Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DE LUXE" MERCERIZED CROCHET AND KNITTING COTTON

65 yds. White 104 yds. Blue. Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

FRONT SECTION. With Blue, ch 2, and work 6 s c in 1st ch, join in first s c.

2nd and 3rd Rows-2 s c in each s c, drop Blue.

4th Row—With White, ch 3, pick up and pull loop through the 2nd ch, pick up 1st ch and pull loop through, pick up each of the next 2 s c leaving all loops on needle, thread over and pull through all loops on needle at one time, ch 1, (the ch 1 is termed the eye of st) * pick up and pull loop through the eye of st just made, side loop of st just made and each of the next 2 s c leaving all loops on needle, thread over and pull through all loops at one time, ch 1, (star st) repeat from * all around, (12 star sts) drop White.

5th Row—Pick up Blue and work 2 s c in each loop and 2 s c in each eye of each star st, (48 s c) drop Blue.

6th Row—With White, same as 4th row having 24 star sts in row.

7th Row—With Blue, work 2 s c in each loop of each star st and 1 s c in each eye of each star st.

8th Row—With White, work same as 6th row having 36 star sts in row.

Repeat the last 2 rows having 54 sts in last row.

11th Row—With Blue, work 1 s c in each loop and 1 s c in each eye of each star st.

The thread is carried underneath in the following rows. When changing Color complete the last half of st with the next Color.

12th Row—With White, ch 3 and work 1 d c in each of the next 5 s c, with Blue, popcorn st in next s c, (popcorn st: 5 d c in same space, drop loop off hook, insert in 1st d c and pull loop through, ch 1 to tighten st) * with White, 1 d c in each of the next 6 s c, with Blue, popcorn st in next s c, repeat from * all around, join.

13th Row—With White, 1 d c in each d c and with Blue, 1 popcorn st in each popcorn st.

14th and 15th Rows—Same as last row, but working 2 d c in first and last st of each White section in each row, drop Blue.

16th Row—With White, 1 d c in each d c and 1 s d c in each popcorn st. (s d c: thread over, insert in st and work off all loops at one time).

17th Row—1 d c in each d c and 1 s c in each s d c, break thread.

BACK SECTION. Work first 11 rows same as front section, but reversing the Colors, break White.

12th Row—With Blue, ch 3, 1 d c in each of the next 5 s c, * ch 1, skip 1 s c, 1 d c in each of the next 5 s c, repeat from * all around, ch 1, join in 3rd st of ch.

13th Row—Ch 3, 1 d c in each of the next 4 d c, * ch 1, 1 d c in each of the next 5 d c, repeat from * all around, ch 1, join.

14th and 15th Rows—Same as last row, but working 2 d c in first and last st of each d c section in each row.

16th Row—1 d c in each d c and 1 s d c in each 1 ch loop.
17th Row—1 d c in each d c and 1 s c in each s d c, break thread.

With Blue, crochet the 2 sections together starting in the s c, ch 3, 3 d c in same space, skip 1 st, 1 s c in each of the next 7 sts, skip 1 st, 4 d c in next s c, skip 1 st, 1 s c in each of the next 7 sts, skip 1 st, 2 d c in next s c, ch 15, turn, sl st in same space for loop, ch 1 turn and work 25 s c over ch, 2 d c in same space as last d c, * skip 1 st, 1 s c in each of the next 7 sts, skip 1 st, 4 d c in next s c, repeat from * all around.

Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DE LUXE" MERCERIZED CROCHET AND KNITTING COTTON

149 yds. White 79 yds. Blue. Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

FRONT SECTION. With Blue, ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 3, (counts as 1 d c) and work 11 d c in ring, join.

2nd Row—Ch 3, 4 d c in same space, slip loop off hook, insert in top of ch and pull loop through, ch 1 to tighten, * ch 1, 5 d c in next d c, slip loop off hook, insert in 1st d c, pull loop through, ch 1, (popcorn st) repeat from * all around, ch 1, join in top of 1st popcorn st.

3rd Row—With White, sl st into loop, ch 3, 3 d c in same loop, * 4 d c in next loop, repeat from * all around, join.

4th Row—With Blue, work a popcorn st in every other d c with ch 1 between each popcorn st.

5th Row—With White, work 3 d c in each loop.

6th Row-With Blue, same as 4th row.

7th Row—Same as 5th row.

In the following rows the thread is carried underneath. When changing color complete the last half of st with the next color to be used.

