Black and White Drama

#3503 BERET

Materials Required—
AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
"STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

6 60-yd. Balls White. 6 60-yd. Balls Black. Steel Crochet Hook #5.

The entire Hat is worked with 2 strands of thread. With White, ch 5, join, ch 3, 11 d c in ring, join each row and start each row with ch 3.

2nd and 3rd Rows—2 d c in each d c.

4th Row—1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, * 1 popcorn st in next d c, (popcorn st: 4 d c in same space, slip thread off hook, insert hook in first d c of group and draw thread through) 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, repeat from * all around ending row with popcorn st in last st.

5th Row-Work in d c increasing in every 4th st.

6th Row—Work in d c increasing in every 3rd st. Repeat 4th, 5th and 6th rows once, then repeat the 4th row and work one row of d c even.

12th Row—Work in d c increasing in every 4th st. Repeat 4th row once and work 1 row even.

15th Row-Increase in every 4th st.

16th Row—Popcorn st, * 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, popcorn st in next st, repeat from * all around, ending row with 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, break thread.

UNDER SECTION—With Black, 5 ch, join, (join each row and ch 3 to start each row).

2nd Row—Work 11 more d c in ring, join to 3rd st of ch 3, (the ch 3 counts as 1 d c).

3rd and 4th Rows-2 d c in each d c.

5th Row-Work even in d c.

6th Row—Work in d c increasing in every 5th d c.

7th, 8th and 9th Rows—Increase in every 7th st and work 2

12th Row—Working in back loop of st only, increase in every 4th st, then picking up both loops of st, work 1 row

14th Row—Popcorn st in every 4th st with 1 d c in each st between popcorn sts.

15th Row-Work in d c increasing in every 4th st.

16th Row—Increase often enough to match stitches in last row of top of hat, break thread.

Band, with the right side of hat towards you, attach Black in

free loop of 12th row, ch 3 and work 1 d c in each st all around. Join and work 3 more rows of d c even, break thread. With Black, crochet the 2 sections together with a row of s c. CORDS FOR BACK OF HAT—Ch 6, join, work 1 s c in each st, without joining rows and working in back loop of st only, work 1 s c in each s c until Black cord measures about 15 inches and White cord measures about 11 inches. Sew each end of Black cord to back of hat about 7 inches apart. Sew White cord just inside Black cord. Line hat if desired.

POPCORN BAG

Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

16-60-yd. Balls White. 1/3 yd. of Lining. 23/4 yds. Cable Cord. Steel Crochet Hook #5.

9 60-yd. Balls Black. ¹/₃ yd. of Buckram. 1 9-inch Zipper.

The entire Bag is worked with 2 strands of thread.

With White, ch 88, 1 d c in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in each remaining st of ch (ch 3 to turn each d c row).

2nd Row-1 d c in each d c.

3rd Row—1 d c in each of the first 4 d c, * popcorn st in next d c, (see hat directions for popcorn st) 1 d c in each of the next 4 d c, repeat from * to end of row.

4th Row—1 d c in each d c and popcorn st. Repeat 3rd and 4th rows 10 times, then work 1 row of d c, break thread and work one more side section in same manner.

GUSSET: With White, ch 11 and work 10 s c on ch, (ch 1 to turn each row). Working in back loop of st only, work 1 s c in each s c until gusset is long enough to fit around 2 sides and bottom of bag, break thread.

ROLL: With Black, ch 13 and work 12 s c on ch, work roll same as gusset until its long enough to go all around bag, break thread and work another roll in same manner.

HANDLE: Work same as roll for about 13 inches, break thread.

TO MAKE BAG: Crochet gusset to 2 sides and bottom of both side pieces. Place Cable cord in roll and sew. Sew cords all around outside of bag. For lining directions, see page 2. Insert lining and sew in position, sew cable cord into handle, sew together to form a ring, attach thread in handle at joining, ch 10, slip thread through zipper tab, ch 10, attach to handle, break thread.

#3513 SCOTCH HAT

Materials Required—

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
"STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

6 60-yd. Balls White or any Color desired. 3/4 yd. 1 inch ribbon. Steel Crochet Hook #5.

