These all-year-round crochet trims will give you a variety of ensembles. Note the riety of ensembles. Note the clever use of doilies in sketch 2601--lovely fringe for epaullettes in sketch 2604--and we know you'll want to make miles of our special crocheted braid for trimming crocheted braid for trimming your dress, your suit, your hat. This braid (in different sizes) is shown in sketches 2606 and 2608 opposite and pages 7 for suits and 10 and 11 for hats.

We have illustrated many of these models with white trims. This was done in order that they might be clearer to you and because "blackout white" is a style feature. However, choose your own color. The peplum looks especially good in bright red. Any color lace cascade with cuffs to match would be very smart.

Instructions on how to give your dresses new life with these crochet trims are found on Pages 4 and 5. If you have any questions regarding your handwork, please write to me. I shall be glad to give you all of the help I can.



HOW TO WAKE THEM



DOILY POCKETS 2601

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" OR "GEM" MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON Size 30

1 150-yd. Ball White or colors will make 2 doilies.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 11 or 12.

Doily measures about $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

Ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 12 s c into ring, join each row.

2nd Row—Ch 5, * d c in next st, ch 2, repeat from * all around.

3rd Row—Work 3 s c in each mesh.

4th Row—Ch 3, d c in next st, * ch 4, skip 1 s c, 1 d c in each of the next 2 sts, repeat from * all around, ch 4, join.

5th Row—* Ch 5, s c in loop, ch 5, s c in d c, repeat from * all around.

6th, 7th and 8th Rows—SI st to center of loop, * ch 6, s c in next loop, repeat from * all around.

9th Row—S c in loop, ch 3, 2 d c in same loop, ch 5, 3 d c in same loop, * ch 6, s c in next loop, ch 6, s c in next loop, ch 6, s c in next loop, ch 6, 3 d c, ch 5, 3 d c in next loop, repeat from * all around, ch 6, s c in next loop, ch 6, s c in next loop, ch 6, join.

10th Row—Sl st to center of 5 ch loop, * ch 6, s c in next loop, repeat from * all around.

11th Row—Repeat 6th row.

12th Row—Sl st to center of loop, ch 6, ** 3 d c, ch 5, 3 d c in next loop, * ch 6, s c in next loop, repeat from * twice, ch 6, then repeat from ** all around, ch 6, s c in next loop, ch 6, s c in next loop, ch 6, join.

13th and 14th Rows—Repeat 6th row.

15th Row—Sl st to center of loop, * ch 7, s c in next loop, repeat from * all around.

16th Row—Work 7 s c in each loop.

17th Row—* Ch 5, skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from * all around. (Do not join this or following rows.)
18th and 19th Rows—Work a 6 ch loop in each loop.
20th Row—Ch 6, ** 3 d c, ch 5, 3 d c in next loop, * ch 6, s c in next loop, repeat from * twice, then repeat from ** all around, ch 6, s c in next loop, ch 6, s c in next loop, join, break thread.

TASSELED PEPLUM 2602

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON Size 5

3 60-yd. Balls Red or any color desired. Steel Crochet Hook No. 6 or 7. 2 Small Buttons. BAND. Ch 16, d c in 4th st from hook, d c in same space, * skip 2 chs, s c in next ch, ch 3, 2 d c in same space, repeat from * twice, skip 2 chs, s c in next ch, ch 4, turn.

2nd Row—2 d c in same space, s c in ch 3 loop of shell in previous row, * 2 d c in same space, s c in next ch 3 loop, repeat from * across row, ch 4, turn.

Repeat 2nd row until band is length desired, break thread.

Join thread in corner st, * ch 14, skip 2 shell patterns, s c between next 2 shell patterns, repeat from * across band, ch 16, turn.

2nd Row—S c in loop, * ch 14, s c in next loop, repeat from * across row to within 2 loops, ch 14, s c in next loop, s c in next loop thus decreasing a loop at end of row, ch 16, turn.

Repeat 2nd row 9 times, break thread.

TASSELS. Wind 15 times over a 2 inch card board, tie at one end leaving an end to tie to peplum and cut at other end. Tie about ½ inch down from top. Tie a tassel in center st of each loop, pull tying threads down through tassel.

Sew buttons in position on band and work 2 buttonholes.

BUTTON ON JABOT 2603

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" OR "GEM" MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON Size 30

1 400-yd. Ball. White. Steel Crochet Hook No. 12.

BAND. Ch 174, d c in 6th st from hook, * ch 1, skip 1 ch, d c in next ch, repeat from * across ch. (85 meshes.)

2nd Row—Ch 4, turn, d c in next d c, * ch 1, d c in next d c, repeat from * across row.

3rd Row — Ch 4, turn and work 5—1 ch meshes, ** ch 9 for buttonhole, skip 4 d c, d c in next d c, * ch 1, d c in next d c, repeat from * 8 times, repeat from ** 5 times having 5 meshes at end of row.

4th Row — Ch 4, turn, work 5—1 ch meshes, * ch 1, skip 1 ch, d c in next ch, repeat from * 3 times, ch 1, skip 1 ch, d c in d c, continue working 1 ch meshes across row,

ch 4, turn and work 1 more row of 1 ch meshes.

6th Row—Start Ruffle. Ch 5, turn, s c in next mesh, * ch 5, s c in next mesh, ch 5, s c in same mesh, repeat from * across row, ch 5, turn.

