each sc. 3rd ROUND: \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, repeat from \* all around. 4th ROUND: 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, repeat from \* all around. Continue increasing in same manner having 1 more st between increases in each round until there are 90 sts in round. NEXT 2 ROUNDS: 1 sc in each sc, join last round, cut yarn, turn. (Section measures about  $4\frac{1}{2}$  inches in diameter). Attach yarn in 11th sc to the left of joining and working through front loop of sts only ch 3, 1 dc in next sc, \* ch 1, skip 1 sc, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts, repeat from \* across 71 sts leaving 19 sts free for back of neck, ch 1, turn. Work even in pattern for 5 inches on the 71 sts ending with 3rd row of pattern, cut yarn.

**TURNBACK:** With right side of last row worked toward you, attach yarn at beginning of row and working through back loop of sts only work 1 sc in each dc, 1 sc in each ch 1, ch 1, turn. NEXT 5 ROWS: Working through both loops of sts only 1 sc in each sc, ch 1, turn. NEXT ROW: Work same as last row of collar of Jacket.





**NECK EDGE BORDER:** Work 65 sc across edge, turn. Ch 3, 1 dc in next st, \* ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts, repeat from \* across row for Beading ch 1, turn. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** 1 sc in each dc, 1 sc in each ch 1 space, ch 1, turn. **NEXT ROW:** 1 sc in each sc, turn. **NEXT ROW:** \* Ch 3, 2 sdc in 1st st of ch, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc, repeat from \* across row, cut yarn. Lace narrow ribbon around top of crown tying in a bow. Lace  $\frac{5}{8}$  inch ribbon through neck edge beading. Finish with ribbon ties.

#### MITTENS

Ch 34 to measure about  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches, 1 dc in 4th st from hook, \* ch 1, skip next st, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts, repeat from \* across ch. Work even in pattern for 2 inches ending with 2nd row of pattern. **NEXT ROW:** Working in pattern decrease 2 patterns evenly spaced. (To decrease: work \* 1 dc between the next 2 sdc, repeat from \* once). **NEXT ROW:** Work even in pattern. **NEXT ROW:** Decrease 2 patterns evenly spaced, ch 1, turn. **NEXT ROW:** 1 sc in each dc, 1 sc in each ch 1 space, ch 1, turn. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** 1 sc in each sc, cut yarn leaving an end. Thread into needle and draw sts together fastening securely. Sew side seam. With right side toward you attach yarn in seam at opposite side of starting ch and work 34 sc across top, join in 1st sc. **NEXT 4 ROWS:** Ch 1, 1 sc in each sc, join. **NEXT ROW:** Same as last row of collar of

Jacket, join, cut yarn. Lace ribbon through 1st row of pattern.

#### BOOTIES

Ch 37 to measure about 6 inches, 1 dc in 4th st of ch, \* ch 1, skip next st, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts, repeat from \* across ch. Work in pattern for 2 inches ending with 2nd row of pattern, cut yarn, turn.

**INSTEP:** Skip 4 patterns, attach yarn in 5th sdc group from beginning and work across 3 patterns, ch 1, turn. Work even in pattern for 2 inches ending with 3rd row of pattern, ch 1, turn. **NEXT ROW:** Work 1 sc in each dc, 1 sc in each ch 1 space across row, 9 sc on side of instep, 14 sc across skipped patterns, then work 14 sc across opposite side (this joins Bootie together at back), 9 sc up opposite side of instep. Do not join this or following rounds, place a marker at beginning of each round. **NEXT ROUND:** 1 sc in each sc decreasing 3 sts evenly spaced around toe. **NEXT 7 ROUNDS:** 1 sc in each sc. **NEXT ROUND:** 1 sc in each sc decreasing 3 sts evenly spaced at toe and decreasing 3 sts at heel. **NEXT ROUND:** 1 sc in each sc decreasing 2 sts evenly spaced at toe and decreasing 2 sts at heel. **NEXT ROUND:** 1 sc in each sc decreasing 1 st at center of toe and 1 st at center of heel, join, cut yarn. Sew sole and back seam. Attach yarn in seam at opposite side of starting ch and work edge same as mittens, cut yarn. Lace ribbon through 1st row of pattern and finish with bow.

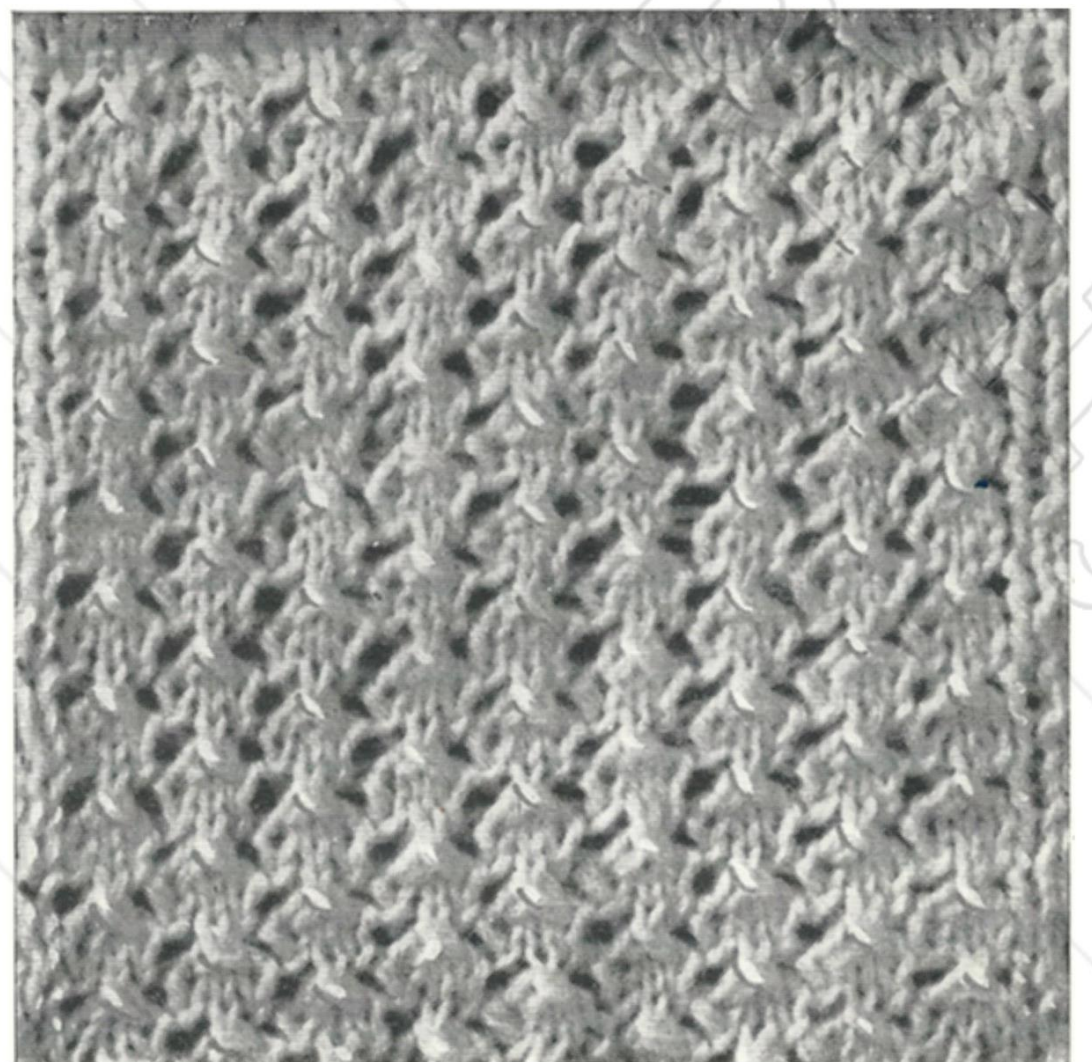
**GAUGE:** 7 sts = 1 inch, 8 rows = 1 inch

Cast on 100 stitches (sts) and work 4 rows in stockinette st (Knit [K] 1 row, Purl [P] 1 row).  
5th ROW: K 1, \* placing yarn from back to front yarn over (yo), K 2 together (tog), repeat from \* across row ending with K 1, then work in stockinette st (K 1 row, P 1 row) for 3/4 inch ending with a P row. \*\* NEXT ROW: K 1, \* yo twice, K 2 tog, repeat from \* across row (increasing row). Working a st in each yo st continue in stockinette st for 1/2 inch ending with a P row. Repeat from \*\* twice.  
NEXT ROW: Repeat increasing row once. NEXT ROW: P across row. Work even in stockinette st for 1 1/2 inches increasing 1 st in last row (501 sts).  
NEXT ROW: K 80 for half of Back, place next 85 sts on st holder for Sleeve, K 171 for Front, place next 85 sts on holder for other Sleeve, K across remaining 80 sts for other half of Back. NEXT ROW: P across 331 sts. NEXT ROW: K 2, \* yo, sl 1, K 2 tog, pass slip st over K st (p.s.s.o.), yo, K 3, repeat from \* across row ending last repeat with K 2. NEXT ROW: P across row. NEXT ROW: K 5, \* yo, sl 1, K 2 tog, p.s.s.o., yo, K 3, repeat from \* across row ending with K 5. NEXT ROW:

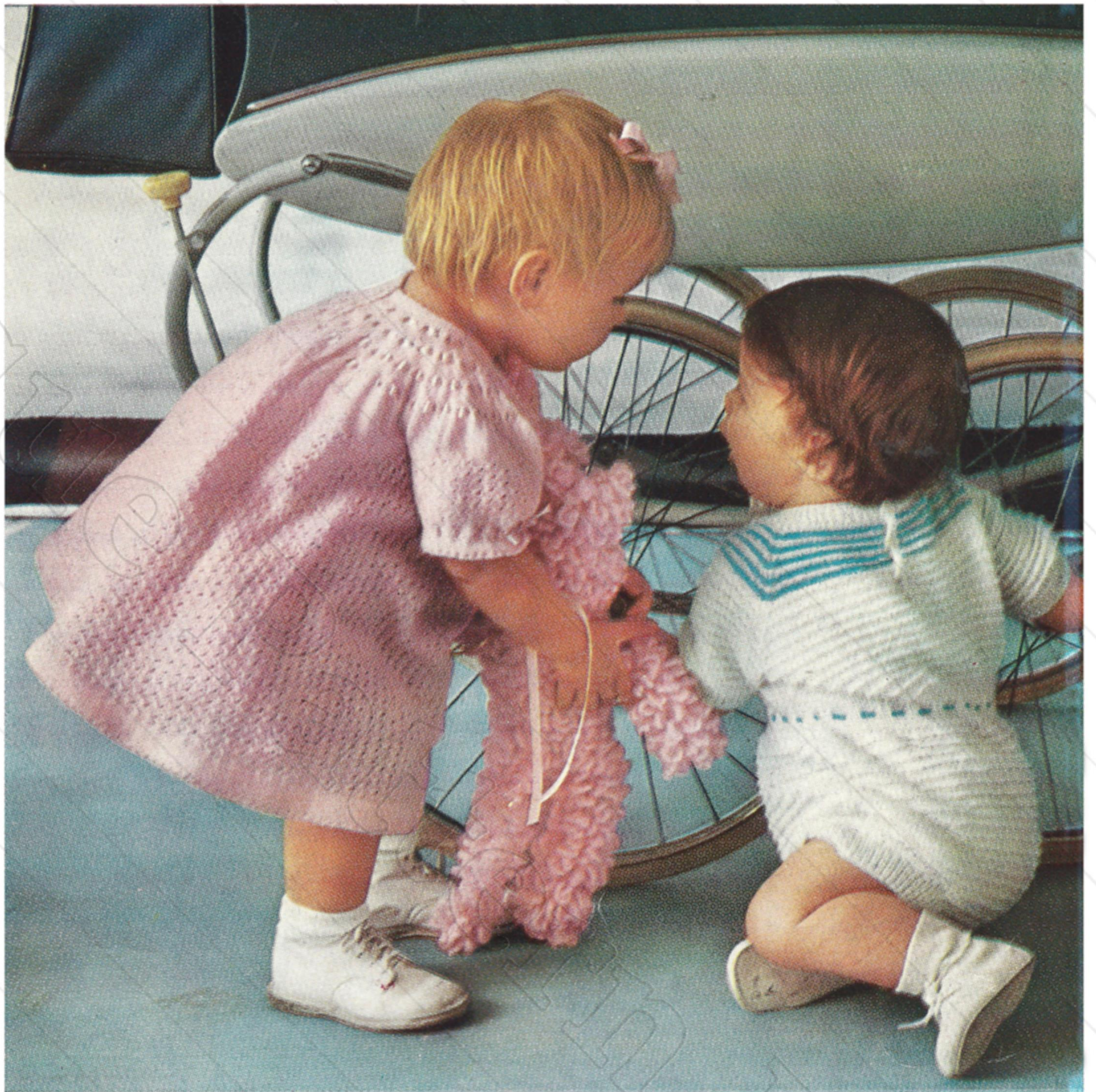
P across row. Repeat last 4 rows for pattern until pattern section measures 10 1/2 inches, then work in stockinette st for 1 inch ending with a P row. NEXT ROW: Repeat 5th row. NEXT ROW: P across row and work 1 inch more in stockinette st, bind off.

Attach yarn at lower edge of back opening on opposite side and work 25 sc, ch 1, turn. **NEXT ROW:** 1 sc in 1st sc, \* ch 2, skip 2 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, repeat from \* 5 times (6 buttonholes). **NEXT ROW:** Work 1 sc in each sc, 2 sc in each ch 2 loop, cut yarn. Sew buttons in position. Lace and tie ribbon as illustrated.

**BACK:** With White and No. 4 straight needles cast on 22 stitches (sts), Knit (K) across row. **2nd ROW:** Purl (P) across row. **3rd and 4th ROWS:** K across each row increasing 1 st at the beginning and end of each row. (These 4 rows form pattern). **5th ROW:** Same as 3rd row. **6th ROW:** P across row increasing 1 st at beginning and end of row. Repeat the last 4 rows 5 times (70 sts). **27th ROW:** With a separate ball of yarn cast on 18 sts on right hand needle, K across row, cast on 18 sts at end of row. **28th ROW:** K across all sts (106 sts). Work even in pattern for 5 1/2 inches ending with 2nd row of pattern. Change to No. 1 needles and work in ribbing of K 1, P 1 for 1 1/2 inches ending on wrong side of work. Change to No. 4 needles and starting with 3rd row of pattern work even in pattern for 2 1/2 inches ending with last row of pattern. **NEXT 2 ROWS.** Bind off 7 sts at the beginning of each row, drop yarn. Place the 1st 46 sts on a stitch holder. Place the remaining 46 sts on another holder.

**FRONT:** Work same as Back but place all 92 sts on one holder.

**SLEEVES:** (Work 2) With White and No. 1 needles cast on 66 sts and work in ribbing of K 1, P 1 for one inch. Change to No. 4 needles and work in pattern for 2 inches ending with last row of pattern. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Bind off 7 sts at the beginning of each row. Place sts on holders. Place a marker at center of Back. On circular needle pick up sts from holders as follows: starting at marker pick up 45 sts for half of back, place a marker, pick up last st of same half of back, place a marker, pick up all sts of one sleeve, place a marker, pick up 1 st of front, place a marker, pick up the remaining sts of front to within last st, place a marker, pick up last st, place a marker, pick up all sts of other sleeve, place a marker, pick up 1 st of other half of back, place a marker, pick up remaining sts of back. (Work back and forth on circular needle).

**START RAGLAN:** 1st ROW: K across sts of back to within 2 sts of 1st marker, K 2 together (tog), K 1, slip 1, K 1, pass sl st over K st (p.s.s.o.), K across sts of sleeve to within 2 sts of next marker, K 2 tog, sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., K across sts of front to within 2 sts of next marker, K 2 tog, K 1, sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., K across sts of sleeve to within 2 sts of next marker, K 2 tog, K 1, sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., K across remaining sts of back. 2nd ROW: K across row. 3rd ROW: Same as 1st row. 4th ROW: P across row. Repeat the last 4 rows 5 times, drop White. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Attach Lt. Blue and work same as 1st and 2nd rows of raglan, drop Lt. Blue. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Pick up White and work same as 3rd and 4th rows of raglan. Repeat last 4 rows 4 times, cut Lt. Blue. Change to No. 1 needles and work in ribbing of K 1, P 1 for 8 rows, bind off. With wrong side of work toward you and with White work 55 single crochet (sc) around back neck opening, ch 1, turn. 2nd ROW: 1 sc in each of the 1st 2 sc, \* ch 2, skip 2 sc for buttonholes, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, repeat from \* 3 times, work remainder of row in sc ending with slip stitch (sl st), cut yarn. Sew buttons in position. Sew sleeve and side seams. With White and No. 1 needles pick up 116 sts around leg opening. Work in ribbing for 10 rows, bind off. Work other leg opening in same manner. Sew snap tape in position at crotch.

With White chain (ch) 69, single crochet (sc) in 2nd stitch (st) from hook and in each remaining st of ch. 2nd ROW: Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each sc. 3rd and 4th ROWS: Repeat 2nd row, drop White do not turn. 5th ROW: Attach Light Blue in 1st sc of 4th row, sc in same space, skip 2 sc, \* insert hook 2 rows below in corresponding st, pull up a long loop over the 2 rows and complete sc, repeat from \* twice, \* skip 2 sts, 3 sc in corresponding

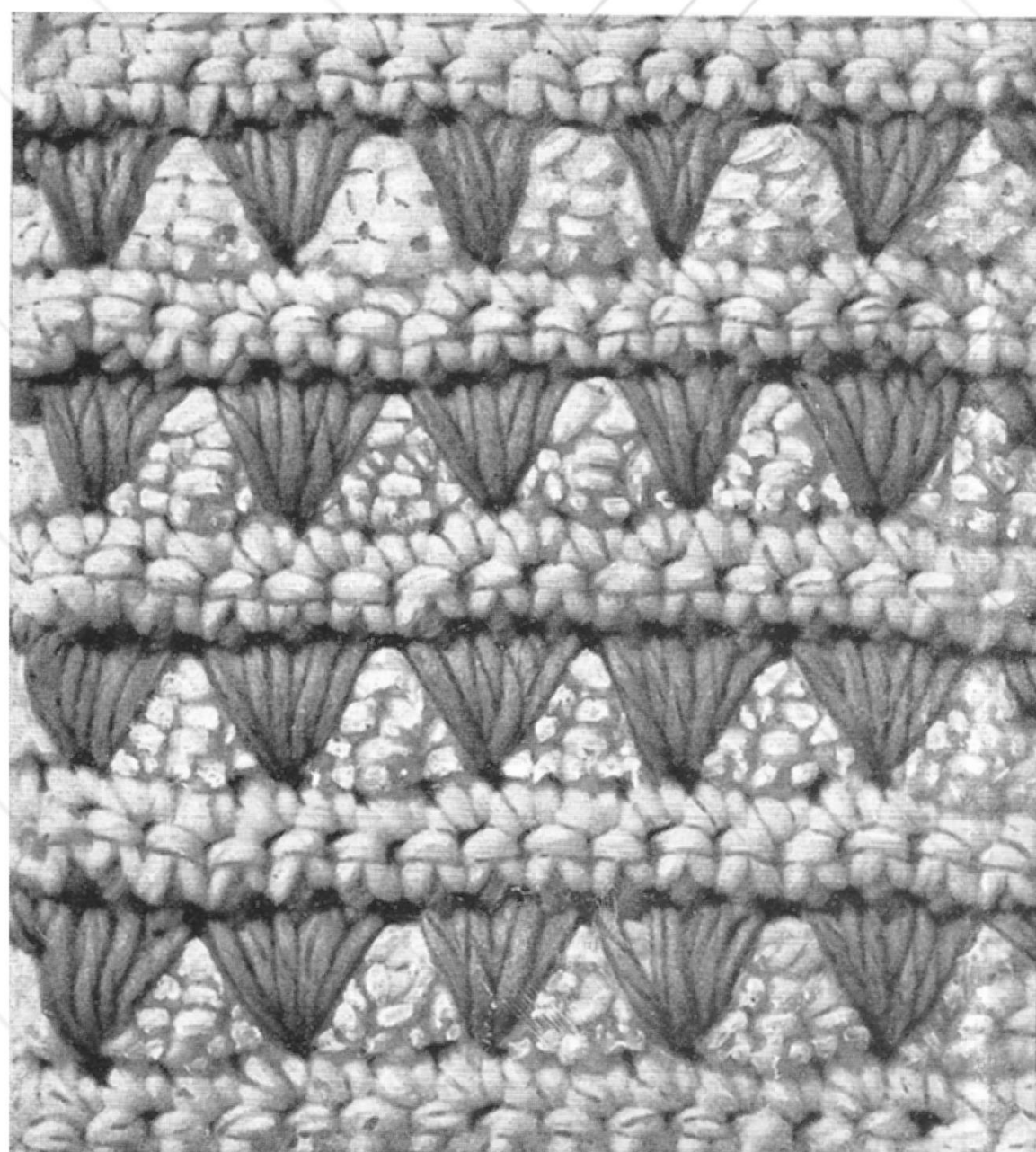

sc 2 rows below, repeat from last \* across row, sc in last sc, cut yarn. 6th ROW: Pick up White, ch 1, turn and work 1 sc in each sc. 7th, 8th and 9th ROWS: Ch 1, turn and work 1 sc in each sc. Repeat last 5 rows for pattern until cover measures 35 inches ending with 2 rows White. Without cutting yarn work a row of sc all around cover working 1 sc in each sc, 1 sc in each row at sides working 3 sc in each corner, do not join. Work 2 more rows of sc all around working in back loop of sts only and working 3 sc in each corner st, slip (sl) st in next 3 sts to even row, cut yarn.

**FRINGE:** Cut Light Blue and White strands 12 inches long, \* take 2 strands of White, double in half, insert hook in 1st sc at corner, pull loop through and draw ends through loop, skip 1 sc, work a Light Blue fringe in next sc. Repeat from \* across both ends of cover. Trim fringe evenly.