The entire Hat is worked with 2 strands of thread. Crown—Ch 33 and work 3 d c in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in each of the next 28 sts of ch, 3 d c in last st, working on opposite side of ch, 1 d c in each of the 28 sts, join each row to ch 3.

2nd Row—Ch 3 (the ch 3 counts as 1 d c) 1 d c in same space with ch 3, 2 d c in each of the next 2 d c, 1 d c in each of the next 28 d c, 2 d c in each of the next 3 d c, 1 d c in each of the next 28 d c.

3rd Row—Ch 3, 1 d c in same space with ch 3, 2 d c in each of the next 5 d c, 1 d c in each of the next 28 d c, 2 d c in each of the next 6 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 28 d c.

4th Row—Work same as 3rd row, working 2 d c in each of the 12 end sts.

5th Row—Ch 3, 1 d c in each of the next 9 d c, 2 d c in each of the next 4 d c, 1 d c in each of the next 48 d c, 2 d c in each of the next 4 d c, 1 d c in each remaining st.

Materials Required—

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
"DE LUXE" MERCERIZED CROCHET

AND KNITTING COTTON

3 250-yd Balls Yellow or any Color desired. 1/4 yd. 1 inch Ribbon.

Steel Crochet Hook #5.

With double strand of thread, ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 8 s c in ring, join in 1st s c.

2nd Row—Ch 3, 2 d c in same space, 2 d c in each remaining s c, do not join this or following rows.

3rd Row—Place a marker at beginning of each row, 2 d c in each st.

4th Row—* 2 d c in 1st d c, 1 d c in next d c, repeat from * all around

5th Row-1 d c in each d c increasing in every 3rd st.

6th Row—Same as last row increasing in every 4th st.

7th Row-1 d c in each st.

8th Row—Same as 6th row increasing in every 5th st.

9th Row—Same as last row increasing in every 6th st.

Next 4 Rows—1 d c in each st.

14th Row-Same as 9th row increasing in every 7th st.

15th Row-Same as last row increasing in every 8th st.

16th Row- 1 d c in each st.

17th Row—S d c in next st, (s d c: thread over, insert in st, pull through and work off all loops at one time) 1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, ch 3, turn, 2 d c in 1st s c, skip next 2 sts, s c in next st, * ch 3, 2 d c in same space, skip 2 sts, s c in next st, (a shell st) repeat from * 45 times ch 3, 2 d c in same space, s c in ch 3 loop of 1st shell, ch 3, turn.

18th Row—2 d c in s c just made, s c in ch 3 loop of next shell, shell in same space and work 45 more shells, shell in same space, sl st in same st with 1st shell, sl st in ch 3 loop of 1st shell, ch 3, turn.

19th and 20th Rows-Same as 18th row.

21st Row—Work 6 shells, then increase 1 shell by working into the s c between shells of previous row, increase after every 6th shell. (8 increases in row).

22nd and 23rd Rows—Work 1 shell in each shell, joining each row and turning each row.

24th Row-Work 40 shells, ch 3, turn.

25th Row-Work 39 shells, ch 3, turn.

26th Row-Work 38 shells, ch 3, turn.

27th Row—Work 38 shells, work another shell, s c in shell of 23rd row, work 17 more shells across row, sl st in 1st shell, ch 3, turn.

28th Row—Work 17 shells, sl st to next shell, then work 1 shell in each remaining shell, sl st in 1st shell, ch 3, turn. 29th Row—1 shell in each shell, sl st in 1st shell, ch 3, turn. 30th Row—Same as last row.

31st Row-Work 40 shells, ch 3, turn.

32nd Row-Work 39 shells, ch 3, turn.

33rd Row—Work 39 shells, work another shell, s c in shell of 30th row, work 17 more shells across row, sl st in 1st shell, ch 3, turn.

34th Row—Work 17 shells, sl st in next shell, and work a shell in each remaining shell, join, break thread.

Gather at back slightly and attach ribbon at back.

TRIPLE POUCH BAG

Materials Required—
AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
"DE LUXE" MERCERIZED CROCHET
AND KNITTING COTTON

7 250-yd. Balls Yellow or any Color desired.

½ yd. Buckram.

1/2 yd. Lining.

Plastic Clip.