7th Row—S c in next loop, * ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from * across row.

8th Row—Ch 5, turn, s c in next loop, ch 5, s c in next loop, ** 3 d c in same loop, s c in same loop, * ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from * 3 times, then repeat from ** across row.

9th Row—Ch 5, turn, s c in next loop, * ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from * across row.

10th Row—Same as 8th row placing the solid dots between dots of previous row.

Repeat 9th and 10th rows.

13th Row—Same as 9th row working to within the last 9 loops at end of row, ch 3, tr c in next loop, ch 5, turn.

14th Row—Repeat 10th row.

15th Row—Same as 13th row working to within the last 9 loops of preceding row, ch 3, tr c in next loop, ch 5, turn.

16th Row—Same as 14th row.

Repeat the 15th and 16th rows 10 times.

Ch 5, turn and work a row of 5 ch loops down entire side of jabot.

SCALLOP. Ch 1, turn, * 4 s c in next loop, ch 3, turn, d c in 1st s c, ch 1, d c in same space, ch 1, d c in same space, ch 1, turn, 2 s c over each of the next 2 loops, 3 s c over next loop, sl st in top of next s c, repeat from * up side of ruffle and across top of ruffle to the band, in band work sl st in next mesh, * ch 1, 3 d c in next mesh, ch 1, sl st in next mesh, repeat from * around entire band and finish lower edge of ruffle with same scallop as side.

Starch with a very thin starch if desired,

FRINGED EPAULLETTES 2604


Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DE LUXE" MERCERIZED CROCHET AND KNIT-TING COTTON OR "STAR" PEARL COTTON Size 5

1 250-yd. Ball or 2 60yd. Balls White or any color desired.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7 or 8.

Ch 48, work 1 d c in 4th st from hook and 1 d c in each remaining ch, ch 3, turn.

2nd Row—Work 1 d c in each d c, ch 3, turn. 3rd Row—Work 1 d c in each d c, ch 5, turn. 4th Row—Skip 2 d c, d c in next d c, * ch 2, skip 2 d c, d c in next d c, repeat from * across row, break thread.



FRINGE. Take 10—12-inch strands, loop through mesh, draw ends through loop and tighten, skip one mesh, repeat from beginning across row.

* Take half of one group of fringe and half of next group of fringe, knot together about 3/4 inch from 1st row of knots. Repeat from * across row.

Trim fringe evenly and with "Star Twist" Mercerized Sewing Thread attach to shoulder as illustrated.

IRISH CROCHET **COLLAR AND CUFFS 2605**

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" MERCERIZED TATTING COTTON OR "STAR" CROCHET COTTON Size 50 or 70 White

5 75-yd. Balls "Star" Tatting Cotton or 2 200-yd. Balls "Star" Crochet Cotton. Steel Crochet Hook No. 13 or 14.

MOTIF. Ch 8, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 16 s c in ring.

2nd Row—Ch 6, skip 1 s c, d c in next s c, * ch 3, skip 1 s c, d c in next s c, repeat from * all around, ch 3, join in 3rd st of ch.

3rd Row—Ch 1 and work 1 s c, 4 d c, 1 s c over each loop, join.


4th Row—SI st into d c, * ch 5, skip 2 d c, s c in next d c, ch 5, skip 2 s c, s c in next d c of next petal, repeat from * all around.

5th Row—Sl st into loop, ** ch 5, s c in next loop, * ch 6, sl st in 5th st from hook for picot, repeat from *, ch 1, s c in next loop, repeat from ** all around.

ch 5, s c between next 2 picots, ch 5, * 4 d c in next loop, ch 5, s c be tween next 2 picots, ch 5, repeat from * all around, join.

7th Row—Sl st into next loop, * ch 7, sl st in 5th st from hook for picot, ch 7, sl st in 5th st from hook for picot, ch 2, s c in next loop, repeat from * all around, (16 double picot loops), break thread.

Work a 2nd motif in same manner joining it



to 1st motif in last row as follows: ch 7, sl st in 5th st from hook for picot, ch 2, join between 2 picots of 1st motif, ch 7, sl st in 5th st from hook for picot, ch 2, s c in next loop of 2nd motif, ch 7, sl st in 5th st from hook for picot, ch 2, s c between picots of next loop of 1st motif, ch 7, sl st in 5th st from hook for picot, ch 2, s c in next loop of 2nd motif and finish row same as 1st motif.

Work 4 more motifs joining them in same manner leaving 6 double picot loops free between joinings. This is half of collar.

Work 6 more motifs for other half of collar joining in same manner.

NECK BAND. Join thread in 1st picot of 5th loop from joining, ch 2, s c in next picot of same loop, * ch 2, s c in next picot of next loop, ch 2, s c in next picot of same loop, repeat from * twice, ** ch 2, d c in next picot of next loop, ch 2, d c in next picot of same loop, d c in 1st picot of next loop of next motif, ch 2, d c in next picot of same loop, * ch 2, s c in next picot of next loop, ch 2, s c in next picot of same loop, repeat from * 3 times, then repeat from ** 3 times, ch 2, d c in next picot of next loop, ch 2, d c in next picot of same loop, d c in next free picot of next loop of next motif, ch 2, d c in next picot of same loop, * ch 2, s c in next picot of next loop, ch 2, s c in next picot of same loop, repeat from * 3 times, ch 13 (this is center front of collar), pick up other half of collar, s c in 1st picot of 5th loop from joining and work in same manner to correspond with 1st half.