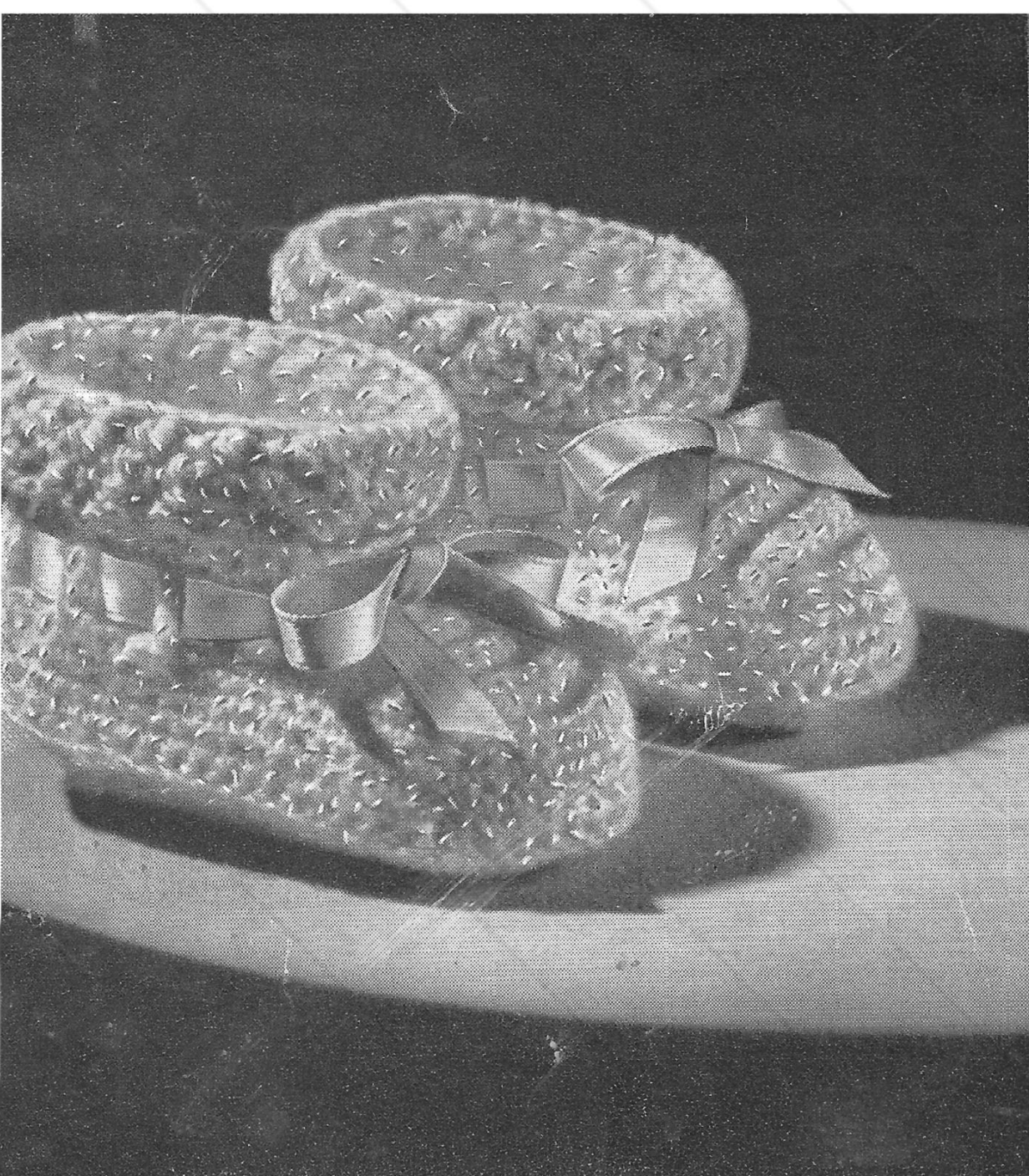

Work 2 rows even in pattern. **NEXT ROW:** Increase 1 st at beginning and end of row. Work even in pattern until Sleeve measures 6 inches from beginning, cut yarn. Work other Sleeve in same manner. Sew sleeve seams.

**EDGE:** Attach Baby Pink in seam, ch 1, dc in same space, slip stitch (sl st) in next st, \* ch 1, dc in next st, sl st in next st, repeat from \* across row, join, cut yarn. Sew shoulder seams and sew sleeves in position.

**COLLAR:** With Baby Pink and wrong side toward you work 65 sc around neck edge, turn.

**BEADING:** 2nd ROW: Ch 3, skip 1 sc, short double crochet (sdc) in next sc (sdc: yarn over hook, insert in st, pull loop through, yarn over and work off all 3 loops at one time), \* ch 1, skip 1 sc, sdc in next sc, repeat from \* around neck edge, ch 1, turn. 3rd ROW: 1 sc in same space, \* sc in next ch 1 space, sc in next sdc, repeat from \* across row working an sc in 2nd st of end ch, ch 1, turn (64 sc). Work in pattern same as Sacque until Collar measures  $1\frac{3}{4}$  inches from beading ending on wrong side, cut Baby Pink. **NEXT ROW:** With right side

toward you attach Baby Pink at beginning of Collar and work edge same as sleeve edge working around entire outside edge. Lace ribbon through beading.

#### **CAP**

With White ch 69 to measure about 13 inches, sc in 2nd st from hook, dc in next st of ch, \* sc in next st, dc in next st, repeat from \* across ch, ch 1, turn. Work in pattern same as Sacque until Cap measures  $4\frac{1}{4}$  inches, cut yarn, turn.

**BACK SECTION:** Skip 21 sts, attach White in next st and work in pattern across 26 sts leaving last 21 sts free, ch 1, turn. Work in pattern for 3 more rows, ch 1, turn. **NEXT ROW:** Keeping pattern uniform decrease 1 st at beginning and end of row. Work 3 rows even in pattern. Repeat the last 4 rows twice, cut White. With Baby Pink crochet back seams together on right side with a row of sc.

**TURNBACK:** With right side of Cap toward you and with Baby Pink work 1 sc in each st of starting ch, ch 1, turn. 2nd ROW: Working through back loops of sts only 1 sc in 1st sc, dc in next sc, \* sc in next sc, dc in next sc, repeat from \* across row, drop Baby Pink. 3rd ROW: Attach White and working through both loops of sts, work in pattern, ch 1, turn. Work 1 more row in White, cut White. Pick up Baby Pink and work 3 rows in pattern, turn. 8th ROW: Ch 1,

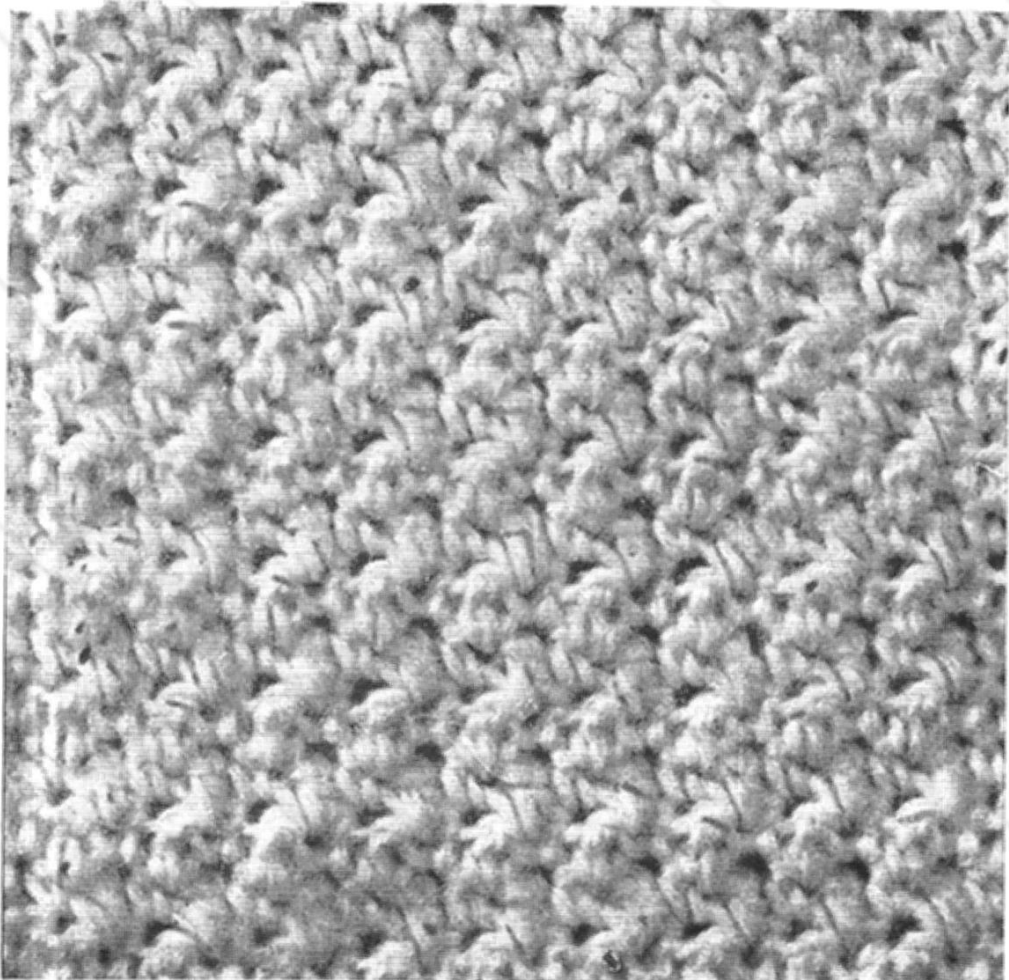

dc in same space, sl st in next st, \* ch 1, dc in next st, sl st in next st, repeat from \* across row, cut Baby Pink.

**NECK BAND:** With right side toward you attach White at lower edge and work 42 sc across neck edge working through both thicknesses of Turnback, cut White, turn. Attach Baby Pink, sc in 1st sc, dc in next sc, \* sc in next sc, dc in next sc, repeat from \* across row, turn. **NEXT ROW:** Same as 8th row of Turnback, cut yarn. Finish with ribbon ties.