Steel Crochet Hook #5 or #6.

Bag is made with double strand of thread.

BACK SECTION: Ch 92, 2 d c in 4th st from hook, skip 3 chs, s c in next ch, * ch 3, 2 d c in same space, skip 3 chs, s c in next ch, repeat from * across row, ch 4, turn.

2nd Row—2 d c in same space, s c in 3 ch loop, * ch 3, 2 d c shell in same space, s c in next 3 ch loop, repeat from * across row, increase 1 shell in last shell, ch 4, turn.

Repeat 2nd row 3 times, then continue working shells even until section measures 113/4 inches, break thread.

FRONT SECTION: Work same as back section until section measures 83/4 inches. Break thread.

2nd POUCH: Ch 84 and work shells across ch.

Next 4 Rows—Increase 1 shell at end of each row, then continue working shells until section measures 7½ inches, break thread.

3rd POUCH: Ch 76 and work same as other sections until piece measures 6 inches, break thread.

FINISHING: Sew 2nd pouch section to front section, sewing 2nd pouch 1½ inches from sides and bottom of front section. Sew 3rd pouch section to 2nd pouch section sewing 3rd pouch 1½ inches from sides and bottom of 2nd pouch section. Sew front and back sections together overcasting on wrong side. Sew elastic at top of 3rd pouch. Fold for a 3 inch flap. Place lining in bag and sew. Attach clip. For lining directions see page 23.

SCOTCH HAT

6th Row—Ch 3, 1 d c in each of the next 11 d c, 2 d c in each of the next 4 d c, 1 d c in each of the next 52 d c, 2 d c in each of the next 4 d c, 1 d c in each remaining d c, join and break thread.

Band—Ch 30 and work 29 s c on ch, ch 3, turn.

2nd Row—2 d c in same space with ch 3, skip 3 s c, s c in next s c, * ch 3, 2 d c in same space, skip 3 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from * 5 times ch 3, turn.

3rd Row—2 d c in same space with ch 3, s c over ch 3 of next shell, * ch 3, 2 d c in same space, s c over ch 3 of next shell, repeat from * 5 times. Continue working same as

3rd row, until work is about 22 inches or a little larger than head size, break thread.

To make Hat—Fold band in center, place a marker in 4th shell of each side from open ends for top of hat, cross band so that both markers meet and sew together at top. Slant both ends till last row meets first row to form a point for back of hat, sew in position, break thread. Place crown in position having center of increasing points at markers at back of hat and in the center fold of front, crochet crown and band together with a row of s c.

Make a 2 loop bow and attach on a slant at back of hat. Line if desired.

Rembrandt's Beret

Materials Required—
AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
"STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

10 60-yd. Balls Black.

"STAR" SIX STRAND MERCERIZED EMBROIDERY COTTON.

6 yds. Yellow and 6 yds. Red.

63 Small Red Sequins and 18 Green Sequins.

Steel Crochet Hook #5.

The entire Beret is worked with 2 strands of thread. Ch 4, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 12 s c in ring.

2nd Row—Ch 3, 1 d c in same space with ch 3, * 2 d c in next s c, repeat from * 10 times (join each row and ch 3 to start each row).

3rd Row—Puff st in next d c, (for puff st see Bag Directions) * 2 d c in next d c, puff st in next d c, repeat from * 10 times, 1 d c in same space with ch 3.

4th Row—Puff st over puff st of previous row, * 1 d c in next d c, 2 d c in next d c, puff st over next puff st, repeat from * 10 times, 1 d c in next d c, 1 d c in same space with ch 3.

5th Row—Puff st in puff st, * 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, 2 d c in next d c, puff st in next puff st, repeat from * 10 times, 1 d c in each remaining d c, 1 d c in same space with ch 3.

6th, 7th and 8th Rows—Work the same as 5th row increasing 1 d c before each puff st in each row.

9th Row—Puff st over puff st, * 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in each of the next 5 d c, 2 d c in next d c, puff st in next puff st, repeat from * 10 times and finish with 2 d c in next d c and 1 d c in each remaining d c and 1 d c in same space with ch 3.

