Crochet Cotton, Size 25, 1 Ball—and 1 Spool Variegated Silkateen. Start at right side of Slipper. 1st Row—Ch. 14, 3 d.c. start in 4th st. from hook, ch. 2, 3 d.c. in next 3 sts., ch. 1 sk. 1, 2 d.t. in next 2 sts., ch. 6, tn. 2nd Row—1 d.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c. over 1st d.c. bel., ch. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c. over 2 chs. bel., ch. 3, tn. 3rd Row—3 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c. over 1st 3 chs. Same figure over 2nd 3 chs., ch. 1, 2 d.t. over the 6 chs. Increase same way until there




No. 634—Napkin Ring
Cut goods the desired size and hem, sl.st. around.
2nd Row—(Start at pt.) ch. 5, 1 d.c. in next sl.st., ch. 2, 1 d.c. in next sl.st., ch. 2, 1 d.c. in 3rd sl.st., 3 at turn. 3rd Row—10 sl.st. over the next 2 o.m., ch. 6, catch back into 5th sl.st., 10 sl.st. in loop of ch., 10 sl.st., ch. 6, catch back into 5th sl.st., 10 sl.st., 10 sl.st. in loop of ch.


16 of these figures in one r. Ruffle 1st Row-4 sl.st. over each d.t., 4 sl.st. over the 6 chs. 2nd Row-2 d.c. in each st. 3rd Row-1 d.c., ch. 1 over each d. c. 4th Row-Ch. 3 over each d.c. Ornament 1st Row-Ch. 4 form ring, 2 sl.st. in each st. 2nd Row-2 sl.st. in each of these 8 sts. 3rd Row-1 sl.st. in 1st sl.st., 2 sl.st. in 2nd sl.st., 1 sl.st. in each one bel. for next 3 rows. Omit same way as increasing is worked for last 3 rows. Fill out with cotton before closing. Chain with 3 double threads for cordeliere.

Insertion. 1st Row—Ch. 40, 1 d.c. in 4th st. from hook, ch. 1, sk. 2, 3 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c. in 4 sts., * 1 kn.st., sk. 5, 3 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c., in next 4 sts. * rep. once, ch. 1, sk. 1, 2 d.c., ch. 3, tn. 2nd Row—Same as 1st r. 3rd Row—1 d.c. over same, ch. 1, 3 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c. over 2 chs. in center, 1 sl.st. in 6th d.c., 1 kn.st., 1 sl.st. in 1st d.c. of next figure, 3 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c., 1 sl.st. in 6th d.c., 1 kn.st., rep. Finishing Row at Side. 1st Row—3 sl.st. over each r. 2nd Row—4 sl.st. over same, 1 p., 4 sl.st. Insertion will be 15 1-2 in. long and is connected. Thimble Holder. 1st Row—Ch. 7, form ring, 22 d.c. in ring, close. 2nd Row—Ch. 3, 1 sl.st., sk. 1, making 11 l.'s. Continue until there are 8 rows, adding 1 ch. st. in each 1. A double ch. is used for holders. Scissor Holder 1st Row—Ch. 21, form ring, ch. 3, 1 d.c. in each st. 2nd Row—Ch. 3, 1 sl.st., sk. 1, making 10 l.'s. Make 6 rows adding 1 ch. st. in each 1. in last 2 rows. 9th Row—2sl.st., 1 p., 2 sl.st. in each 1. A double ch. is used for holders. Medallion on Wheel 1st Row—Ch. 8, form r., 16 sl.st. in ring. 2nd Row—Ch. 4, sk. 1, 1 d.c., * ch. 4, 1 d.c. in same st., sk. 1, 1 d.c., * 6 times. 3rd Row—1 sl.st., 1 s.c., 5 d.c., 1 s.c., 1 sl.st. over each 4 chs. Pin Cushion—Ch. 44. 1st and 2nd Rows—13 o.m. 3rd Row—4 o.m., 2 s.m., 1 o.m., 2 s.m., 4 o.m. 4th Row—Same as 3rd r. 5th Row—2 o.m., 2 s.m., 1 o.m., 1 s.m., 1 o.m., 1 s.m., 2 o.m. 6th Row—2 o.m., 2 s.m., 1 o.m., 1 s.m., 2 o.m. 7th Row—6 o.m., 1 s.m., 6 o.m. Rep. in opp. direction. Finishing Row. 1st Row—3 sl.st. in each m., add 3 at cor. 2nd Row—4 sl.st. over same, 1 p. Glue 12 small match boxes together, 3 rows of four each. Wind string around, let dry 24 hours. Requires 31-2 yds. ribbon as wide as height of box and 1-2 yd. the length of box. Sew narrow ribbon around each box. Sew on front of box whatever they will contain. Place lining, wide ribbon and insertion around whole case. Glue medallions in front of spools, which are us