8th Row—With White, ch 3, 1 d c in each of the next 5 d c, with Blue, popcorn st in next d c, * ch 1, skip 1 d c, popcorn st in next d c, repeat from * 4 times, ** with White, skip 1 d c, 1 d c in each of the next 6 d c, with Blue, popcorn st in next d c, * ch 1, skip 1 d c, popcorn st in next d c, repeat from * 4 times, then repeat from ** all around, join.

9th Row—With White, ** 1 d c in each d c and 2 d c in next popcorn st, with Blue, * popcorn st in next loop, ch 1, repeat from * 4 times, with White, 2 d c in next popcorn st, then repeat from ** all around.

10th Row—Same as 9th row but having 4 popcorn sts in Blue in each Blue section and 14 d c in White between each Blue section.

11th Row—Work in same manner decreasing 1 popcorn st in each Blue section and increasing 4 d c in each White section.

12th and 13th Rows—Same as last row decreasing 1 popcorn st in each Blue section, but increasing 6 d c in each White section, break Blue thread.

14th Row—With White, 1 d c in each d c and 3 d c in each popcorn st, break thread.

BACK SECTION. Work 1st 3 rows same as front section. The remainder of back is worked in White.

4th Row-1 d c in each d c, join.

5th Row-1 d c in each d c increasing 1 d c in every 3rd st.

6th Row—1 d c in each d c.

7th Row—Same as 5th row.

8th Row—Increase 1 d c in every 6th d c.

9th and 10th Rows—Increase 1 d c in every 8th d c.

11th Row—Increase in every 10th d c.

12th Row—Increase in every 4th d c.

13th Row—Same as 9th row.

14th Row—Increase in every 25th d c, break thread.

With Blue crochet the 2 sections together as follows: * 1 s c in each of the next 6 d c, ch 2, popcorn st in next d c, ch 2, repeat from * all around.

With Blue, cover a bone ring with s c and attach to potholder as illustrated.

143 yds. White 42 yds. Blue.


Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

FRONT SECTION. With Blue, ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 3, and work 11 d c in ring, join, (12 d c).

2nd Row—Ch 3, 4 d c in same space, drop loop off hook, (Continued on page 12)

Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "PURITAN" MERCERIZED CROCHET AND KNITTING COTTON

148 yds. White.

"STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5 12 yds. Red.

"STAR" SIX STRAND MERCERIZED EMBROIDERY COTTON

1 Skein Black.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

With White, ch 26, 1 d c in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in each remaining ch.

2nd Row—Ch 4, turn and work 3 d c in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in each d c working 3 d c in end st.

Repeat the 2nd row twice.

5th and 6th Rows—Ch 3, turn, 1 d c in each d c increasing 1 d c at beginning and end of row, ch 3, turn.

Next 5 Rows—1 d c in each d c increasing 1 d c at beginning of each row.

12th Row—Decrease 1 d c at beginning and end of row.

Next 5 Rows—Decrease 1 d c at end of each row.

Next Row—Increase 1 d c each end of row.

Next Row—Increase 2 sts at each end of row.

Next 2 Rows—Decrease 2 sts at beginning and end of each row.

Next Row—Increase 1 d c at each end of row.

Next 3 Rows—Increase 1 d c at the beginning of each row.

Next 3 Rows-Work even.

Next Row—Decrease 1 d c at each end of row.

Next Row—Ch 4, d c in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in each d c working 3 d c in last st.

Next 2 Rows—Increase 1 d c at beginning and end of each row.

Next Row—Ch 3, turn, 1 d c in same space, 1 d c in each of the next 9 d c, 1 s d c in next d c, (s d c: thread over, insert in st, pull through and work off all loops at one time), 1 s c in next d c, ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, sl st in each of the next 2 sts, 1 s c in next st, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 6 d c, 2 d c in next st, ch 3, turn, 1 d c in same space, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, 1 s d c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 s c in next st, sl st down side of ear to head, 1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 3 d c, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, 1 tr c in each of the next 5 d c, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, 1 s d c in each of the next 3 d c, 1 s c in each of the next 4 d c, 1 s d c in next d c, 1 d c in each of the next 9 d c, 2 d c in next d c, ch 3, turn, 1 d c in same space, 1 d c in each of the next 6 d c, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 d c, 1 s c in next st, 1 sl st in each of the next 2 sts, ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, 1 sl st in each of the next 2 sts, 1 s c in next st, 1 s d c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, 2 d c in next d c, break thread and work another section in same manner.

With Red, crochet the 2 sections together with a row of s c, working 1 s c in each s c across lower edge and working 2 s c in each d c row all around and 2 s c in every other st across top.

With Black "STAR" Six Strand Embroidery Cotton, embroider the face as illustrated using an outline stitch working the eyes about 21/4 inches from top.