10th, 11th, 12th, 13th and 14th Rows—Work same as 9th row increasing 1 d c before and after each puff st in each row. (There should be 19 d c betwen puff sts in 14th row.) Next 8 Rows—Work even in pattern.

23nd Row—Start decreasing, thread over, insert needle in puff st, pull loop through, thread over, insert needle in next d c, pull loop through, thread over and pull through all loops but one on needle, thread over and pull through remaining loops, * 1 d c in each of the next 17 d c, thread over, insert needle in next d c, pull loop through, thread over, insert needle in next puff st, pull loop through, thread over, insert needle in next d c, pull loop through, thread over and work off same as last decreasing puff st, repeat from * 10 times. Last section work in d c decreasing 1st.

Next 5 Rows—Continue working the same as 23rd row, decreasing 2 d c in each section of each row or until Beret is correct head size, do not break thread.

BANDEAU: Ch 3, * thread over, insert needle in puff st, pull loop through, repeat from * once, thread over, insert in next d c and work off as a puff st, * 1 d c in each d c, puff st in next puff st, repeat from * twice, then work 1 d c in each d c decreasing in last d c and puff st.

Work 6 more rows decreasing at beginning and end of each row, then work 1 row of puff sts, break thread.

Embroider Beret as illustrated. The half Lazy Daisies are in Yellow, the large Lazy Daisy is in Red.

Red Sequins are scattered, Green are used as stems for Red Lazy Daisy.

TO LINE BERET: Cut 2 circles a little larger than Beret, cut head size out of one circle, sew the 2 circles together and fit them into Beret. If a roll is desired, sew a piece of

lining about 3 inches wide and long enough to fit around Beret, fill with cotton and sew to edge of lining. Cut a piece to fit bandeau and sew in position, then sew lining all around.

HALF MOON BAG

Materials Required—
AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
"STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

18 60-yd. Balls Black.

"STAR" SIX STRAND MERCERIZED EMBROIDERY COTTON.

5 yds. Yellow and 5 yds. Red.

40 small Red sequins - 16 Green sequins. Steel Crochet Hook #5.

The entire Bag is worked with 2 strands of thread.

Ch 66 and work 65 s c on ch. (ch 3 to turn each row).

2nd, 3rd and 4th Rows-1 d c in each d c.

5th Row—1 puff st in first d c, (puff st: * thread over needle, insert needle in stitch, pull loop through, repeat from * twice, thread over needle and pull through all loops but one, thread over needle and pull through remaining loops) * 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in each of the next 6 d c, puff st in next d c, repeat from * 7 times.

6th Row—Puff st in puff st, * 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in each of the next 7 d c, puff st in next d c, repeat from * 7 times.

7th Row—Puff st in puff st, * 1 d c in each of the next 9 d c, puff st in next puff st, repeat from * 7 times. 8th Row—Same as 7th row.

9th Row—Puff st in puff st, * 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in each of the next 8 d c, puff st in next puff st, repeat from *

10th Row—Puff st in puff st, * 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in each of the next 9 d c, puff st in puff st, repeat from * 7 times.

Repeat the last 4 rows 3 times, having 1 more d c between increasing points in each increasing row, then work 4 more rows even.

27th Row—1 puff st in puff st, * 1 puff st in each of the next 17 d c, 1 puff st in next puff st, repeat from * 7 times, break thread and work another section in same manner. Without breaking thread, crochet the two sections together as follows: * Ch 3, puff st in same space, skip 1 row, s c in next row, repeat from * down side to corner, across loweredge * ch 3, puff st in same space, skip 2 puff sts s c in next puff st, repeat from * to corner and work other side to correspond. Around opening at top of bag work 1 d c in each of the first 7 sts, puff st in next st, continue in same manner all around, break thread.

HANDLE. Ch 6 and work 5 s c on ch (ch 3 to turn each row).

2nd Row—Puff st in first st. 1 d c in each of the next 3 s c, puff st in next s c.

3rd Row—Puff st in puff st, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, puff st in puff st. Repeat 3rd row until handle is desired length.

Finishing—Embroider in Lazy Daisy st and sequins as illustrated. Insert lining into bag and sew handle in position. For lining directions see page 2.

Tab for zipper—With single thread, ch 3 and work 10 s c in first st, join.