2nd Row—Ch 5, turn, ** d c in next mesh, * ch 2, d c in next mesh, repeat from * 5 times, ch 2, tr c in next mesh, ch 2, thread over needle twice, insert in next mesh and work off 2 loops twice, thread over needle twice, insert in next mesh and work off all loops 2 at a time, ch 2, tr c in next mesh, ch 2, repeat from ** across row working 4-2 ch meshes on ch at center of collar.

3rd Row—Turn, sl st into mesh, ch 7, sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, d c in same mesh, * d c, picot, d c in next mesh, repeat from * across row, without breaking thread start scallop.

Ch 6, s c in next mesh, ch 6, s c in next mesh, ch 6, d c in next s c between loops, * ch 6, s c between next 2 picots of next loop, ch 6, d c in next s c between loops, repeat from * 8 times, ** ch 6, s c in joining between motifs, * ch 6, d c in s c between loops, ch 6, s c between next 2 picots, repeat from * 5 times, ch 6, d c in next s c between loops, repeat from ** 3 times, ch 6, s c in joining between motifs, * ch 6, d c in next s c between loops, ch 6, s c between next 2 picots, repeat from * 8 times, ch 6, d c in next s c between loops, ch 6, s c in last picot, ch 6, s c in 1st free mesh of band, ch 6, turn.

2nd Row-* S c in next loop, ch 6, s c in next loop, ch 6, s c in same loop, ch 6, repeat from * across row.

3rd Row—Turn, s c in next loop, * ch 6, s c in next loop, repeat from * across row, ch 6, s c in next free 6th Row—S1 st into loop, chi by W. alle and Work 1 more SUITABLE CHANGES

A good suit is a valuable investment. Here are 5 ways to vary its appearance --5 ways to preserve that crisp, fresh look.

Dickies are always good. The one shown on illustration 2609 was cut down from an old shirtwaist that had split under the arms. The butterfly dickey 2610 is completely crocheted and forms a vestee. We've used our special braid again for frogs and to outline the lapels and jacket on sketch 2611. This is one of the best suit rejuvenators we know of. For that feminine touch on a masculine suit tack on a bunch of violets--make an extra bunch to pin on your pocketbook. The Colonial jabot is especially nice...note the unusual edging design.

Try these changes for year round versatility. Instructions will be found on pages 8 and 9.

CUT-ME-DOWN DICKEY 2609

Use an old blouse for dickey. Cut straight down from shoulders in front and back and hem edges. Sew tape at waistline to front and back and tie to hold in position. Sew buttons in position to correspond with buttonholes in jabot. Use "Star Twist" Mercerized Sewing Thread for all sewing.

JABOT

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" CROCHET COTTON SIZE 70 OR "STAR" MERCERIZED TATTING COTTON

3 200-yd. Balls Crochet Cotton or 6 75-yd. Balls Tatting Cotton.


Steel Crochet Hook No. 14.

Ch 154, work 1 d c in 6th st from hook, * ch 1, skip 1 ch, d c in next ch, repeat from * to end of row, ch 4, turn. (75 meshes.)

2nd, 3rd and 4th Rows—D c in next mesh, * ch 1, d c in next mesh, repeat from * across row.

5th Row—Ch 4, turn, d c in next mesh, * ch 1, d c in next mesh, repeat from * 5 times, ** ch 7 (buttonhole), skip 2 meshes, d c in next mesh, * ch 1, d c in next mesh, repeat from * 10 times, repeat from ** 3 times, ch 7, skip 2 meshes, d c in next mesh, * ch 1, d c in next mesh, repeat from * 6 times, ch 4, turn and work a row of 1 ch meshes working a mesh in every other ch of buttonhole. Work 3 more rows of 1 ch meshes.

RUFFLE. Ch 5, turn, s c in next mesh, * ch 5, s c in next mesh, repeat from * down side, around bottom meshes work 3—5 ch loops in each mesh then work 1— 5 ch loop in each mesh up other side, ch 5, turn and



work 4 rows of 5 ch loops even. Work 3 rows of 6 ch loops, 3 rows of 7 ch loops and 4 rows of 8 ch loops. break thread.

CENTER RUFFLE. Attach thread at top of 2nd row of meshes from buttonholes and work a row of 5 ch loops same as other ruffle working 3—5 ch loops in each mesh around bottom, work other side to correspond, ch 5, turn and work 2 more rows of 5 ch loops, 2 rows of 6 ch loops, 1 row of 7 ch loops, 1 row of 8 ch loops, break thread

SCALLOP. Attach thread on under ruffle at center top, ch 7 sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, * ch 2 d c in same loop, ch 4, sl st in top of the complete the control of the c

* twice, ** ch 4, s c in next loop, ch 4, d c in next loop, picot, * ch 2, d c in same loop, picot, repeat from * twice, then repeat from ** all around both ruffles and across top of jabot.

BUTTERFLY CROCHETED DICKEY 2610 Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" OR "GEM" MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON Size 30

6 150-yd. Balls White or any color desired.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 11 or 12.


FRONT SECTION. Ch 185, d c in 6th st from hook, * skip 2 chs, d c in next ch, ch 2, d c in same ch, repeat from * across row, ch 5, turn.

2nd Row—D c in mesh, * d c in next mesh, ch 2, d c in same mesh, repeat from * across row, ch 5, turn.