### BOOTIES

**SOLE:** With White ch 14, 3 sc in 2nd st from hook, 1 sc in each of the next 11 sts of ch, 3 sc in last st, working on other side of ch, 1 sc in each of the next 11 sts, do not join this or following rounds, place a marker at beginning of each round. **2nd ROUND:** \* 2 sc in each of the next 3 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 11 sc, repeat from \* once. **3rd ROUND:** \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, repeat from \* twice, 1 sc in each of the next 12 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, repeat from \* once, 1 sc in each of the next 11 sc. **4th and 5th ROUNDS:** 1 sc in each sc on sides increasing 3 sc evenly spaced around each end in each round. **6th ROUND:** 1 sc in each sc. **7th ROUND:** Same as 4th round, sl st in next st to even round, ch 1, turn. **8th ROUND:** 1 sc in each st picking up entire st by inserting hook under entire st, join, ch 1, turn. This forms a ridge around Sole. **NEXT 3 ROUNDS:** 1 sc in each sc, do not join rounds. Fold in half lengthwise and mark center for toe. **12th ROUND:** 1 sc in each sc decreasing 3 sts evenly spaced around toe (to decrease: \* insert hook in next sc, pull loop through, repeat from \* once, yarn over and work off all loops at one time). **NEXT ROW:** 1 sc in each sc to within 4 sts from center of toe, then working in back loop of sts only work 1 sc in each of the next 8 sc, working through both loops of sts, sl st in each of the next 2 sc, ch 1, turn. **NEXT ROW:** Skip the 2 sl sts and working in back loop of sts, 1 sc in each of

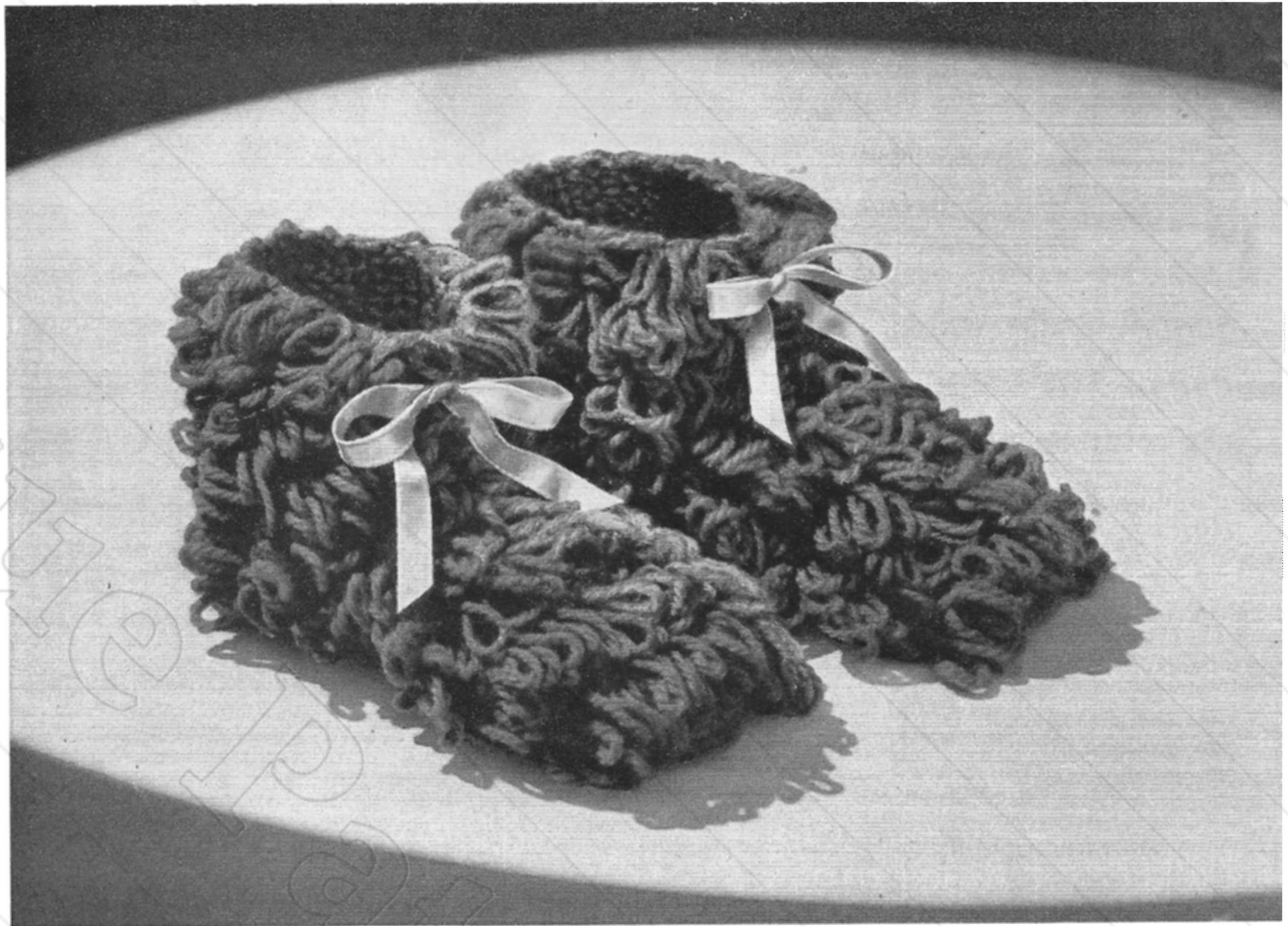


the next 8 sc, working through both loops of sts sl st in each of the next 2 sc on side of Bootie, ch 1, turn. **BEADING:** Ch 4, skip 1 sc, dc in next sc, \* ch 1, skip 1 sc, dc in next sc, repeat from \* all around, ch 1, join in 3rd st of ch. **NEXT ROUND:** Ch 1, 2 sc in each ch 1 space, join. **NEXT ROUND:** Ch 1, sc in same space, dc in next st, \* sc in next st, dc in next st, repeat from \* all around, join, turn. **NEXT ROUND:** Work in pattern same as Sacque working an sc in each dc and a dc in each sc, join, turn. **NEXT ROUND:** Same as last round, join, do not turn, cut White. **NEXT ROUND:** Attach Baby Pink and work 1 sc in each st decreasing 4 sts evenly spaced, join, ch 1, turn. **NEXT ROUND:** Start Cuff, working through back loop of sts only \* sc in next sc, dc in next sc, repeat from \* all around, join, turn. **NEXT ROUND:** Working through both loops of sts only work in pattern all around, join, turn. **NEXT ROUND:** Same as 8th row of Turnback of Cap. Lace ribbon through beading. Work other Bootie in same manner.

### MITTENS

With White ch 33 to measure about  $4\frac{3}{4}$  inches. Work in pattern same as Sacque until Mitten measures 2 inches from beginning. **NEXT ROW:** Sc in 1st st, dc in next sc, \* sc in next dc, dc in next sc, repeat from \* once, insert hook in next dc, pull loop through, skip next sc, insert hook in next dc, pull loop through, yarn over and work off all loops at one time (a decrease), \* work 5 sts, decrease in next 3 sts same as before, repeat from last \* once, work in pattern to end of row, ch 1, turn. Work 1 row even in pattern (26 sts), ch 1, turn. **NEXT ROW:** Work 2 sts, decrease in next 3 sts, \* work 5 sts, decrease in next 3 sts, repeat from \* once, work across remaining sts. Work 1 row even (20 sts). **NEXT ROW:** Decrease twice across row, cut yarn leaving an end, thread into needle and draw sts together. Sew side seam. Attach White at other side of starting ch, ch 4, skip 1 st, dc in next st, \* ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st, repeat from \* all around for beading, ch 1, join in 3rd st of ch. **NEXT ROW:** Ch 1 and work 2 sc in each ch 1 mesh, join. Work 4 rows in pattern joining each row and turning each row, cut White. **NEXT ROW:** Attach Baby Pink on wrong side and work 1 sc in each st, join, ch 1, do not turn. **NEXT ROW:** Working through back loops of sts only, \* sc in next st, dc in next st, repeat from \* all around, join, turn. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Working through both loops of sts work even in pattern, join each row but do not turn at end of last row. **NEXT ROW:** Same as 8th row of Turnback of Cap. Lace ribbon through beading. Work other Mitten in same manner.

**UPPER SECTION:** Starting at toe chain (ch) 18, to measure about 2 inches, 1 single crochet (sc) in 2nd stitch (st) from hook, 1 sc in each remaining st of ch, ch 1 to turn all rows. 2nd and 3rd ROWS: 1 sc in each sc. 4th ROW: 1 double loop st in each sc (double loop st: insert hook in st, wind yarn twice around index finger, pick up and pull both loops through st, yarn over and complete sc). 5th ROW: 1 sc in each loop st. 6th and 7th ROWS: 1 sc in each sc. Repeat last 4 rows 3 times, then repeat 4th row once. 21st ROW: 1 sc in each st. 22nd ROW: 1 sc in the 1st 12 sc, ch 1, turn. 23rd ROW: 1 sc in next 7 sc for instep, ch 1, turn. 24th ROW: Same as 4th row. NEXT 3 ROWS: Same as 5th, 6th and 7th rows. Repeat last 4 rows once, then repeat 4th row once (32 rows), cut yarn. Ch 12, and with wrong side of

Bootie facing, 1 sc in each of the next 5 sc to left of instep, ch 1, turn. NEXT ROW: 1 sc in each sc and 1 sc in each st of ch, ch 1, turn. NEXT ROW: Same as 4th row. NEXT 3 ROWS: Repeat 5th, 6th and 7th rows. Repeat last 4 rows 6 times, then repeat 4th row once, cut yarn leaving an end. Thread into needle and sew Bootie at side, then sew instep in position on both sides. Work another section in same manner.

**SOLE:** Ch 6, 1 sc in 2nd st from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1 to turn all rows. 2nd ROW: 2 sc in 1st and last sc, 1 sc in each sc between. NEXT 3 ROWS: Repeat 2nd row. 6th ROW: 1 sc in each sc. NEXT 6 ROWS: Repeat 6th row. 13th ROW: Decrease 1 st at beginning and end of row, 1 sc in each st between (to decrease: insert hook in st, pull loop through, insert hook in next st, pull loop through, yarn over and pull through all loops at one time). NEXT 4 ROWS: Work even. 18th ROW: Repeat 13th row. NEXT 3 ROWS: Work even. 22nd ROW: Increase in 1st and last st. NEXT 4 ROWS: Work even. 27th ROW: Same as 13th row. 28th ROW: Work even. 29th and 30th ROWS: Repeat last 2 rows. 31st ROW: Repeat 13th row, cut yarn. Work 3 more Sections in same manner. Crochet 2 Sole Sections together with a row of sc. Sew Sole Section to Upper Section. Sew a bow in position as illustrated.

**GAUGE:** 5 sts = 2 inches

With White cast on 70 stitches (sts) and work in garter st (Knit [K] each row) until Cover measures 36 inches, bind off.

**WEAVING:** Cover is woven with a double strand of yarn leaving 6 inches free on each end for fringe. 1st ROW: With White and starting in right hand corner and working to top of cover, skip 1st K st, \*\* insert needle down in next K st, \* skip 2 ridges on wrong side and bring needle up, skip 3 ridges on right side, insert needle down, repeat from \* to top of cover inserting needle up in last st. 2nd ROW: With White insert needle down in next cast on st and work same as 1st row. 3rd ROW: With White insert needle up in next cast on st, \* skip 2 ridges on right side, insert needle down, skip 3 ridges on wrong side and bring needle up, repeat from \* to top of cover inserting needle down in bound off st. Repeat from \*\* for entire cover working 5 more

rows White, 1 row Aquamarine Blue, 2 rows Pearl Gray, 1 row Aquamarine Blue, 2 rows Buttercup, 1 row Aquamarine Blue, 2 rows Shell Pink, 1 row Aquamarine Blue, 2 rows Pearl Gray, 1 row Aquamarine Blue, 2 rows Shell Pink, 1 row Aquamarine Blue, 2 rows Buttercup, 1 row Aquamarine Blue, 2 rows Pearl Gray and 1 row Aquamarine Blue. Repeat color scheme from beginning once, then work 8 rows White. Trim fringe evenly.