The embroidery is all done in Black except the nose and mouth which is done in Red. The chin is 4 inches from top of head. The tie is 1½ inches long and ¾ inch wide. The legs are 2 inches long.

RING. With Red, wrap around 1 finger 3 times, remove from finger and work 28 s c over ring. Sew to top of potholder.

No. 3208

Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

4 60-yd. Balls Yellow.

2 60-yd. Balls Blue or any Color desired.

2 Small Buttons for Eyes.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 4 or 5.

(Entire Holder is worked with two strands of thread.)

FRONT LEG. With Yellow, ch 11, work 1 s c in second st from hook, 1 d c in next st, * 1 s c in next st, 1 d c in next st, repeat from * 3 times, ch 1 to turn each row.

2nd Row—1 s c in last d c, 1 d c in next s c, * 1 s c in next d c, 1 d c in next s c, repeat from * 3 times. (The last 2 rows form the pattern used throughout the potholder.) Work four more rows of pattern, then ch 27, turn.

7th Row—1 s c in second st from hook, 1 d c in next st, * 1 s c in next st, 1 d c in next st, repeat from * 11 times, then work across front leg, working 1 s c in d c and 1 d c in s c.

8th Row—1 s c in first d c, 1 d c in next s c, * 1 s c in next d c, 1 d c in next s c, repeat from * across row.

Work next 12 rows even.

21st Row—Begin Tail—1 s c in first d c, 1 d c in next s c, * 1 s c in next d c, 1 d c in next s c, repeat from * 5 times. 22nd Row—Skip the first 2 sts, * 1 s c in next d c, 1 d c in next s c, repeat from * 5 times.

23rd Row—Work pattern even across tail.

24th Row—Skip first 2 sts, * 1 s c in next d c, 1 d c in next s c, repeat from * across tail.

25th and 27th Rows-Work same as 23rd row.

26th and 28th Rows—Same as 24th row.

29th Row—Skip 1 st, 1 d c in next s c, * 1 s c in next d c, 1 d c in next s c, repeat from * once.

30th Row—Skip 1 st, d c in next s c, s c in next d c, repeat across row, break thread. Attach thread in last st of ch at lower part for hind leg. Work 1 s c in first st, 1 d c in next st, * 1 s c in next st, 1 d c in next st, repeat from * 3 times. Work 5 more rows of pattern even, break thread.

Attach thread in 12th st from tail, work pattern across row, turn and work back, then slip st to next st, break thread.

HEAD. Ch 17 and work in pattern across ch.

2nd and 3rd Rows-Work pattern even.

4th Row-Skip 2 sts and work 7 patterns across row.

5th and 6th Rows-Work 7 patterns.

7th Row—Work 7 patterns, then ch 5.

8th Row—Work 2 patterns on ch and 7 patterns across remainder of head.

9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th and 15th Rows—Work in pattern even.

Break thread and work another section in same manner. With Blue, work two sections following the first 14 rows and hind leg directions.

COLLAR. With single thread of Blue, ch 7, 3 d c in 4 th st from hook, skip 2 sts, s c in last st, ch 3, turn, 2 s c in same space with ch 3, s c over ch 3 of first shell, * ch 3, turn, 2 d c in same space with ch 3, s c over ch 3 of last shell, repeat from * until work measures about 7 inches, break thread.

To Assemble—Sew head sections to body. Sew the two Blue under sections together at top. Pad lightly, head, tail and body of Scotty as far as neck. Place the two Yellow sections together. With a double strand of Blue and starting at head where it is sewed to body, crochet the two Yellow sections together with single crochet, working around the head, across back and around tail. Fit the Blue under section in and crochet the Blue and Yellow section together in same manner.

Sew collar in position leaving a loop at top.

Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "PURITAN" MERCERIZED CROCHET AND KNITTING COTTON

119 yds. White.

"STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

1 60-yd. Ball Red. Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

MOTIF. With White, ch 7, join to form a ring, ch 3 (counts as 1 d c) and work 17 d c in ring, join. (18 d c)

2nd Row—Ch 3, 4 d c in same space, slip loop off hook, insert in 3rd st of ch and pull loop through, ch 1 to tighten, ch 2, 5 d c in next d c, slip loop off hook, insert in 1st d c and pull loop through, ch 1 to tighten, (popcorn st), * 1 d c in next d c, popcorn st in next d c, ch 2, popcorn st in next d c, repeat from * all around ending row with 1 d c in next d c, join in top of 1st popcorn st.

3rd Row-Sl st into loop and work 2 popcorn sts with ch 2 between in same place, * 1 d c in popcorn st, 3 d c in next d c, 1 d c in next popcorn st, 2 popcorn sts with ch 2 between in next loop, repeat from * all around ending row with the 5 d c, join break thread.