Repeat 2nd row until work measures 83/4 inches. Next Row—Work to center of dickie, then ch 5. turn

and continue working pattern for 5 inches.

Next Row-Start decreasing for neckline. Work 1 pattern in each pattern to within end pattern, work 1 d c



in end pattern, ch 3, turn work 1 d c in 1st pattern and continue pattern across row. Work 4 more rows of pattern decreasing at neckline in same manner.

Next Row-Start decreasing at shoulder, decreasing in same manner. Continue decreasing at neck and shoulder until 1 pattern remains, break thread.

Join thread at dividing point and work other half to correspond, break thread.

RUFFLE. Join thread in corner at neck, ch 8, s cain same space, ch 8, s c in same space * ch 8, s c in next space, ch 8, s c in same space, repeat from * to other corner of neck, ch 9, turn and work 5 more rows of 8 ch loops, then 6 rows of 9 ch loops, then 2 rows of 10 ch loops.

Next Row—Ch 10, turn, s c in loop, ** ch 3, tr c in next loop. * ch 7, sl st in 5th st from hook for picot, ch 2, tr c in same loop, repeat from * 5 times, ch 3, s c in next loop, then repeat from ** all around ruffle joining in same space as ch 8 loops.

Join thread in same space with ch 8 loops on opposite end of collar and finish edge to correspond.

BACK SECTION. Ch 185 and work 8 rows of pattern. Next Row-Start decreasing for shoulders. (Work de-

Join thread in 1st pattern at other shoulder, ch 5, d c in same space, work 1 pattern in each of the next 12 patterns, 1 d c in next pattern, ch 3, turn, 1 d c in 1st pattern and continue decreasing to correspond with other shoulder.

Sew shoulder seams. Sew tapes at waist. Press under a damp cloth. If desired, leave 1 shoulder seam open and finish with buttons and loops or snaps.


BRAIDED FROGS 2611 Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON Size 5

1 60-yd. Ball White or any color desired for each frog. Steel Crochet Hook No. 7 or 8.

Ch 7, join and work 1 s c in each s c. Without joining rows and working in back loop of st only, continue working 1 s c in each s c, until work measures about 18 inches, break thread.

TO MAKE FROG. Fold cord in half with "Star Twist" Mercerized Sewing Thread, sew together about 2 inches from fold to form loop. Make 2 loops with remainder of cord as illustrated.

Work another 18 inch cord and fold in same manner for other half of frog.



VIOLETS 2612 Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "SILLATEEN SANSIL"

1 60-yd. Ball Shaded Lavender will make 14 violets. (50 violets used in bouquet.)

2 60-yd, Balls Green. 1 60-yd. Ball Yellow.

5 yds. narrow Green crepe paper and a few inches of wire.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.

With Yellow, leaving about a 4 inch end of thread, ch 5, join to form a ring and work 10 s c in ring, join.

2nd Row—* Ch 4, skip 1 st, s c in next st, repeat from * 4 times, break thread leaving a 4 inch end.

3rd Row—Attach Shaded Lavender in loop, s c in same loop, * ch 1, ** d c in same loop, repeat from * 3 times, * ch 1, tr c in same loop, repeat from * 3 times, * ch 1, d c in same loop, repeat from * 3 times, ch 1, s c in same loop, ch 1, s c in next loop, ch 1, repeat from ** all around, break thread.

Use wire from top of milk bottle about 7 inches long. Take about 17 violets and twist the long end of threads together with wire. Wrap stem with a piece of Green crepe paper tape. Make 2 more bunches in same manner.

each remaining ch, ch 3, turn, 2 d c in each of the next 2 d c, 1 d c in each of the next 28 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 10 sts, s c in next st, ch 2, turn, skip 1 st, 1 d c in each st to within the last 2 sts, 2 d c in each of the last 2 d c, ch 3, turn, 1 d c in same space, 2 d c in next st, 1 d c in each of the next 30 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 8 sts, 1 s c in next st, ch 2, turn, skip 1 st, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 sts, 1 d c in each st to end, 2 d c in end st, ch 2, turn, thread over needle, insert in next st, pull through, * insert in next st, pull through, repeat from *, thread over and pull through all loops but one, thread over and pull through 2 loops, 1 d c in each of the next 24 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 5 sts, s c in next st, ch 2, turn, skip 1 st, 1 s d c in each of the next 5 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 19 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 4 sts, ch 2, turn, skip 1 st, s c in next st, 1 s d c in each of the next 5 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 10 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 6 sts, break thread and work other half of leaf to correspond.

Work another leaf. Run wire through center of leaf to keep firm and twist around stems as illustrated.

COLONIAL JABOT 2613

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON

3 150-yd. Balls Size 30. White.


Steel Crochet Hook No. 7 or 8.

Ch 90, d c in 6th st from hook, * ch 1, skip 1 ch, d c in next ch, repeat from * across ch.

2nd and 3rd Rows—Ch 4, turn, * d c in d c, ch 1, repeat from * across row.

4th Row—Ch 6, s c in corner mesh, * ch 6, s c in same mesh, ch 6, s c in same mesh, ch 6, s c in next mesh, repeat from *, ch 6, s c in same mesh, ch 6, s c in same mesh, * ch 6, s c in next mesh, ch 6, s c in same mesh, repeat from * to corner. Work other corner and other side to correspond.