2nd Row—Work a puff st with ch 1 between in each s c. 3rd Row—Work a puff st with ch 2 between over the ch 1 between puffs, join, ch 12, slip loop through zipper, ch 1 and work 1 s c in each ch, break thread.

The Loop Cossack

12 60-yd. Balls Black or any Color desired.

Steel Crochet Hook #5 or #6.

Hat is made with double strand of thread.

Ch 154, join, taking care not to twist ch, ch 2, 1 s d c in same space (s d c: thread over, insert in st, thread over and pull through all loops on needle at one time), 1 s d c in each remaining st, join in 1st s d c, ch 1, turn.

2nd Row-1 loop st in each st, (loop st: wind thread over index finger, insert hook in st, draw thread through pulling thread from under finger, drop loop from finger letting fall to right side of work and complete s c) join in 1st loop st ch 2, turn.

3rd Row-1 s d c in each loop st, join in 1st s d c.

4th and 5th Rows-Ch 2, 1 s d c in same space, 1 s d c in each remaining st, join in 1st s d c, ch 1 at end of last row turn.

6th Row-Same as 2nd row.

Repeat last 4 rows twice.

15th Row—Work in s d c decreasing every 7th st, (decrease: thread over, insert in st, thread over, pull through, insert in next st, pull through, thread over and pull through all loops on needle at one time) join in 1st s d c.

16th and 17th Rows—Work even in s d c, ch 1, at end of last row turn.

18th Row-Same as 2nd row.

Next 3 Rows—Work even in s d c, ch 1, at end of last row

22nd Row-Same as 2nd row.

23rd Row-Work in s d c decreasing every 6th st, join in

24th and 25th Rows-Work even in s d c, ch 1, at end of last row turn.

26th Row-Same as 2nd row.

27th Row-Work in s d c decreasing every 5th st, join in 1st s d c.

28th and 29th Rows-Work even in s d c, ch 1, at end of last row turn.

30th Row-Same as 2nd row.

Next 3 Rows—Work even in s d c, ch 1, at end of last row

Repeat last 4 rows, then repeat 2nd row, ch 1, turn and work 1 s c in each st, join in 1st s c, break thread.

CROWN: Ch 3 and work 8 s d c in 1st st of ch, join in 1st s d c.

2nd Row-Ch 2, 2 s d c in same space, 2 s d c in each remaining st, do not join this or following rows.

Continue working rows of s d c, increasing a sufficient number of times to keep work flat until crown measures 3½ inches in diameter or fits top of hat, 1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 sl st in each of the next 3 sts, break thread. Turn hat inside out and overcast crown in position. Work a row of s c around lower edge of hat.

LOOP BAG

Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

22 60-yd. Balls Black or any Color desired.

1/3 yd. Buckram.

1/3 yd. Lining.

12 inch Zipper.

Steel Crochet Hook #5 or #6.

Bag is worked with double strand of thread.

SIDE SECTION: Ch 98, s d c in 3rd st from hook, (s d c; thread over, insert in st, pull through and work off all loops at one time) 1 s d c in each remaining ch, ch 2, turn.

2nd Row-1 s d c in each s d c, ch 1, turn.

3rd Row-Work 1 loop st in each s d c, (loop st wind thread over index finger, insert hook in st, draw thread through pulling thread from under finger, drop loop from finger letting fall to right side of work and complete s c) ch 2 turn.

4th Row-Work 1 s d c in each loop st, ch 2, turn.

5th Row—Work 1 s d c in each s d c, ch 1, turn.

Repeat last 3 rows 7 times, then work 1 more row of loop sts and 1 more row of s d c, break thread.

Work another section in the same manner.

Gusset-Ch 11, s d c in 3rd st from hook, 1 s d c in each remaining ch, ch 2, turn.

2nd Row-1 s d c in each st, ch 2, turn.

Repeat 2nd row until gusset is length required

Roll—Ch 21, s d c in 3rd st from hook, 1 s d c in each remaining ch, ch 2, turn.

2nd Row-1 s d c in each st, ch 2, turn.

Repeat 2nd row 61 times, break thread.

Work another roll in same manner.