Attach Red and work 3 s c, ch 1, 3 s c in next loop, 1 s c in popcorn st, 1 s c in each of the next 5 d c, 1 s c in next popcorn st, repeat from beginning all around, join, break thread. Work 6 more motifs in same manner and sew together as illustrated for front section.

BACK SECTION. MOTIF. With White, ch 7, join to form a ring, ch 3 and work 17 d c in ring, join. (18 d c)

2nd Row—Ch 6, * 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, ch 3, repeat from * all around ending row with 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, join in 3rd st of ch 6.

3rd Row—Ch 3, * 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in next loop, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, repeat from * all around ending row with 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, join, break thread.

Attach Red and work same as last row of other motifs. Work 6 more motifs in same manner and sew together as illustrated. With Red, crochet the two sections together. Starting at joining, work a popcorn st in same space, * ch 2, skip 3 sts, s c in next s c, ch 2, skip 2 sts, 3 d c in next s c, ch 2, skip 2 sts, s c in next s c, ch 2, skip 2 sts, 5 d c in 1 ch loop at corner, repeat from *, ch 2, skip 3 s c, s c in next s c, ch 2, skip 2 s c, 3 d c in next s c, ch 2, skip 2 s c, s c in next s c, ch 2, popcorn st in joining and continue in same manner all around, do not break thread, ch 18 for loop, s c in same space, turn, ch 1 and work 32 s c over loop, break thread.

Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "PURITAN" MERCERIZED CROCHET AND KNITTING COTTON

169 yds. White.

"STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

1 60-yd. Ball Red.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

MOTIF. With White, ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 3, and work 15 d c in ring, (16 d c).

2nd Row—Ch 3, thread over needle, insert in st and pull loop up the length of a d c, * thread over needle, insert in same space and pull loop up the same length, repeat from *, thread over and pull through all loops on needle but one, thread over and pull through 2 loops, ch 3, puff st in same space, (puff st: thread over needle, insert in st and pull loop up the length of a d c, * thread over needle, insert in same space and pull loop up the same length, repeat from * twice, thread over and pull through all loops on needle but one, thread over and pull through 2 loops). * 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in next d c, 2 d c in next d c, 2 puff sts with ch 3 between in next d c, repeat www.antiquepatternlibrary.org 2025, 11

from * twice, 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in next d c, 2 d c in next d c, join in 1st puff st.

3rd Row-Sl st to loop and work 2 puff sts with ch 3 between in same space, 2 d c in next puff st, 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, puff st in next d c, 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, 2 d c in next puff st, 2 puff sts with ch 3 between in next loop, repeat from * twice, 2 d c in next puff st, 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, puff st in next d c, 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, 2 d c in next puff st, join.

4th Row—SI st to next loop and work 2 puff sts with ch 3 between in same space, 2 d c in next puff st, 1 d c in each of the next 4 d c, 1 d c in puff st, 1 d c in each of the next 4 d c, 2 d c in next puff st, 2 puff sts with ch 3 between in next loop, repeat in same manner all around, join, break thread. Work 13 more motifs in same manner, then work 4 motifs in Red. Sew the 4 Red and 5 White motifs together arranging as illustrated for front section.

The 9 White motifs are used for back section.

With Red, crochet the 2 sections together with a row of s c working 3 d c, ch 4 sl st in top of last d c for picot, 2 d c in each corner mesh and at each joining, ch 15 for loop, turn, sl st in same space, ch 1, turn and work 25 s c over ch, break thread.

Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "PURITAN" MERCERIZED CROCHET AND KNITTING COTTON

112 yds. White.

"STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

1 60-yd. Ball Red.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7,

FRONT SECTION. With Red, ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 3 and work 15 d c in ring, join. (16 d c.)

2nd Row—Puff st in each st with ch 1 between each puff st, (puff st: thread over needle, insert in st and pull up the length of a d c, * thread over needle, insert in same space and pull up same length, repeat from * twice, thread over and pull through all loops but one, thread over and pull through 2 loops).

3rd Row—Attach White and work 3 d c between each puff st, join.

4th Row—Ch 3, * puff st in next st, 1 d c in each of the next 2 sts, repeat from * all around ending row with 1 d c in next st, join.

5th Row—With Red, 2 s c in each st.

6th Row—With White, 1 d c in each s c.

7th Row—Same as 4th row.

8th Row—1 d c in each st.

9th Row—With Red, 1 s c in each d c increasing 1 s c in every 3rd st, break thread.

CIRCLES. With White, ch 7, join to form a ring, ch 4, counts as 1 tr c) and work 23 tr c in ring, join, (24 trc) break thread.