4 Balls, Size 10 Cotton. Bottom. 1st Row—Ch. 10, form ring, ch.
3, 28 d.c. in ring, j. 2nd Row—Ch. 5, sk. 1, 3 d. c., * ch. 2, sk. 1, 3
d.c. * 5 times (there must be 3 d.c. 7 times). 3rd Row—Ch. 5, sk. 2
chs., 5 d.c. over 3 d.c. (that is 2 d.c. in 1st and 2 d.c. in last d.c.
bel.), ch. 2, rep. around. 4th Row—Ch. 5, sk. 2 chs., 8 d.c. over 5 d.c.
(that is 2 d. c. in 1st, 3rd and 5th d. c.), ch. 2, rep. 5th Row—Ch. 5,
sk. 2 chs., 10 d.c. over 8 d.c. (that is 2 d.c. in 1st and last d. c. bel.),
ch. 2, rep. In this way 5th r is increased. Continue until 18 rows are
worked. 19th Row—14 o.m. over each one of the 7 parts. 20th Row
—3 sl.st. in each m. Fasten thread. Filet and Upper Part. 1st Row
—6. 56, work 2 rows of 17 o.m. Then follow design. Work the 2
designs 5 times, then 1 r. of 17 o.m., j. Lower Edge. 1st Row—3 d.c.
in each m. 2nd Row—4 d.c. over same, sk. 5th d.c. Sew to bottom.
Upper Part 1st Row—3 d.c. in each one of 4 o.m., 2 d.c. in 5th o.m.
2nd Row—1 d.c. over same. 3rd Row—2 d.c. in one st., ch. 4, sk. 4.
4th Row—Same, placing the 2 d.c. over the 4 chs. Continue until
there are 15 of these rows. Edging. 1st Row—4 d.c. over 4 chs., ch.
2 over 2 d.c. 2nd Row—Ch. 7 going back into 2nd st., ch. 2, 1 sl.st.
over 2 chs., sk. 4 d. c. Cord—Ch. with 3 double thread. Ornaments.
1st Row—Ch. 5, form ring, 2 sl.st. in each st. 2nd Row—2 sl.st. in
each st. Work 7 rows without increasing, fill with cotton, then 2 rows
omitting same way as increasing is made.

1 sl.st. over 1st d.c. of sh.st., ch. 4, 1 sl.st. in
the loose ch.st., ch. 4, 1 sl.st. in last d.c. of last
sh.st., ch. 2, 1 d.c. in 1st d.c. bel., ch. 1, 5 pt.st.
(of 3 d.c. each) over 15 d.c., ch. 4 bet. each,


No. 30 Thread. 1st Row—1 r. of o.m. in linen. 2nd Row—3 sl.st., ch. 1, 3 sl.st. over 1st 2 spaces, sk. 3rd and 4th sps., ch. 6. 3rd Row—14 d.c. over 6 chs., 1 sl.st. over the 1 ch.st. 4th Row—5 sl.st. over 5 d.c. in center of scallop, ch. 7, 1 tr.t. in last sl.st., 5 sl.st. over next scallop. 5th Row—16 d.c. over the 7 chs., 1 sl.st. over 3rd sl.st. bel. 6th Row—2 sl.st. over 3rd and 4th sl.st. bel., 3 d.c., 4 p. with 3 d.c. bet. each over cach 7 chs.

No. 30 Thread. 1st Row—Ch. 52, 1 d.c. in 4th st. from hook, ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 4 d.c. with 2 chs. bet. each in next st., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 o.m., ch. 7 sk. 7. Rep. in opp. direction. At end of r., 2 d.c., ch. 3, tn. 2nd Row—1 d.c. over same, 1 o.m., ch. 3, 1 sl.st. over 5 chs., 4 d.c. in 1st sp., 3 d.c., ch. 1, 3 d.c. in 2nd sp., 4 d.c. in 3rd sp., 1 sl.st. over next 5 chs., ch. 3, 1 o.m., 7 d.c. in (not over) the 7 ch. sts., 1 o.m. Rep. in opp. direction.