Sew crocheted roll to side of bag as illustrated and sew gusset in position. For roll stuffing, cut a strip of material 14 inches long, 3 inches wide. Fold lengthwise, seam one short side, and the long edge, turn right side out and fill with cotton, sew other end. Sew each end of roll, place roll stuffing in position and sew. Finish other roll in same manner. Sew gussets in position, insert lining in bag and sew. For lining directions see page 23.

#3510 BASIC BEANIE

Illustration on page 12 Materials Required-AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

5 60-yd. Balls Black or any Color desired.

Steel Crochet Hook #5 or #6.

Beanie is made with double strand of thread.

Ch 3, 8 s d c in 1st st of ch, (s d c: thread over, insert in st, thread over, pull through and work off all loops at one time) join in 1st s d c.

2nd Row—Ch 2, 2 s d c in same space, 2 s d c in each remaining st, do not join this on following rows.

3rd Row-Mark the beginning of each row, * 1 s d c in

next st, 2 s d c in next st, repeat from * all around. 4th Row-Work in s d c increasing in every 3rd st.

5th Row-Same as last row, but increase in every 4th st. Next 4 Rows—Continue increasing at increasing points having 1 more st between increasing points in each row.

10th Row-Increase in every 3rd st.

11th Row-Increase in every 12th st.

12th Row-Increase in every 13th st.

13th Row-Increase in every 14th st.

Next 3 Rows-Work even.

17th Row—Increase in every 5th st.

Next 9 Rows—Work even, 1 s c in each of next 3 sts, 1 sl st in each of next 3 sts, break thread.

Trim with feathers, clips or ribbon bows as desired.





#3507 TWO COLOR SNOOD

Materials Required—
AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
"SILLATEEN SANSIL"

6 60-yd. Balls Red. 2 60-yd. Balls White. ½ yd. of round Elastic. Steel Crochet Hook #7 and #9.

With #7 hook and Red thread chain 14 inches and work 1 s c in 12th st from hook, * ch 7, skip 4 sts of ch, 1 s c in next st, repeat from * to end of row, (ch 10 to turn each row).

2nd Row—2 s c over the 7 ch loop, * ch 7, 2 s c over the next 7 ch loop, repeat from * to end of row. BRACELET BAG Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

8 60-yd Balls China Blue or any Color desired. 9 60-yd. Balls Black or any Contrasting Color. Steel Crochet Hook #4 or #5.

Bag is worked with double strand of thread.

With China Blue, ch 37, d c in 4th st from hook, skip 2 chs, s c in next ch, * ch 2, d c in same space, skip 2 chs, s c in next ch, (a shell) repeat from * across row, ch 3, turn.

2nd Row—D c in last s c of previous row, s c in ch 2 loop, * ch 2, d c in same space, s c in next ch 2 loop, (shell) repeat from * across row, shell in same space with last shell, (an increase) ch 3, turn.

3rd Row-1 shell in each shell, ch 3, turn.

Repeat last 2 rows twice, then work 26 rows even but ch 1 at the end of the 33rd row.

34th Row—SI st to ch 2 loop (a decrease) and work a shell in each shell, ch 3, turn.

Next 3 Rows—1 shell in each shell.

Repeat last 4 rows 6 times, then work 12 rows even, break thread. Work another section in same manner.

With Black, work same as 1st section, then continue working in shell pattern until section measures 17½ inches, break thread.

Work another section in same manner.

Place a Blue and Black section together and starting at bottom of bag sew together for 10 inches on straight edge for center of bag.

Sew other side in same manner, then sew sides together to within 7½ inches of Black section and 4 inches of Blue section. Sew Blue and Black sections together at top. (To close bag insert Black section through Blue). Line bag if desired.

#3511 MOTIF HAT —Continued from page 20 SECTIONS AROUND SQUARES: Ch 43 and work 42 s c on ch, working in back loop of st only, work 12 more rows of s c, decreasing 1 s c at beginning and end of each row, break thread and work 3 more sections.

HEAD BAND: Ch 151 and work 150 s c on ch, join each row and ch 1 to turn each row, working in back loop of st only, work 6 rows of s c even.

8th Row—1 s c in each of first 24 s c, 2 s c in next s c, * 1 s c in each of next 24 s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from * all around and work 2 rows even.