2nd Row—With Red, 1 s c in each tr c increasing 1 s c in every 3rd st, break thread and work 15 more circles in same manner. On right side sew 2 circles together holding to form a ridge. Sew remaining circles together in same manner and sew circles around front section as illustrated.

BACK SECTION. With Red, ch 6, join to form a ring and work 16 d c in ring, join.

2nd Row—1 d c in each d c with ch 1 between each d c, join.

3rd Row—With White, 3 d c in each mesh, join each row. 4th Row—1 d c in each d c.

5th Row—With Red, 2 s c in each d c.

6th Row—With White, 1 d c in each s c.


7th Row—With Red, 1 d c in each d c.

8th Row—With White, 1 d c in each d c.

9th Row—With Red, 1 s c in each d c increasing 1 s c in every 3rd st.

10th Row-With White, 1 d c in each s c.

11th Row—1 d c in each d c increasing 11 sts in row evenly spaced.

12th Row—With Red, 1 s d c in next d c, (s d c: thread over, insert in st and work off all loops at one time) 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, 2 tr c in next d c, 1 tr c in next d c, 2 tr c in next d c, 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, 1 s d c in next d c, repeat from beginning all around. Sew the two sections together.

LOOP. With Red, wrap around 2 fingers 5 times, then work 35 s c over loop and sew to potholder as illustrated.

No. 3213 Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "PURITAN" MERCERIZED CROCHET AND KNITTING COTTON

150 yds. White.

"STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5.

25 yds. Red.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

With White, ch 28, turn and work 27 s c on ch, ch 1, turn.

2nd Row-1 s c in each s c, ch 2, turn.

3rd Row—Skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, * ch 1, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, repeat from * across row, ch 2, turn.

4th Row—2 s c in 1st s c, ch 1, 2 s c in next s c, (an increase) * ch 1, skip 1 s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from * across row, ch 1, 2 s c in end ch, ch 2, turn.

5th Row—Skip 1 s c, 2 s c in next s c, * ch 1, skip 1 s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from * across row, ch 2, turn.

Repeat the 4th row.

7th, 8th & 9th Rows—Same as 5th row.

10th Row—Increase 1 pattern at beginning of row and 1 pattern at end of row then work 2 rows even in pattern.

Repeat the last 3 rows.

16th Row—Increase 1 pattern at beginning and end of row, then work 20 rows even in pattern.

37th Row—Decrease 1 pattern each end of row, then work 3 rows even.

Repeat the last 4 rows.

45th Row—Decrease 1 pattern each end then work 2 rows

48th Row—Decrease 1 pattern each end then work 3 rows even.

52nd Row—Decrease 1 pattern each end then work 2 rows even.

55th Row—Decrease 1 pattern each end then work 1 row even, break thread.

57th Row—With Red, skip 2 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 10 s c, ch 1, turn.

Next Row—1 s c in each s c, ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, 1 s c in next st, 1 s d c in next st, (s d c; thread over, insert in st, pull through and work off all loops at one time) 1 d c in each of the next 4 sts, 1 s d c in next st, 1 s c in next st,

SPOUT. With White, attach thread in first st at straight edge and working toward lower edge work 9 patterns across straight edge, ch 2, turn, work a pattern in each pattern increasing 1 pattern at end of row, ch 2, turn.

Next Row—Decrease 1 pattern at end of row then work 1 row even.

Next Row—Decrease 1 pattern at end of row.

Next Row—Increase 1 pattern at end of row.

Next Row—Decrease 1 pattern at end of row.

Next Row—Decrease 1 pattern at beginning of row.

Next Row—Decrease 1 pattern at end of row, break thread. Work another section in same manner.

With Red, crochet the 2 sections together, starting at lower edge, work 1 s c in each s c across bottom, * ch 3, d c in

same space, skip ½ inch space, s c in next st, repeat from * all around, break thread.

Thread Red into needle and work a row of outline st about 1 inch down from Red top. Work another outline st ½ inch from lower edge and across side to separate the spout from body. Draw a 3½ inch circle in center and work numerals on it as illustrated. Work a small solid circle in center of clock and work 2 hands using the lazy daisy st.

HANDLE. With White, ch 37, and work 36 s c on ch, break thread.

Attach Red and work 1 s c in each s c working 3 s c at end, turn and working on other side of s c, work 1 s c in each of the next 7 s c, * skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from * 6 times, 1 s c in each remaining st, break thread leaving an end to sew.

Sew to potholder as illustrated.

LOOP. Wrap Red around small finger 3 times, remove from finger and work 20 s c over loop. Attach to top of potholder.