Without joining rows, work 5 more rows of 6 ch loops,




then work 4 rows of 7 ch loops, 4 rows of 8 ch loops, 4 rows of 9 ch loops, and 1 row of 10 ch loops.

Next Row—* 5 s c, ch 4, 5 s c in next loop, repeat from * all around.


Next Row—Sl st into loop, work 3 tr c cluster sts with ch 5 between each cluster st in same loop (cluster st: * thread over needle twice, insert in loop, pull through and work off 2 loops twice, repeat from * twice, thread over and pull through all loops at one time), * work 3 tr c cluster sts with ch 5 between each cluster st in next loop, repeat from * all around, join, break thread. LEAF. With Green, ch 44 for some and give pattern library of 20125, while still damp.

NIGHT GOWN FRILL 2624

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON Size 30 White

1 150-yd. Ball will make about 8 inches of ruffling. Steel Crochet Hook No. 12 or 13.

Ch 8, d c in 6th st from hook, ch 1, skip 1 ch, d c in next ch, ch 4, turn.

Next Row—Ch 8, turn, * thread over twice, insert in same space, work off 2 loops twice, thread over twice, insert in next tr c, work off 2 loops twice, thread over and pull through all loops on needle, ch 3, repeat from * 3 times, tr c in same space, ch 7, turn, s c in next tr c, ch 1, turn, s c in loop, ch 20, sl st in 9th st from hook to form a ring, ch 4, work 3 tr c in ring, ch 4, sl st in ring, ch 3, sl st in first mesh, ch 3, sl st in ring, * ch 4, work 3 tr c in ring, ch 4, sl st in ring, repeat from * 3 times, ch 11, s c in loop, * ch 20, sl st in 9th st from hook to form a ring, ch 4, work 3 tr c in ring, ch 4, sl st in ring, ch 3, sl st in center of last petal, ch 3, sl st in ring, and complete flower in same manner, repeat from * 3 times. ** Sl st in tr c, tr c in next tr c, * ch 3, thread over twice, insert needle in same space, week off 2 loops twice thread.

Next Row—Ch 6, turn, tr c in same space, ch 2, 2 tr c with ch 2 between in s c over next tr c, * s c in s c over next tr c, 2 tr c with ch 2 between in next s c over next tr c, ch 2, 2 tr c with ch 2 between in next s c over next tr c, repeat from * across row, break thread.

If beading is not desired, join thread in 1st tr c, work 1 s c in each tr c and 3 s c in each mesh, break thread.

BRAID AND BUTTON TRIM 2615

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON Size 5

2 60-yd. Ball White or colors. Steel Crochet Hook No. 7 or 8.

BUTTON. Ch 4, join and work 8 s c in ring.

2nd Row—Increase by working 2 s c in each s c.

3rd Row—Increase by working 2 s c in every 2nd s c.

4th Row—Increase by working 2 s c in every 3rd s c.

5th, 6th and 7th Rows-Work even.

8th Row-Working in back loop of st only, work even.

9th and 10th Rows—Working in both loops of st, work even.

Insert button or button mold.

11th, 12th and 13th Rows — Decrease by skipping every 3rd s c, draw sts together, break thread.

Attach thread in free loop of 8th row and work 1 s c in each st all around, break thread and work six or as many buttons as desired.

CORD. Ch 7, join, ch 1, work 1 s c in each ch. Without joining rows and working in back loop of st only, work 1 s c in each s c until cord is length desired.

Sew buttons in position and wind cord around buttons as illustrated.

FRINGED TASSEL 2616

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON Size 5

2 60-yd. Balls Red or any color desired. Steel Crochet Hook No. 6 or 7.

Ch 8, join to form a ring, ch 1, work 12 s c in ring.

2nd Row—Ch 1, work 2 s c in each s c.

Continue working rows of s c, increasing a sufficient number of times to keep work flat, until work measures $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches in diameter.

Next Row—Ch 3, 2 d c in same space, skip 2 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from beginning all around.

Next Row—* Ch 6, s c in ch 3 loop of shell of previous row, ch 6, s c in s c between shell sts, repeat from * 5 times, break thread.

FRINGE. Wind 12 times over an 11 inch cardboard cut at one end and loop through mesh. Work a fringe in each mesh. Trim evenly and with "Star Twist" Mercerized Sewing Thread attach to hat as illustrated.

RUFFLED EDGE 2617

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON Size 5

3 60-yd. Balls Light Hunter Green or any color desired. 1 yd. Narrow Velvet Ribbon. Steel Crochet Hook No. 6 or 7.

Make a ch slightly longer than band of crown, tr c in 12th st from hook, * ch 4, skip 4 chs, tr c in next ch, repeat from * across ch, ch 8, turn.

2nd Row—Tr c in tr c, * ch 4, tr c in next tr c, repeat from * across row, ch 8, turn.

Repeat 2nd row until work fits band of hat, break thread. Sew band together.

RUFFLE. Attach thread in any mesh and work 4 tr c with ch 4 between each tr c in each mesh, join.

Next Row—Work 1 tr c with ch 5 between each tr c in each mesh, join.

Repeat last row, break thread.

Press and lace ribbon through 1st row of ruffle. Tack in position on hat. Work may be starched with a very thin starch if desired.

3rd Row—Ch 7, tr c in same space, * ch 3, tr c in next mesh, ch 3, work 2 tr c with ch 3 between each tr c in next mesh, repeat from * all around, ch 3, tr c in next mesh, ch 3, join.