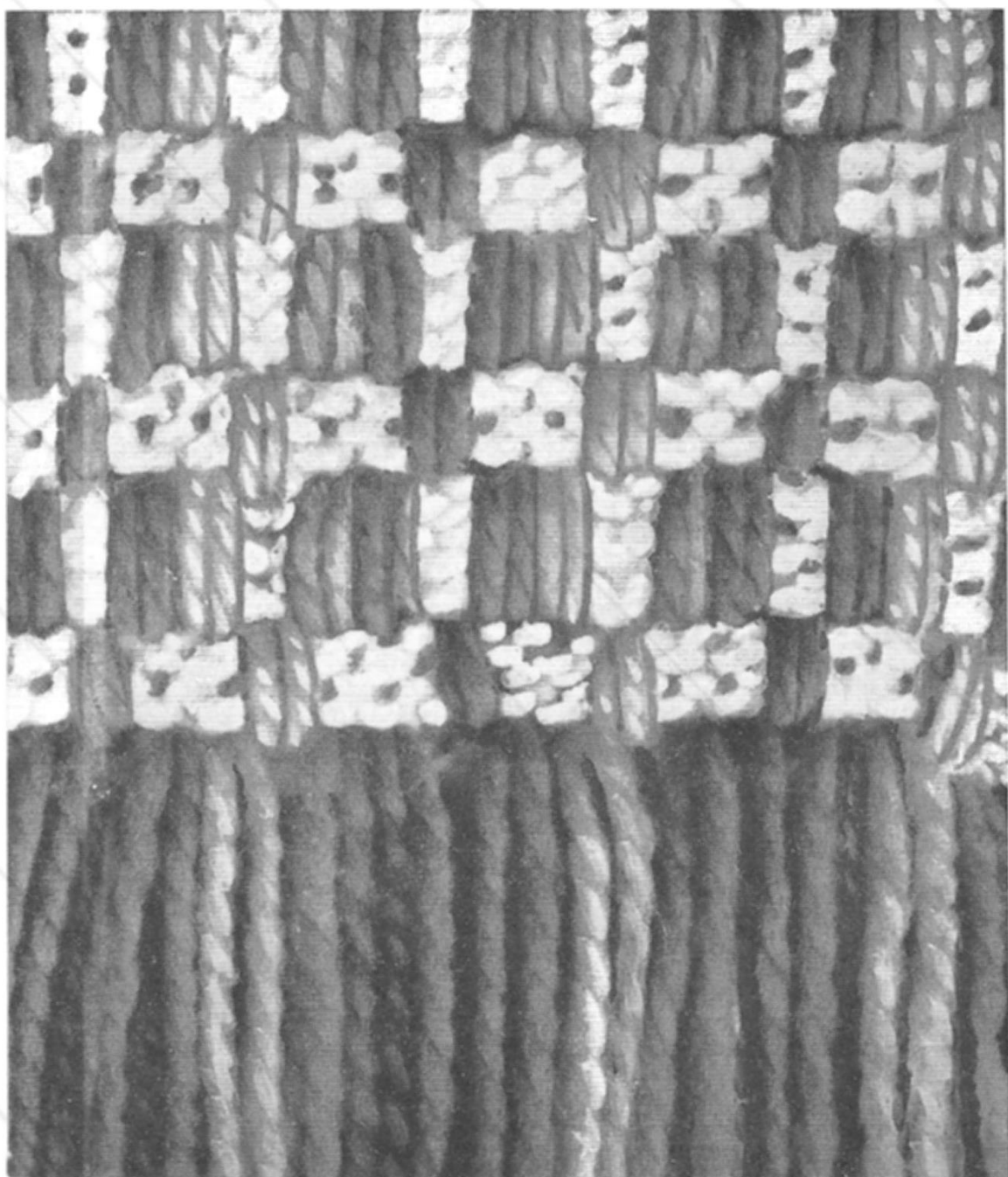

NOTE: Double loop sts will be referred to as loop sts from now on. 3rd ROUND: 1 sc in each sc increasing 4 sts evenly spaced. 4th ROUND: 1 loop st in each of the next 3 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 7 sts, 1 loop st in each of the next 3 sts. 5th ROUND: 1 sc in each st increasing 4 sts evenly spaced. 6th ROUND: 1 loop st in each of the next 4 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 9 sts, 1 loop st in each of the next 4 sts. 7th ROUND: Repeat 5th round. 8th ROUND: 1 loop st in each of the next 7 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 7 sc, 1 loop st in each of the next 7 sc. 9th ROUND: Repeat 5th round. 10th ROUND: 1 loop st in each of the next 9 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 7 sc, 1 loop st in each of the next 9 sc. 11th ROUND: 1 sc in each st (25 sc). 12th ROUND: 1 loop st in each of the next 10 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 5 sc, 1 loop st in each of the next 10 sc. 13th ROUND: 1 sc in each st decreasing 4 sts evenly spaced (to decrease: \* insert hook in next st, pull







loop through, repeat from \* once, yarn over and work off all loops at one time). 14th ROUND: 1 loop st in each of the next 9 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc, 1 loop st in each of the next 9 sc. 15th ROUND: Same as 13th round. 16th ROUND: 1 loop st in each of the next 8 sc, 1 sc in next sc, 1 loop st in each of the next 8 sc. 17th ROUND: 1 sc in each st decreasing 3 sts evenly spaced. 18th ROUND: 1 loop st in each sc, join, cut yarn.

**BODY:** Ch 11, 1 sc in 2nd st from hook, 1 sc in each st of ch, ch 1 to turn all rows. 2nd ROW: 1 loop st in each sc. 3rd ROW: 1 sc in each st. Repeat last 2 rows until work measures about  $4\frac{1}{4}$  inches ending with a loop st row, cut yarn. Work another section in same manner.

**FRONT LEGS:** Ch 7, 1 sc in 2nd st from hook, 1 sc in each st of ch, ch 1 to turn all rows. 2nd ROW: 1 sc in each sc. 3rd ROW: 1 loop st in each sc. Repeat last 2 rows until leg section measures about 5 inches from beginning ending with a loop st row, cut yarn. Work another section in same manner.

**HIND LEGS:** Ch 8, 1 sc in 2nd st from hook, 1 sc in each st of ch, ch 1 to turn all rows. 2nd ROW: 1 sc in each sc. 3rd ROW: 1 loop st in each sc. Repeat last 2 rows until leg section measures about 7 inches

ending with a loop st row, cut yarn. Work another section in same manner.

**EARS:** Ch 2, 2 sc in 2nd st from hook, ch 1 to turn all rows. 2nd ROW: 1 loop st in each st. 3rd ROW: 2 sc in each st. 4th ROW: 1 loop st in each st. 5th ROW: 2 sc in 1st st, 1 sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in last st. 6th ROW: 1 loop st in each st, cut yarn. Work another section in same manner.

**TAIL:** Ch 4, 1 sc in 2nd st from hook, 1 sc in each st of ch, ch 1 to turn all rows. 2nd ROW: 1 loop st in each sc. 3rd ROW: 1 sc in each st. Repeat last 2 rows until tail section measures 8 inches, cut yarn.

**TO ASSEMBLE:** Fill head with cotton. Sew sides of body together leaving about 2 inches free from shoulders for front leg opening. Sew across lower edge then fill with cotton. Sew top and shoulders of body. Sew head to center of top of body section. Fill front legs slightly with cotton and sew all around. Sew in position having the sc section for paws. Fill hind legs in same manner and sew as illustrated. Sew ears in position. With "AUNT LYDIA'S" CARPET and BUTTON THREAD sew 4 long stitches on paws. Sew Tail same as front leg, but do not fill, sew tail in position. Cut features as illustrated from felt and sew or paste in place.

**SOLES:** Work same as Soles of Loop st Booties on Page 23 having 72 sc in last row.

**UPPER SECTION:** Fold sole in half lengthwise, mark center of heel. Attach Lt. Blue at center, 1 sc, 1 dc in same space, \* skip next sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, repeat from \* 15 times, skip 1 sc, \* 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, repeat from \* 4 times, \* skip next sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, repeat from \* 15 times, join in 1st sc, ch 1, turn. 2nd ROW: 1 sc in each st, join, drop Lt. Blue, attach White, ch 1, turn. 3rd ROW: 1 sc, 1 dc in same space, \* skip next sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, repeat from \* all around, join in 1st sc, ch 1, turn. 4th ROW: 1 sc in each st, join, drop White. Repeat the 3rd and 4th rows once, drop Lt. Blue, pick up White, ch 1, turn. 7th ROW: Repeat 3rd row. 8th ROW: 1 sc in each of the 1st 27 sts, \* decrease in next 2 sts (to decrease: insert hook in st, pull loop through, insert hook in next st, pull loop through, yarn over and work off all loops at one time) repeat from \* 10 times, 1 sc in each of the next 27 sts, drop White, pick up Lt. Blue, join, ch 1, turn. 9th ROW: 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, directly over the sc of previous row, \* skip next sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, repeat from \* 15 times, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, \* skip next st, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, repeat from \* 14 times, join, ch 1, turn. 10th ROW: 1 sc in each st, join, cut yarn. **INSERT:** With Lt. Blue ch 7, sc in 2nd st from hook, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sts, 3 sc in next st, working on opposite side of ch, 1 sc in each of the next 5 sts, ch 1, turn. 2nd ROW: 2 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, 2 sc in each of the next 3 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, ch 1, turn. 3rd ROW: Working in sc work 2 sc in 1st and last sc, ch 1, turn. 4th ROW: 2 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in each of the next 8 sc, 2 sc in each of the next 2 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 8 sc, 3 sc in next sc, 1 sc in end of each of the next 5 rows, join in 1st sc, cut yarn leaving a length for sewing. Sew this section to last row of slipper at instep leaving 8 sts of this section free and 20 sc free on each side of slipper (48 free sc).

**BEADING:** Attach Lt. Blue at joining at back of slipper, ch 4, skip next sc, dc in next sc, \* ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next sc, repeat from \* all around, ch 1, join, cut yarn, do not turn.

**EDGE:** Attach White in same space, then work 1 sc,

ch 3, 1 sc in each mesh, join, cut yarn. Starting at heel lace narrow ribbon through beading, tie with a bow.

**POMPON:** Wind Lt. Blue and White together over a 4 inch cardboard 50 times, remove from cardboard, tie in center, cut both ends. Trim and sew to slipper as illustrated. Work another slipper in same manner.

**ROW:** 1 sc in each of the next 22 sc, sl st in next st, do not drop White, ch 1, turn. 17th ROW: Skip the sl st, sl st in next st, drop White, with Lt. Blue \* 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, skip next sc, repeat from \* across row ending with sc in last sc. 18th ROW: 1 sc in each of the next 21 sts, drop Lt. Blue. 19th ROW: With White 1 sc, 1 dc in 1st sc, \* skip next sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, repeat from \* across row ending with skip next sc, sc in last sc. 20th ROW: 1 sc in each sc, drop White. 21st ROW: With Lt. Blue 1 sc, 1 dc in 1st sc, \* skip next sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, repeat from \* 6 times, skip next st, sc in next st, sl st in each of the last 4 sts. 22nd ROW: Sl st across the 1st 10 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 11 sts, drop Lt. Blue. 23rd ROW: With White 1 sc, 1 dc in 1st sc, \* skip next sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, repeat from \* once, skip next st, sl st in next st, ch 1, turn. 24th ROW: Skip the sl st, sl st in each of the next 3 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 3 sts, cut yarn.