Join White at back of slipper in last d c, work 2 s c in d c, 1 s c in each of the next 10 rows joining the 2 sections, then over 1 section only work 1 s c in each row, 2 s c in last row. Working over the entire st at lower edge of slipper, work 1 s c over each s c, at toe, work 1 s c in each of the next 10 rows, then join the two sections together and work down the opposite toe and across lower edge and up back to the joining, break thread.

Join 2 strands of Red at toe joining and work 1 s c in one section, then 1 s c in opposite section, 1 s c in first section, 1 s c in opposite section. Keep on working 1 s c in first section, then one s c in opposite section until all rows of toe are worked together, continue across top of slipper in same manner until slipper is joined to top of beading, break thread.

TIE. With 2 strands—Ch about 15 inches, work 1 s c in each ch. Run through beading and tie in a bow. Sew bow in place. Work heel same as shoe No. 3221.







2nd Row—Working in back loop of st only, 1 s c in each of the next 4 s c, 1 s d c in each of the next 10 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 53 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 3 sts, ch 2, turn. 3rd Row-Working in front loop of st only, 1 s d c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 53 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 10 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 4 sts, ch 1, turn and repeat the last 2 rows 13 times, break hread.

Thread White into needle and working on a ridge, pull thread through from wrong side about 11/2 inches from top, work over 2 sts on right side, insert needle between next 2 sts and pull thread through to wrong side, thread over next 2 sts on wrong side and pull through to right side, insert needle at base of first st and pull through to wrong side, continue in same manner for about 31/2 inches, work each stripe about 1 inch apart. Potholder illustrated has 6 stripes varying in length.

Cut a lining from any suitable material same shape as potholder allowing 1/4 inch all around to turn under, sew in position on inside of potholder.

Attach thread at bottom of potholder and work 28 s c across row, join together and work 1 s c in every other s c.

2 60-yd. Balls Orange. 20 yds. Green for Stems.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

Entire potholder is worked in s c.

Ch 5, join to form a ring and work 10 s c in ring, join.

2nd Row—Ch 1, * 1 s c in next s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from * all around.

3rd Row—Increase in every 3rd st, join.

4th Row—Increase in every 4th st, join.

5th Row—Increase in every 5th st, then work 1 row even. Do not join, ch 1, turn.

7th Row—* 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from * 9 times, ch 1, turn. Work back and forth for remainder of potholder.

8th Row—Increase in every 4th st, ch 1, turn.

9th Row—Increase in every 5th st, ch 1, turn.

10th & 11th Rows—Work even.

12th Row—Increase in every 6th st, ch 1, turn.

Work even until work measures 4 inches from beginning.

Next Row—Decrease every 10th st, then work 2 rows even. Repeat the last 3 rows.

Next Row—Decrease every 10th st then work 1 row even. Repeat the last 2 rows.

Next Row—Decrease every 8th st then work 1 row even.

Next Row—Decrease every 7th st then work 1 row even.

Next Row—Decrease every 6th st then work 1 row even.

Next Row—Decrease every 6th st then work 2 rows even.

Next Row—Decrease every 7th st then work 2 rows even.

Next Row—Decrease every 6th st then work 2 rows even. Repeat the last 3 rows twice.

Next Row—Decrease every 5th st then work 2 rows even.

Next Row—Decrease every 3rd st then work 7 rows even, join.

Next Row—1 s c in every other s c, break thread.

LINING. Using suitable material, cut a circle about 2 inches in diameter, then cut a strip same length as potholder and cut same shape as potholder allowing ½ inch to turn in on each side. Sew top of strip around circle. Sew in position. Sew potholder together at bottom for about 1 inch.

STEM. With Green, ch 3, join to form a ring, ch 1, 1 s c in each ch, without joining rows work 1 s c in each s c taking up back loop of st only. Work for 2½ inches, break thread. Work 7 more stems in same manner. Then work one loop 5 inches in same manner. Sew stems to top of potholder as illustrated.

No. 3234—CORN Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

3 60-yd. Balls Yellow. 10 yds. Green.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

With Yellow, ch 55, d c in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in each remaining ch, ch 3, turn.

2nd & 3rd Rows—1 d c in each d c, ch 3, turn.

4th Row-4 d c in next d c, drop loop from hook, insert in 1st d c and pull loop through, ch 1 to tighten st (a popcorn st), 1 d c in next d c, * 4 d c popcorn st in next d c, 1 d c in next d c, repeat from * across row ending with 1 d c, ch


5th Row—1 s c in each d c and 1 s c in each popcorn st, ch 3, turn and repeat the 4th and 5th rows 15 times, ch 3, turn. Next Row—1 d c in each popcorn st and 1 d c in each d c. Next 2 Rows—1 d c in each d c.