NO. 605-MINT BASKET SHOWN ON FRONT COVER.

No. 30 Thread. Upper Part. 1st Row—Ch. 19, 15 d.c. start in 4th st. from hook, ch. 3, tn. 2nd Row—2 d.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, 3 d.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, 4 d.c., ch. 3, tn. 3rd Row—15 d.c., that is 1 d.c. in each st. 4th Row—Same as 2nd r. 5th Row—Same as 3rd r. 6th Row—Same as 2nd r., then *ch. 3, 1 d.c. over the 3 ch.sts. of r. bel. *twice, ch. 3, fasten on 3rd r., ch. 2, fasten again, tn. 7th Row—5 d.c. in 1st, 2nd and 3rd sp., 6 d.c. in 4th sp., 15 d.c., ch. 3, tn. 8th Row—Same as 2nd r., then ch. 2, sk. 2 over scallop, *1 d.t., ch. 3, 1 d.t. in next st., ch. 2, sk. 2, *sk. 3 after 2nd and 4th figure, making 6 figures in all, ch. 2, fasten with 2 sl.st. on 1st r., tn. 9th Row—3 d.c., ch. 3, 3 d.c. over each 3 chs., 1 sl.st. over each 2 chs., ch. 2, 15 d.c. Connect 1st and last little pt. Work 8 scallops for basket. Join and sew to bottom. Bottom 1st Row—Ch. 55, 1 sl.st. in each st., 3 sl.st. in 1st and last ch.st.; going back on other side by working same. 2nd Row—Ch. 1, tn. (The turn-

ing after each r. gives rib effect), 2 sl.st. over same taking up back thread, 3 sl.st. in 3rd sl.st., 1 sl.st. in each st., 3 sl.st. in 3rd last sl.st., 2 sl.st., over same, 3 sl.st. in last sl.st. Rep. same over other side. 3rd Row—Ch. 1, tn., 1 sl.st. over same taking up back thread, 3 sl.st. in center sl.st. of every increasing. Continue until there are 5 of these rows. Now increase in every other r. only until there are 11 r. Fasten thread. Handle. 1st Row—Ch. 11, 2 d.c. start in 4th st. from hook, ch. 2, sk. 2, 3 d.c., ch. 3, tn. 2nd Row—7 d.c., ch. 3, tn. Continue to desired length and sew to basket. Wild Rose—Pink, Green and Yellow Silkateen. Petals of Pink. 1st Row—Ch. 4, 6 d.c. in 1st ch.st. 2nd Row—Ch. 3, 10 d.c. over 6 d.c. 3rd Row—Ch. 3, 6 d.c. over 1st 4 d.c., 2 s.c. over next 2 d.c., 6 d.c. over last 4 d.c., ch. 2, 1 sl.st. in r. bel. Fasten thread. Work 5 of these petals. Calyx of Green. 1st Row—Ch. 4, form ring, 2 sl.st. in each ch.st. 2nd Row—2 sl.st. in each one bel. 3rd Row—1 sl.st. over each one bel. Work 3 more rows without increasing. Center of Yellow. 1st Row—Ch. 4, form ring, 2 sl.st. in each ch.st. 2nd Row—2 sl.st. in each one bel. 3rd Row—1 sl.st. in 1st sl.st., 2 sl.st. in 2nd sl.st. Wind green silkateen over wire for stems, form hook of same, place in calyx, fill out with cotton, place petals around and sew on.