**LEFT FRONT YOKE:** Work 1st 12 rows same as Back Yoke. 13th ROW: With Lt. Blue 1 sc, 1 dc in 1st sc, \* skip next sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, repeat from \* 12 times, skip next sc, sl st in next sc, ch 1, turn. 14th ROW: Skip the sl st, 1 sc in each remaining st, drop Lt. Blue. 15th ROW: With White work in same manner as 13th row but repeat from \* 10 times. 16th ROW: Repeat 14th row, drop White. 17th ROW: With Lt. Blue work in same manner as 13th row but repeat from \* 8 times. 18th ROW: 1 sc in each st, drop Lt. Blue. 19th and 20th ROWS: With White repeat the 3rd and 4th rows of Back Yoke. **NEXT 4 ROWS:** Repeat the 21st, 22nd, 23rd and 24th rows of Back Yoke, cut yarn. Cut lining same size as each section of Yoke. Sew all shoulder seams. Attach Lt. Blue in corner st at lower front edge of Right Front, working up front, working Lt. Blue over Lt. Blue and White over White work 3 sc on side of each row, cut White, with Lt. Blue work 71 sc around neck edge, work down side of Left Front Yoke in same manner, cut White, with Lt. Blue work 29 sc across lower edge of yoke to corner, 3 sc in corner, working along shoulder edge work 45 sc to next corner, 3 sc in corner, work 47 sc across lower edge of Back Yoke, 3 sc in corner, work other shoulder edge and Front Yoke same as opposite side, cut yarn, do not turn.

**BEADING:** (for outer edge of yoke) Attach Lt. Blue in corner st of lower edge of Left Front Yoke work-

ing across Yoke ch 5, skip next sc, treble crochet (trc) in next sc, \* ch 1, skip next sc, trc in next sc, repeat from \* to within 2 sc of corner sc, ch 1, skip next sc, 3 trc with ch 1 between each trc in corner st, then repeat from 1st \* 3 times, \* ch 1, skip next sc, trc in next trc, repeat from \* to end of row, cut yarn, do not turn.

**EDGE:** Attach White in 4th st of ch, sc in same space, \* ch 1, 4 dc with ch 1 between each dc in next trc (dc shell), ch 1, sc in next trc, repeat from \* all around, cut yarn.

**BEADING FOR NECK EDGE:** Attach Lt. Blue in 6th sc from top corner of Right Front Yoke, ch 5, skip next sc, dc in next sc, \* ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next sc, repeat from \* 28 times, cut yarn, do not turn. With White work edge in same manner as above.

**FINISHING:** Turn under a small hem along all edges of lining and baste to wrong side of Yoke. Hem lining to Yoke working along the sc row of Yoke leaving Beading and Edge free.

**SLEEVES:** With Lt. Blue ch 40 and work 1st 4 rows same as Back Yoke alternating color of stripes and ending last row with ch 3, turn. 5th ROW: 1 sc in 2nd st from hook, \* skip next st, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, repeat from \* across row ending with skip next st, sc in last st. 6th ROW: 1 sc in each st, ch 3, turn. Repeat the last 2 rows 8 times ending last row with ch 1, turn. Repeat the 3rd and 4th rows of Back Yoke 5 times. 33rd ROW: Repeat 3rd row. 34th ROW: 1 sc in each st to within last 2 sts, sl st in next st, ch 1, turn. 35th ROW: Skip the sl st, \* 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, skip next sc, repeat from \* across row ending with sc in last sc. Repeat the last 2 rows 7 times. 50th ROW: 1 sc in each st. Repeat the 3rd and 4th rows 3 times, cut yarn at end of last row. Sew side seams. With right side of work toward you attach Lt. Blue at cuff edge of seam, work 4 sc in stripe at seam then work 1 sc in each stripe, join, do not turn.

**BEADING:** Ch 4, skip next sc, dc in next sc, \* ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next sc, repeat from \* all around ending with ch 1, join in 3rd st of ch, cut yarn.

**EDGE:** Attach White in joining and work in same manner as edge for yoke but working into the dc instead of trc. Work another sleeve in same manner.

**RIGHT FRONT SKIRT:** With Lt. Blue ch 114, 1 sc, 1 dc in 2nd st from hook, \* skip next st of ch, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, repeat from \* across ch ending with skip next st, sc in last st, ch 1, turn. 2nd ROW: 1 sc in each st, drop Lt. Blue, attach White, ch 1, turn. 3rd ROW: 1 sc, 1 dc in 1st sc, \* skip next sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, repeat from \* across row ending with skip next sc, sc in last sc, ch 1, turn. 4th ROW: 1 sc in each of the 1st 64 sts, ch 2, \* skip next 2 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 10 sts, repeat from \* 3 times, drop White. Repeat the 3rd and 4th rows of Back Yoke 21 times alternating color of stripes. 47th ROW: With White repeat 3rd row. 48th ROW: 1 sc in each st to within last 4 sts, drop

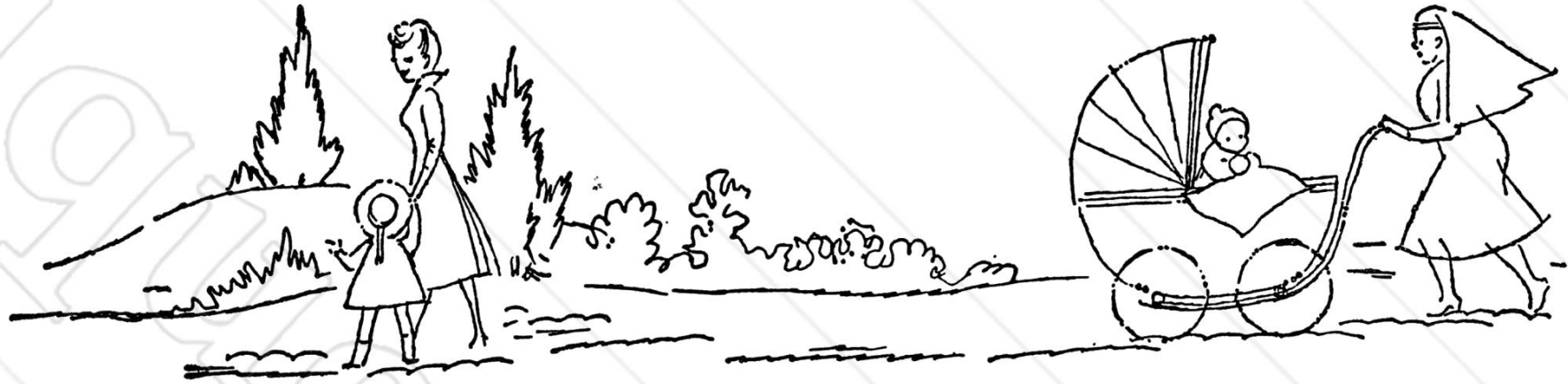
White, with Lt. Blue ch 1, turn. 49th ROW: Repeat 3rd row. 50th ROW: 1 sc in each st to within last 2 sts, drop Lt. Blue, with White ch 1, turn. Repeat last 2 rows once. Repeat the 3rd and 4th rows of Back Yoke twice alternating color of stripes. 57th ROW: Repeat 3rd row. 58th ROW: 1 sc in each st to within last 7 sts, sl st in next st, drop Lt. Blue, with White ch 1, turn. 59th ROW: Skip the sl st and 1st sc, \* 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, skip next sc, repeat from \* across row ending with sc in last sc. Repeat the last 2 rows 4 times alternating color of stripes. 68th ROW: 1 sc in each sc to within last 9 sts, sl st in next st, ch 1, turn. 69th ROW: Repeat 59th row. Repeat the last 2 rows 3 times. 76th ROW: Repeat 68th row, cut yarn.

**LEFT FRONT SKIRT:** With Lt. Blue ch 114 and work 1st 2 rows same as Back Yoke. Repeat the 3rd and 4th rows of Back Yoke 22 times alternating color of stripes. 47th ROW: Repeat 3rd row of Back Yoke. 48th ROW: Sl st across 1st 4 sts, 1 sc in each remaining st, drop White with Lt. Blue ch 1, turn. 49th ROW: Repeat 3rd row of Back Yoke to within the 4 sl sts at end of row, ch 1, turn. 50th ROW: Sl st across 1st 2 sts, 1 sc in each remaining st, drop Lt. Blue. 51st ROW: Repeat 3rd row to within last 2 sl sts, ch 1, turn. Repeat the last 2 rows once. 54th ROW: 1 sc in each st. Repeat 3rd and 4th rows of Back Yoke once. 57th ROW: Repeat 3rd row. 58th ROW: Sl st across 1st 8 sts, 1 sc in each remaining st, ch 1, turn. 59th ROW: Repeat 3rd row to within the sl sts at end of row ending with a sl st in last sc. 60th ROW: Skip the sl st and 1 dc, sl st in each of the next 6 sts, 1 sc in each remaining st. Repeat the last 2 rows 3 times. 67th ROW: Repeat the 59th row. 68th ROW: Skip the sl st and 1 dc, sl st in each of the next 8 sts, 1 sc in each remaining st, ch 1, turn. Repeat the last 2 rows 4 times, cut yarn.

**SKIRT BACK:** Starting with Lt. Blue work same as Right Front Skirt for the 1st 38 rows omitting the buttonholes and alternating colors of stripes, then repeat from the 47th to the last row. With right side of 1st row toward you and working along starting ch attach White, repeat the 3rd and 4th rows of Back Yoke 18 times, then repeat from the 47th to the last row of Left Front Skirt. Block each section. Sew side seams matching the color of the stripes. With Lt. Blue work a row of sc along each front edge of skirt, work sc along the lower edge matching the colors.

**FINISHING:** Gather upper straight edge of Left Front of Skirt to fit Left Front Yoke. Adjusting gathers evenly over cast Skirt to Yoke along starting ch of Yoke leaving the beading and edge free on the right side. Sew Right Front of Skirt to Right Yoke and Back of Skirt to Back Yoke in same manner. Sew Sleeves and buttons in position. Lace narrow ribbon through beading at Sleeve and Neck edges, tie with a bow. Lace 1/2 inch ribbon through beading around outer edge of Yoke.