Next Row—1 s c in every 3rd st, break thread leaving an end. Thread into needle and draw together with a running st. Work a row of s c across each side. Attach thread at lower edge and work 1 s c in every 3rd st, turn and work 1 s c in every other st, break thread leaving an end. Thread into needle and draw together same as top.

LEAVES. With Green, ch 23, s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each of the next 2 chs, 1 s d c in each of the next 3 chs, (s d c: thread over, insert in st, pull through and work off all loops at one time) 1 d c in each of the next 3 chs, 1 tr c in each of the next 5 chs, 1 d c in each of the next 4 chs, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 chs, 1 s c in each of the next 2 chs, break thread leaving an end to sew. Work 5 more leaves in same manner and sew to top of corn as illustrated, tacking each leaf in position.

LOOP. With Green, wrap around 2 fingers 3 times, then cover loop with s c and sew to top of corn.

Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

2 60-yd. Balls Red

3 Small Hooks, 1 piece Wood 7 inches long, 3/4 inch wide and 1/4 inch thick, 1 one inch Ring.

Steel Crochei Hook No. 7 or 8.

Ch 25 and work 24 s c on ch.

2nd Row—Ch 3, turn, (the ch 3 counts as 1 d c) 1 s c in next s c, * 1 d c in next s c, 1 s c in next s c, repeat from * to end of row, turn.

3rd Row—1 s c in next d c, * 1 d c in next s c, 1 s c in next d c, repeat from * to end of row, turn. Continue working same as 3rd row until work is long enough to cover wood. Then work 1 row of s c, fold lengthwise and crochet one end together with one row of s c, break thread. Attach thread at top and crochet long side together, insert wood and crochet end together. Then work 1 row of shells on 2 short sides and across top (shell: ch 3, 2 d c in same space, skip 2 s c, s c in next s c) break thread.

STRAPS. Ch 9, work 8 s c on ch.

2nd Row—Ch 3, turn, 1 s c in next s c, * 1 d c in next s c, 1 s c in next s c, repeat from * to end of row.

3rd Row—Ch 3 turn, 1 s c in d c, * 1 d c in s c, 1 s c in d c, repeat from * to end of row. Repeat 3rd row until work measures 6 inches, break thread and make another strap.

Work s c over bone ring. Sew one short end of straps together half way across, then sew ring in position. Sew other ends of straps to rack, and screw hooks in position.

No. 3202

Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

2 60-yd. Balls Red.

2 60-yd. Balls White or Cream for each Potholder.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 6.

With Cream and using 2 strands of thread, ch 36 and work 35 s c on ch, ch 3 to turn.

2nd Row—1 d c in each s c.

3rd Row—Ch 3, (the ch 3 counts as one d c) * thread over needle, insert needle under next d c, pull thread through, thread over needle and work off as a d c, repeat from * to end of row ending row with a d c in the ch 3.

4th Row—Drop the Cream, attach Red, ch 3 and work 1 d c in next d c, * thread over needle, insert needle under next d c, pull thread through, thread over and work off as a d c, 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, repeat from * to end of row.

5th Row—Work same as 3rd row, drop Red, pick up Cream and work 2 rows same as 4th and 5th rows. Continue working, following 4th and 5th rows, working 2 rows Red and 2 rows Cream until you have 5 Red waffle rows and 6 Cream waffle rows. Then work 1 row of s c across top working 1 s c in each s c. Work 1 row of s c down one side, working 3 s c in each 2 rows, break thread. Attach thread on opposite corner and work s c down side, then work one row of s c all around, working 1 s c in each s c with 3 s c at corners, break thread.

UNDER SECTION. Using one strand of Cream, ch 46 and work 1 d c in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in each remaining ch, ch 3 to turn. Work 4 more rows of d c in Cream, 10 rows in Red, 5 rows in Cream, break thread. With Red, work 1 row of s c all around, break thread.

With Red crochet the two sections together with a row of s c working through the back loop of upper section.

RING. Ch 15, skip 3 sts, slip st in next st, ch 1, and work s c over ch.

No. 3203

Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

4 60-yd. Balls Red or any Color desired.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 5.

Ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 8 s c over ring, join in 1st s c.

2nd Row—Ch 3, 2 d c in same space, 2 d c in each remaining s c, join in 1st d c.

3rd Row—Ch 3, 2 d c in same space, 2 d c in each remaining d c, join in 1st d c.

4th Row—Ch 1, turn and work 2 loop sts in each st, (loop st: wind thread over index finger, insert hook in st, draw thread through pulling thread from under finger, drop loop from finger letting fall to right side of work and complete s c) join in 1st st.