11th Row—Increase in every 26th s c and work 2 rows even, break thread.

TO MAKE HAT: Sew the 4 squares together under the popcorn sts. Starting at one corner working to opposite corner. Sew other sections to squares under the popcorn sts. When all sections are sewed to crown, work 1 row of s c all around, working 1 s c in each s c and 1 s c in each row with 2 s c in corners.

2nd Row—* 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, popcorn st in next s c, repeat from * all around.

3rd Row-1 s c in each s c.

4th Row—Turn and working in back loop of st only, 1 s c

in each s c. Work one more row same as 4th row, break thread. Sew hat band in position under the 3rd row of s c of top section. The straight section is sewed to the 10th row of band and the curved section is graduated from the 10th to the 13th row of band. Line and sew in hat band.

MOTIF BAG Materials Required— MERICAN THREAD COMPA

20 60-yd Balls Red or any Color desired.

1/3 yd. Buckram.

1/3 yd. Lining.

8 inch Zipper.

Steel Crochet Hook #5.

Work 18 squares same as hat #3511 GUSSET: Ch 15 and work 14 s c on ch. Working in back loop of st only work 1 s c in each s c until gusset measures about 24 inches, break thread.

HANDLE: Ch 9 and work in s c until work measures about 30 inches or length desired.

TO MAKE BAG: Sew the squares together in same manner as hat having 9 squares for each side. Starting at top and working all around three sides of side section, sew gusset in position under popcorn sts. Sew handle in position. For lining directions see page 23.

#3501 BUMPER

6 60-yd. Balls Heliotrope or any Color desired.

Cotton or Kapok for Stuffing Roll.

Plastic Bicycle Clip. 3 yds. 1 inch Ribbon.

Steel Crochet Hook #4 or #5.

Hat is worked with double strand of thread.

Ch 3, 8 s d c in 1st st of ch, (s d c: thread over, insert in st, pull through and work off all loops at one time) join in 1st s d c.

2nd Row—Ch 2, 2 s d c in same space, 2 s d c in each remaining st, do not join this or following rows.

3rd Row—Place a marker at beginning of each row, * 2 s d c in next st, 1 s d c in next st, repeat from * all around.

4th Row-Increase in every 3rd st.

5th Row—Increase in every 4th st.

6th to 14th Rows—Continue working in same manner having one more st between each increasing point in each row.

15th Row—1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, * insert needle under next entire s d c, pull thread through and complete s c, repeat from * all around working across the 1st 3 s c, join.

16th Row—Ch 2, 1 s d c in same space, 1 s d c in each remaining s c increasing in every 5th st. Do not join this or following rows.

17th and 18th Rows-1 s d c in each s d c.

19th Row—Increase in every 6th st.

Next 7 Rows—1 s d c in each s d c.

27th Row—Decrease every 6th st (decrease: thread over, insert in st, pull through, insert in next st, pull through and work off all loops at one time).

28th Row—Decrease every 5th st, break thread.

Fill roll with cotton, sew in position to s c row.

Cover plastic bicycle clips with ribbon and sew in position at each side. Finish with bows as illustrated.

BAND BOX

Materials Required— AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

8 60-yd. Balls Heliotrope or any color desired. 1/8 yd. Buckram. 1/8 yd. Lining. 1 yd. 11/2-inch Ribbon. Steel Crochet Hook #5 or #6. Band Box is made with double strand of thread.

BOTTOM: Ch 3, 8 s d c in 1st st of ch, (s d c; thread over, insert in st, pull through and work off all loops at one time) join in 1st s d c.

2nd Row—Ch 2, 2 s d c in same space, 2 s d c in each remaining st. Do not join this or following rows.

3rd Row—* 2 s d c in next st, 1 s d c in next st, repeat from * all around.

4th Row-Increase in every 3rd st.

5th and 6th Rows—Continue working in same manner having one more st between increasing points in each row.

7th Row—Increase in every 3rd st.

8th Row-Increase in every 8th st.

9th Row-Increase in every 9th st.

10th Row-Increase in every 5th st.

11th, 12th and 13th Rows—Same as 5th row.