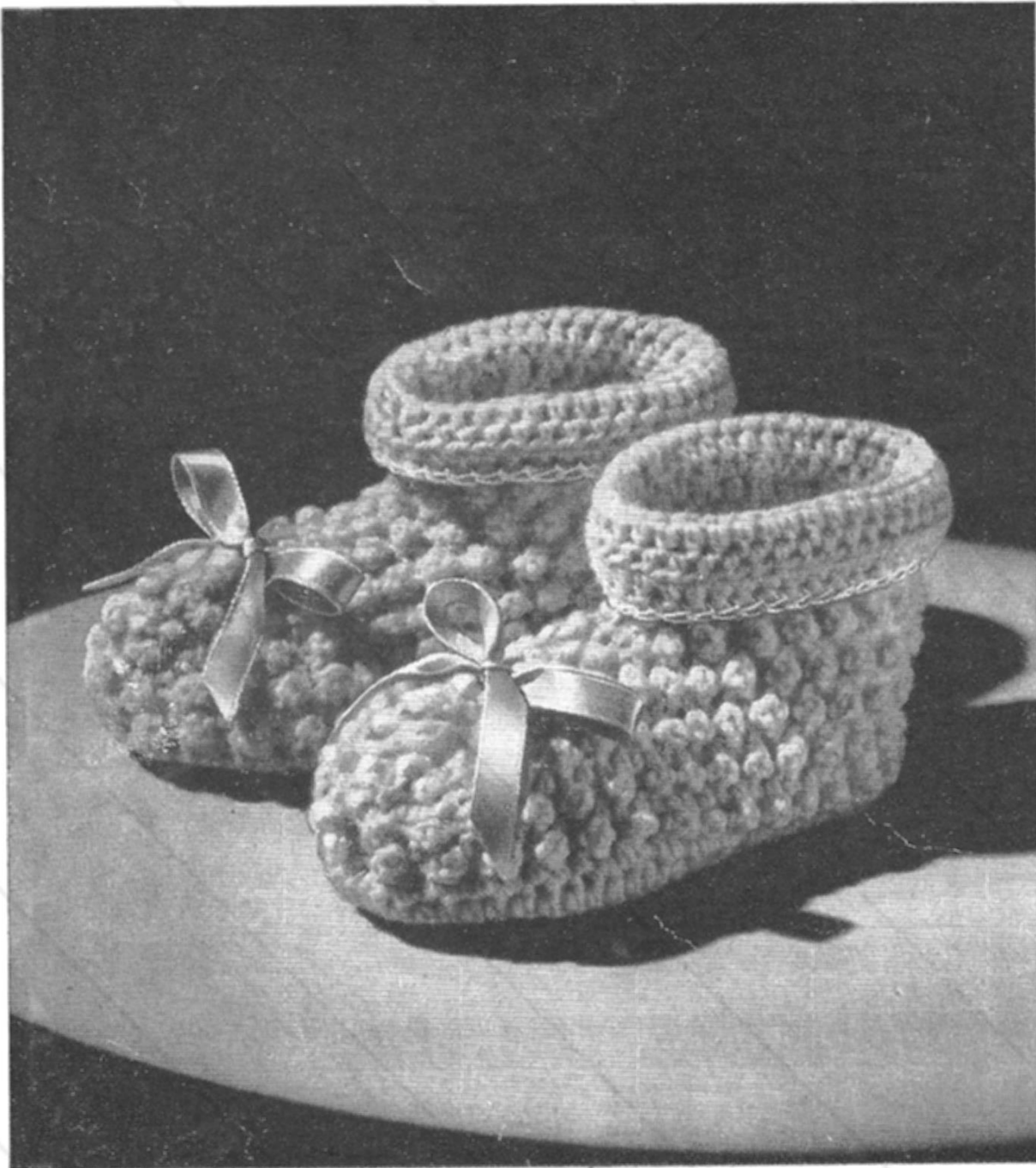

### SACQUE

**FRONTS:** Chain (ch) 36, 1 short double crochet (sdc) in 3rd stitch (st) from hook (sdc: yarn over, insert in st, pull loop through, yarn over and pull through all 3 loops at one time), \* ch 4, slip (sl) st in 1st st of ch for picot, skip next st of ch, 1 sdc in each of the next 2 sts of ch, repeat from \* across ch, ch 1, turn. 2nd ROW: 2 single crochet (sc) between 1st 2 sdc, \* ch 1, 2 sc between next 2 sdc, repeat from \* across row, ch 2, turn. 3rd ROW: Skip 1 sc, 1 sdc in next sc, \* ch 4, sl st in 4th st of ch for picot, 1 sdc in each of the next 2 sc, repeat from \* across row, ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows for pattern. Work even in pattern until fronts measures 10 1/2 inches ending with 2nd row of pattern, cut yarn.

**BACK:** Ch 84 and work in pattern for 10 1/2 inches same as fronts, cut yarn.

**SLEEVES:** Ch 57 and work in pattern for 6 1/2 inches, cut yarn.

**FINISHING:** Sew sleeve seams. Sew side seams leaving 4 inches free for armhole. Sew 4 inches across each side for shoulder seams. With right side of work toward you join yarn in center of back neck edge, ch 2, work a row of sdc all around edges working 1 sdc in each sc and 1 sdc in each skipped st of ch, 3 sdc in each corner st and 2 sdc over each sdc on sides, join. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** Ch 2, 1 sdc in each sdc working 3 sdc in each corner st, joining and turning each row, cut yarn.

**UNDER COLLAR:** Ch 55, sdc in 3rd st from hook, 1 sdc in each remaining st of ch, ch 2, turn. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** 1 sdc in each sdc, ch 2, turn at end of each row, cut yarn. Sew under collar in position. With wrong side of sacque toward you attach RAYON CROCHET in corner st and working across collar and through both thicknesses, work 1 sc in each st working 3 sc in each corner st, join, cut thread. With right side of sacque toward you attach RAYON CROCHET at left neck edge and work 1 sc in each st, 3 sc in each corner st. Work 10 button-holes evenly spaced on right front placing 1st button-



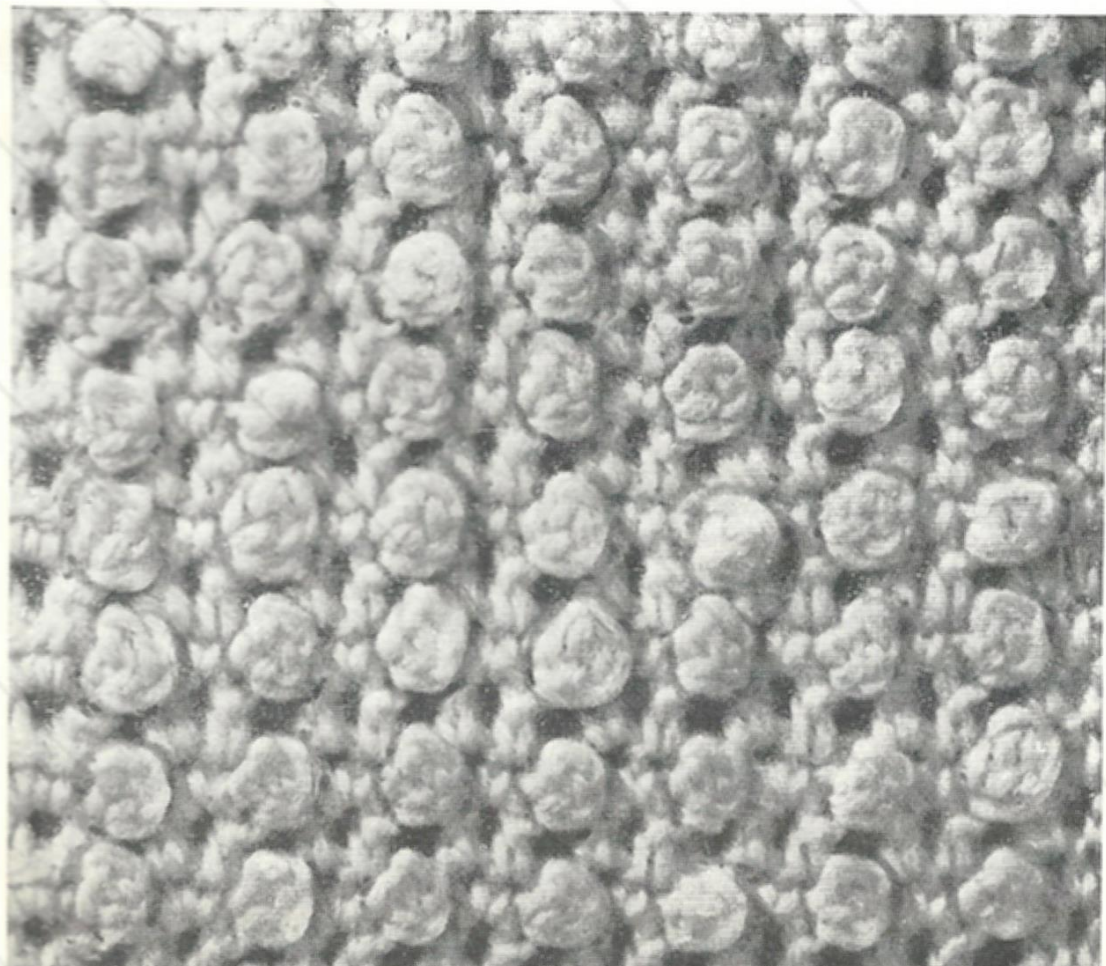
hole  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch from lower edge and last buttonhole  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inches from top.

**BUTTONHOLE:** Work 1 sc, ch 5, 1 sc in same sc. Sew buttons in position. Attach yarn in sleeve seam and work 2 sdc in each ch 1 space, join, turn. **NEXT 4 ROWS:** Ch 2, 1 sdc in each sdc, join each row and turn each row, cut yarn. **NEXT ROW:** Attach RAYON CROCHET and work 1 sc in each sdc, join, cut thread.

#### CAP

Ch 87 and work in pattern for 8 inches, cut yarn. Fold in half and seam short edge for back of Cap. With RAYON CROCHET and right side of Cap facing, join between 2 sdc of 2nd group of sdc and work 1 sc between 2 sdc of each succeeding row to back seam, cut thread. \* Skip 4 picots and 3 groups of 2 sdc, join RAYON CROCHET between 2 sdc of next group of sdc and work 1 sc between each 2 sdc of each succeeding row as before, cut thread. Repeat from \* twice, then skip 2 picots and 1 group of sdc, join RAYON CROCHET between next 2 sdc of next sdc group and complete row to correspond. \* Skip 4 picots and 3 sdc groups and work RAYON CROCHET row between next group of 2 sdc. Repeat from \* twice, cut thread.

**BORDER:** With right side facing join yarn in corner st, and work 2 sdc in each ch 1 space across front,



1 sdc in each row across lower edge decreasing every 2nd st and working 3 sdc in each corner, join, turn. **2nd ROW:** Ch 2, 1 sdc in each sdc working 3 sdc in each corner sdc, join. Repeat 2nd row 3 times, join and turn each row, cut yarn. **NEXT ROW:** Join RAYON CROCHET and work 1 sc in each sdc working 3 sc in each corner st, join, cut thread. Finish with ribbons ties as illustrated.

#### MITTENS

Ch 33 and work in pattern until there are 8 picot rows. **16th ROW:** Skip 1st group of 2 sdc, \* 2 sc between next 2 sdc groups, repeat from \* twice, 1 sc between each of next 3 groups of sdc, \* 2 sc between next group of 2 sdc, repeat from \* twice, sc between last group of 2 sdc, ch 2, turn. **17th ROW:** Yarn over, insert hook in next sc, pull through, yarn over, insert in next sc, pull through, yarn over and pull through all loops at one time (a decrease), \* ch 4 picot, 1 sdc in each of the next 2 sc, repeat from \* twice, ch 4 picot, skip next sc and complete row in picot pattern. **18th ROW:** Work even in sc pattern. **19th ROW:** Work even in picot pattern. **20th ROW:** 1 sc between each group of 2 sdc, cut yarn leaving an end.