5th Row—Ch 3, turn, ** 1 d c in each of the next 2 sts, thread over, * insert in next st, pull through, repeat from *, thread over and pull through 3 loops, thread over and pull through remaining loops, (a decrease) repeat from ** all around, join in 1st d c.

6th Row—Ch 3, 1 d c in same space, 1 d c in next st, 2 d c in next st, * 1 d c in each of the next 2 sts, 2 d c in next st, repeat from * all around, join in 1st d c.

7th Row—Same as 6th row but increasing in every 4th st.

8th Row—Same as 4th row but working 1 loop st in each st.

9th Row—Ch 3, turn, work 1 d c in each st increasing in every 4th st, join in 1st d c.

10th Row—Ch 3, 1 d c in each d c increasing in every 5th st, join in 1st d c.

11th Row—Ch 3, 1 d c in each d c, join in 1st d c.

12th Row—Same as 8th row.

13th Row—Ch 3, turn, 1 d c in each st increasing in every 3rd st.

14th and 15th Rows—Same as 11th row.

16th Row—Same as 8th row.

17th Row—Ch 3, turn, 1 d c in each st increasing in every 4th st, join, break thread.

Work back of potholder in same manner working the loop st rows in s c, break thread. Crochet the 2 sections together with a row of s c and finish with a loop as follows; ch 20, sl st in same st, ch 1, turn and cover loop with s c, break thread.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

FRONT SECTION. With Green, ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 3 (counts as 1 d c) and work 11 more d c in ring, join. 2nd Row—Ch 3, 4 d c in same space, s c in next d c, * 5 d c in next d c, s c in next d c, repeat from * all around, join, break thread.

3rd Row—Attach White in s c between petals, ch 3, 4 d c in same space, s c in center st of next petal, * 5 d c in s c between next 2 petals, s c in center st of next petal, repeat from * all around, join.

4th Row-1 d c in each d c and 5 d c in each s c, join.

5th Row—With Green, 1 s c in each d c, join.

6th Row—With White, 1 d c in each st increasing 1 d c in every 3rd st, (80 d c) join each row.

In the following rows the thread is carried underneath. When changing Color always complete the last half of st with next color.

7th Row—With White, ch 3, 1 d c in each of the next 6 d c, with Green, puff st in next st (puff st: thread over needle, insert in st and pull loop up the length of a d c, * thread over needle, insert in same st and pull loop up same length, repeat from * twice, thread over and pull through all loops on needle at one time but one, thread over and pull through 2 loops) * with White, 1 d c in each of the next 7 d c, with Green, puff st in next st, repeat from * all around.

8th Row—With Green, puff st in same space, * with White, 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, 2 d c in next d c, with Green, 1 puff st in each of the next 3 sts, repeat from * all around ending row with 2 puff sts in Green. 9th Row—With Green, puff st in puff st, puff st in next d c, * with White, 1 d c in each of the next 5 d c, with Green, 1 puff st in each of the next 5 sts, repeat from * all around ending row with Green, 1 puff st in last d c, 1 puff st in each of the next 2 puff sts.

10th Row—With Green, puff st in next puff st, * with White, 1 d c in next puff st, 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, 1 d c in next puff st, with Green, 1 puff st in each of the next 3 puff sts, repeat from * all around ending row with 2 puff sts in Green.

11th Row—With White, ch 3, d c in same space, * 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, 2 d c in next st, repeat from * twice, with Green, puff st in next puff st, ** with White,

2 d c in next puff st, 1 d c in each of the next 2 sts, * 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, repeat from *, 2 d c in next puff st, with Green, puff st in next puff st, repeat from ** all around.

12th Row—With White, 1 d c in each d c and 3 d c in each puff st.

13th Row—With Green, 1 s c in each d c increasing 1 s c in every 15th st, break thread.

BACK SECTION. Work first 6 rows same as front section.

7th Row-With White, 1 d c in each d c.

8th Row—Increase in every 4th st.

9th Row—Increase in every 10th st.

10th Row-Increase in every 5th st.

11th Row—Increase in every 6th st.

12th Row—Increase in every 7th st.

13th Row—With Green, 1 s c in each d c increasing 4 sts evenly spaced in row.

Crochet the 2 sections together with Green, * 1 s c in each of the next 6 s c, ch 2, d c in same space, ch 3, sl st in top of last d c for picot, d c in same space, ch 2, sl st in same space, repeat from * all around, working a loop after last 6 s c, (loop: ch 15, turn, sl st in same space, ch 1, turn and work 26 s c over ch.)