4th Row—Work 1 tr c with ch 3 between each tr c in each mesh increasing at increasing points (8 increasing points in row), join.

5th Row—Work 3 tr c with ch 3 between each tr c in each mesh, join.

6th Row—Work 1 tr c with ch 4 between each tr c in each mesh, join, break thread.

4 motifs were used for hat illustrated. With "Star Twist" Mercerized Sewing Thread tack bows in each motif and tack in position in hat.

LEAF AND BRAID 2621

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON Size 5

3 60-yd. Balls Light Hunter Green or any color desired. Steel Crochet Hook No. 6 or 7.

Ch 4, work 3 s c on ch, ch 1, turn. (Always ch 1 to turn.)

2nd, 3rd and 4th Rows—1 s c in each s c.

5th Row—Increase 1 st on both sides.

6th Row—Work even.

Repeat last 2 rows 5 times.

17th Row—Increase 1 st at end of row.

18th Row-Increase 1 st at beginning of row.

19th and 20th Rows—Repeat last 2 rows. Then work 6 rows even.

27th Row-Increase 1 st at beginning of row.

28th Row-Increase 1 st at end of row.

29th and 30th Rows—Repeat last 2 rows.

31st Row—Decrease 1 st at end of row.

32nd Row—Decrease 1 st at beginning of row.

33rd Row—Decrease 1 st at each end.

34th Row—Decrease 1 st at beginning of row.

35th and 36th Rows—Decrease 1 st at end of row.

37th and 38th Rows-Work even.

39th Row—Decrease 1 st at each end.

40th Row-Work even.

Repeat last 2 rows 5 times, then decrease 1 st at each end. Work a row of s c all around, break thread. Embroider a ch st through center of leaf.

4 leaves were used and attached to hat illustrated. Work a cord to fit around outer edge. For cord directions see No. 2619.

LACE RUFFLE FOR HAT AND DRESS 2622

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" OR "GEM" MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON Size 30

2 400-yd. Balls White will make lace for both Trim and Hat.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 11 or 12.

Ch 11, d c in 4th st from hook, * ch 1, skip 1 ch, d c in next ch, repeat from *, ch 4, turn.

2nd Row—D c in d c, * ch 1, d c in next d c, repeat from *, ch 4, turn. Repeat 2nd row for desired length.

RUFFLE. Ch 1, turn, s c into last mesh made, work a 5 ch loop in each mesh to cerner, in corner mesh work 6—5 ch loops, work a 5 ch loop increasing in every 2nd mesh down long side to corner, in corner mesh work 6—5 ch loops, work a 5 ch loop in each of the next 2 meshes, ch 6, turn.

Next 2 Rows—Work a 5 ch loop in each loop.

Next 4 Rows—Work a 6 ch loop in each loop.

Next Row—Ch 3, turn, 2 d c in same loop, ch 5, 3 d c in same loop, * ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 5, work a 3 d c, ch 5, 3 d c shell in next loop, repeat from * across row, break thread.

Lace for front of dress and cuffs illustrated on page 3 is worked in same manner.



With double strand of Emerald, form a 1/2 inch loop on hook, thread over and pull through loop, s c in single loop of st, * draw a 1/2 inch loop on hook, thread over and pull through loop, s c over single loop of st (a single loop knot st), repeat from * 6 times, turn, s c in 5th s c from hook.

2nd Row—* Draw a ½ inch loop on hook, thread over and pull through loop, s c over single loop of st just made, repeat from *, (a double loop knot st) skip next s c of knot st in previous row, s c in next s c, repeat from beginning across row.

3rd Row—Always work a 3 loop knot st to turn, increase 1 knot st in 1st and last sts, then work 1 row even. Repeat last 2 rows until there are 50 knot sts in row. Break thread.

RUFFLE. Attach double strand of Yellow in point and work a knot st in each st increasing 1 knot st in every 2nd knot st.

2nd Row—Without joining rows, work a knot st in each knot st, then work 1 more row in Yellow, break thread. Attach Emerald and work 1 row, break thread.

BAG, GLOVES AND CALOT 2630

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "SILLATEEN SANSIL"

Entire set requires 6 60-yd. Balls Yellow 2 60-yd. Balls Heliotrope 2 60-yd. Balls Peach Steel Crochet Hook No. 9 or 10.

BAG.

Cut 2 circles 4 inches in diameter. Overcast together over a 3 inch cardboard. Cut a piece of material 5 x 19 inches, sew the ends together, hem both sides, gather and sew one side to covered circle.

Join Yellow "Sillateen Sansil" in seam, and work a double knot st (double knot st: * pull up a 1/4 inch loop on hook, thread over and pull through loop, s c in single loop of st, pull up a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch loop on hook, thread over and pull through loop, s c in single loop of st), skip 3/8 inch, s c in material, repeat from * all around. Without joining rows, work 8 more rows of double knot sts.

BEADING. Ch 9, d c in center s c of next double knot st, * ch 6, d c in center of next double knot st, repeat from * all around, ch 6, join in 3rd st of ch.

Next Row—Work 3 double knot sts in each mesh.

Next 2 Rows—Work a double knot st in center s c of each double knot st, break thread.

FLOWERS. Ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 5, d c in ring, * ch 2, d c in ring, repeat from * 7 times, ch 2, join.