14th Row—1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, working in back loop of st only, 1 s d c in each remaining s d c, 1 s d c in each of the 3 s c at beginning of row, join in next s d c. 15th Row—Ch 2 and working in both loops of st, s d c in same space, 1 s d c in each remaining st. Do not join this or following rows.

16th Row-1 s d c in each st.

Repeat 16th row 18 times, break thread.

TOP: Work 1st 13 rows same as bottom.

14th Row-Work 1 s d c in each st.

15th Row—Same as 14th row of bottom.

16th Row-Same as 15th row of bottom.

17th, 18th and 19th Rows—1 s d c in each st, break thread.

FINISHING: Cut 2 buckram circles for top of bag. Cut a cardboard circle same size, place between buckram circles and baste. Cut 2 buckram strips same length and width as top of bag. Cut a cardboard same width and length, place between buckram strips and baste together overlapping edge for a seam. Cut lining for top circle slightly larger, baste and sew. Cut lining for band slightly larger and sew, then overcast band and top together on wrong side. Place in crocheted section and stitch. Cut 2 buckram circles about ½ inch smaller than top for bottom of bag. Cut cardboard circle same size and finish as top. Cut 2 buckram strips same width and about 11/4 inches shorter than top band. Cut a cardboard strip same length and width and finish same as top band. Overcast bottom and side section together on wrong side, place in bag an overcast lining in position. Cut two 11/4 inch pieces of ribbon, turn raw edges under and stitch in position to each side of top section. Pull ribbon through and sew in position to each side of bottom section as illustrated.

#3514 LOOP-THE-LOOP SNOOD

Materials Required—
AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
"STAR" PEARL COTTON, SIZE 5

3 60-yd. Balls Lt. Emerald or any Color desired.

14 inches very narrow elastic.

Steel Crochet Hook #5 or #6.

With single strand of thread, ch 1, * pull up about a 3/8 inch loop on hook, thread over and pull through, s c in single loop, (a single knot st) repeat from * 32 times, turn.

2nd Row—S c in 4th s c from hook, * pull up about a 3/8 inch loop on hook, thread over and pull through, s c in single loop, repeat from *, (a double loop knot st) skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, * double loop knot st, skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from * across row, work 3 single loop knot sts, turn.

3rd Row—S c in center s c of double knot st of previous row, * double knot st, s c in next center s c of next double

knot st, repeat from * across row, work 3 single loop knot sts, turn.

Repeat 3rd row 20 times, break thread. Gather at each end. Join thread at side and over elastic work * 5 s c, s c over elastic and into next center s c of double knot st, repeat from * to end gathers, 5 s c over elastic, s c over elastic and into end gathers, 5 s c over elastic, s c over elastic and into next center s c of next double knot st, continue in same manner across remainder of snood, join, break thread.

Band—Ch 125 and work 124 s c on ch, ch 1, turn.

2nd Row—Work 1 loop st in each st, (loop st: wind thread over index finger, insert hook in st, draw thread through pulling thread from under finger, drop loop from finger letting fall to right side of work and complete s c) ch 1, turn.


3rd Row—Work 1 s c in each st, ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows 5 times, break thread.

Sew band to each end of snood.





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LINING AND FINISHING BAGS

Stiffening—When stiffening is required, cut stiffening of buckram or double crinoline or cardboard, the same shape and size of bag before seaming.

Lining—Cut lining same as stiffening, but allow ½ inch on all sides. Place lining over stiffening, turn raw edges over and sew to stiffening. Sew seams of bag, overcast lining edges folding to correspond with bag. Insert lining in bag and sew in position. For bags where stiffening would show on right side, cut lining double, sew seams on 3 sides, slip stiffening into lining, insert into bag adjusting open edge to bag.

Draw String Bags do not require stiffening but may be lined if desired. For flat bottoms, cut stiffening desired size and shape, overcast in position to lining.

Slide Fasteners—Where slide fasteners are required, sew fastener 1/4 inch below top on wrong side before lining, then sew lining about 1/8 inch below fastener.

Steam Bags—Place bag wrong side up, pin flat, place a damp cloth over bag and pass hot iron over cloth (do not allow weight of iron to rest on bag). Let bag dry before finishing.