**CUFF:** With right side facing join yarn in 1st st and work 1 sc in each sdc and each ch 1 space, ch 2, join, turn. **2nd ROW:** Work 1 sdc in each sc, ch 2, turn and work 4 more rows of sdc, cut yarn. Join

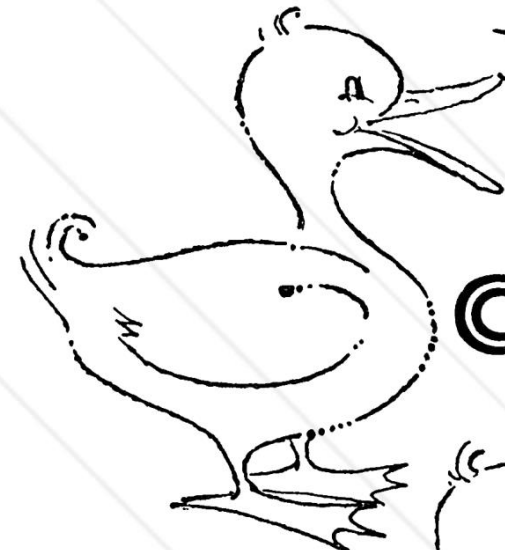
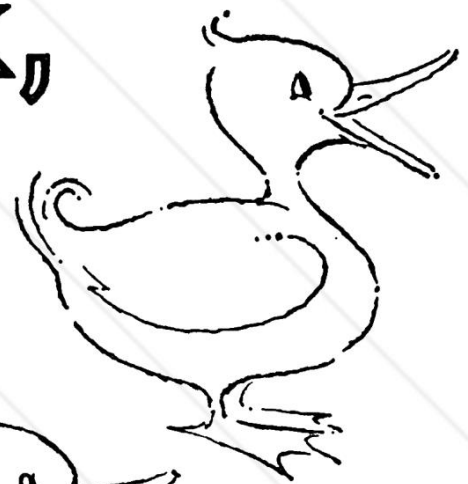

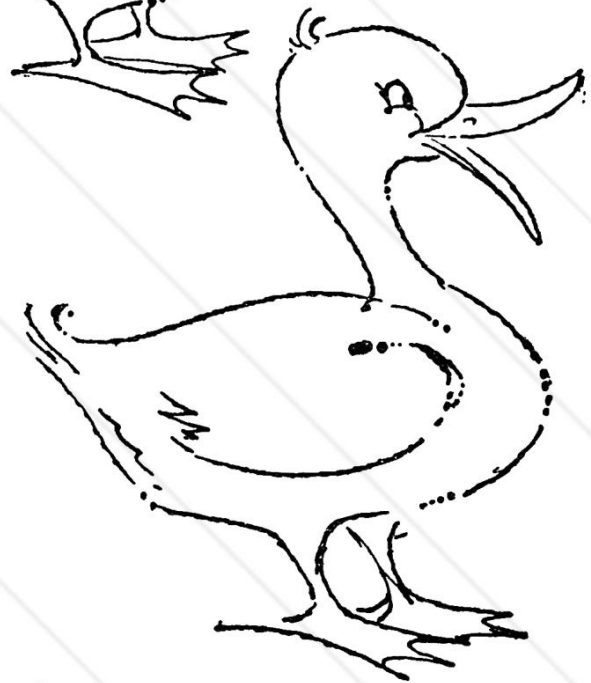

Join yarn in center st at heel, working in back loop of sts only work 1 sdc in each sc decreasing 1 st on each side of toe, join, turn. 2nd ROUND: Ch 2, working through both loops of sts only, 1 sdc in next sdc, \* ch 4, sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, 1 sdc in each of the next 2 sdc, repeat from \* all around ending with ch 4, sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, join, turn. 3rd ROUND: Ch 1, always holding picot to front, 2 sc between each sdc group, join, turn, sl st to next sc. Repeat last 2 rounds 3 times, then repeat 2nd round once, join, turn. 11th ROUND: Work in sc same as 3rd round but working 1 sc between each of 15 sdc groups around toe and instep section, complete remainder of round with 2 sdc between sdc groups, join, cut yarn. Seam 2 inches from center of toe for instep, then repeat 2nd and 3rd rounds twice, join, turn. NEXT ROUND: Ch 2, 1 sdc in each sc, join, turn. NEXT 4 ROUNDS: Ch 2, 1 sdc in each sdc, join and turn each round, cut yarn. Fold cuff over, join RAYON CROCHET and work 1 sc in each sdc, join, cut thread. Finish with bow at base of instep.

Note: double loop sts will be referred to as loop sts from now on. 3rd ROW: 2 sc in each st. 4th ROW: 1 loop st in each sc. 5th ROW: 2 sc in 1st st, 1 sc in each of the next 2 sts, 2 sc in last st. 6th ROW: 1 loop st in each sc. 7th ROW: 2 sc in

1st st, 1 sc in each sc to within last sc, 2 sc in last st.  
8th ROW: Repeat 7th row. Repeat last row 5 times.  
14th ROW: 1 sc in each sc. Repeat last row 3 times.  
18th ROW: Repeat 7th row (22 sc). 19th ROW: 1 sc in each sc. 20th ROW: Repeat 7th row. 21st ROW: Repeat 19th row. 22nd and 23rd ROWS: Repeat 7th row (28 sc). Work 4 rows even. 28th ROW: Repeat 7th row (30 sc). Work 12 rows even. 41st ROW: Decrease 1 sc at beginning and end of row (to decrease: insert hook in st, pull loop through, insert hook in next st, pull through, yarn over and work off all loops at one time). Work 2 rows even. 44th ROW: Repeat 41st row. Repeat last row 7 times (12 sc), do not turn. Work a row of sc all around section working 1 sc in each row and 1 sc in each sc, cut yarn. Work another section in same manner.

**HEAD:** Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd st from hook, place a marker at beginning of each round and do not join. 2nd ROUND: 2 sc in each sc. 3rd ROUND: 1 sc in each sc, 4th ROUND: Working in sc increase 4 sts evenly spaced. 5th ROUND: 1 sc in each sc (16 sc). 6th ROUND: Repeat 4th round but increase 6 sts evenly spaced. 7th ROUND: Repeat 5th round. 8th ROUND: Repeat 6th round. 9th ROUND: Repeat 5th round (28 sc), ch 1, join, turn. 10th ROW: 1 sc in each of the next 14 sc, ch 1 to turn all rows. 11th ROW: Decrease 1 st at beginning and end of row. 12th ROW: 1 sc in each sc. 13th ROW: Repeat 11th row. 14th ROW: Repeat 12th row. 15th and 16th ROWS: Repeat 11th row. 17th and 18th ROWS: Repeat 12th row. 19th ROW: Working in sc increase 2 sts evenly spaced. 20th ROW: 1 sc in each sc increasing 3 sts evenly spaced. 21st ROW: 1 sc in each sc. 22nd ROW: 1 sc in each sc increasing 4 sts evenly spaced. 23rd and 24th ROWS: 1 sc in each sc, cut yarn.

**FRONT NECK SECTION:** Attach Lt. Yellow at end of last round of head, 1 sc in same space, 1 sc in each of the next 13 sc, ch 1 to turn all rows. 2nd ROW: 1 sc in each sc (14 sc). 3rd ROW: 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, ch 6 for mouth opening, skip next 6 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc. 4th ROW: 1 sc in each sc, 1 sc in each st of ch, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc. 5th ROW: 1 sc in each sc. 6th ROW: Decrease in 1st 2 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 10 sc, decrease in next 2 sc. 7th ROW: 1 sc in each sc. 8th ROW: Decrease in 1st 2 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 8 sc, decrease in next 2 sc. 9th ROW: Repeat last row but having 2 sts less between decreases. 10th and 11th ROWS: Repeat 7th row. 12th ROW: Repeat 9th row. 13th ROW: Repeat 7th row. 14th ROW: 1 sc in each sc increasing 2 sts evenly spaced. 15th ROW: Repeat last row increasing 3 sts evenly spaced. 16th ROW: 1 sc in each sc. 17th ROW: Repeat 14th row but increasing 5 sts evenly spaced. 18th ROW: Repeat last row (21 sc). 19th ROW: 1 sc in each sc, cut yarn.

**BEAK:** With right side of work toward you attach Orange at right side of mouth opening, 1 sc in same space, 1 sc in each of the next 6 sts, 1 sc on side of opening, 1 sc in each sc (14 sc), join, ch 1, turn. 2nd ROW: 1 sc in each of the next 7 sc, ch 1 to turn all rows. 3rd ROW: 1 sc in each sc. 4th ROW: Decrease 1 st in 1st 2 sc, 1 sc in each sc, decrease in last 2 sc. 5th ROW: 1 sc in each sc. 6th ROW: Decrease in 1st 2 sc, 1 sc in next sc, decrease in next 2 sc, cut yarn. Attach Orange at right side of under section of beak and work 1 sc in each of the next 7 sc, ch 1 to turn all rows. Repeat 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th rows of beak once. NEXT ROW: 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, work 5 sc on side of beak and complete beak in same manner, join, cut yarn.

**LEFT WING:** With Lt. Yellow, ch 2, 2 sc in 2nd st from hook, ch 1 to turn all rows. 2nd ROW: 1 loop st in each sc. 3rd ROW: 2 sc in each st. 4th ROW: 1 loop st in each sc. 5th ROW: 2 sc in 1st st, 1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in last st. 6th ROW: Repeat 2nd row. 7th ROW: 2 sc in 1st st, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sts, 2 sc in last st. 8th ROW: Repeat 2nd row. 9th ROW: 1 sc in each of the next 6 sts, decrease in last 2 sts. 10th ROW: Repeat 2nd row. 11th ROW: 1 sc in each st. 12th ROW: Repeat 2nd row. 13th ROW: 2 sc in 1st st, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sts, decrease in next 2 sts. 14th ROW: 1 loop st in each st. 15th ROW: 1 sc in each sc. 16th ROW: Repeat 2nd row. 17th ROW: Decrease in 1st 2 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sts, 2 sc in last st. 18th ROW: Repeat 2nd row. 19th ROW: 1 sc in each sc. 20th ROW: Repeat 2nd row. 21st ROW: Decrease in 1st 2 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 3 sts, decrease in next 2 sts. 22nd ROW: Repeat 2nd row. 23rd ROW: Decrease in 1st 2 sts, 1 sc in next sc, decrease in next 2 sc. 24th ROW: Repeat 2nd row, cut yarn.

**RIGHT WING:** Work 1st 8 rows of Left Wing. 9th ROW: Decrease in 1st 2 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 6 sts. 10th ROW: 1 loop st in each sc. 11th ROW: 1 sc in each st. 12th ROW: Repeat 10th row. 13th ROW: Decrease in 1st 2 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sts, 2 sc in last st. 14th ROW: Repeat 10th row. 15th ROW: Repeat 11th row. 16th ROW: Repeat 10th row. 17th ROW: 2 sc in 1st st, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sts, decrease in next 2 sts. 18th ROW: Repeat 10th row. 19th ROW: 1 sc in each st. 20th ROW: Repeat 10th row. 21st ROW: Decrease in next 2 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 3 sts, decrease in next 2 sts. 22nd ROW: Repeat 10th row. 23rd ROW: Decrease in 1st 2 sts, 1 sc in next st, decrease in next 2 sts. 24th ROW: Repeat 10th row, cut yarn.

**TO ASSEMBLE:** Sew sides of head and neck sections. Fill head and neck with cotton. Sew the 2 body sections together leaving an opening for filling. Fill with cotton and sew opening closed. Sew head and wings to body as illustrated. Cut eyes and nostrils from felt and sew or paste in place.