2nd Row—Sl st to mesh, ch 5, tr c in mesh, * ch 1, tr c in same mesh, repeat from * 8 times, ch 1, work 11 tr c with ch 1 between each tr c in each of the next 9 meshes, join.

3rd Row—* Ch 3, s c in ch between tr c, repeat from * all around, break thread.

15 yds. required for each flower. On bag illustrated 4 Yellow, 2 Peach and 2 Heliotrope flowers were used. A Yellow flower was placed between each color.

Sew flowers on seam of bag, spacing flowers evenly.

DRAW STRINGS. Cut a strip of material 20 x 2 inches. Sew together making a 1/4 inch seam, turn over a pencil. Press flat. Lace drawstring through beading and sew ends together. Make another drawstring. (Pull each string from opposite direction.) WHOW, and quepallern liberal year as 2id 20 sitisful

CAP.

Cut 5 separate pieces (like bulging triangles) $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches deep and 43/4 inches across the lower edge. This allows for 1/2 inch seams. Stitch all pieces together, press seams. The lower edge can be turned under and stitched all around or a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch bias band of same material can be used for inner facing. Trim with flowers (same as bag) as illustrated. (5 Heliotrope, 3 Peach and 3 Yellow flowers were used on cap illustrated.)

GLOVES.

These may be made of same material, using free glove pattern (see opposite page) as bag and calot or take old white gloves and dye to match and trim with crochet.

Open glove 5 inches down side seam, work a row of s c around opening, break thread.

GUSSET. Ch 1, * pull up a 1/4 inch loop on hook, thread over and pull through loop, s c in single loop of st, repeat from * 9 times.

2nd Row—S c in 5th s c from hook, * pull up a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch loop on hook, thread over and pull through loop, s c in single loop of st, repeat from *, skip next s c, s c in next s c, then repeat from * twice.

3rd Row—Work a 3 loop knot st, turn, s c in center s c of knot st in previous row, work a double knot st in center s c of each double knot st.

Next 2 Rows—Decrease 1 st at beginning of row. (Decrease by working a single loop knot st to turn.)

Next Row—Work a 3 loop knot st, turn, s c in center s c of knot st in previous row, work a double knot st in center s c of next knot st.

Repeat last row 8 times, break thread.

Sew gusset in position.

Repeat 3rd row twice.

RUFFLE. Attach thread at top of glove and work a row of double knot sts, spacing about 1/8 inch apart and working a double knot st in each s c of knot st across gusset.

Next 2 Rows—Work a double knot st in center s c of each knot st, break thread. Sew 1 Yellow flower at base of gusset as illustrated.

JEWELRY 2631

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON Size 5

3 60-yd. Balls Yellow or any color desired. Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

2 Clasps.

NECKLACE BAND. Ch 158, s c in 2nd st from hook, work 1 s c in each of the next 9 chs, work 1 s d c in each of the next 10 chs, work 1 d c in each of the next 117 chs, work 1 s d c in each of the next 10 chs, work 1 s c in each of the next 10 chs, break thread.

BALLS. Ch 4, join to form ring, ch 1, work 8 s c into ring. Without joining rows work 2 s c in each s c, then next 3 rows work 1 s c in each s c. Stuff with cotton. Narrow by skipping every other st until 1 st remains, ch 5, join to 60th st on band.

Work another ball same as 1st ball, but ch 8 before joining to band. Join in same st as 1st ball.

* Skip 3 sts, join next 2 balls in next st, repeat from * 7 times.

Sew clasp in position.

BRACELET. Band. Make a ch slightly larger than wrist, work 1 d c in 3rd st from hook, work a d c in each remaining ch, break thread.

Work balls same as for necklace, but join to band with ch 5 and ch 3 instead of ch 5 and ch 8, * skip 3 d c, join next 2 balls in next d c, repeat from * all around





When a 4-year-old's dress gets too small make a pinafore.

PINAFORE 2635

Rip sleeves and hem out of dress.

Starting at shoulders cut straight down to within $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches from waistline or to the belt on the front and back of dress.

Cut a strip of the hem for ruffle, allowing enough on bottom of dress for narrow hem.

Divide the material cut from the hem in half using 1 piece for each ruffle. Leave as wide as possible for shoulders and cut, graduating to about 1 inch at the waist line.

Gather the ruffles and sew to each side of front and back as illustrated.

If dress has no belt, sew a facing of about 11/2 inches all around to give the appearance of a belt . The sleeves may be used for the facing.

A small piece from the ends of sash may be used for pockets.

Make enough lace for the 2 ruffles, around neck and around each pocket with

"STAR" MERCERIZED TATTING COTTON

3 75-yd. Balls White.

1 Spool "Star Twist" Mercerized Sewing Thread. Steel Crochet Hook No. 14.

LACE. Ch 8, work 4 d c in 4th st from hook, ch 3, skip 2 chs, d c in next ch, d c in last ch, ch 3, turn.

2nd Row—D c in next d c, ch 3, 5 d c in 1st d c of d c group, turn.

3rd Row-* Ch 5, sl st in 1st ch for picot, repeat from * twice, 5 d c in 1st d c, ch 3, skip 3 d c, s c in next d c, ch 3, d c in next d c, d c in 3rd st of ch, ch 3, turn and repeat the 2nd and 3rd rows for length desired.