Five Spools White and 1 spool Colored Silkateen. 9-Inch Oval Hoop. 1st Row—Ch. 10, form r., ch. 3, 23 d.c. in r., close. 2nd Row—24 d.c., ch. 1 bet. each. 3rd Row—48 d.c., ch. 1 bet. each. 4th Row—1 d.c. in each st., making 96 d.c. 5th Row—2 d.c., ch. 3, sk. 2, rep. 23 times. 6th Row—8ame as 5th r., increasing 2 d.c. and 3 chs., 3 times, making 2 d.c., 27 times. 7th Row—2 d.c., ch. 3. Do not increase in this r. 8th Row—Increase 2 d.c., 4 times, always increasing in center of increasing bel. (2 d.c., 31 times). 9th Row—2 d.c., 35 times. 10th-11th Rows—(Colored Thread). Same as 9th r. (Do not increase). 12-13-14-15-16th Rows—(White Thread) worked the same but increasing in each r. and ending with the 16th r. of 2 d.c., 46 times. 17th Row—(Colored Thread) 2 d.t., ch. 3, 2 d.t., ch. 8 over every other sp., making 23 of these figures. 18th Row—2 d.t., ch. 3, 2 d.t., ch. 7. 19th Row—2 d.t., ch. 3, 2 d.t., ch. 4 taking up the chs. of the 2 rs. bel. with 1 sl.st., ch. 4. Repeat these 3 rows twice in white; once in blue; then 3 times in white. 1st Upper Row—1 sl.st. over 1st 3 chs., ch. 8 to next 3 chs. 2nd Row—10 sl.st. over each 8 chs. Upper Edge. 1st Row—4 d.c. over same, ch. 2, 8 d.c. in 3rd sp. bel. ch. 2, 2 d.c. Finishing Row.—1st Row—1 sl.st. in 1st 1. of 5 chs., ch. 2, 8 d.c. in 3rd sp. bel. ch. 2, 2 d.c. Finishing Row.—1st Row—1 sl.st. in 1st 1. of 5 chs., ch. 2, 8 d.t. with 1 ch. bet. each in 2nd 1, ch. 2. 2nd Row—Ch. 3 over each d.t. On upper edge, 1 p., 2 sl.st. Wind tape over hoop, sew bag to this. For strings ch. to desired length with double thread, fasten over hoop, then sew edging over it. Tassel—Wind thread over 3 fingers about 28 times, draw last thread thru all with hook, leaving loop on top. Wind thread tightly about 5 times, 1-4 inch from top of tassel and cut.

No. 614—Pin Cushion Top.

1st Row—Ch. 6, form r., ch.
6, 15 d.t. with 2 ch. bet. each
in r. Close. 2nd Row—3 sl.st.
in every sp. 3rd Row—Ch. 5,
3 d.t. in 3 sts. (Keep last loop
of thread on hook, pull thread
thru all), ch. 6, 4 d.t. in next
4 sts., ch. 6, rep. 10 times.
4th Row—9 sl.st. over each l.
5th Row—Work thread up to
center of 1st l., ch. 8, 1 sl.st.
in center of next l., rep. 11
times. 6th Row—Ch. 3, 12
d.c. in each 1. 7th Row—3
d.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, making 3 d.c.
24 times. 8th Row—3 d.c., ch. 3,
3 d.c. over every 4 chs. 10th
Row—3 d.c. over 3 chs. in center, 3 d.c. over 3 chs. in center, 3 d.c. over 3 chs. in center
(making 12 d.c. and 3 chs). 11th Row
—1 d. c. over each one bel., 3
d.c., ch. 3, 3 d.c. over 3 chs.
in center (making 18 d.c. in
this r.). 12th Row—10 p. over
18 d.c. Connect 11th p. with
2nd one; this forms upper pt.

No. 636—Match Holder

Requires 1 Ball Size 30 Cotton and An Egg Beater. Center of Spoon. 1st Row—Tie thread close to handle, ch. 5, 1 sl.st. around wire, ch. 5, 1 sl.st. around wire, ch. 5, 1 sl.st. around wire, continue around. Make 6 rows same as 1st row, using a sl.st. in center of each ch. 8th Row—Ch. 4, 1 sl.st. in center. 9th Row—Same. 10th Row—Ch. 3, 1 sl.st. in center. 11th Row—Same. 12th Row—Ch. 2, 1 sl.st. in center, ch. 1, sl.st. on both sides bringing both sides together. Outside of Wire. 1st Row—Tie thread at top, ch. 3, 1 sl.st. all around. 2nd Row—Ch. 3, 1 d.c. in loop of ch., 2 d.c. in same loop, ch. 1, 1 d.c. in next loop, ch. 1, 2 d.c. in next loop, ch. 2, 2 d.c. in same loop, rep. around. 3rd Row—Ch. 3, 2 d.c. in the center of the 2 ch., ch. 2, 3 d.c. in same place, ch. 1, 3 d.c. in the 2 chs. of next loop, ch. 2, 3 d.c. in same place, rep. around. 4th Row—Ch. 5, 1 sl.st. under the 2 chs., ch. 5, 1 sl.st. in same place, ch. 5, 1 sl.st. bet. next shell, rep. around. Band. 1st Row—Ch. 3, 1 sl.st., ch. 3, 1 sl.st., ch. 5, tn. 2nd Row—Ch. 3, 1 sl.st., ch. 5, tn. Continue until length desired.