Size 30 to 70 White

1 Spool White "Star Twist" Mercerized Sewing Thread.

1 150-yd. Ball will make 50 inches of lace.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 13 or 14.

Ch 29, s c in 9th st from hook, * ch 5, skip 3 chs, s c in next ch, repeat from * 4 times, ch 5, turn.

2nd Row—S c in next loop, * ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from * 4 times, ch 5, turn.

3rd Row—Repeat 2nd row.

4th Row—* 2 d c in next loop, ch 2, repeat from * 4 times, 2 d c in last loop,

ch 2, 2 d c in same loop, ch 2, 2 d c in same loop, ch 2,

2 d c in same loop, s c in end loop of row below, ch 5, turn.

5th Row—** S c in next 2 ch loop, * ch 5, s c in next 2 ch loop, repeat from * 7 times, ch 5, turn.

6th Row—S c in next loop, ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from * 4 times, ch 5, turn.

7th Row—Same as 6th row. Wywaywanning and continuous arms 2025, 11






1 60-yd. Ball White or any color desired will make about 50 inches of cord.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7 or 8. Ch 5, join and work 1 s c in each st of ch. Without joining rows and working in back loop of st only, continue working 1 s c in each s c until cord is desired length.

Leave about $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch length, * fold cord to form a 11/2 inch loop, sew in position, leave length desired between loops, repeat from * to end of cord. With "Star Twist" Mercerized Sewing Thread attach to garment to form artificial bolero, collar or sleeve trim.

PUSSY CAT BOW 2607



Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON

2 175-yd. Balls Size 50 White or any color desired. Steel Crochet Hook No. 12 or 13.

CENTER SECTION. Ch 25 and work 1 d c in 9th st from hook, * ch 3, skip next 3 chs, d c in next ch, repeat from * 3 times.

2nd Row—Ch 1, turn, sl st in mesh, work 3 tr c cluster st with ch 3 between each cluster st in same mesh (cluster st, * thread over needle twice, insert in mesh and work off 2 loops twice, repeat from * twice, thread over and work off all loops at 1 time), * skip next mesh and work 3 tr c cluster sts with ch 3 between in next mesh, repeat from *.

3rd Row—Ch 1, turn, sl st in ch 3 loop, ch 6, d c in next loop, * ch 3, d c in next loop, repeat from * 3

Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows until piece measures 12 inches or desired length, break thread.

Join thread in corner mesh, work 2 s c in mesh, * 4 s c over ch 4 or 1 tr c of cluster st, 3 s c in next mesh, repeat from * to corner, work 8 s c in each corner and

work 6 s c in same mesh with 2 s c, join.

Next Row-* Ch 4, skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from * all around to opposite side. (Do not work 4 ch loops across top.)

Next Row—Ch 7, turn and work a 7 ch loop in each

Next 2 Rows—Ch 8, turn and work an 8 ch loop in each loop.

LARGE BOW. Ch 145 and work 1 d c in 9th st from hook, * ch 3, skip next 3 chs, d c in next ch, repeat from * across row.

2nd Row—Ch 1, turn, sl st in mesh, work 3 tr c cluster sts with ch 3 between each cluster st in same mesh, * skip next mesh and work 3 tr c cluster sts with ch 3 between each cluster st in next mesh, repeat from * across row.

3rd Row—Ch 1, turn, sl st in ch 3 loop, ch 6, d c in next loop, * ch 3, d c in next loop, repeat from * across row.

Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows 6 times, break thread.

With right side of work toward you, join thread in corner mesh, ** work 8 s c in mesh, * 4 s c over ch 4 or 1 tr c of cluster st, 3 s c in next mesh, repeat from * to corner, work 8 s c in corner mesh and 3 s c in each mesh to corner, repeat from **, join.

Next Row. * Ch 4, skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from * all around.

Without joining rows, work 1 row of 7 ch loops and 2 rows of 8 ch loops, break thread.

SMALL BOW. Ch 121 and work small bow same as large bow, repeating 2nd and 3rd rows 4 times, break thread. Finish same as large bow.

CENTER BAND. Ch 8, s c in 2nd ch from hook and work 1 s c in each remaining ch, ch 1, turn.

2nd Row—Work 1 s c in each s c, ch 1, turn and repeat 2nd row until piece measures 2½ inches, break thread.

FINISHING. Press each piece, place small bow over large bow, gather through center and sew band in position.

Attach bow to top of center section.

BELT is worked with double strand of thread.

Ch 16, d c in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in same st, skip 2 chs, sl st in next st, * ch 3, 2 d c in same space, skip 2 chs, sl st in next st, repeat from * across row, ch 4, turn.

2nd Row—2 d c in sl st of previous row, sl st in ch 3 loop of shell, * ch 3, 2 d c in same space, sl st in ch 3 loop of next shell, repeat from * across row, ch 4, turn. Repeat 2nd row until belt measures 28½ inches or is length desired.

POCKETS. Ch 25, d c in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in same st, skip 2 chs, sl st in next st, * ch 3, 2 d c in same space, skip 2 chs, sl st in next st, repeat from * across row, ch 4, turn.

2nd Row—2 d c in 1 st of previous row, sl st in ch 3 loop of shell, * ch 3, 2 d c in same space, sl st in ch 3 loop of next shell, repeat from * across row, ch 4, turn. Repeat 2nd row until pocket measures $6\frac{1}{2}$ inches, break thread.


